- The Roadrunners are 10-2 in series openers this season. They are 7-1 in home series openers and 3-1 on the road.

- Senior first baseman Mike Warren leads UTSA in both multi-hit and multi-RBI games this season. The San Antonio native is tied with Horacio Correa III with 20 multi-hit efforts while leading the Roadrunners with 14 multi-RBI games.

- With Logan Kinder's inside-the-park home run on Friday night against Rice, the Roadrunners have now had two round-trippers this season stay inside the yard. Mike Warren also had an inside-the-park home run against Lamar on Apr. 29.

Roadrunners close out regular season play at East Carolina

UTSA BRIEF: UTSA (31-22, 15-12 C-USA) will embark on its final regular season voyage Thursday beginning a three-game series at East Carolina. The final regular season stop has postseason implications as both the Roadrunners and Pirates are in the thick of the projected Conference USA Tournament field.

SERIES HISTORY: This will be the first-ever meeting between the two programs. A road trip from San Antonio to Greenville, North Carolina registers at 1,480 miles and would take approximately 23 hours by car. On the trip you would pass through Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia, South Carolina and North Carolina.

SCOUTING EAST CAROLINA

The Pirates dropped two-of-three games at Southern Miss this past weekend before defeating High Point on Tuesday.

Senior DH/RHP Drew Reynolds was extremely busy during the series with the Golden Eagles, registering 12-at bats in three games as a hitter and posting both a win and a loss as a pitcher in Saturday's doubleheader.

The 7-5 victory in 15 innings in game one Saturday matched the longest game in ECU school history, set twice previously. Senior 3B Zach Houchins, who had four hits and scored the game-winner in game one, finished the weekend 7-for-14 (.500) with a home run, two RBI and three runs scored.

Junior RHP Jeff Hoffman, who ranks among the C-USA leaders in strikeouts with 72, will undergo season-ending surgery this week. He posted a 3-3 record with a 2.94 ERA in 10 starts this season.

The Pirates have played a league-high 20 one-run games in 2014, posting a 12-8 record in those outings. The 12 wins are second only to Florida (14) among Division I schools.

HOME COOKING

The Roadrunners have played 33 of their 53 games at home this season and have only left the state of Texas for four separate three-game series at Southern Miss, Tulane, Old Dominion and Middle Tennessee. UTSA has a 21-12 record at Roadrunner Field.

SQUAD BREAKDOWN

Among the 31 players on the Roadrunners' roster, 28 hail from Texas. Only Tony Ramirez (Ferdale, Mich.), Andre Vieyra (Valley Center, Kan.), and Jeremy Filipek (Langley, B.C.) come from outside the Lone Star State. There are (8) seniors, (12) juniors, (4) sophomores, and (7) freshmen.

MULTI-HIT BARRAGE

UTSA currently has seven players who have 10 or more multi-hit games in 2014. Horacio Correa III and Mike Warren lead the way with 20 such contests. Jesse Baker has the most games with at least three hits with seven and John Welborn has a pair of four-hit games on his resume.

SHUT IT DOWN

UTSA is the only C-USA team with two players ranked in the top-10 in saves. Logan Onda leads the way with seven and Matt Sims has added five more this spring. Sims is ranked second in program history with 20 career saves.

COMPLETE GAMES IN A SERIES

Brock Hartson and Justin Anderson threw complete games at Tulane to bookend a series victory over the Green Wave. It is believed to be the first time in program history that two UTSA hurlers have gone the distance in the same three-game series. Hartson also went the distance in Friday's 4-2 victory over Rice.

LONG BALLS GALORE

In UTSA's eight-run third inning at Middle Tennessee on May 3 the Roadrunners hit two home runs, a three-run shot by Mike Warren and a grand slam by C.J. Pickering. It was the first time since May 17, 2013 at Louisiana Tech that the Roadrunners had two round trippers in the same inning.

GRAND SALAMI

Pickering's grand slam is UTSA's third this season joining Tony Ramirez and RJ Perucki for the team-lead with one apiece. It is the most grand slams in a season for a UTSA team since the 2008 team also had three.

JASON MARSHALL
Head Coach
Second season/14th at UTSA
Texas A&M, 1996

After serving as an assistant and associate head coach at UTSA for 12 years, Jason Marshall just completed his first season as the head coach of the Roadrunners baseball program. Marshall was named the fourth skipper in UTSA baseball history on June 18, 2012.

In his first year at the helm, Marshall guided the Birds to a 35-25 overall record and their third appearance in an NCAA Regional after the club captured the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Tournament Championship. UTSA, which posted a perfect 4-0 record en route to the league title, was sent to the Corvallis (Ore.) Regional and took No. 3 national seed Oregon State to its last at-bat before the Beavers rallied for a 5-4 victory. The Roadrunners wrapped up their first postseason run in eight years the following day with a 6-1 loss to Texas A&M.

Three UTSA players — Daniel Rockett (ninth round/Kansas City Royals), Riley Good (14th round/Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim) and Clint Sharp (38th round/Angels) — were drafted after the campaign concluded, while right-handed pitcher Brock Hartson was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball. Third baseman RJ Perucki earned first-team all-league honors, while Good, Hartson and Rockett garnered second-team accolades.

In their first and only season in the WAC, the Roadrunners led the circuit with a .299 batting average and 629 hits. Perucki (.350/fifth) and Good (.335/ninth) both ranked among the top 10 batting averages in the league and the duo tied for second in the WAC with 84 hits apiece. Perucki also finished second in the circuit with 132 total bases and third with 12 home runs, while Rockett's .562 slugging percentage was good for third.

Marshall spent 12 years on the Roadrunners' coaching staff before being promoted to head coach, including nine as the associate head coach from 2004-12.

The Abilene native was hired at UTSA prior to the 2001 season and spent three campaigns as an assistant before being promoted to associate head coach. He served as both the infielders coach and recruiting coordinator while running the Roadrunners' summer camps.

A standout performer at Texas A&M from 1989-92, he was named the Aggies' Most Valuable Player after leading the team in games played (61), hits (66), runs scored (35) and RBIs (40) as a senior.

Following his collegiate career, he was drafted by the Royals in the 13th round of the 1992 MLB Draft. Marshall went on to play four seasons in the Royals organization before finishing his professional career in 1995.

Marshall earned a bachelor of science degree in kinesiology from Texas A&M in 1996. His wife, Ashleigh, have two sons, Cooper and Jackson, and a daughter, Kate.
