LAST MEETING: March 29, 2015 in San Antonio, Texas (L, 5-9)

UTSA AT A GLANCE: The Roadrunners will hit the road for a three-game series against No. 19 Florida Atlantic in the Sunshine State. UTSA heads into the weekend off a 6-0 loss to Texas State in the rubber game of the year. The Bobcats scored half of their runs on a pair of home runs in the first and second innings. The Roadrunners were shutout for the second time this season and tallied a season-low of two hits. Bryan Arias had the first hit of the game in the fourth and Jason Serchay had a pinch-hit shot up the middle in the ninth. Meanwhile, Jake Harrison received his first decision of the season behind 3.2 innings of work. He was charged with all six TXST runs. Offensively, the Roadrunners are led by freshman Bryan Arias as he sports a .325 batting average with 50 hits, six doubles, three triples, 21 runs, 14 RBI, three stolen bases and a .403 slugging percentage. On the mound, Chance Kirby leads the pitching staff with a 4.19 ERA and is 1-4 on the season. He's tossed 62.1 innings and is second on the staff with 39 strikeouts. Friday night starter Aaron Burns follows with a 4.79 ERA and leads Conference USA with 12 starts. Burns is 3-6 and has thrown 67.1 innings.

FLORIDA ATLANTIC AT A GLANCE: The 19th-ranked Florida Atlantic Owls will take on No. 3 Miami on Thursday before heading into the weekend series against UTSA on Friday. The Owls are currently third in the league standings behind Southern Miss and Rice with a 14-7 record in league action and 30-12 mark overall. In the Owls' last 10 games, Florida Atlantic is 5-5 and most recently dropped a 4-3 decision to Southern Miss in Boca Raton. Leading the way for the Owls is CJ Chatham as he is batting a .391 clip and has seen action in all 42 games - all starts as well. Chatham tops the team with 70 hits, including 15 doubles, four triples and five home runs, with 39 RBI, 40 runs scored and sports a .603 slugging percentage.

UP NEXT: UTSA will play in its second to last home midweek game in a rescheduled match-up against in-town opponent Incarnate Word on Wednesday, May 11, at 6 p.m.

Last Time Out

SAN ANTONIO — Texas State blanked UTSA by a score of 6-0 on Tuesday night at Roadrunner Field. It marked the third and final meeting of the spring between the I-35 rivals.

The Roadrunners (15-28), who were shut out for the second time this season, recorded just two hits on the night. Bryan Arias had an infield single in the fourth and Jason Serchay lined a pinch-hit shot up the middle in the ninth.

Every player in the Texas State (24-22) starting lineup record at least one hit with three picking up a pair of base knocks.

The Bobcats scored their first three runs of the game on a pair of home runs with a solo shot in the first and a two-run long ball in the second. Texas State scored its final three runs in the fourth, as eight batters stepped up to the plate.

Both starting pitchers were the pitchers of record.

Jake Harrison (0-1) gave up all six runs and took his first decision of the season. Meanwhile, Chad Dullnig went 5.1 scoreless innings and scattered six hits in his fifth appearance of the season.

Meanwhile, Texas State starter Jeremy Hallonquist went five innings and allowed just one hit, walked two and struck out one for the win.

UTSA will return to Conference USA play this weekend when it travels to the Sunshine State to take on No. 17 Florida Atlantic for a three-game series that will begin at 5:30 p.m. (CT) on Friday.

Diamond Notes

Two of the biggest names in UTSA history were drafted in the 2015 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Senior catcher **John Bormann** had his name called out for a second time and was selected in the 24th round by the Pittsburgh Pirates. Junior right-hander **Brock Hartson** also had his name called and was selected in the 21st round by the Cleveland Indians.

Roadrunners were selected **sixth** in the **Conference USA preseason poll**. Rice was the unanimous preseason favorite receiving all 12 votes. The Owls have won either the regular season or tournament title in each of its 10 years as a member of Conference USA.

UTSA will have another tough schedule ahead of them when they face **six** teams (Houston, Houston Baptist, Florida Atlantic, FIU, Rice, Texas) that earned a **regional berth** in 2015 with half of those hailing from **Conference USA**.

The City of Hattiesburg and **Southern Miss** will host the **2016 Conference USA Baseball Tournament**. Eight teams will make the trip to play in the double-elimination tournament.

Head coach Jason Marshall will return a core of his starting lineup with the exception of three players - John Bormann, Jesse Baker, Kevin Markham. Markham will sit out the 2016 season due to injury.

The **2016** season will mark the **fifth consecutive season** that the UTSA baseball team **opens at home**. The last time the Roadrunners hit the road for Opening Day was back in 2011 when the team opened at Louisiana Monroe.

In **season openers**, UTSA is **10-19** in school history and has won each of its last three Opening Days under the direction of Jason Marshall. He is the fastest coach in program history to reach 100 wins. He currently owns a 103-76 career record.

UPDATE: UTSA is now 11-19 in season openers with a 2-1 victory over UConn.

UTSA **wins** its **fourth straight** season **opener** with a 2-1 victory over UConn (2/19). Skyler Valentine scored the game-winning run on a wild pitch. Valentine hit a solo home run in the bottom of the second for the Roadrunners first run of the game to tie the score at one.

Sophomore **Chance Kirby** got the **starting nod** on **Opening Day** and was **masterful** in his 7.1 innings of action. Kirby recorded six strikeouts and **retired 10 straight** after allowing a home run in the top of the second. The long ball was the only hit given up by the right-hander.

The Roadrunners **won** their first **two** games of the 2016 season in **walk-off fashion**. Skyler Valentine led UTSA to victory in the season opener as he crossed home on a wild pitch. The following day, the Roadrunners defeated UConn by a score of 6-5 and used Ben Brookover's RBI double to drive in the winning run.

UTSA **rallied** from a **4-0 deficit** to **defeat** Sam Houston State 8-5 in the Roadrunners' first midweek game. Andre Shewcraft pitched three scoreless innings and was backed by a three-run eighth for the win.

In the second series of the season, UTSA pulled out a **series win** over **McNeese** after getting swept in Louisiana the previous year. The Roadrunners **outscored** the **Cowboys 32-24** and scored 24 of its runs in the last two games of the series.

Although only **seven games** have gone down in the books, UTSA has **yet to score first** in any game.

UPDATE: UTSA scored first against No. 21 Houston and won 3-2 for the first win of the season against a ranked opponent.

Tuesday's **win** against **No. 21 Houston** (3/1) **improves** the Roadrunners record to **6-2** on the year. The mark is **identical** to the **start** the Roadrunners had **last season** and finished 33-25 and 17-13 in Conference USA. It was also the third straight 30-plus win season for head coach Jason Marshall.

The **last time** UTSA **lost six consecutive** was in the Roadrunners' last season in the Southland Conference in **2012**. UTSA finished 22-32 overall and 11-21 in league play.

Aaron Burns and Andre Shewcraft combined for a **6-0 shutout** against FIU to start the series. It was the **first shutout** for UTSA. By this time last year, the Roadrunners had already four shutouts with two coming back-to-back.

UTSA's second meeting with **Texas State** looked more like a **home run derby** than anything else. Both teams **combined** for **six home runs** with the Bobcats blasting four and the Roadrunners two. It was the second time this season that UTSA allowed four home runs in one game.

The Marshall series was the **first** this season for the Roadrunners were the pitching staff **allowed less** than double digit **walks**. UTSA **issued** just **seven** over the course of three games.

UTSA **earned** its **first Conference USA series win** on the road against **Old Dominion**. The Roadrunners started with a 3-0 shutout behind an incredible pitching performance by Karl Craigie. UTSA then returned for the rubber match and won 7-2.

Another one bites the dust. The Roadrunners face another injury on the roster and will be down a pitcher. Junior **Andre Shewcraft** will be **shut down** the rest of the way due to a torn labrum. That now makes **four injuries** this season.



Diamond Notes

The Roadrunners **snapped** its second **six-game losing skid** on Sunday, May 1, in a **5-4 extra-innings decision** against Louisiana Tech. Bryan Arias laced a ball through the right side to score Trent Bowles for the game-winning run. It was the **first extra-innings game** for UTSA and the third time the Roadrunners have won in walk-off fashion this season.

In 2016, the Roadrunners have **multiple** scheduled **dates** against **three teams** - Texas State, Incarnate Word and Baylor. UTSA **completed** its **series** with **Texas State** on Tuesday (5/3) and **went 1-2** against the I-35 rivals. **One more meeting** remains between the Roadrunners and **UIW and Baylor** in back-to-back midweek games coming up next week and the following week after that.

In the final meeting of the season, **Texas State shutout** UTSA in a 6-0 decision. It was the **second shutout** for the Roadrunners as they registered a **season-low two hits**. Its previous low was four against UConn in the season opener.

UTSA will take on its **second ranked opponent** of the season when the Roadrunners meet with **No. 19 Florida Atlantic** for a three-game Conference USA tilt. The all-time series record between the two is tied at 3-3. The Roadrunners defeated No. 21 Houston earlier in the season on the road, 3-2.
