Cards Continue Road Swing at UTSA, Texas Tech Although Lamar University is continuing its four-game road swing - a stretch that includes nine of 12 away from home – the Cardinals (1-4) will stay within the borders of the Lone Star State to face UTSA and Texas Tech. The Cardinals are looking to bounce back from a tough start to the season, which has seen four consecutive losses after a season opening win. The last three games have been close with LU falling by single digits in each of the last three. Big Red will look to turn things around Wednesday when they travel to San Antonio, Texas to face UTSA. The Roadrunners enter the week with a 3-3 (.500) record and have won two of their last three, but are coming off a 19-point set back against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. The game against the Roadrunners will tip off Wednesday at 2 p.m. from the Convocation Center, and will be televised on CUSA TV. LU will then travel to Lubbock, Texas Saturday for a game against Texas Tech. The Red Raiders are 4-0 and have been consistent on the year scoring between 84 and 89 points in each contest. Tech is coming off a 22-point victory over UIW Saturday and will host Omaha Tuesday before taking on the Cardinals. Saturday's game at Tech will tip off at Saturday at 3 p.m. from the United SuperMarkets Arena. It will be televised on ESPN+.

n LU vs. the Roadrunners

Wednesday's contest will be the 36th all-time meeting between the two schools. LU holds a slight 19-16 (.543) advantage, but the Roadrunner have won each of the previous two meetings, including an 88-66 decision in San Antonio last season. The schools have split the previous four games, but LU is 9-10 (.474) all-time in San Antonio.

LU vs. the Red Raiders

Saturday's contest against Texas Tech will be just the fifth all-time meeting between the two schools. Texas Tech holds a 3-1 (.750) lead in the series with all three wins com-

ing in Lubbock. LU's lone victory in the series came during the 2008-09 season in Beaumont (85-79). The contest in Lubbock will be the first meeting since the 2009-10 season.

LU in November

The Cardinals have played nearly .500 basketball all time in the season's opening month throughout its history. LU is 90-91 (.497) all-time in the month of November – including a 61-14 (.813) mark at home.

Defending The Nest

LU has made the Montagne Center one of the toughest venues for opponents to play over the course of its 30-plus year history. The Cardinals are 355-174 (.671) all-time in the Montagne Center. LU recorded a program-best 15 home wins in 1987-88 season and is 1-1 at home this season.

Heating Up

One of the school's all-time leading three-point shooters, senior Davion Buster got out to a slow start but appears to be heating up. After hitting just five threes in his first three games, Buster has knocked down seven in the previous two. He is shooting .412 from long range during that stretch.

Getting the Start

Senior transfer C.J. Roberts recorded the first start of his LU career at Southern Mississippi and rewarded the coaching staff with a career-high 16 points. It is the second time this season that Roberts has scored in double figures. He also pulled down six rebounds and dished out four assists against the Golden Eagles.

A Tale of Two Halves

LU enters the week with a 1-4 record, but that could very easily be reversed. At Georgia Tech, the Cardinals fell behind by 22 points in the first half only to rally within four in the second half but came up just short. Against both Stetson and Southern Mississippi, the Cardinals owned double-digit leads only to fall in the second half in close battles. In the first half of the previous two games LU has held opponents to a 17-of-59 (.288) performance, but in the second half it has been a much different story. In the final twenty minutes of the past two games, opponents have shot a combined 32-of-55 (.582) against LU.

The Cardinal Rule

LU was one of the Southland's more dominant teams before making the transition to the Western Athletic Conference this past offseason. The Cardinals won 52 percent of their SLC games and had more NCAA tournament appearances than any of the current Southland school (6), and their five NIT berths were also tops in the league. LU had 81 players earn all-conference honors, including 32 first-team selections. Six players were named league newcomer of the year, there were four MVP selections and a conference defensive player of the year. Five former Cardinals had also been named SLC tournament MVP.

Alvin Brooks Head Coach 1-4/First Season at LU 55-88/Sixth Season Overall

One of the all-time great players in Lamar University Cardinal basketball history, Alvin Brooks was named the program's 12th head coach on April 1, 2021. Brooks returns to

the program that he led to the 1980 NCAA Sweet 16 as a player, and where his coaching career began.

A college coaching veteran with 37 years' experience on the sidelines, Brooks has participated in 23 postseason tournaments as a coach or student-athlete – including most recently serving as an assistant on a Houston squad that advanced to the 2021 Final Four in Indianapolis. During his career, Brooks has helped coach teams to seven conference championships, including two with LU (1982-83 and 1983-84). The list of conference titles that Brooks has been a part of includes the 1983 and 1984 Southland Conference (LU), 1992 Southwestern Conference Co-Champions and SWC Classic Champions (Houston), 2004 WAC Co-Champions (UTEP) and the 2019 and 2020 American Athletic Conference titles (Houston).

Brooks' players have also reaped the benefits of his guidance as he coached 17 players who competed in the NBA with a dozen more playing professionally overseas. The list of players Brooks has guided to the NBA includes Greg Anderson, Randy Brown, Damyean Dotson, Rolando Ferreira, Anthony Goldwire, Carl Herrera, Damon Jones, Sam Mack, Bo Outlaw, Alvaro Teheran, Craig Upchuch, Rickie Winslow, Andre Emmett, Acie Law IV, Antoine Wright, Fili Rivera and Tom Sewall.

A former All-Southland Conference guard for the Cardinals in the early 1980s, Brooks returns to the Golden Triangle after spending the previous 11 seasons with the Cougars. During his time in Houston, Brooks has helped build the program back to national prominence.

The Cougars have finished either first or second in the American Athletic Conference standings in each of the past four seasons, and have won at least 20 games in each of the previous six seasons – including a 33-win campaign in 2018-19. The consecutive seasons of at least 20 wins is the most successful sixyear stretch in program history. The 2020-21 season also marked the fourth consecutive season the Cougars have finished ranked among the top 25, which is also a program first.

The list of program firsts doesn't stop there. In 2018-19, Houston posted a school-record 33 wins and posted the program's first outright AAC regular-season championship. That season, the Cougars advanced to the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 for the first time since 1984.

Before joining Kelvin Sampson's staff, Brooks spent five seasons as the Cougars' head coach from 1993 to 1998, becoming one of the nation's youngest head coaches at the time, and Houston first African-American head coach in program history.

Before rejoining the Cougars' program, Brooks spent two seasons as the director of operations at Kentucky (2007-09). Brooks' coaching career has also consisted of stops Texas A&M, UTEP, North Texas, Texas Tech and LU.

Brooks' coaching career began at his alma mater in 1981 where he would serve as an assistant to Cardinal Hall of Honor head coach Pat Foster for the next five seasons. During that stretch, the Cardinals won 109 games, posted a .712 winning percentage (109-44), made four postseason NIT appearances, won two Southland Conference regular-season titles and advance to the 1983 NCAA Championships where they advanced to the second round of the tournament.

Fans of the Red and White will always remember Brooks for his time as the Cardinals' point guard from 1979 to 1981. A two-year letterwinner who played for legendary coaches Billy Tubbs and Foster, Brooks guided the Cardinals to 47 wins – including three NCAA tournament wins, consecutive SLC titles and an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance.

A 1981 All-Southland selection, Brooks was a 10thround selection of the San Antonio Spurs in the 1981 NBA draft. Selected by the Beaumont Enterprise as one of the five greatest players in LU history, Brooks was inducted into the Cardinals Hall of Honor in 2019.

In just two short seasons with the Cardinals, Brooks became the school's all-time leader in assists with 432 – a mark which still ranks second in program history. Brooks averaged better than 10 points per game during his senior season and set the school single-season record with 249 assists.

A 1982 graduate of LU, Brooks and his wife, Richelle, have five children – daughter, Andree, and sons Casey, Julian, Vincent and Alvin III. Alvin has followed in his father's footsteps and is currently an assistant coach at Baylor.
