UTSA AT A GLANCE: UTSA returns eight letter winners for the upcoming 2015-16 season, including top rebounder and senior Akunna Elonu. Of those eight letter winners, just two were regular starters one year ago. The Roadrunners finished in an unexpected tie for fourth in the Conference USA standings with an 11-7 league record and earned a first-round bye at the Conference USA Basketball Championship with 64-63 win over WKU. Head women's basketball coach Lubomyr Lichonczak rounded out his roster with the addition of five new faces, including former UTSA volleyball standout Dempsey Thornton. Lichonczak's other additions include a pair of freshman and a junior college and Division I transer. With the loss of point guard Kamra King, the third-year head coach will rely heavily on freshman Alexus Dukes. The Harker Heights native was a standout athlete at Harker Heights HS and was a McDonald's All-American nominee her senior year.

**TEXAS AT A GLANCE:** Texas opens up the 2015-16 season checking in at No. 11 in the WBCA Coaches' Poll and No. 12 in the AP Top-25 Preseason Poll. The Longhorns are coming off a 24-11 season and are predicted to finish second in the Big 12. UT made a run at the NCAA Tournament last season and were bounced out in the Third Round with a 105-54 loss to eventual champion-UConn. Four Longhorns players were selected to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team with freshman Lashann Higgs tabbed as the Preseason Freshman of the Year. Ariel Atkins, Imani Boyette and Kelsey Lang each earned a spot on the honorable mention team.

**UP NEXT:** The Roadrunners continue on with its two-game season-opening road trip as the team heads to Abilene Christian for a November 21 match-up.
