Quick NOTES...

- Brock Hartson has lowered his season ERA to 1.65 and in turn lowered his career ERA to a UTSA record low 2.73. The record holder entering the season was Josh Blakely who had a 2.88 career mark between the 2006-07 seasons. Hartson has not allowed an earned run since the first inning against Louisiana Tech on Mar. 28. That is a span of 29.0 innings.

- UTSA is 20-7 this season when it scores the first run of the game and only 6-8 when opponents plate the first run. The Roadrunners have scored in the first inning in 17 games this season while opponents have registered a run in the first inning nine times.

Runners looking to end season-long three-game skid vs. Charlotte

UTSA BRIEF: UTSA begins a three-game Conference USA series Friday night at Roadrunner Field with fellow league newcomer Charlotte (12-25-1, 4-13 C-USA) at 6 p.m. The Roadrunners will be looking to end a three-game losing streak that continued Tuesday with a 5-2 setback at Houston Baptist. While the losing streak has come at a pivotal point in the season, the Birds remain in the thick of the Conference USA league race. UTSA is trailing only Rice and Southern Miss and is tied with East Carolina for third place with four weekends left in the regular season.

SERIES HISTORY: UTSA will be meeting the 49ers for the first-time ever. It will also be the Roadrunners first meeting with a team from the state of North Carolina. The two campuses are separated by 1,251 miles, equivalent to an 18-hour drive. A road trip from the Alamo City to Charlotte would take you through Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia, South Carolina, and finally North Carolina.

SCOUTING CHARLOTTE

Charlotte (12-25-1, 4-13 C-USA) comes to the Alamo City playing its best baseball of the season having won four of its past five games including a 12-4 triumph over Wake Forest on Wednesday.

Brett Land is the 49er's leader at the plate with a .298 average and a team-leading nine doubles.

Charlotte pounded out a season-high 17 hits on its way to scoring a season-best 12 runs in Wednesday's victory over the Deamon Deacons.

The 49er's have been plagued by an inconsistent defense committing a league-high 51 errors and 41 unearned runs.

HOME COOKING

The Roadrunners have played 25 of their 41 games at home this season and have only left the state of Texas for three separate three-game series at Southern Miss, Tulane, and Old Dominion. UTSA has a 18-7 record at Roadrunner Field.

SQUAD BREAKDOWN

Among the 31 players on the Roadrunners' roster, 28 hail from Texas. Only Tony Ramirez (Ferndale, Mich.), Andre Vieyra (Valley Center, Kan.), and Jeremy Filipek (Langley, B.C.) come from outside the Lone Star State. There are (8) seniors, (12) juniors, (4) sophomores, and (7) freshmen.

MULTI-HIT BARRAGE

UTSA currently has seven players who have 10 or more multi-hit games in 2014. Horaco Correa III leads the way with 17 such contests followed by RJ Perucki who has 16. Jesse Baker has the most games with at least three hits with six and John Welborn has a pair of four-hit games on his resume.

EIGHTH INNING IS WINNING TIME

UTSA has outscored its opponents 43-15 this season in the eighth inning. In the Bird's 7-6 victory over Texas State on Apr. 15 UTSA scored six runs in the eighth to upend a 2-1 deficit.

WEEKEND ROTATION

The Roadrunner's weekend triumvirate of starting pitchers — Brock Hartson, Nolan Trabanino and Justin Anderson — will bring a combined 2.37 ERA into the series, which ranks 16th nationally. Fellow Conference USA foes FIU and UAB top the list headed into this weekend's slate of games.

JASON MARSHALL
Head Coach
Second season/14th at UTSA
Texas A&M, 1996

After serving as an assistant and associate head coach at UTSA for 12 years, Jason Marshall just completed his first season as the head coach of the Roadrunners baseball program. Marshall was named the fourth skipper in UTSA baseball history on June 18, 2012.

In his first year at the helm, Marshall guided the Birds to a 35-25 overall record and their third appearance in an NCAA Regional after the club captured the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Tournament Championship. UTSA, which posted a perfect 4-0 record en route to the league title, was sent to the Corvallis (Ore.) Regional and took No. 3 national seed Oregon State to its last at-bat before the Beavers rallied for a 5-4 victory. The Roadrunners wrapped up their first postseason run in eight years the following day with a 6-1 loss to Texas A&M.

Three UTSA players — Daniel Rockett (ninth round/Kansas City Royals), Riley Good (14th round/Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim) and Clint Sharp (38th round/Angels) — were drafted after the campaign concluded, while right-handed pitcher Brock Hartson was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball. Third baseman RJ Perucki earned first-team all-league honors, while Good, Hartson and Rockett garnered second-team accolades.

In their first and only season in the WAC, the Roadrunners led the circuit with a .299 batting average and 629 hits. Perucki (.350/fifth) and Good (.335/ninth) both ranked among the top 10 batting averages in the league and the duo tied for second in the WAC with 84 hits apiece. Perucki also finished second in the circuit with 132 total bases and third with 12 home runs, while Rockett's .562 slugging percentage was good for third.

Marshall spent 12 years on the Roadrunners' coaching staff before being promoted to head coach, including nine as the associate head coach from 2004-12.

The Abilene native was hired at UTSA prior to the 2001 season and spent three campaigns as an assistant before being promoted to associate head coach. He served as both the infielders coach and recruiting coordinator while running the Roadrunners' summer camps.

A standout performer at Texas A&M from 1989-92, he was named the Aggies' Most Valuable Player after leading the team in games played (61), hits (66), runs scored (35) and RBIs (40) as a senior.

Following his collegiate career, he was drafted by the Royals in the 13th round of the 1992 MLB Draft. Marshall went on to play four seasons in the Royals organization before finishing his professional career in 1995.

Marshall earned a bachelor of science degree in kinesiology from Texas A&M in 1996. His wife, Ashleigh, have two sons, Cooper and Jackson, and a daughter, Kate.
