• UTSA's 25-12 start to the season is tied for the second best start in program history through 33 games. The 1994 team started 24-9 and advanced to UTSA's first-ever NCAA Regional (Austin, Texas) while 2006 squad finished 37-22. The 2008 team also started the year 22-11. The '94 and '08 teams share the program record for total wins in a season at 39.

• Senior 1B Mike Warren had his career-high 30-game consecutive reached base streak snapped in Tuesday's win over Texas State. The San Antonio native has now reached base safely in all but two games this season.

UTSA looks to emerge from three-way second place tie at Old Dominion

UTSA BRIEF: UTSA will return to Conference USA action this weekend when it travels to Norfolk, Va., to face Old Dominion. The Roadrunners (25-12, 10-5 C-USA), who have won six of their last nine outings, enter the weekend in a three-way tie for second place in the league standings with Southern Mississippi and UAB. UTSA scored six runs in the eighth inning to rally for a 7-2 victory against I-35 rival Texas State on Tuesday night.

SERIES HISTORY: UTSA will be meeting the Monarchs for the first-time ever. It will also be the Roadrunners first meeting with a team from the state of Virginia. The two campuses are separated by 1,590 miles, equivalent to a 25 hour drive. A road trip from the Alamo City to Norfolk, Va. would take you through Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina and finally Virginia.

SCOUTING OLD DOMINION

The Monarchs (22-15, 10-8 C-USA) also have won six of their past nine games following last weekend's series win against East Carolina.

Old Dominion, which sports a .284 team batting average, is led by P.J. Higgins, who is hitting at a .346 clip.

The Monarchs and Roadrunners have strikingly similar profiles in that both offenses hit above .280 and have a penchant for extra-base hits in addition to a nearly 2-to-1 walk/strikeout ratio.

On the mound both teams are similar in hits allowed, WHIP and batting average against.

HOME COOKING

The Roadrunners have played 25 of their 37 games at home this season and have only left the state of Texas for a pair of three-game series at Southern Miss and Tulane. UTSA has a 18-7 record at Roadrunner Field.

SQUAD BREAKDOWN

Among the 31 players on the Roadrunners' roster, 28 hail from Texas. Only Tony Ramirez (Ferndale, Mich.), Andre Vieyra (Valley Center, Kan.), and Jeremy Filipek (Langley, B.C.) come from outside the Lone Star State. There are (8) seniors, (12) juniors, (4) sophomores, and (7) freshmen.

MULTI-HIT BARRAGE

Senior left fielder Tony Ramirez has multiple hits in his last four games to break into double digits in the category this season. Ramirez joins six other Roadrunners with double digit multi-hit games with RJ Perucki and Horacio Correa III leading the way with 16 apiece.

EIGHTH INNING IS WINNING TIME

UTSA has outscored its opponents 43-14 this season in the eighth inning. In Tuesday night's 7-6 victory over Texas State the Birds scored six runs in the eighth to upend a 2-1 deficit.

BASES CHUCKED

UTSA has been outstanding this season with the bases loaded going 25-for-56 (.446). Mike Warren has done the most damaged in the situation with six hits in 11 opportunities (.545).

RECEIVING VOTES

UTSA is now receiving votes in the NCBWA (National Collegiate Baseball Writer's Association) national poll. The Roadrunners are one of 26 teams in the receiving votes category outside the Top-30 poll voted on weekly.

After serving as an assistant and associate head coach at UTSA for 12 years, Jason Marshall just completed his first season as the head coach of the Roadrunners baseball program. Marshall was named the fourth skipper in UTSA baseball history on June 18, 2012.

In his first year at the helm, Marshall guided the Birds to a 35-25 overall record and their third appearance in an NCAA Regional after the club captured the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Tournament Championship. UTSA, which posted a perfect 4-0 record en route to the league title, was sent to the Corvallis (Ore.) Regional and took No. 3 national seed Oregon State to its last at-bat before the Beavers rallied for a 5-4 victory. The Roadrunners wrapped up their first postseason run in eight years the following day with a 6-1 loss to Texas A&M.

Three UTSA players — Daniel Rockett (ninth round/Kansas City Royals), Riley Good (14th round/Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim) and Clint Sharp (38th round/Angels) — were drafted after the campaign concluded, while right-handed pitcher Brock Hartson was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball. Third baseman RJ Perucki earned first-team all-league honors, while Good, Hartson and Rockett garnered second-team accolades.

In their first and only season in the WAC, the Roadrunners led the circuit with a .299 batting average and 629 hits. Perucki (.350/fifth) and Good (.335/ninth) both ranked among the top 10 batting averages in the league and the duo tied for second in the WAC with 84 hits apiece. Perucki also finished second in the circuit with 132 total bases and third with 12 home runs, while Rockett's .562 slugging percentage was good for third.

Marshall spent 12 years on the Roadrunners' coaching staff before being promoted to head coach, including nine as the associate head coach from 2004-12.

The Abilene native was hired at UTSA prior to the 2001 season and spent three campaigns as an assistant before being promoted to associate head coach. He served as both the infielders coach and recruiting coordinator while running the Roadrunners' summer camps.

A standout performer at Texas A&M from 1989-92, he was named the Aggies' Most Valuable Player after leading the team in games played (61), hits (66), runs scored (35) and RBIs (40) as a senior.

Following his collegiate career, he was drafted by the Royals in the 13th round of the 1992 MLB Draft. Marshall went on to play four seasons in the Royals organization before finishing his professional career in 1995.

Marshall earned a bachelor of science degree in kinesiology from Texas A&M in 1996. His wife, Ashleigh, have two sons, Cooper and Jackson, and a daughter, Kate.
