## QUICK HITTERS

- **Rick Insell** is Middle Tennessee's all-time winningest basketball coach with **386** wins.
- **Rick Insell** is third among active coaches in their 17th season or less for wins. Insell is entering his 17th season leading his alma mater.
- MT secured its **950th all-time win** at Lipscomb (12/6), becoming just the 28th Division I women's basketball team (out of 351) with 950 all-time victories.
- The Lady Raiders have **five international players** on the roster - the most ever for a single season at Middle Tennessee. The previous high for a single season was three. The players hail from Belarus, Canada, Isreal, Russia and Spain.
- Middle Tennessee welcomes seven newcomers to the roster in 2021-22: five freshmen and two transfers.
- The Lady Raiders were picked third in the C-USA Preseason Coaches Poll.

• Matt Insell and Billy Fennelly serve as full-time assistant coaches to their dad, while Kendyl Brooks is the assistant director of operations under her dad at Virginia Tech.

• Rick and Matt Insell made history when MT and Ole Miss played Nov. 23, 2014, while Matt was serving as head coach of the Rebels. It marked the first time in NCAA Division I WBB history that a father and son faced one another as head coaches. MT won the game, 71-65.

### Insell All-Time Winningest Hoops Coach At MT

• Lady Raider HC Rick Insell is the all-time winningest basketball coach in MT history with **386 wins**.

• Insell earned his 350th win in just his 476th game when MT defeated Marshall, 75-55, Jan. 9, 2020.

• Insell surpassed former men's basketball coach Kermit Davis, who won 332 games in his 16 years.

• All of Insell's wins are against Division I foes as he has never scheduled a non-Division I regular-season opponent in his 17 seasons leading MT.

• Insell became the winningest coach in MT women's history on Jan. 5, 2013 with a 60-39 win against South Ala., which was win No. 183, surpassing Lewis Bivens.

### Insell Ranks Amongst Nation's Best

• Rick Insell is one of the nation's winningest coaches since being named the Lady Raiders' head coach in 2005.

• In his 17th season leading the MT program, Insell is third for most wins among NCAA Division I active coaches during that span. Only Mark Kellogg (Stephen F. Austin) and Jeff Walz (Louisville) have won more.

• Middle Tennessee's win at Lipscomb was the 950th in program history, making it just the 28th Division I program (out of 351) with 950 or more victories.

### Series History vs. UTSA

• MT and UTSA meet for the eighth time.  
 • MT leads the series, 7-0.  
 • Rick Insell is 7-0 vs. UTSA.  
 • The Lady Raiders are 3-0 vs. UTSA on the road.  
 • All seven meetings have taken place as C-USA members.

### Scouting UTSA

• UTSA is 3-8 under veteran HC Karen Aston, who is in her first season at UTSA.

• Aston has also previously served as head coach at Texas, North Texas and Charlotte.

• UTSA returns seven players from last season.

• LaPraisjah Johnson leads UTSA in scoring with 10.3 ppg. She is the only Roadrunner averaging double figures. Jady Pimentel averaged 9.5 points.

• The Roadrunners have utilized seven different lineups in the first 11 games of the season.

• UTSA was picked 14th in the C-USA Preseason Coaches Poll.

### Vs. Conference USA

• MT is 105-31 vs. C-USA members since joining the league prior to the 2013-14 season.

• The 105 wins are the most of any league member during this span.

• Overall, Rick Insell's teams are 231-46 (83 percent) vs. league foes, having posted a 126-15 mark in the Sun Belt Conference.

### Bench Please

• MT's bench has been strong this season with the Lady Raider bench averaging 17.9 ppg., which is almost three times its average last season.

• Junior forward Kseniya Malashka and freshman guard Courtney Blakely are big reasons for the outstanding production, combining for 17.5 points per game.

• MT's bench has scored 20-plus points **six times** and notched double-figure points **nine times**.

• By comparison, MT's bench did not score 20-plus in any game last season and reached double figures just eight times.

**Raiders On The Road**

- MT has enjoyed great road success under HC Rick Insell.
- The Lady Raiders are **145-79 overall on the road** under Insell, for a 65 percent winning ledger.
- Insell's teams are **49-15 on the road in C-USA play** (75 percent), and **109-28** (79 percent) in **conference road games overall (C-USA & Sun Belt)**.

**Calling Long Distance**

- The Lady Raiders consistently have been amongst the nation's top 3-point shooting teams under HC Rick Insell, knocking down 200-plus treys in 13 of his 16 seasons.
- MT is 11th nationally for 3-point FGs per game (9.9) and 18th nationally for 3-point FGs made (99).
- The Lady Raiders have hit **eight-plus treys eight times**, and 14-plus twice: Lipscomb (16) and East Carolina (14).
- MT is easily on pace to reach 200-plus 3-pointers this season and could challenge the single-season school record of 313 set in 2009-10.

**Freshman Standout Gregory Sets Career High**

- MT freshman guard Jalynn Gregory was named C-USA Freshman of the Week for the second time (12/20) after her career-best performance against Southern Illinois.
- Gregory set career highs for points (27), field goals (10) and tied her career highs for 3-pointers (5) in MT's 62-61 win.
- Gregory was 10-of-18 from the field, including a sizzling 5-of-8 from 3-point range.
- Gregory scored 10 of her 27 in the fourth quarter to help rally the Lady Raiders from an eight-point second-half deficit.

**Lady Raiders Defense Stifling**

- MT's defense has been a strong suit in 2021-22. The Lady Raiders rank 43rd nationally in scoring defense, yielding 54.5 points per game. The Lady Raiders have held eight opponents below 60 points.
- MT has been particularly solid defending the 3-point line. MT ranks 10th nationally in 3-point FG defense, limiting foes to 22 percent beyond the arc.

**50 Below**

- The Lady Raiders held their four opponents to less than 50 points, marking the only time in program history that a MT team has held four straight foes to less than 50 points during any stretch.
- Prior to limiting Tennessee Tech to 47 points in their fourth game of the season, the 2021-22 Lady Raiders had become only the third team in program history to hold three straight opponents to less than 50 points during any stretch. The other two occurrences were Jan. 11-18, 2018; and Jan. 22-29, 2005.
- MT has held five opponents under 50 points this season.

**Setting The Tone**

- MT turned up the defense at the outset of games against East Carolina and VCU.
- The Lady Raider defensive effort was record-setting in terms of fewest points allowed in a quarter.
- They allowed four points in the first quarter at VCU which are the fewest allowed in the first quarter since NCAA Women's Basketball switched from halves to quarters prior to the 2015-16 season. The four points also tied for the fewest points given up in any quarter in Lady Raider history.
- MT allowed just five first-quarter points vs. ECU.

**Spreading The Wealth**

- MT has been more efficient offensively at the outset of the 2021-22 season, forcing defenses to focus on more players within the offensive system.
- Four different players have led the Lady Raiders in scoring this season. Consequently, MT only had three different players lead the team in scoring in all 25 games of the 2020-21 season.
- Kseniya Malashka (3), Courtney Whitson (3), Jalynn Gregory (3) and Dor Saar (3) have each led the Lady Raiders in scoring.
- Six Lady Raiders average 5.7 points or more, including two true freshmen: Gregory (9.4) and Courtney Blakely (6.3).

**Smashing Debut**

- Transfer Kseniya Malashka made a statement in her Lady Raider debut against Vanderbilt.
- Malashka provided a spark off of the bench with a team-high 17 points on 8-of-12 shooting, to go with six rebounds, three steals and two blocked shots.

### Lady Raiders Land Heralded Transfer

• MT welcomes the addition of graduate transfer Dor Saar for the 2021-22 season.

• Saar, who hails from Isreal, turned in one of the most prolific careers in University of Maine's history during her four years there.

• Saar is Maine's all-time leader for 3-point FGs (235) and she is second on the program's all-time assists list (507). Saar is a member of program's 1,000-point club, and she is the only player in Maine women's basketball history with 1,000-plus points and 500-plus assists.

### Statistically Speaking ...

• The Lady Raiders will be looking in different places to replace a bulk of its offense from last season.

• MT lost 72 percent of its scoring, 57 percent of its 3-point field goals, 59 percent of its rebounding, 66 percent of its steals and 79 percent of its assists from 2020-21.

• Rebounding and 3-point shooting are two of the strongest areas for returning production. Courtney Whitson (56) and Alexis Whittington (39) combined for 41 percent of the team's 3-pointers.

• Whitson and Whittington were also two of the team's top rebounders last season. Whitson averaged a team-best 7.7 caroms, and Whittington pulled 5.8 per game.

### International Flavor

• MT has five International players on its 2021-22 roster, which is the most of any single season. They hail from Belarus, Canada, Isreal, Russia and Spain.

• MT has not had a strong history of landing International players as only five had suited up for the Lady Raiders in program history prior to the 2020-21 season.

### 70 Magic Number

• When MT scores **70-plus** under Insell it is a staggering **253-19** for a 93 percent winning clip.

• Give MT 80 points or more and they are nearly unbeatable under Insell with a **121-2** mark.
