Roadrunners, off to their best Southland Conference start in school history, to host Lions in key three-game series this weekend

UTSA RETURNS HOME FOR KEY SLC SERIES: UTSA — winners of four in a row, eight of its last nine games and 10 of 12 overall — returns to Roadrunner Field this weekend for a key three-game Southland Conference series against Southeastern Louisiana, which begins at 6 p.m. on Friday. The Roadrunners enter the set with a 14-11 overall record and perfect 6-0 mark in the Southland Conference, their best SLC start in school history. UTSA, which scored in double figures just twice in its first 17 games, now has done so in five of its last eight contests. The Roadrunners have hit double digits in five of their six SLC games, have outscored the opposition, 69-27, and are averaging 11.5 runs per contest.

SCOUTING THE LIONS: Southeastern Louisiana collected victories on Tuesday (3-2, Alcorn State) and Wednesday (11-4, Mississippi Valley State) and now stands at 20-8 overall. The Lions took 2-of-3 games from Northwestern State last weekend and enter Friday's contest at 4-2 in SLC play. SE Louisiana holds a slim 15-13 edge in the all-time series that dates back to the 1998 campaign, but the Roadrunners have won five of the past seven matchups. UTSA has taken 2-of-3 games

in each of the past two regular seasons and also has a 9-8 victory (10 innings) in the 2005 SLC Tournament to its credit.

PERFECT START BEST EVER: The Roadrunners, off to a perfect 6-0 start in the Southland Conference after back-to-back sweeps at McNeese State and against Central Arkansas the past two weekends, are off to their best SLC start in school history. UTSA went 4-0 to open the conference season in both 1994 and '96. The consecutive sweeps also mark the first time the program's 16-year history that

the Roadrunners have swept back-to-back three-game series against league opponents. UTSA now has swept SLC foes 15 times in school annals, nine of which have come under the direction of head coach Sherman Corbett.

RED HOT OFFENSE: After starting the year slowly, the UTSA offense has exploded the past nine games, eight of which have resulted in victories. The Roadrunners have scored 88 times (9.8 pg) and outscored the opposition by 44 runs during that time. UTSA has posted a .335 batting average on the strength of 115 hits (12.8 pg), slugged an astonishing .636 (218 total bases) and reached base at .398 clip. More than 50 percent of 115 hits (58) have gone for extra bases, including 30 doubles, 11 triples and 17 home runs. The Roadrunners also have stolen 11 bases in 13 attempts, which translates to an 84.6 percent success rate.

YOU DROPPED A BOMB ON ME: Seventeen of UTSA's 22 home runs (77.2 pct.) this season have been hit during the past nine contests. Leading the long ball parade is junior Zach Etheredge, who has slugged five in the past eight games. Sophomore James Keithley, junior Trent Lockwood and senior Ryan Saltzgaber each have hit three bombs in the last nine tilts and Lockwood and Saltzgaber have grand slams among their three bombs. Also on the board are redshirt freshman Tim Palincsar, senior Mitch Ponza and sophomore Michael Rockett, all three of whom have left the yard once during the past eight contests.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Three Roadrunners currently are enjoying career-best hitting streaks. Sophomore James Keithley has hit safely in 13 consecutive games dating back to March 4. Keithley is hitting .381 (24-63) with three doubles,

three triples, four home runs (.714 slugging pct.) and nine RBIs. Meanwhile, junior Trent Lockwood and senior Ryan Saltzgaber enter this weekend's series rid-

PLAYER UPDATES

C • Zach Etheredge, Jr. - Starter in all 25 games ... leads the squad with eight multi-RBI performances, ranks second with five home runs, 24 RBIs and a .558 slugging percentage and third with 53 total bases and 11 multi-hit efforts ... also hitting .316 with six doubles, a triple and a .371 on-base percentage ... had a seven-game hitting streak from March 17-27 in which he posted a .452 average (14-31) with three doubles, a triple, five home runs (1.097 slg%) and 16 RBIs ... claimed SLC Hitter of the Week honors on March 26 after he hit .450 (9-20) with three doubles, a triple, three home runs and 11 RBIs ... named to Southwest Diamond Classic All-Tournament Team (4-10, 4 R, 4 RBIs).

1B/DH • Trent Lockwood, Jr. - Has started 24 games, 21 at first base and three at DH ... leads club in batting average (.381), multi-hit games (13), home runs (six), RBIs (29), multi-RBI contests (eight), total bases (65), slugging percentage (.670) and on-base percentage (.440) ... also ranks second in hits (37) and doubles (eight) ... currently on a season-best 10-game hitting streak, the last eight of which have resulted in multi-hit performances ... owns a .532 batting average (22-42) with seven doubles, a triple, three homers (.952 slg%)

and 17 RBIs during the streak ... hit safely in his first eight games as a Roadrunner (only player with two eight-game streaks this season) ... had six RBIs on March 17 at McNeese State ... named to Southwest Diamond Classic All-Tournament Team (5-14, 3 R, 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBIs, SB).

2B/LF • James Keithley, So. - Has started 16 games at second base and nine in left field ... leads team with three triples and five stolen bases, ranks second with 24 runs and 58 total bases and third with 35 hits, four home runs, a .527 slugging percentage and 11 multi-hit games ... also has .318 batting average with five doubles and 15 RBIs ... currently on a career-best 13-game hitting streak in which he is hitting .381 (24-63) with three doubles, three triples, four home runs (.714 slg%) and nine RBIs ... squad is 10-2 since he moved into the leadoff spot on March 9 ... has scored in nine games in a row ... has .386 batting average (32-83) with seven two-hit games, three three-hit performances and a career-best four-hit effort (March 10) in last 18 contests ... hitting .371 (33-89) with five doubles, three triples, four home runs and 15 RBIs since starting the season 2-for-21 (.095) ... went 7-14 (.500) with four runs scored, a triple, his first homer of the year and four RBIs vs. the College

of Charleston (March 9-11) ... was 7-for-15 (.467) with eight runs scored, a double, one triple, a pair of home runs and three RBIs last weekend vs. Central Arkansas ... 2006 honorable mention All-SLC.

3B • Ryan Saltzgaber, Sr. - 2007 pre-season second-team All-SLC ... starter in all 25 contests ... ranks second on the squad with a pair of triples and third in batting average (.330), runs scored (19) and stolen bases (four) ... currently on a career-high 10-game hitting streak, two of the last three of which have been three-hit efforts ... hitting at a .364 clip (16-44) with two doubles, a pair of triples, three homers (.705 slg%) and 14 RBIs during the 10-game stretch ... has 10 multi-hit games this season, including three three-hit performances ... 2006 honorable mention All-SLC.

SS • Marshal Davis, Jr. - Starter in all 25 games ... has reached base by hit, walk or hit by pitch in 28 of his last 29 games dating back May 22, 2006 ... leads team with 22 walks and ranks third with a .414 on-base percentage ... also has scored 16 runs, stroked three doubles and a triple and driven in eight runs ... has five two-hit games and a career-high-tying three-hit performance on March 17 at McNeese State.

CF • Michael Rockett, So. - 2007 pre-season first-team All-SLC ... leads team with 38 hits, 10 doubles and 13 multi-hit games, ranks second with a .352 batting average and third with 22 RBIs ... also has 18 runs scored, a triple, one home run and three stolen bases ... has recorded eight two-hit games, four three-hit performances and a career-high-tying four-hit effort vs. Central Arkansas (March 24) ... tied his career high with four RBIs against Houston (Feb. 22) and again last Sunday vs. Central Arkansas ... was 10-for-13 (.769) with two doubles, a triple, his first homer of the season and six RBIs in last weekend's series against UCA ... 2006 Freshman All-America and second-team All-SLC selection.

LF/DH • Tim Palincsar, Fr. - Starter in 22 games this year (5 LF/17 DH)... leads club with 26 runs scored and five stolen bases, ranks second with 11 walks and a .414 on-base percentage and is third with seven doubles ... also hitting .329 with a triple, two home runs and 16 RBIs ... has four consecutive games with at least two hits ... has recorded a career-high three hits three times (March 3, 18 & 27) and three RBIs on two other occasions (March 10 & 27) ... hit his first career homer vs. the College of Charleston on March 10 ...

had seven-game hitting streak from Feb. 23-March 4 (.385/10-26) ... named to the Al Ogletree Classic All-Tournament Team (5-11, 2 R, 2B, SB).

SP • Josh Ruffin, Sr. - Preseason first-team All-SLC pick is one of the best pitchers in school history ... leads team with 34 strikeouts in team-high 43.2 innings and also has three quality starts ... is 2-1 with 5.77 ERA in his seven starts ... tossed a four-hitter for first complete game of year and struck out seven, as UTSA won its SLC opener at McNeese State (March 16) ... allowed just one run on five hits and fanned six in seven innings vs. the College of Charleston (March 9) ... struck out career-high nine and picked up first victory of year vs. Gonzaga (Feb. 23) after allowing just three runs on six hits in eight-plus innings ... 2006 first-team All-SLC pick.

HEAD COACH SHERMAN CORBETT: With more than 20 years of playing and coaching experience, Sherman Corbett is in his seventh season at UTSA. The winningest coach in school history (188 victories), Corbett led the Roadrunners to 37 victories a year ago, the second-most in school history. In his first six seasons, he has coached a pair of 30-win squads and 24 All-SLC players, including seven first-teamers. Corbett also has mentored the 2001 SLC Pitcher of the Year (Jared Howton), 2002 SLC Player and Hitter of the Year (Mark Schramek), 2003 SLC Freshman of the Year (Ryan Crew) and two Freshman All-Americans — Crew (2003) and Michael Rockett (2006). Twelve of his Roadrunners have gone on to professional careers, including eight being selected in the MLB Draft.
