Job duties include:

- Shoot and edit short- and long-form video content promoting our student-athletes, programs and department.
- Operate camera and/or various broadcast systems for live game streams. (Volleyball, Basketball, Baseball, Softball, etc.)
- Support digital/feature video production needs as assigned.
- Ingest and log footage while pulling selects for editors.
- Assist with the maintenance, organization and scheduling of equipment.

Distribution of content includes social media, web, video board and facility screens.

Interested students should be pursuing a Bachelors degree and possess excellent communication and organizational skills; willingness to work evening, weekend and holiday hours; demonstrated experience in the field of video production; strong computer skills.
