UTSA AT A GLANCE: UTSA is the winner of its last two games at its own Thanksgiving Classic this past weekend. Tesha Smith had a breakout weekend as she combined for 33 points and collected a career-high 22 points against Illinois State. Smith also registered the team's first double-double of the year and her eighth total. The San Antonio native is averaging team bests of 11.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game. The Roadrunners head up I-35 to take on rival Texas State with a 2-2 record off of wins over Illinois State and Houston Baptist. UTSA had five Roadrunners score in double figures Sunday with Niaga Mitchell-Cole leading the way with 14. In the Roadrunners' opening game at the Thanksgiving Classic, UTSA held the Redbirds to just three points and ended the first guarter on a 24-0 run.

TEXAS STATE AT A GLANCE: Texas State welcomes UTSA with a 2-4 record and currently on a three-game losing streak. The Bobcats are coming off the Cancun Challenge-Mayan Tournament and notched losses to Iowa State, Idaho and Duke. Texas State sits tied for eighth in the Sun Belt standings and were voted to finish sixth in the preseason poll. The Bobcats are being outscored by 20 points and are shooting a mere 32.6 percent from the field. Its 34 points against Duke was the lowest score total this season for Texas State after totaling just 11 points in the first half. On the court, Taeler Deer is averaging double figures with 12.2 points per game and totaled a season-high of 32 against North Texas almost two weeks ago.

UP NEXT: UTSA will hit the road for its final road trip for the month of December and take on No. 21 Oklahoma on Dec. 13. Sunday's contest will air on Fox Sports Southwest Plus.

LAST TIME OUT

SAN ANTONIO — UTSA wrapped up its annual Thanksgiving Classic with a 79-50 victory against Houston Baptist on Sunday afternoon at the Convocation Center.

The Roadrunners (2-2) won both their games over the weekend and three players were named to the all-tournament team with Niaga Mitchell-Cole named the Most Valuable Player. Tesha Smith and Akunna Elonu joined Mitchell-Cole on the five-member team.

Mitchell-Cole led five players in double figures with 14 points and she added five rebounds. Alexus Dukes and Carlie Heineman both tallied 13 points, while Smith contributed 11 and Elonu scored 10.

UTSA's second victory of the season came after an early back-andforth battle with the Huskies (2-3). Two ties and four lead changes occurred in the first period before the Roadrunners could gain a comfortable lead over the Huskies. UTSA ended the first quarter on an 8-0 run to take an 18-11 advantage.

Houston Baptist struggled on the floor, shooting 31 percent (19-of-62) from the field, but the Huskies were 7-of-11 from 3-point range.

The Roadrunners were 32-of-60 from the floor and held a 37-35 rebounding edge.

UTSA continued its scoring onslaught throughout the remainder of the contest and held its largest lead of 34 in the third quarter with 33 ticks remaining.

Houston Baptist was led by Rachel Arthur's 15 points and she added three assists, a rebound and one steal.

UTSA will hit the road for its next two contests beginning with a Thursday, Dec. 3, matchup at I-35 rival Texas State (2-4). Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Strahan Coliseum.
