DU on ALTITUDE: The Pioneers will six make appearances on Altitude TV. Todd Romero (Play-byplay) will be back for a sixth season.

Denver head coach Rodney Billups and selected players will be available for interviews. Media requests for both Denver and opposing coaches and players should be made to the DU men's basketball SID. Opponent requests will be forwarded to the visiting SID. The DU men's basketball locker room is closed to the media.

Camera Procedures: Photographers must work within the designated areas. Photographers may shoot from the right side of each end line of Magness Arena. Requests to photograph from any other location must be made in advance to the University of Denver Athletic Media Relations Department. The University of Denver reserves the right to accept or reject credential requests.

Radio: All radio stations wishing to broadcast from Hamilton Gymnasium should contact the University of Denver Athletic Communications Office at least one week prior to the event. Last Time Out

- Denver dropped its first contest of the season this past Friday, losing 72-71 to Ottawa (Ariz.).
- The Pioneers were led by KJ Hunt, who had a game-high 23 points.
- Touko Tainamo had a career-best 13 points off the bench.
- Jordan Johnson continued to his solid play from the guard position, scoring 12 points and handing out four assists.
- Tevin Smith and Payton Moore each added 10 points.

About Denver

- The Pioneers are averaging 69.5 points per game this year fifth in the Summit League.
- Denver is allowing 68.5 points per game on the season, fourth in the Summit League.
- DU is shooting 44.8 percent from the field, second in the Summit League last season.
- Denver is doing a good job holding the opponents to tough shots, allowing 41.3 percent shooting, fourth in the Summit League.
- The Pioneers rank second in the Summit League in steals per game, swiping 9.5 a night.
- The Crimson and Gold rank fourth in the Summit League at getting to the line, earning 17 attempts a game.
- DU ranks fifth in the Summit League in 3-point percentage at 31.6 percent in 2020-21.
- The Pioneers lead the Summit League in 3-point defense, allowing just a 21.7 percent make rate.
- KJ Hunt leads the team in scoring at 20.0 points per game, good for first in the Summit League.
- Payton Moore leads the team in rebounding, ripping down 7.0 boards a contest, 11th in the Summit League.
- Jordan Johnson ranks first in the Summit League in assists per game, handing out 4.0 a game.
- Moore is second in the Summit League in free throw attempts with 12.
- Johnson and Moore rank second in the Summit League in steals per game with a 2.5 average.

• Freshman Tevin Smith was named in the preseason as one of the top impact newcomers in the NCAA this by ESPN. com

- Smith, who hails from Danville, Ill., is the highest rated recruit to sign out of high school in program history.
- Smith was ranked as the No. 8 overall player in the state of Illinois last year and the No. 2 player at his position.

It's Time

- Head coach Jeff Wulbrun begins a new era for Pioneer Basketball.
- Wulbrun enters his first season in charge in 2021-22.
- Wulbrun spent the past seasons at Stanford as an assistant and associate head coach under Jerrod Haase.

• With Stanford, Wulbrun helped land back-to-back-to-back top-tier recruiting classes, including top-10 classes in 2017 and 2020.

• Prior to working at Stanford, Wulbrun was with Haase at UAB, where helped guide the team to an NCAA Tournament appearance and win in 2015, the first in a decade for the program.

• Wulbrun has also worked on a coaching staff at Virigina Tech (2011-12), Illinois State (1993-97) and California (1986-93).

We Want To Be An Elite-Level Defensive Team

• Denver has been a tough team to beat when it dials up the defense over the years.

• The Pioneers have a 44-29 (.602) record, 1-1 under Wulbrun, since 2016 when allowing 78 or fewer points in a contest.

Welcome to the New Age

- Denver features a whole new look in 2021-22 with nine new players.
- The Pioneers have added three graduate transfers in KJ Hunt, Payton Moore and Michael Henn.

• Hunt, a Little Rock, Ark. native, brings veteran experience after a tournament as the starting point guard at Morehead State last season.

• Moore joins the Crimson and Gold after spending the past three seasons at Rice University.

• Henn brings an outside shooting touch and size to the frontcourt, spending last season at Portland in the West Coast Conference.

• DU adds its first-ever JUCO All-American signing in Jordan Johnson from Hinds Community College.

• Johnson scored a team-best 20.8 points last year at Hinds CC while handing out 7.0 assists and was named NJCAA Second Team All-American.

- Denver adds five freshman in Coban Porter, Tevin Smith, Touko Tainamo, Felipe Motta and Pedro Lopez-Sanvicente.
- Porter comes from a basketball royality, with brothers Michael Jr. and Jontay playing the NBA.




• Smith, a Danville, Ill. native, is the highest rated recruit to sign with the Pioneers out of high school according a 247 sports.


• Tainamo brings a toughness and size down on the low block after playing in Helsinki, Finland, where he was the captain of the U20 National Team.

MAXIMIZING THE BUZZ

The buzz Oral Roberts' junior Max Abmas created in March during his squad's run to the Sweet 16 is carrying over to November as he the Rockwall, Texas native has been named a presason All-American by three publications and on the watch lists for the NABC Player of the Year, the Jersey Mikes Naismith Player of the Year and Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year.

CAN THE JACKS MAKE IT EIGHT STRAIGHT?

SDSU has won at least a share of seven of the last eight regular season titles, including five straight. Third-year head Eric Henderson is 2-for-2 in terms of regular season titles after his squad won nine of 12 league contests during a 2021 league slate that saw four of the Jackrabbits' games cancelled by Covid-19.

SWEET RUN

Oral Roberts became the third Summit League team to reach the Sweet 16 in 2021 and the lowest seed to ever do so after the 15th-seeded Golden Eagles beat No. 2 Ohio State and No. 7 Florida before falling to No. 3 Arkansas by two points in the South Regional semifinal, 72-70.

NOTING THE PIONEERS

• The Pioneers are under the direction of first-year head coach Jeff Wilbrun, who is the only new coach among the league's 10 members this season.

• The former Stanford assistant has nine newcomers on his first DU roster, joining six returners.

• Senior Tristan Green is one of two returning starters Wilbrun inherits. He is the team's top returning scorer (5.9/g) and rebounder (4.6/g).

• Transfer K.J. Hunt started an NCAA Tournament game for Morehead State last season and will look to have an immediate impact on the program. Hunt averaged 6.9 ppg a year ago in 24 starts.



JEFF WULBRUN Head Coach • First Season Cypress, Calif. Cal State Fullerton (1984)

Head coach Jeff Wulbrun enters his first season as the leader of the men's basketball program in 2021-22.

Wulbrun, who owns nearly three decades of experience as a basketball coach, spent the past five seasons at Stanford. After serving the first two years as an assistant coach, Wulbrun was elevated to the James C. Gaither Associate Head Coach of Men's Basketball prior to the 2018-19 season.

Working directly with the Cardinal forwards and centers, post play has been one of Wulbrun's specialties for over 30 years. He has developed a plethora of All-Pac-12 performers at Stanford, including Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey, who formed one of the top tandems in the conference, Josh Sharma, who excelled at his highest level during his senior season, and Oscar da Silva, who has emerged as a player who can work both the low and high post and take his opponents off the dribble. All four players feature heavily in the Cardinal record books.

Wulbrun also oversees Stanford's scheduling, where he has secured home games against some of the top programs in the nation, with both North Carolina (2017) and Kansas (2019), among others, visiting Maples Pavilion. A force in recruiting, Wulbrun has helped Stanford land backto-back-to-back top-tier recruiting classes, including top-10 classes in 2017 and 2020.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04 and was led by junior Oscar da Silva (All-Pac-12 first team, 15.7 ppg, 6.4 rpg) and Tyrell Terry (All-Pac-12 honorable mention, 14.6 ppg, 4.5 rpg, 3.2 apg), who emerged as one of the nation's top freshmen.

The 2018-19 team won 15 games, and was led by NBA Draft choice KZ Okpala, who went to the Miami Heat. He joined over 30 players under Wulbrun that have gone on to professional careers, including NBA All-Stars Jason Kidd and Kevin Johnson. He also served as an assistant coach for the gold-medal-winning United States at the Maccabi Games in 2019 in Budapest, Hungary.

In Wulbrun's second season, Stanford won 19 games overall and returned to the postseason for the first time in three years. Stanford finished third in the Pac-12 standings and won 11 conference games in 2017-18, its best finish and most conference wins in 10 years. The '17-18 team posted its highest scoring average (75.9 ppg) in 16 seasons, and led the conference in rebounding (39.1 rpg).

Wulbrun has been a member of Haase's staff each of the last eight seasons at both Stanford and UAB. Wulbrun's relationship with Haase dates back nearly three decades when he first recruited and signed Haase as a member of the California coaching staff.

Over a successful coaching career that spans 30 years (20 years in college and 10 in high school), Wulbrun has helped guide three different collegiate programs – California, Illinois State and UAB – to the NCAA Tournament.

At each stop, Wulbrun has played a key role in bringing in highly-regarded recruiting classes, highlighted by top-10 classes at Stanford in 2017 and 2020, a top-30 class with the Cardinal in 2018 and a top-five class at California that included Haase and Jason Kidd. At UAB, Wulbrun was responsible for landing the top recruiting class in Conference USA. Known for identifying and recruiting international talent, Wulbrun has helped bring in top prospects from Australia, Germany and Lithuania to Stanford.

At UAB, Wulbrun was part of a coaching staff that guided the Blazers to 80 wins in the four-year span, including the 2016 Conference USA regular-season championship and the 2015 conference tournament title. In 2015, UAB earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 2011 and captured the Blazers' first win in the NCAAs since 2005. The Blazers' 26 wins in 2015-16 were a school record. He recruited and helped develop UAB all-conference selections Chris Cokley and William Lee during his time with the Blazers. Lee finished his career as UAB's all-time leader in blocked shots (291) and Cokley completed his career third in UAB history in career scoring with 1,660 points.

Before reuniting with Haase at UAB, Wulbrun served on the staff at Virginia Tech (2011-12), Illinois State (1993-97) and California (1986-93).

A Cypress, California, native, Wulbrun was an assistant coach at California under Lou Campanelli for seven seasons, helping lead the Golden Bears to five postseason appearances. During his time in Berkeley, Wulbrun helped sign Haase out of South Lake Tahoe High School, along with Jason Kidd and Lamond Murray. Wulbrun also coached three-time NBA All-Star Kevin Johnson, who served eight years as the Mayor of Sacramento.

Wulbrun helped lead Illinois State to three postseason appearances, including the 1997 Missouri Valley Conference regular-season and tournament title and berth in the NCAA Tournament in his four seasons with the Redbirds. He was also was active in real estate sales and development in Illinois. He was appointed the Chief Operating Officer of Distinctive Designs, a residential construction company, in 1998.

During his seven successful years in the business world, Wulbrun also served as the head coach of Central Catholic High School in Bloomington, Illinois. He developed Central Catholic into one of the top high school programs in Illinois.

Wulbrun jumped back into collegiate coaching full time in 2011, working with Seth Greenberg at Virginia Tech for one season. He then reunited with Haase on his staff at UAB, when Haase was named the head coach of the Blazers in 2012.

Wulbrun holds a bachelor of arts in communications from Cal State Fullerton (1984). He and his wife, Jennie, are the proud parents of daughter, Kendall, and son, Jared. Kendall attended TCU, and is now the assistant director of admissions at Santa Clara University, and Jared attends Purdue University, where he is a member of the men's basketball team. Jennie works as a programs & events manager for the Positive Coaching Alliance.
