### Fast Break Points

- UTSA has won its past four contests. The Roadrunners haven't won five games in a row since the 2010-11 season and haven't won six in a row since the 2008-09 season.
- During the four-game winning streak, UTSA won two consecutive games in overtime. It was the first back-to-back overtime games in Roadrunners history since the 2005-06 season.
- After not having a player average double figures in scoring during the 2012-13 campaign, Kamra King has answered the call in 2013-14. The Norman, Okla. native is averaging 15.3 points per game (12th in Conference USA) and 2.00 3-pointers per contest (3rd in C-USA).
- UTSA will go only as far as its defense takes them. So far, the Roadrunners have held opponents to 60.2 points per game, good for sixth best in Conference USA.
- The Roadrunners have struggled on the offensive end of the court through the seasons first nine games averaging a league low 59.9 points per game and shooting .352 from the field and .211 from behind the 3-point arc.
- At Texas, Tesha Smith became the first freshman in UTSA history to record a double-double (10 points, 10 rebounds) in her debut. Smith also secured a double-double in the Roadrunners loss to Savannah State with 16 points and 11 rebounds.
- Against Lamar, King set a career-high with 27 points. King has led the Roadrunners in scoring in four of the first six contests of the season after ranking as the top point producer her first two seasons in the Alamo City.
- In UTSA's exhibition win over East Central (Okla.), Miki Turner led four players in double figures with 16 points and the Roadrunners defeated the Lady Tigers by a score of 76-50. Kamra King added 13 points on 4-of-5 shooting, while juniors Ashley Spaletta and Niaga Mitchell-Cole each tallied 11. Freshman Tesha Smith pulled down a game-high 15 rebounds in 15 minutes of action.
- UTSA returns seven letterwinners and two starters from last year's team that finished 16-14 overall and 10-8 in the Western Athletic Conference. The Roadrunners earned a fourth-place finish in the WAC standings after they were picked to finish eighth in the preseason media poll and ninth the coaches' poll.
- UTSA is competing in its third conference in as many seasons after officially joining Conference USA on July 1, 2013. The Roadrunners competed as members of the Southland Conference from 1992-2012 before joining the Western Athletic Conference for the 2012-13 campaign.
- Among the squad's newcomers this season is McKenzie Adams, a senior from nearby Schertz, Texas. Adams will be playing her first competitive basketball games since high school and has spent the last three years dominating the volleyball court. She won ACC Freshman of the Year as a freshman at Virginia before transferring to UTSA, where she was the Southland Newcomer of the Year as a sophomore in 2011. Last season she earned honorable mention All-America honors from the American Volleyball Coaches Association and was named Western Athletic Conference Player of the Year. Adams was also picked as the 2013 C-USA Preseason Player of the Year.
- The Roadrunners showed a knack for not letting up in the second half as the team went 13-0 last season when leading at halftime.
- Radford claimed six consecutive Big South Tournament titles (1991-96) under Lichonczak's guidance and made three straight NCAA Tournament appearances (1994-96). Lichonczak earned Big South Coach of the Year honors in 1992 after the squad posted a 20-9 record and 11-1 league ledger en route to a conference regular-season title.

UTSA Athletics Director Lynn Hickey announced the hiring of Lubomyr "Luby" Lichonczak as the eighth head women's basketball coach in the program's history on Aug. 28, 2013.

"I'm excited to have someone with the wealth of coaching experience and knowledge of our program that Luby possesses," Hickey said. "He has coached at significant programs around the country along with some outstanding service in the professional ranks. As a member of my coaching staff for several years at Texas A&M, I have first-hand knowledge of his values, his desire to help our students grow and become successful on and off the court as well as his passion for the sport."

"First, I would like to thank my family, who has continuously supported me throughout my career, and all of the numerous players, coaches and administrators that have helped me along the way," Lichonczak said. "I also would like to thank President Dr. Ricardo Romo, Athletics Director Lynn Hickey and Associate Athletics Director Tamica Smith-Jones for giving me this wonderful opportunity."

"I believe that our university athletic environment can be a classroom for life in educating the whole person, mind, body, heart and spirit. Working with young people in an educational and competitive environment is an important undertaking and a challenge and I look forward to facing this challenge with hard work, intensity, caring and enthusiasm."

Lichonczak has spent 11 years on the Roadrunners' coaching staff, including the last nine as the associate head coach. He was hired at UTSA prior to the 2002-03 season and spent two campaigns as an assistant before being promoted to associate head coach. Lichonczak primarily worked with the post players and served as the program's scouting coordinator and team academic liaison and assisted with scheduling and recruiting.

During his time on the UTSA bench he helped mentor 23 all-conference selections – including seven first-team All-Southland Conference picks – one Southland Player and Defensive Player of the Year (Monica Gibbs/2009), three Southland Newcomers of the Year (Dwella Holliday, 2003/Vivian Ewalefo, 2006/Onika Anderson, 2008) and a pair of Southland Freshmen of the Year (Richelle Parks, 2005/Monica Gibbs, 2006).

He was instrumental in helping UTSA win back-to-back Southland Tournament Championships to earn the program's only NCAA Tournament appearances in 2008 and '09. The 2008-09 squad posted a school-record 24 wins and became the first No. 15-seed in the history of the NCAA Division I Championship to take a No. 2-seed to overtime.

In addition to the squad's accomplishments on the court, Lichonczak aided several student-athletes in the classroom. Ryba Pawlaczky earned ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Aca-

demic All-District IV, Southland Student-Athlete of the Year and first-team Southland All-Academic in 2009, while Nicole Dunson took home the league's Student-Athlete of the Year and first-team all-academic honors in 2005.

Lichonczak came to the Alamo City after spending the 2001-02 campaign as the associate head coach at Colorado State where he helped the Rams to a 24-7 mark, including a 12-2 league record en route to the Mountain West Regular Season Championship and an at-large berth in the NCAA Tournament.

His stint in Fort Collins came after an 11-year run as the head coach at Radford (1990-2001). Lichonczak coached the Highlanders to a 151-151 (.500) overall record and 99-53 (.651) mark in Big South Conference games. His 151 wins rank second in program annals.

Under his guidance, Radford claimed six consecutive Big South Tournament titles (1991-96) and made three straight NCAA Tournament appearances (1994-96). Lichonczak earned Big South Coach of the Year honors in 1992 after the squad posted a 20-9 record and 11-1 league ledger en route to a conference regular-season title.

Lichonczak was an assistant under Hickey at Texas A&M from 1987-90 after a pair of seasons (1985-87) at Old Dominion, where he helped the Monarchs to the 1987 Sun Belt Conference Championship and an NCAA Tournament berth. Prior to his time in Norfolk, Va., Lichonczak was an assistant at Ohio State from 1980-85 and aided the Buckeyes to four consecutive Big Ten titles (1982-85) and NCAA Tournament appearances in 1982, '84 and '85. The 1985 squad finished the season with a 26-2 record, 18-0 Big Ten mark and advanced to the Elite Eight before falling to Old Dominion, the eventual national champion.

His coaching career began at his alma mater, Idaho, in 1978. In his final campaign with the Vandals, the squad went 25-6 and claimed the Region IX Championship to advance to the Association for Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (AIAW) Division II National Tournament.

Along with his collegiate experience, Lichonczak served in the WNBA as an advance scout for the San Antonio Silver Stars in 2010 and was a first assistant and offensive coordinator for the Washington Mystics in 2009. In addition, he was an assistant coach for the Nigerian Women's National Team in 2007.

Lichonczak, who earned a bachelor of science degree in social studies and education from Idaho in 1978 and a master of arts degree in athletic administration from Ohio State in 1985, and his wife, Maryann, have a son, Yov, and a daughter, Nika.

#### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

##### EBONY ROWE, MIDDLE TENNESSEE | 6-1, SR., F | LEXINGTON, KY



Rowe averaged a double-double, scoring 24.7 points and grabbing 11.7 rebounds in Middle Tennessee's victories over UCF, USF and South Dakota State last week. The senior forward opened the week with 20 points and 11 rebounds in MT's 63-51 victory at UCF. Rowe followed up that performance with a critical 25 points and 11 rebounds as MT knocked off the USF Bulls, 68-62, in Tampa. Rowe closed out the weekend by matching her season-high with 29 points and grabbing 13 rebounds as the Raiders won their eighth straight with a 59-44 win over South Dakota State. She shot 68 percent from the field, knocking down 11 of 16 shots. Rowe dished out eight assists and shot 55.1 percent (27-of-49) from the field on the weekend. She also moved into second all-time with 1,997 points on Saturday. Rowe's 11 makes against SDSU moved her to second all-time with 784 career field goals made. Rowe leads the Blue Raiders 23.2 points and 11.6 rebounds per game. The Lexington, Ky., product has nine double-doubles in 12 games and a school-best 62 in her career. She has scored double-figures in 18 consecutive games and 105 times in her four-year career. Rowe has now collected two C-USA Players of the Week honors (Dec. 2).

#### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

##### CHELSEY ROMERO, MARSHALL | 6-1, F | QUEENS, N.Y.



Romero averaged 11.5 rebounds per game and tied her career high with 14 boards against Delaware State on Dec. 21. She also established a personal best of three blocks against both opponents. Against Wofford, she scored 10 points, had nine rebounds and shot .417 from the field. The forward helped the Herd to back-to-back victories for the first time in head coach Matt Daniel's two seasons. Romero stepped into the starting lineup to play for junior center Chukwuka Ezeigbo, who is out of the country with a family emergency. This is Romero first C-USA Freshman of the week honor.
