THE SETTING:

After finishing the season with a series sweep and clinching a Big Ten Tournament berth after tying for third place, the fourth-seeded Hawkeyes travel to Columbus, OH, to take on the fifth-seeded Purdue Boilermakers for the fourth-straight game on Wednesday afternoon at 11:05 a.m. (CDT). The tournament bid is the third under Head Coach Jack Dahm in his seven-year tenure and first since 2007. Iowa won seven of its last eight conference games to finish the regular season. Furthermore, the Hawkeyes won four of their last five Big Ten series', capturing sets over Michigan, Ohio State and Penn State (2-1) and Purdue (3-0).

ON THE NET:

lowa baseball fans can follow the Hawkeyes with live stats (gametracker) on <u>hawkeyesports.com</u>. Just click on the GT link found on both the front page and the baseball schedule page. Whistlin' Ray Gilmore is in his 33rd season with the Hawkeye baseball program and will be posting the stats.

ON THE RADIO:

Hawkeye fans can listen to every tournament game on AM-800 KXIC and <u>hawkeyesports.</u> **com**. The voice of the Hawkeyes, Brent Balbinot will handle the play-by-play.

ON THE TUBE:

All Big Ten Tournament games will be televised on the Big Ten Network (HD). Games on Wednesday and Thursday will feature play-by-play by Brent Stover with color by former Hawkeye Danan Hughes. Brian Barnhart and Scott Pose will call Thursday as well, and on Friday.

SCOUTING PURDUE:

Purdue finished the regular season 31-22 and 12-12 in Big Ten Play. The Boilermakers were handed their first conference sweep in Iowa City last weekend.

Kevin Plawecki and Cameron Perkins had strong bats in the three-game series.

The Hawkeyes hit .345 off the Purdue pitching staff last weekend. The Boilermakers amassed an 8.25 ERA and allowed 10 extra base hits. Ace Matt Bischoff leads the pitching staff. The righty has a team-best 3.45 ERA and averages just over a strikeout an inning.

IOWA VS BISCHOFF:

lowa has had success against the ace the last three years. Last Friday in Iowa City, Bischoff got the loss, his first conference defeat and only his second overall loss on the season. The righty allowed four earned runs on nine hits, a walk, while striking out four.

In 2009, Bischoff got the loss in a 15-7 Iowa win, going 5.2 IP, 8 R, 6 ER, 10 hits, 3 BB. Two years ago in Iowa City, Purdue won 8-6, but Bischoff was chased after 2.0 IP. He surrendered seven hits, 6 ER and 2 BB in those two innings.

BRINGIN' OUT THE BROOMS:

The series sweep against Purdue last weekend was lowa's only three-game Big Ten sweep of the season and first since 2007 (vs. Indiana).

It also was the first Hawkeye sweep to end the regular season since 1980 (vs. Michigan State in a two-game series).

TAKING FOUR OF FIVE:

With the series win over Purdue last weekend, the Hawkeyes finished the season taking three straight conference series' and four of the their last five.

After being swept at Indiana April 17-18, lowa took two at Michigan, two at Penn State, two vs. Ohio State and three against Purdue. The Hawkeyes boasted a 9-3 record in the final three weekends of conference play.

GOING YARD:

The Hawkeyes connected with six homers in the three-game series against Purdue last weekend. Both **Kurtis Muller** and **Trevor Willis** blasted a pair, with **Ryan Durant** and **Tyson Blaser** each collecting one.

Willis had two in the series opener, a team game-high this year. Blaser's bomb registered as the redshirt juniors first of his career.

lowa is a perfect 6-0 on the year with two or more homers hit in a game.

MULLER GETS WHITE-HOT:

Junior **Kurtis Muller** saw the ball well last weekend against Purdue. The leadoff hitter went 10-for-14 (.714) with two doubles, two homers, three stolen bases, five runs scored and six RBI to lead lowa to a series sweep.

The center fielder is currently on a six-game hit streak and leads the team in 10 statistical categories, including: at bats (198), runs (49), hits (76), triples (6), slugging percentage (.556), walks (21), hit by pitches (21), on base percentage (.458), stolen bases (24) and field-ing percentage (1.000%).

Z-ROB DOMINATES BIG TEN:

Go-to reliever **Zach Robertson** leads the pitching staff in the conference. The southpaw boasts a team-low 2.45 ERA, a team-most 13 appearances, as well as a perfect 4-0 record and one save. He has struck out 24 Big Ten opponents in 22 innings of work and averages over two strikeouts per walk.

Robertson recorded his first career save against Purdue in game two of the series last Friday.

HIPPEN COMPLETES FOURTH:

Sophomore **Jarred Hippen** threw his conference -best fourth complete Big Ten game and earned his fifth win in game one of a doubleheader against Purdue last Friday. Hippen outdueled Matt Bischoff in the contest, allowing the Boilermakers only two runs on five hits with two walks and a career-best nine strikeouts.

All four complete games have been in conference play and all have resulted in a win.

Hippen's third complete game of the season was game one of a doubleheader against Minnesota on May 1. It was the southpaw's second-consecutive complete game. He allowed only four runs, three earned, on 10 hits wiwth seven strikeouts and issued no walks.

In his second complete game the Rock Falls, IL, native, allowed only two runs, one earned, scattered six hits and struck out five en route to his third win in a 5-2 victory at Michigan.

Hippen's first career complete game was in the Big Ten opener at Michigan State. He allowed three runs off seven hits and striking out two. The last Hawkeye to throw a complete nine was Nate Johnson in 2004.

SOLID HAWKEYE DEFENSE:

lowa has played strong defense in recent weeks. In fact, in three of the Hawkeyes' past four games, they have been perfect -- committing no errors.

1. lowa makes only its eighth appearance to the conference tournament in school history and is playing for its first win in tournament play under Head Coach **Jack Dahm**.

2. Kurtis Muller saw the ball against Purdue last weekend, the junior went 10-for-14 (.714) with two doubles, two homers and three stolen bases to lead Iowa.

3. **Kevin Lee** is at 11 saves on a the year, a school record. Lee has picked up a save in every opportunity, except one, in which he later earned the win in extras.

LEE MAKES THE BOOKS:

Closer **Kevin Lee** notched his 11th save of the season in one and two-thid innings pitched in lowa's 12-9 victory over Purdue Saturday afternoon. Lee's 11 saves in a season is a school single-game record.

Lee allowed three baserunners, allowing one hit and walking too-- however struck out two including a called strikeout to end the game.

DAHM AT BIG TEN TOURN:

This trip to the Big Ten Tournament is Iowa's third under Head Coach **Jack Dahm**. After taking the helm in July 2003, Dahm has taken teams to the tournament in 2005 and 2007. He is still looking for a tournament win.

In 2005, Iowa fell to Minnesota 14-7 and Michigan 8-6. In 2007, the Hawkeyes lost to Illinois 12-3 and Penn State 5-3.

IOWA FINISHES IN THIRD:

The Hawkeyes finished the Big Ten season tied for third with Northwestern. The third place finish is the highest for Iowa, since 2005.

In 2005, Iowa finished 19-13 in Big Ten play.

ALL-TIME SERIES:

lowa leads the all-time series over Purdue, 84-62-1. The Hawkeyes have now taken two-straight Friday night games from ace Matt Bischoff. Iowa took three last weekend however, only picked up one win out of three in 2009.

In 2009, Iowa slugged past the Purdue Boilermakers, 15-7, in the weekend series opener Friday afternoon at Lambert Field. Iowa plated 15 runs, five each in the second and ninth innings, on 18 hits en route to its 11th overall and second Big Ten triumph. The offensive output was Iowa's second-highest scoring and hitting performance of the season. The Hawkeyes scored 25 runs on 25 hits at Tennessee-Martin earlier this season.

2009 IOWA DRAFT PICKS:

Three Hawkeyes were drafted in the Major League Baseball's 2009 First-Year Player Draft. Right-handed fireballer **Steve Turnbull**, lefty relief pitcher **Kyle Heim** and closer **Mike Schurz** all signed contracts in June. Three-time all-Big Ten selection **Justin Toole** later signed a free agent contract.

Other draftees included current lowa freshmen: **Matt Dermody** and **Dan Sheppard**.

Head Coach Jack Dahm



In six years as lowa's head baseball coach, Jack Dahm has established the Hawkeyes as Big Ten contenders and is ready to lead the Iowa baseball program to new heights with his commitment to excellence.

Since taking over the Iowa baseball team in July of 2003, Dahm has sparked resurgence in the Hawkeye program, having success Hawkeye fans hadn't seen in years.

In Dahm's 16 years as a head coach, he has produced 24 first team allconference performers, eight freshmen All-Americans and two All-Americans. In his six years at Iowa, Dahm has coached 24 all-Big Ten selections,

including eight first teamers. Iowa had only four first team selections in the previous 14 years before his arrival in Iowa City.

Last season, lowa went 16-35, but was decimated by injuries, which gave several young players opportunities and experience. Three Hawkeyes received all-conference honors. Ryan Durant received first team laurels, while Justin Toole was named third team all-Big Ten for the third consecutive year. Freshman Dallas Burke was named a unanimous choice to the conference's all-freshman team after seeing significant time on the field.

Five Hawkeyes were drafted in 2009, including two incoming recruits. Relievers Steve Turnbull, Kyle Heim and Mike Schurz were all picked up, as well as Matthew Dermody and Dan Sheppard. Additionally, Justin Toole signed a free agent contract with the Cleveland Indians. Thirty-four of Dahm's players have been selected in the MLB Draft, while four have gone on to play in the major leagues.

In 2009, Coach Dahm surpassed Dick Schultz for the third-most victorious coach in Iowa history at Duane Banks Field on March 21st in a 9-4 victory over Western Illinois. Dahm picked up his 400th win as a Division I coach at Northern Iowa on April 23. He also picked up his 124th victory as an Iowa head coach against Ohio State on May 16, which surpassed Scott Broghamer (1998-03) for fourth in Iowa coaching victories.

The 42-year old Dahm and his wife, Lynn, have been married for 16 years. The couple has three children - sons Casey and Tyler and daughter Lyndsey. He was born January 19, 1967 in Skokie, Illinois.

IOWA AT BIG TEN TOURNAMENT:

The Hawkeyes' bid to the conference tournament marks only the eighth time in school history, the least appearances of any Big Ten school. The highest Iowa has ever finished was second in 1983 under Duane Banks.

The Black and Gold have a 4-14 (.222) record at the tournament collectively and have appeared in the tournament in: 1983, 1987, 1989, 1990, 2002, 2005 and 2007. Iowa's highest finish at the tournament is second (1983).

lowa's last tournament victory came in 1990 when the Hawkeyes beat Ohio State (6-4) in lowa City.

lowa is 1-4 all-time in Big Ten Tournament games against Michigan, 1-1 vs. Minnesota, 0-1 vs. Purdue and Indiana. The Hawkeyes lost 4-0 to Purdue in 1987 in Ann Arbor.

HAWKEYES SUCCESSFUL VS ACES:

lowa picked up wins against the Big Ten's most dominant pitchers: Friday night starters.

lowa has defeated Purdue's Matt Bischoff (7-2), Minnesota's Seth Rosin (11-4), Michigan's Alan Oaks (5-2) and Michigan State's AJ Achter. Having not faced Ohio State ace Alex Wimmers -- Iowa was five for eight against aces in the conference.

SITUATIONALLY SPEAKING:

Ryan Durant is hitting a solid .373 against southpaw pitchers. While **Mike McQuillan** is hitting .406 off of rightys.

Kurtis Muller is cool under pressure, hitting .490 with two outs. The leadoff leads the team with 20 two-out RBI, followed by Durant with 15.

Zach Robertson has been dominant against lefties, who are hitting a mere .108 against him. Opponents are hitting .215 with two outs against Nick Brown and Jarred Hippen paces the pitching staff with eight batters who have grounded into double plays. The trio are all averaging over two strikeouts per walk to lead lowa.

BROWN PICKS UP FIFTH:

Sophomore **Nick Brown** threw a solid six and two-third innings to clinch a doubleheader sweep over the Boilermakers last weekend. The power pitcher picked up his fifth win of the season, fourth in the conference, allowing only one run on seven hits with four striekouts.

IOWA VS TOURNEY TEAMS:

The Big Ten Tournament features the top six teams of the 10-team conference. Bids to the conference tournament came down to the wire this season, being decided in the final day of Big Ten Play. The playing field includes: Minnesota, Michigan, Northwestern, Iowa, Purdue and Indiana.

lowa fell to No. 1 seeded Minnesota at home, winning only the Friday night game and dropping the last two. The lone win was sophomore **Jarred Hippen**'s third complete game. Golden Gopher ace Seth Rosin went five innings and got the loss. He allowed eight earned runs on nine hits with a walk and two strikeouts.

The Hawkeyes won the series at No. 2 seed Michigan, taking the first two of the three games. Hippen registered his second complete game and both him and starter **Nick Brown** held the Wolverine offense to only two runs in each win.

Northwestern and Iowa did not compete this season.

The Black and Gold swept No. 5 seed Purdue to conclude the regular season in Iowa City. Hippen recorded his fourth complete game and Iowa's offense was paced by junior **Kutis Muller**. The leadoff went 10-for-14 with six RBI on two doubles and two homers.

The Hawkeyes were swept at No. 6 Indiana. Despite losing all three games, lowa kept it close in game one and went into extras in the second contest.

BASE PATH THEIEVES:

Last weekend, Hawkeye baserunners stole ten bases from the Boilermakers. Juniors **Kurtis Muller** and **Zach McCool** led the way, each going a perfect 3-for-3. Four other Hawkeyes recorded a stolen bag.

KENYON PROVIDES RELIEF:

Junior **Zach Kenyon** has been solid out of the bullpen for lowa in the long relief role.

The hurler went four and one-third innings allowing only one run on four hits with four Ks in lowa's Saturday victory over Purdue.

WILLS GUNS 'EM OUT:

Junior **Trevor Willis** boasted strong defense the past few weeks, but has remained constant in gunning people out; whether it be at second, third or home. The junior has six assists to lead the Big Ten this season and ranks in the top 50 in the country.

STREAKIN' HAWKEYES:

Sophomore **Mike McQuillan**'s team seasonhigh16-game hit streak snapped last weekend against Purdue. But junior **Zach McCool** currently is on an 11-game hit streak.

Both junior **Kurtis Muller** and McQuillan lead the team with 23 multi-hit contests, followed by senior **Ryan Durant** with 21.

Durant leads the team with 12 multi-RBI games, with Muller and McCool tied for second with nine.

STACKING UP IN THE BIG TEN:

When compared to the conference's best in overall games several Hawkeyes rank in the top 10.

Kurtis Muller is tied for first in fielding percentage. The junior also ranks in triple (second), stole bases (third), bastting average (fifth), on base percentage (fifth) and hits (eighth). Ryan Durant is second in sacrifice flies and seventh in doubles and Zach McCool ranks first in sacrifice bunts.

Ace **Jarred Hippen** ranks in batters struck out looking (1st), innings pitched (third) and ERA (sixth), **Kevin Lee** ranks second in saves. **Zach Robertson** ranks fifth in wins.

DURANT SOLID IN BIG TEN:

lowa's cleanup hitter, **Ryan Durant** has hit a solid .359 in conference play. He leads the team with 12 doubles, 20 RBI and a .522 slugging percentage.

Durant ranks in the Big Ten, in conference games only, in doubles (first), sacrifice flies (first) and sacrifice bunts (third).

FROSH SWINGS IT:

Freshman **Mike Corbeil** has become a regular in the Hawkeye lineup, filling the DH role. Against Purdue, the lefty went 3-for-8 with a double, walk, run scored and RBI.

On the season, Corbeil boasts a .311 batting average with 14 RBI, four doubles, a .405 slugging percentage and two sacrifice flys. He leads all freshman in those statistical categories.

HOLDING ON TO WIN:

The Hawkeyes are 11-1 with the lead after five innings in Big Ten games. In overall games, lowa boasts a 22-3 record.

With the lead in the eighth inning, lowa is a perfect 13-0 in conference play and 25-0 overall.

MULLER EARNS FIRST BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Kurtis Muller was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week by the conference on May 10. Muller shared the honor with Indiana's Alex Dickerson. The weekly accolade is the first of Muller's career and first for the Hawkeyes this season.

Muller put on an offensive clinic in the final two games against the Nittany Lions. In the series finale, Muller collected a game and career-high five RBI, recording hits in his first five at-bats to tie the school single-game record. With the game tied, he blasted a threerun homer, his first of the season, to put the Hawkeyes in front to stay. The next half inning, he made a sliding catch into the wall to help preserve the lead. The native of Sun Prairie, WI, nearly hit for the cycle in Saturday's 9-3 triumph. He went 3-for-6 (single, double, triple) while registering two RBI.

MULLER LACES FIVE:

In the series finale at Penn State, **Kurtis Muller** tied an individual-game record after going 5-for-6. In the feat, the outfielder collected a game and career-high five RBI, recording hits in his first five at-bats. With the game tied, he blasted a three-run homer, his first of the season, to put the Hawkeyes in front to stay.

Teammate **Zach McCool** tied the individualgame record earlier in the season. He went 5-for-6 from the leadoff spot for Iowa in its series finale against the Spartans. McCool's five hits ties a single-game school record, last achieved by former Hawkeye standout, Justin Toole, in 2008.

RECORD BREAKING McCOOL:

Junior **Zach McCool** tied yet another school record. McCool laced two consecutive triples in lowa's victory over Western Illinois on April 6. The last time that was done was in 1999 by Brian Burks.

McCool tied another individual-game record earlier in the season. He went 5-for-6 from the leadoff spot for Iowa in its series finale against the Spartans. McCool's five hits ties a singlegame school record, last achieved by former Hawkeye standout, Justin Toole, in 2008.

BIG TEN OPENER VICTORY:

With a gem of a pitching performance from **Jarred Hippen**, Iowa picked up its first conference-opening win since a 9-5 triumph over Michigan in 2003.

Besides that, Iowa had won six of its last seven games and snapped Michigan State's 11-game win streak.

THE UNITY COUNCIL:

Senior Michael Jacobs, red shirt junior Tyson Blaser, junior Kurtis Muller, sophomore Patrick Brennan and freshman Dan Sheppard.

ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM:

With a 2-1 record, Iowa had several quality performances in Florida (Feb. 26-28). Sophomore pitcher **Jarred Hippen** and senior outfielder **Ryan Durant**, however, were the two Hawkeyes to earn second team all-tournament honors by **collegebaseball360.com**.

Hippen got his first win of the year, by-way of an eight and two-third innings performance with eight Ks and only one walk. Durant went 6-for-11 with a double, homer and six RBI.

STRIKING FIRST:

lowa has out-scored its opponents 52-39 in the first inning this season.

DUANE BANKS FIELD:

Every year the UI Athletics Department continues to upgrade Duane Banks Field. This year's primary addition is 500 new chair back seating behind home plate.

For the first time, season tickets are available for purchase. Fans can reserve their own chair backs for the 2010 season by calling the UI Athletic Ticket Office at 1-800-IA-HAWKS.

Besides that, in 2009, the Recreation Building underwent a complete makeover. Improvements included: a new locker room, lounge, training room and weight room.

Muller was recognized as a freshman all-American by Ping! in 2008. The native of Sun Prairie, WI, is a three-time Unity Council member and an ISAAC representative.

BAYLOR STANDOUT VOLUNTEERS:

Zach Dillon is in his first season as a volunteer coach at the University of Iowa.

Dillon attended Baylor University and was subsequently selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the 20th Round (595th overall) of the 2006 amateur entry draft as a catcher.

Dillon was part of a College World Series qualifying Baylor team in 2005. The team finished with a 46-24 record and ranked fourth nationally--the program's highest final ranking ever. Dillon scored the winning run in arguably the best game in Baylor history. In the College World Series, the Bears rallied from a 7-0 deficit through six innings for an 8-7 victory, eliminating the top-ranked and top-seeded Tulane. It was the second largest comeback in CWS history.

THE ASSISTANT COACHES:

Head Coach Jack Dahm is assisted by coach Ryan Brownlee and coach Chris Maliszewski, along with volunteer coach Zach Dillon.

Over the past nine seasons, Brownlee has had 21 players he coached or recruited drafted; two more signed free agent contracts. This past summer, Steve Turnbull, Kyle Heim, Mike Schurz and recruits Matt Dermody and Dan Sheppard were drafted by major league teams. In six years of coaching summer collegiate leagues, he has seen 33 of his players sign pro contracts, including Khalil Green of the Padres and Kevin Cash of the Yankees, Joe Thatcher of the Padres, Dan Meyer of the Marlins and Luke Scott of the Astros.

In 2008, Brownlee's expertise on stealing bases and knowledge of hitting were essential in establishing team and individual records. Iowa stole 138 bases, which are the most in a single-season by a Hawkeye team; the previous record of 127 was set by the 1981 team. The team total ranked third in the nation. On top of that, Iowa knocked out 436 singles for a new single-season record and wore 86 pitches to set a single-season team record in hit-by-pitches.

Maliszewski is in his second season as the Hawkeyes' pitching coach. In addition to his role as pitching coach, Maliszewski is also responsible for the team's travel arrangements and assists in the youth summer camps. In his first season, the team's ERA in Big Ten play improved 1.45 points from 2008 to 2009. On top of that, Hawkeye pitchers recorded nearly 20 less walks then the season before and over 30 strikeouts more than in 2008.

Over the summer, Maliszewski had three Hawkeye relievers get drafted; Steve Turnbull, Kyle Heim and Mike Schurz, all of whom signed professional contracts.

RBI ALERT:

Sophomore **Mike McQuillan** drove in seven RBI to lead lowa to victory over Illinois State Feb. 22. The RBI total is the most since Dallas Burke drove in six against Minnesota on May 2, 2009. Seven RBI also ties for the conference's game-high this year (tying two other Big Ten players).

WHISTLIN' RAY:

Of all the members of the Hawkeye baseball program, the longest tenured is "Whistlin" Ray Gilmore, who serves as lowa's official scorekeeper. Gilmore started as a batboy in 1978, and has since served as manager, public address announcer and unofficial mascot for lowa Baseball.

Iowa Head Baseball Coach Jack Dahm has announced that Kasey Carling, Patrick Lala, Bryan Niebalski and Taylor Zeutenhorst have signed National Letters of Intent to attend the University of Iowa and Kyle Haen, Jake Mangler and Aaron Smit intend to enroll and admit to the University of Iowa.

Carling, a native of Salem, UT, is a middle infielder who will be in the mix at shortstop. Carling lettered three years in baseball earning all-state, all-region and all-conference accolades his senior season. He also helped his Spanish Fork HS team win the state title in 2009. Carling was a NJCAA distinguished academic all-American last season with Salt Lake City Community College. He started every game at short stop and was named to the SWAC all-region team.

Haen, from Verona, WI, is an athletic outfielder that bats lefty. Haen was a National Honor Society and high honor roll athlete in high school. He started on the varsity baseball team since his freshman year, the team is 69-7 with him on the roster. In 2009, Haen helped lead his Madison Edgewood HS team to a division two state championship and was named first team all-conference, all-city and all-area. 
