

UTSA NOTES

MORE ON THE SERIES

UTSA and Texas Tech will be meeting for the seventh and eighth times on Tuesday with the Red Raiders holding a 5-1 advantage. The two clubs split a doubleheader in 2009, which marked the only win for the Roadrunners in the all-time series.

LAST TIME OUT

UTSA completed a series sweep of Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on Sunday by erasing an 8-0 deficit and winning 14-10 behind the strength of four home runs. Last weekend's sweep also marked the Roadrunners first series win of the 2011 season.

MORE ON LAST WEEKEND'S SWEEP

The UTSA offense was perfectly in tune in the three-game set with Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. The Roadrunner bats knocked around Islander pitchers for a .390 batting average. UTSA posted 46 hits, including 18 extra-base knocks, while scoring 35 runs. The Birds connected for seven home runs and slugged .686 in the series.

ON DECK

Following Tuesday's doubleheader, the Roadrunners will continue its road swing with a three-game series at Stephen F. Austin this weekend.

HUTSON NAMED SLC HITTER OF THE WEEK

Senior infielder Ryan Hutson was named the Southland Conference Hitter of the Week after batting .571 and slugging .929. He swatted a pair of doubles, a two-run homer, drove in four and stole a base while leading UTSA to a 4-0 record during the week.

TURNING TWO

As of April 4, UTSA was the nation's leader in double plays. The Roadrunners have turned 39 double plays prior to Tuesday's game. The oddest double play completed by UTSA was of the 9-4-2 variety, coming against UT Arlington on March 18. The Roadrunners turned a season-high three double plays against Houston on March 1.

To date, 90 of UTSA's 160 runs (56%) this season have been scored by underclassmen. Sophomores have crossed home plate 49 times (31%), while freshmen (including two redshirt freshmen) have scored 41 times (25%).

DOUBLE DIGITS

The Roadrunners have recorded 10 or more hits in 11 games this season. UTSA's season high is 19 hits, which occurred twice (last on April 1 vs. Texas A&M-Corpus Christi).

REACHING BASE SAFELY

Freshman outfielder Riley Good has an impressive current streak going. The Godley native has reached base safely in 20 consecutive games, the longest of any UTSA player this season.

HUTSON SECOND IN UTSA CAREER HOME RUNS

Senior infielder Ryan Hutson moved into second place on the all-time Roadrunners home run list after hitting his second home run of the game against Southeastern Louisiana on March 12. Hutson currently has 41 home runs and trails only Jeff Juarez (47) for the all-time home run title at UTSA.

WALTON NAMED SLC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

On March 21, senior right-hander Taylor Walton was named the Southland Conference Pitcher of the Week. The Midland native appeared in two games during the week prior to the voting period and helped the Roadrunners snap a seven-game losing streak by tossing his second career complete game in a 4-1 victory over UT Arlington on March 19.

CONTINUING THE TWO-WAY TREND

Junior utility man Casey Selsor is continuing to perform as a true two-way player for the Roadrunners. Selsor has made six starts on the mound, posting an 1-3 record with a 5.03 ERA. When not pitching, Selsor has split time

between first base and right field, recording a .292 batting average (26-for-89) with seven doubles, a triple and nine RBIs.

ROCKETT TAKING OFF

Sophomore center fielder Daniel Rockett is looking to ride the momentum from summer ball into the 2011 season. Rockett won the Hawai'i Collegiate Summer Baseball League Most Valuable Player award after leading the Waikiki Surfers to the league title. Following the season, he was named the No. 5 prospect in the HCBL by *Baseball America*.

CARPENTER DRIVING IN THE RUNS

Senior outfielder Tyler Carpenter leads all UTSA players with five multi-RBI contests this season. Carpenter recorded a four-RBI game against Oregon State on Feb. 28. He also has four games with two RBIs.

DALTON NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-SOUTHLAND SECOND TEAM

Sophomore third baseman Ryan Dalton was named to the Preseason All-Southland Second Team. The Sugar Land, Texas, native recorded UTSA frosh records a year ago with 17 home runs (t-No. 2 in NCAA among all freshman) and 51 RBIs.

LANGLEY AMONG TOP NEWCOMERS IN SOUTHLAND CONFERENCE

Junior right-handed pitcher Jordan Langley comes into the 2011 season as the No. 3 top newcomer according to *Baseball America*. Langley transferred to UTSA from Marion Military Institute in Alabama, which competed in the Alabama Community College Conference.
