Roadrunners conclude home slate with No. 14 Rice

UTSA BRIEF: A series win last weekend over Middle Tennessee has UTSA positioned in a tie for fourth place in the Conference USA standings with six league games remaining. The C-USA Tournament will take place May 21-24 in Hattiesburg, Miss.

SERIES HISTORY: UTSA (30-19, 14-10) will be looking for its second-ever win over Rice and first since the 1994 season. The Owls own an 11-1 edge in the all-time series and have won the past nine. Rice took last season's contest, 11-5, on March 20 at Reckling Park.

SCOUTING RICE

Perennial Conference-USA power Rice has continued its domination of the league this spring and enter the weekend series at UTSA with a two-game lead over second-place UAB for the regular season crown.

The Owls (32-15, 18-6 C-USA) have the second ranked offense and the second ranked pitching staff in the conference, trailing only FIU in both categories. The team calling card may lie on defense as the defending C-USA champs lead the league with a .980 fielding percentage.

Four Owls have averages north of .300 with John Clay Reeves leading the way with a .341 mark. Shane Hoelscher boasts a team-high 16 doubles while Skyler Ewing has been the lead RBI mark with 39.

On the hill, Rice has been bit by the injury bug as ace Zach Lemond has been on the shelf since leaving an Apr. 4 contest at East Carolina. Despite the injury the Owls have continued to pitch effectively with opponents batting just .229 this season.

HOME COOKING

The Roadrunners have played 30 of their 49 games at home this season and have only left the state of Texas for four separate three-game series at Southern Miss, Tulane, Old Dominion and Middle Tennessee. UTSA has a 20-10 record at Roadrunner Field.

SQUAD BREAKDOWN

Among the 31 players on the Roadrunners' roster, 28 hail from Texas. Only Tony Ramirez (Ferdale, Mich.), Andre Vieyra (Valley Center, Kan.), and Jeremy Filipek (Langley, B.C.) come from outside the Lone Star State. There are (8) seniors, (12) juniors, (4) sophomores, and (7) freshmen.

MULTI-HIT BARRAGE

UTSA currently has seven players who have 10 or more multi-hit games in 2014. Horaco Correa III leads the way with 20 such contests followed by Mike Warren who has 19. Jesse Baker has the most games with at least three hits with seven and John Welborn has a pair of four-hit games on his resume.

EIGHTH INNING IS WINNING TIME

UTSA has outscored its opponents 45-15 this season in the eighth inning. In the Bird's 7-6 victory over Texas State on Apr. 15 UTSA scored six runs in the eighth to upend a 2-1 deficit.

SHUT IT DOWN

UTSA is the only C-USA team with two players ranked in the top-10 in saves. Logan Onda leads the way with seven and Matt Sims has added five more this spring. Sims is ranked second in program history with 20 career saves.

COMPLETE GAMES IN A SERIES

Brock Hartson and Justin Anderson threw complete games at Tulane to bookend a series victory over the Green Wave. It is believed to be the first time in program history that two UTSA hurlers have gone the distance in the same three-game series.

LONG BALLS GALORE

In UTSA's eight-run third inning at Middle Tennessee on Saturday the Roadrunners hit two home runs, a three-run shot by Mike Warren and a grand slam by C.J. Pickering. It was the first time since May 17, 2013 at Louisiana Tech that the Roadrunners had two round trippers in the same inning.

GRAND SLAMS

Pickering's grand slam is UTSA's third this season joining Tony Ramirez and RJ Perucki for the team-lead with one apiece. It is the most grand slams in a season for a UTSA team since the 2008 team also had three.

JASON MARSHALL
Head Coach
Second season/14th at UTSA
Texas A&M, 1996

After serving as an assistant and associate head coach at UTSA for 12 years, Jason Marshall just completed his first season as the head coach of the Roadrunners baseball program. Marshall was named the fourth skipper in UTSA baseball history on June 18, 2012.

In his first year at the helm, Marshall guided the Birds to a 35-25 overall record and their third appearance in an NCAA Regional after the club captured the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Tournament Championship. UTSA, which posted a perfect 4-0 record en route to the league title, was sent to the Corvallis (Ore.) Regional and took No. 3 national seed Oregon State to its last at-bat before the Beavers rallied for a 5-4 victory. The Roadrunners wrapped up their first postseason run in eight years the following day with a 6-1 loss to Texas A&M.

Three UTSA players — Daniel Rockett (ninth round/Kansas City Royals), Riley Good (14th round/Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim) and Clint Sharp (38th round/Angels) — were drafted after the campaign concluded, while right-handed pitcher Brock Hartson was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball. Third baseman RJ Perucki earned first-team all-league honors, while Good, Hartson and Rockett garnered second-team accolades.

In their first and only season in the WAC, the Roadrunners led the circuit with a .299 batting average and 629 hits. Perucki (.350/fifth) and Good (.335/ninth) both ranked among the top 10 batting averages in the league and the duo tied for second in the WAC with 84 hits apiece. Perucki also finished second in the circuit with 132 total bases and third with 12 home runs, while Rockett's .562 slugging percentage was good for third.

Marshall spent 12 years on the Roadrunners' coaching staff before being promoted to head coach, including nine as the associate head coach from 2004-12.

The Abilene native was hired at UTSA prior to the 2001 season and spent three campaigns as an assistant before being promoted to associate head coach. He served as both the infielders coach and recruiting coordinator while running the Roadrunners' summer camps.

A standout performer at Texas A&M from 1989-92, he was named the Aggies' Most Valuable Player after leading the team in games played (61), hits (66), runs scored (35) and RBIs (40) as a senior.

Following his collegiate career, he was drafted by the Royals in the 13th round of the 1992 MLB Draft. Marshall went on to play four seasons in the Royals organization before finishing his professional career in 1995.

Marshall earned a bachelor of science degree in kinesiology from Texas A&M in 1996. His wife, Ashleigh, have two sons, Cooper and Jackson, and a daughter, Kate.
