### **Fast Break Points**

- UTSA will hit the road for the first time this season when it heads west for a matchup at Northern Arizona at 8:30 p.m. (CT) on Wednesday, Dec. 3.
- This will be the second meeting between the Roadrunners and Lumberjacks. Northern Arizona opened the 2013-14 season with a 74-63 win at UTSA on Nov. 9, 2013.
- UTSA comes into Wednesday's game averaging 76.6 points per game, a mark that leads Conference USA and ranks 55th in the nation. The Roadrunners have three players averaging in double figures and five that average at least 9.0 ppg.
- Ryan Bowie led UTSA in Sunday's loss to Southern Utah with a season-high 29 points, which is the fourth-best individual scoring output by a Conference USA player this season. He ranks among the league's top 15 in six different categories.
- Jeromie Hill leads the team and ranks seventh in C-USA at 16.4 ppg, while his 8.2 rebounds per outing rank fourth. He has scored in double figures in each of his last 13 games dating back to the 2012-13 season.
- With 82 points in the first five games of the season, Hill moved past Leon Watson (1996-2000) and into seventh place on the school's career scoring charts. Now with 1,277 points, he needs 30 points to tie McEverett Powers (1998-2002)
- Wednesday's game can be heard live in the San Antonio area on Ticket 760 AM beginning with the pregame show at 8 p.m. (CT). Andy Everett (play-by-play) has the call. The broadcast also can be heard live online at goUTSA.com or on your mobile device with the free iHeartRadio app.

#### **Media Policy**

All interviews with student-athletes and coaches must be arranged at least 24 hours in advance by contacting the UTSA Athletics Communications Office. Telephone interviews are available on a "call-back" basis only at a time that is convenient for the student-athlete or coach. Telephone numbers will not be given out to members of the media under any conditions. Postgame interviews will be conducted courtside following a 10-minute "cooling off" period. The UTSA locker room is closed to the media. Most practices are open to the media and public. We request media members contact Assistant Athletics Communications Director Jordan Korphage at least 24 hours in advance for practice times/dates and interview requests. In most cases, student-athletes and coaches will be made available after practice.

Scouting Northern Arizona: Third-year head coach Jack Murphy returned four starters and eight letterwinners from last year's team that went 15-17 overall and tied for second in the Big Sky Conference with a 12-8 mark. Among the returners is leading scorer Quinton Upshur, who paces the squad at 13.4 ppg. The 6-5 senior guard, who was the league's newcomer of the year and first-team all-conference in 2013-14, is shooting 42.5 percent from the field and 40 percent behind the arc. The only other player averaging in double figures is 6-4 guard Kris Yanku. The Chatsworth, Calif., native has come off the bench in all seven games this season and is averaging 10.6 points while shooting 46.3 percent from the floor. The Lumberjacks will be playing just their second home game when they host UTSA on Wednesday night and it will be their first contest of the season in the Skydome. Northern Arizona, which was picked to finish third in the league, defeated Fresno State in its only other home game before a neutral-court win over Southern last weekend. The squad has suffered defeats at Xavier, Toledo, Ole Miss and Middle Tennessee along with a neutral-court loss to North Carolina Central.

**Series History:** Wednesday's game will mark just the second all-time meeting between UTSA and Northern Arizona. The Lumberjacks took a 74-63 win on Nov. 9, 2013, in San Antonio to open the 2013-14 season. The Roadrunners will be facing their second consecutive Big Sky opponent after dropping a 93-92 heartbreaker to Southern Utah on Sunday. UTSA is 6-5 all-time against current members of the Big Sky.

**Last Meeting:** Hyjii Thomas finished with a then-career-high 17 points, but Northern Arizona put together a 17-2 run in the second half to pull away for a 74-63 victory to open the 2013-14 season on Nov. 9, 2013, at the Convocation Center. Thomas connected on four field goals and was 9-of-11 from the free-throw line to lead the Roadrunners. The senior played 39 minutes and added six rebounds, a pair of assists, two steals and a block to his stat line. Keon Lewis came off the bench to connect on six of his seven attempts from the floor and registered all 15 of his points in the second half. Fellow newcomer Kaj-Björn Sherman added eight points off the bench for UTSA, which shot 60 percent (15-of-25) in the second half and 42.9 percent for the game. Max Jacobsen and Aaseem Dixon scored 17 points apiece to lead the Lumberjacks.

Last Time Out: A.J. Hess hit a 35-footer at the buzzer, one of four triples for Southern Utah in the final minute, to push the visiting Thunderbirds to a 93-92 victory at UTSA on Sunday afternoon at the Convocation Center. Ryan Bowie led five Roadrunners in double figures with 29 points on 10-of-18 shooting, including a pair of 3-pointers and seven free throws. Jeromie Hill nearly finished with his third double-double of the season with 17 points and nine rebounds, while Kaj-Björn Sherman tied a career high with 16 points. Keon Lewis added 15 points and Larry Lewis Jr. chipped in 11 and a season-high six assists in the losing effort. UTSA shot 50.9 percent for the game and held a 36-28 edge in the paint, but it shot just 60.9 percent from the free-throw line. UTSA led 87-81 with a minute left, but Southern Utah hit four of its final five shots, all from behind the arc, and the Roadrunners missed three free throws to leave the door open for the Thunderbirds.

**Coming Home:** A total of seven players will get a homecoming of sorts this week as the Roadrunners play at Northern Arizona (Dec. 3) and Washington State (Dec. 6). UTSA has four players that hail from the Grand Canyon State including Larry Lewis Jr. (Scottsdale), Gino Littles (Phoenix), George Matthews (Phoenix) and Lucas O'Brien (Chandler), while Edwin Olympio attended Westwind Prep Academy in Phoenix last season. In addition, Keon Lewis (Seattle) and Kaj-Björn Sherman (Mercer Island) will return to their home state of Washington when the Roadrunners meet the Cougars.

**Scoring More:** Heading into Wednesday's game, UTSA leads C-USA teams and ranks 55th in the nation in scoring by averaging 76.6 ppg. The Roadrunners feature three of the league's top 11 scorers and have five players averaging at least 9.0 ppg. The group is led by senior Jeromie Hill, who ranks sixth in the league at 16.4 ppg and is joined by Ryan Bowie (8th/15.8 ppg) and Keon Lewis (11th/14.8 ppg) among the league's best. In addition, freshmen Larry Lewis Jr. and Christian Wilson average at least 9.0 ppg, as well. Bowie and Lewis have produced two of the highest individual scoring outputs among conference players this season with 29 points in the Roadrunners' loss to Southern Utah (Nov. 30) and 28 points in the win over Huston-Tillotson (Nov. 14), respectively.

**Climbing the Charts:** Senior Jeromie Hill continues to climb up UTSA's career charts. The 6-8 forward ranks third in school history with 97 starts, fifth with 486 field goals, sixth with 639 rebounds, seventh with 1,277 points and tied for eighth with a 6.6 career rebounding average. Hill became just the sixth player in program history to top 1,000 points and 500 rebounds with a 12-point, nine-rebound performance against Utah State (Dec. 29, 2012). The two-time all-conference pick needs just 30 points and 29 rebounds to move into the school's top five for both categories. Additionally, Hill could become just the second Roadrunner (joining Devin Brown, 1,922 points/751 rebounds) to reach both the 1,500-point and 700-rebound plateaus with 223 points and 61 boards the rest of the way. He is the only player in program history and the only current C-USA player to appear in at least 95 games and start all of them.

**Lewis Leading the Way:** Senior Keon Lewis picked his offense up right where he left off last season. After leading the Roadrunners with 12.6 points per game in 2013–14, the Seattle native scored 31 points in UTSA's exhibition win over Southeastern Oklahoma State (Nov. 6) before he dropped 28 points in the season opening victory over Huston-Tillotson (Nov. 14). His 28-point outing was the best individual scoring performance in an opener under Brooks Thompson and was the most points scored by any C-USA player during the season's opening weekend. Through five games, Lewis ranks 11th in the league with 14.8 ppg and he has scored at least 10 points in 25 of his 32 games at UTSA. In addition to his scoring, he is tied for sixth in the circuit with 4.0 assists per outing.

**Seeing Double:** Jeromie Hill produced back-to-back double-doubles (Nov. 17 & 21) for just the second time in his career and the first time since his freshman season. The senior, who now has 12 double-doubles in his career, scored 16 points and added 10 rebounds in UTSA's loss to Texas-Pan American (Nov. 17) before a 16-point, 11-rebound performance in the Roadrunners' win over Texas State (Nov. 22). It's the first time that he's strung together a pair of double-doubles since the first two games of his career when he had 16 points and 10 rebounds in his collegiate debut against Huston-Tillotson (Nov. 12, 2010) and a career-high 27 points and 12 boards at Evansville (Nov. 17, 2010). In addition, Hill has scored in double figures in 13 consecutive games dating back to the 2012-13 season.

**Baba Bowie:** Through five games, junior Ryan Bowie already has proven to be one of the best all-around players in Conference USA. The transfer from Iowa Western ranks among the league's best in six different statistical categories including minutes (t-1st/35.40 mpg), steals (t-4th/1.6 spg), points (8th/15.8 ppg), rebounds (10th/7.0 rpg), 3-point field goals made (t-13th/8) and field goal percentage (15th/.508). A native of Lewisville, Bowie scored a season-high 29 points in Sunday's loss to Southern Utah, which is the most points scored by a UTSA player and the fourth-best individual output among C-USA players this season. He went 10-of-18 from the floor with a pair of 3-pointers and seven free throws in the losing effort. Bowie is just the second player in the league so far this season to connect on at least 10 field goals in a game.

**Rivalry Comeback:** UTSA's 80-67 win over Texas State on Nov. 22 produced the largest comeback win in Brooks Thompson's eight-plus seasons. The Bobcats went on a 16-2 run in the first half to claim a 27-11 lead before the Roadrunners began to chip away and eventually run away with a late 17-3 spurt of their own. Prior to Saturday, the best comeback under Thompson came in a 78-77 win over Oral Roberts on Nov. 15, 2011, in Stillwater, Okla., as part of the NIT Season Tip-Off. The Golden Eagles hit a 3-pointer at the first half buzzer to grab a 46-31 lead only to watch as the Roadrunners completed the comeback on Sei Paye's running, one-handed triple from 25 feet out at the final horn. UTSA's win against Texas State also saw five Roadrunners reach double figures. The Roadrunners had at least five players score in double digits four times last season, including six players doing so in an 89-76 win over Rice (Jan. 30, 2014).

**New to the Scene:** Seven of UTSA's eight newcomers made their regular season debuts for the team in the seasonopening win over Huston-Tillotson. The group totaled 41 of the team's 92 points, shot 51.9 percent (14-of-27) from the floor and was led by 11 points apiece from junior college transfer Ryan Bowie, who also tied for the team lead

with seven rebounds, and redshirt freshman Larry Lewis Jr. Bowie helped fuel an early 11-2 run with seven straight points and the Lewisville native hit his first four shots, including the team's first 3-pointer of the campaign, en route to a 5-of-8 shooting performance. Meanwhile, Lewis Jr. scored nine of his 11 points in the second half and totaled three assists and a pair of steals in 25 minutes. Fellow newcomers Austin Karrer (7 points), Gino Littles (2 points), Edwin Olympio (4 points) and James Ringholt (6 points) added to the group's impressive debut. UTSA's final newcomer, Christian Wilson, made his debut with 15 points, including 10 in the second half, against Texas State (Nov. 22).

**The Return:** In the Nov. 14 season opener, senior Jeromie Hill returned to the floor for his first regular-season action since a loss to UT Arlington (March 15, 2013) in the semifinals of the 2013 Western Athletic Conference Tournament. Last season, Hill redshirted with a knee injury and the win over Huston-Tillotson was his first official game in 609 days.

**Milestones In Sight:** Now in its 34th season of play, UTSA has a chance to reach a pair of milestones this season. With 495 wins in program history, the squad needs just five more to reach 500, while six more home triumphs would give the Roadrunners 300 victories in the Convocation Center.

Rare Air: UTSA head coach Brooks Thompson is in exclusive company among his coaching counterparts. Thompson is one of just eight Division I head coaches that are former NBA first round draft selections (Johnny Dawkins, Stanford; Bryce Drew, Valparaiso; Bobby Hurley, Buffalo; Dan Marjerle, Grand Canyon; Danny Manning, Wake Forest; Scott Padgett, Samford; Reggie Theus, Cal State Northridge are the others) and one of 23 leading men that have played in the association. Thompson, who is in his ninth season at UTSA, was selected by the Orlando Magic in the first round of the 1994 NBA draft and also played for the Utah Jazz, Denver Nuggets, Phoenix Suns and New York Knicks. Michael Curry (Florida Atlantic) is the only other C-USA head coach that has played in the NBA.

**Conference USA Year Two:** UTSA is entering its second season as a member of Conference USA. This will mark the first time that the Roadrunners have been in the same conference for consecutive seasons since their final two as a member of the Southland Conference (2010-11 & 2011-12). UTSA spent the 2012-13 campaign with in the Western Athletic Conference before its first season in C-USA a year ago. East Carolina, Tulane and Tulsa all left the circuit on July 1, 2014, and were replaced by Western Kentucky to form a 14-team league. While last season's C-USA Tournament took all 16 members, the 2015 field will feature the circuit's top 12 teams.

**Roadrunners Ink Allen, Cockrell to NLIs:** UTSA inked Nick Allen (Surprise, Ariz./Willow Canyon HS) and A.J. Cockrell (Tulsa, Okla./Memorial HS) during the early signing period. Allen, a 6-7 forward, averaged 15 points and 4.3 rebounds as a junior and was ranked as the No. 23 prospect from the class of 2015 in Arizona by *The Arizona Republic*. Meanwhile, A.J. Cockrell is a two-time state champion and is ranked among the top 15 prospects in Oklahoma by *Okhoops.com*. The 6-8 forward averaged 10.9 points and 8.7 rebounds a season ago and was a *Tulsa World* honorable mention all-state and all-metro selection. The pair will join the Roadrunners for the 2015-16 season.

**Thompson's Tenure:** Now in his ninth season at UTSA, head coach Brooks Thompson is the second-longest tenured coach in program history. The former NBA first-round pick has guided the Roadrunners to 116 wins, including just the sixth 20-win season in school annals with a 20-14 mark in 2010-11. That squad won the Southland Conference Tournament by defeating the field's top three seeds in a four-day stretch before besting Alabama State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, which was the first NCAA Tournament victory for UTSA in any sport.

**International Connection:** During head coach Brooks Thompson's first four seasons at the helm, UTSA had just one international player on campus in the form of Oldendorf, Germany, native Richie Frohlich (2008-10). This season, four foreign players dot the Roadrunners roster. Senior Jeromie Hill was born and raised in Cairns, Australia, while sophomore Phillip Jones (Freeport) hails from the Bahamas. In addition, freshmen Edwin Olympio (Marseille, France) and James Ringholt (Brisbane, Australia) join the squad. All totaled, Thompson has had nine foreign players during his nine years in the Alamo City.

**Up Next:** UTSA will finish its western road swing with a 2 p.m. (CT) contest on Saturday, Dec. 6, at Washington State. The game will be broadcast on the Pac-12 Network with Kevin Calabro (play-by-play) and Dan Dickau (analysis) calling the action.

Former NBA First Round draft pick and Oklahoma State star Brooks Thompson is in his ninth season as head coach of the UTSA men's basketball program. Introduced as the Roadrunners' fifth head coach on April 18, 2006, Thompson has assembled a talented and hard-working staff with more than 40 combined years of collegiate coaching experience and the result has been a turnaround both on and off the court.

In his eight years in the Alamo City, UTSA has registered the school's first-ever NCAA postseason victory in any sport, captured one league championship, made two conference tournament title game appearances and recorded the most successful four-year stretch (76 wins) in two decades. More than 20 school records have fallen under his watch, while nine players have earned allconference honors and three have been tabbed league freshman of the year (Devin Gibson, 2008; Melvin Johnson III, 2010; Jeromie Hill, 2011).

The Roadrunners also have taken care of business in the classroom. UTSA has collected eight league all-academic certificates under Thompson, including Southland Conference Student-Athlete of the Year honorees in Gibson (2010, '11) and Hill (2012). Kurt Attaway garnered Academic All-District accolades in 2007. Additionally, the program's Academic Progress Rate (APR) has improved significantly since Thompson's arrival, jumping from an 818 for the season prior to his arrival to a 949 in the last report. Thompson also has placed a strong emphasis on graduating players, as more than 80 percent of his student-athletes who have exhausted their eligibility at UTSA have earned their undergraduate degree.

Last season, Thompson led the Roadrunners in their first season as a member of Conference USA. Despite losing its top three scorers from the 2012-13 campaign, UTSA averaged nearly five more points per game and opened its inaugural season in C-USA with a pair of home victories.

In 2012-13, UTSA won five of its last eight games for a strong finish in its first and only season in the Western Athletic Conference (WAC). The ninth-seeded Roadrunners ran past No. 8 San Jose State (67-49) in the opening round of the WAC Tournament before pulling off the biggest upset by seed in the tournament history by ousting top-seed and regular season co-champion Louisiana Tech, 73-67, in the quarterfinal round. UTSA made the program's third conference tournament semifinal appearance in the past five seasons, where it fell to UT Arlington. UTSA defeated Holy Cross and Old Dominion on the season-opening weekend en route to capturing the Liberty Tax Classic crown. Michael Hale III earned third-team All-WAC honors and Hill was named to the WAC All-Academic Team.

The 2010-11 campaign arguably was the most successful in 20 years. Thompson guided UTSA to the Southland Tournament Championship for the first time since 2004 and to the program's fourth NCAA Tournament appearance, where it registered the first NCAA postseason victory in any sport in the department's 30-year history with a 70-61 first-round victory over Alabama State during the First Four on March 16 in Dayton, Ohio. That outcome gave UTSA its first 20-win season in 19 years. He led the Roadrunners to their second consecutive 4-1 start — a school record — and their fourth straight 4-0 start at home. UTSA tied for third in the Southland West Division and fifth overall to qualify for its fourth straight Southland Tournament, where it upset the top three seeds en route to the crown. Top-ranked Ohio State ended the Roadrunners' season at 20-14 with a 75-46 setback in the NCAA Second Round in Cleveland.

Six school records were broken in 2010-11, as Gibson has

eclipsed the career assists, steals, free throws, games played and starts standards and the single-season free throws mark. Gibson earned first-team NABC All-District 23 and first-team All-Southland honors and was named Southland Tournament MVP and Southland Student-Athlete of the Year for the second straight season. Hill was tabbed a Mid-Major Freshman All-American by CollegeInsider.com and Southland Freshmen of the Year and he earned honorable mention all-league accolades along with Johnson III and all-tournament honors along with Gibson.

Thompson came to UTSA from Arizona State, where he served as an assistant coach for two seasons. He helped the Sun Devils post eight wins against teams that qualified for the postseason and one of his players — Ike Diogu — was the Pac-10 Player of the Year, a second-team All-American and the ninth overall pick in the 2005 NBA Draft (Golden State Warriors). The Sun Devils qualified for the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) in 2005. Prior to his stint at Arizona State, Thompson was head coach at Yavapai College in Prescott, Ariz., for two seasons (2002-04) where he compiled a 55-14 record and a .797 winning percentage, the highest in school history. He was named NJCAA Region I Coach of the Year both seasons and Arizona Community College Athletic Conference (ACCAC) Coach of the Year in 2002-03. Thompson led the Roughriders to back-to-back ACCAC regular season titles the first two conference titles in school history — and to two consecutive Region I Tournament Championships.

Thompson guided Yavapai to a 28-7 record in 2002-03, qualifying for the NJCAA Tournament and finishing with a final national ranking of No. 11. In 2003-04, Yavapai was ranked as high as No. 8 and finished the season with a 27-7 mark, a No. 17 ranking and a second straight NJCAA Tournament berth — Yavapai had previously qualified just once in 1980. The Roughriders scored 91.1 points per game (14th in the nation) and ranked 13th in the country in both field goal percentage (55.0) and 3-point field goal

He began his coaching career as an undergraduate assistant at Oklahoma State in 1998-99 and served as head coach at Metro Christian Academy in Tulsa, Okla., in 1999-2000. He then was an assistant coach for one season at Southeastern Louisiana in 2000-

Thompson returned to his alma mater for one season as director of basketball operations in 2001-02, helping the Cowbovs reach the NCAA Tournament.


In all, Thompson has coached 17 players who have gone on to professional careers, including five current or former NBA players. That list includes Diogu, former Oklahoma State stars Maurice Baker, Desmond Mason and Melvin Sanders and former Yavapai standout Larry Owens.

Also a standout player, he was the 1989 Colorado Prep Player of the Year after guiding Littleton High School to a 24-0 record and the Class 4A State Championship.

Thompson played two seasons at Texas A&M in 1989-91 where he earned second-team All-Southwest Conference honors after his sophomore campaign. He then transferred to Oklahoma State where he was a second-team All-Big Eight selection in 1992-93 and a first-team all-conference performer in 1993-94. He led the Cowboys in assists both seasons and averaged 16.9 points per game as a senior. He tallied 1,675 career points during his four collegiate seasons.

The Orlando Magic selected Thompson in the first round of the 1994 NBA Draft. He played in the NBA Finals in 1995 for the Magic and set the franchise record for most points in a guarter (21). He also played for the Utah Jazz in 1996, the Denver Nuggets in 1996-97, the Phoenix Suns in 1997-98 and the New York Knicks in 1998 and spent one year overseas with Iraklis in Greece (1997).

Following his professional playing days, Thompson earned a bachelor's degree in political science from Oklahoma State in 2001. He and his wife, Michelle, have three daughters, Ryan Michelle, Brooke and Addison.
