FROM THE TIP

▶ Oklahoma opened the Porter Moser era with a 77-59 victory over Northwestern State Nov. 9 at Lloyd Noble Center.

▶ All 10 newcomers to the 2021-22 squad appeared against the NSU Demons. **Tanner Groves** and **Jordan Goldwire** each started. Groves and Jalen Hill led the OU offense with 15 points, while the duo grabbed nine and eight rebounds, respectively.

▶ Moser's victory against NSU moved him to 294 NCAA DI career victories. He amassed 188 wins at Loyola Chicago.

▶ With the victory against Northwestern State, the Sooners have won 18 consecutive season openers dating back to 2003-04.

▶ Oklahoma and UTSA will meet for the fifth consecutive season when the two teams clash Friday. OU is 6-0 against the Roadrunners and opened the 2020-21 campaign with a 105-66 victory.

▶ Moser was named the 15th head coach in University of Oklahoma men's basketball history by Vice President and Director of Athletics Joe Castiglione on April 3, 2021. Nearly 10 years to the day Lon Kruger was hired on April 1, 2011.

▶ Moser brought over 17 years of experience as a NCAA DI head coach to the Sooners and had previous stops at Loyola Chicago, Illinois State and Arkansas-Little Rock.

▶ In his previous four years in the Windy City, Moser claimed three regular season Missouri Valley Conference titles, won six NCAA Tournament games, secured two Sweet 16 berths and reached the 2018 Final Four. During that stretch, Moser totaled a record of 99-36 (.733), and tied for the 10th most wins by a Division I head coach since the start of the 2017-18 season.

▶ The 2017-18 season was historic for the Moser led Ramblers, who tallied a school record 32 wins and reached their first Final Four appearance since winning the NCAA Championship in 1963. Loyola earned a No. 7 ranking in the final USA Today Coaches Poll and was just the fourth No. 11 seed ever to advance to the Final Four.

▶ The 2021-22 team features only five returners - **Elijah Harkless**, **Umoja Gibson**, **Jalen Hill**, **Rick Issanza** and **Blake Seacat**. The Sooners return just 27.1% of their scoring and 33.8% of their minutes played from last season.

▶ The Sooners return the lowest percentage of their scoring from last season in the Big 12 and are second lowest in minutes played returning in the conference.






▶ Oklahoma's roster features eight transfers, which is tied with Penn State for the most of any major conference program and is ranked 10th nationally.

▶ OU has seven NCAA DI transfers which is tied for sixth nationally and is the most among any major conference program.

KEY STAT VS. NORTHWESTERN STATE

▶ After opening the 2021-22 slate with a shooting display behind the 3-point line (18-for-27, 66.7%), OU tallied 44 of its 77 points in the paint against Northwestern State.

GAME OVERVIEW

Oklahoma (1-0, 0-0 Big 12) opened the 2021-22 campaign and Porter Moser era with a 77-59 victory over Northwestern State Tuesday, Nov. 9. With the victory against Northwestern State, the Sooners have won 18-consecutive season openers dating back to 2003-04. The Sooners turn their attention to the UTSA Roadrunners (1-0, 0-0 C-USA) Friday, Nov. 12. The Friday contest will match the two teams for the fifth consecutive season. Tip is scheduled for 7 p.m. CT and will air on the Sooner Sports Radio Network (KRXO 107.7 FM The Franchise in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa; Varsity Radio App) with Tom Dore announcing. Chad McKee and Kevin Henry have the call on Bally Sports Oklahoma+.

► **Brady Manek** led the Sooners with 29 points and made a career-high eight 3-pointers. **De'Vion Harmon** (22), **Trey Phipps** (12) and **Kur Kuath** (10) also finished with double-figure points.

► The Sooners earned the season-opening victory last season after previous games against UCF and Florida were canceled.

► Oklahoma scored back-to-back halves with 50-plus points and its 54-point outburst was a season best.

► The 105-point performance marked the first time OU topped 105 points since Oklahoma beat Oklahoma State 109-89 Jan. 3, 2018. It was the fifth time in program history the Sooners scored 105 points.

► **Umoja Gibson**, **Jalen Hill** and **Blake Seacat** are the only returners that appeared against the Roadrunners last season. Gibson earned the start and scored eight points. Hill appeared off the bench and added seven points and grabbed six boards.

SERIES HISTORY: UTSA

► Oklahoma continues its home stand to start the 2021-22 slate when the UTSA Roadrunners visit Norman Nov. 12.

► OU holds a 6-0 advantage over UTSA and a 4-0 record against the Roadrunners in Norman. The two teams will meet for the fifth consecutive season on Friday.

► The Sooners opened the unusual non-conference slate last season with UTSA after games at UCF and against Florida were canceled. OU dominated the Roadrunners 105-66 Dec. 3, 2020.

► The win last season marked the third game in the series that the Sooners topped 100-plus points. OU opened the series with a 112-72 win (1983) and followed it up in the second series appearance with a 107-75 win (1995) in Norman.

► UTSA head men's basketball coach Steve Henson served five years (2011-16) as an assistant coach under former OU head coach Lon Kruger. Henson also spent seven seasons with Kruger at UNLV (2004-11) and one season at Illinois (1999-2000). He also played for Kruger at Kansas State (1986-90).

SCOUTING THE ROADRUNNERS

► UTSA opened its 2021-22 schedule with a 97-66 victory over Trinity (Texas) at the Convocation Center. The Roadrunners had four players reach double figures and were led by junior center Jacob Germany (24 points). Jordan Ivy-Curry (19), Dhieu Deing (13) and Darius McNeil (11) each reached double-digit points.

► Germany, Ivy-Curry, Deing, McNeill and Cedrick Alley Jr. all started in the season opener. UTSA shot 47.4% (36-76) from the field and 30.4% (7-23) from beyond the arc. The Roadrunners forced 20 turnovers which resulted in 29 points.

SERIES HISTORY: EAST CAROLINA/MYRTLE BEACH INVITATIONAL

► Oklahoma and East Carolina will meet for the first time Nov. 18 at the Myrtle Beach Invitational. The Sooners will take part in the tournament for the first time in program history.

GET TO KNOW THE NEWCOMERS

► With the base of his first team assembled, Moser netted his first signee in **Alston Mason**, a 6-1 guard from Overland Park, Kan. Mason, a three-star recruit, already had a relationship with OU's new head coach, as he was recruited by Moser during his time leading the Ramblers. Mason is from the same high school as Custer, whom Moser coached at Loyola.

► The 2021-22 freshman class features Mason, **Bijan Cortes** and **C.J. Noland**. Cortes and Noland, who signed under Kruger, were each ranked as four-star recruits by Rivals and 247Sports and maintained their commitment to the Sooners because of their belief in Moser and what he is building in Norman. The trio represent the only freshman scholarship signees on Moser's first OU team.

► In early May 2021, Moser announced the addition of four transfers – super senior forward **Ethan Chargois** (from SMU), super senior guard **Jordan Goldwire** (from Duke), redshirt senior forward **Tanner Groves** and his brother, junior forward **Jacob Groves** (both from Eastern Washington).

► Porter Moser earned his first victory in the Crimson and Cream Tuesday night at Lloyd Noble Center in his OU coaching debut. Moser netted his 294 NCAA Division I victory.

► The Sooners finished the night shooting 55.2% (32-58) from the floor and 64.5% (20-31) in the second half.

► After scoring 28 points and holding a three-point edge at the half, OU stormed out of the gates in the second to take control of the contest. OU scored 49 points in the second half and were propelled by Jalen Hill, who tallied 12 of his career-high 15 points, in the second period. Tanner Groves provided a consistence energy for the Sooners, and matched Hill's team-best 15 points.

► Groves led OU on the glass, wrangling a team-high nine rebounds, while Hill snagged eight boards. The duo were the only two Sooners to have 4-plus rebounds.

► Ten Sooners made their Oklahoma debut in the victory. T. Groves and Jordan Goldwire both started.

GET TO KNOW THE NEWCOMERS CONTINUED ...

► Tulsa product **Chargois** started 86 of his 108 career games at SMU, averaging 9.5 points, 4.9 rebounds and 1.7 assists in 24.1 minutes per contest. Despite his large frame, he also flashed an ability to shoot from the outside by knocking down 120 career 3-pointers (made 31.8% of his attempts). Chargois finished his SMU career ranked 40th in school history in scoring (1,024 points), 33rd in rebounds (531), tied for 13th in blocked shots (70) and 18th in games started.

► An experienced 6-2 point guard from Norcross, Ga., **Goldwire** played in 116 games at Duke. He joins the Sooners as a graduate transfer with one season of eligibility remaining. During his senior season with the Blue Devils, the guard averaged 5.8 points, 4.0 assists, 2.1 rebounds and 2.2 steals in 28.5 minutes per game. A member of the 2021 All-ACC Defensive Team, Goldwire ranked second in the ACC and third among all major conference players in steals per game (2.2) in 2020-21. The new Sooner is expected to pair well in the OU backcourt with Harkless, who was second in the Big 12 in steals (1.9) last season.

► The 2021 Big Sky Conference Player of the Year, 6-10 forward **Tanner Groves** averaged 17.2 points, 8.0 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 1.1 blocks while shooting 56.0% from the field as a junior at Eastern Washington. He ranked second in the Big Sky in rebounds and field goal percentage while finishing fourth in scoring and sixth in blocked shots. In 24 games last season, he tallied nine double-doubles and scored at least 20 points seven times. Over his three-year career, the elder Groves is shooting 54.7% from the field, 37.3% from behind the arc (41-110) and 74.0% from the free throw line. He has two years of eligibility remaining.

► The 6-9 **Jacob Groves** is coming off a sophomore campaign at EWU in which he averaged 9.3 points and 4.2 rebounds per game while shooting 55.2% from the field, 36.4% from 3-point range (16-44) and 75.7% from the foul line. Against Kansas in the NCAA Tournament, he made 8 of 11 shots (4 for 5 from 3-point range) and finished with 23 points and nine boards.

► In June, Moser went to the transfer portal again, signing super senior **Marvin Johnson**. Johnson, a guard who earned first-team All-Ohio Valley Conference honors last season at Eastern Illinois, scored in double figures in 23 of 26 contests and ranked in the top 10 in the OVC in scoring (15.3 points per game), assists (4.7 assists per game) and steals (1.9). The 6-6, 190-pounder played in 26 of 27 games for Eastern Illinois last year and started 22.

► OU announced its only junior college signee – **Akol Mawein** – in late May. Mawein was rated by 247Sports as the No. 4 overall junior college recruit in the 2021 class and the No. 1 power forward. The 6-10, 230-pound Mawein, who was born in South Sudan and grew up in Sydney, Australia, spent the last two years at Navarro College in Corsicana, Texas. In 22 games last season he averaged 12.5 points, 5.2 rebounds and 1.0 assist while adding 17 steals and 13 blocks as Navarro finished 16-6 and won 10 of its last 11 contests.

► The 2021-22 roster was finally completed with the addition of freshman walk-on Jake Moser.

RETURNERS

Moser started building his 2021-22 team with five returning players – **Elijah Harkless, Umoja Gibson, Rick Issanza, Jalen Hill** and **Blake Seacat**.

Harkless and **Gibson** have the most experience donning the Crimson and Cream. Gibson started in 15 of his 27 games last year and averaged 27.0 minutes per contest – the fourth-highest mark on the team. The Waco, Texas, native is OU's leading returning scorer, tallying 9.1 points per game and shooting an impressive 41.1% (58 of 141) from 3-point range.

Gibson flashed his sharp-shooting ability last season with an 8-of-11 performance from the 3-point line against West Virginia, finishing with a season-high 29 points. Harkless played in 23 games last season and made 17 starts, the most of any returning Sooner, and averaged 8.1 points per contest. The senior guard scored in double figures eight times last season, including in three of the last four games. He finished with 16 points against Missouri in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament and is the team's leading returning rebounder at 5.4 per game.

Hill appeared in 25 games during the 2020-21 campaign and made five starts. The versatile forward averaged 4.4 points and 2.9 rebounds per contest. Hill started in both NCAA Tournament games last season against Missouri and Gonzaga.

After redshirting his first season in Norman, **Issanza** totaled 23 minutes in his five games last year. The 7-1 center looks to have a bigger impact on both ends of the court for Moser.

STAFF ASSEMBLED

Moser hired David Patrick and K.T. Turner as associate head coaches. Patrick spent the previous season as the associate head coach at Arkansas, and Turner held the same title at Texas during the 2020-21 campaign. Emanuel Dildy joined the Sooners as an assistant coach after serving in the same role at Northwestern and previously under Moser at Loyola Chicago from 2013-16.

Moser rounded out his staff with Matt Gordon (Special Assistant to the Head Coach and Director of Recruiting) and Clayton Custer (Director of Video Operations and Player Development). Both were on his Ramblers staff. Bryce Daub (Director of Strength and Performance) and Mike Shepherd (Director of Operations) remained on staff in their roles previously held under Lon Kruger, who retired in March.

MEET THE NEW GUYS: 2022 SIGNING CLASS

► Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser announced Wednesday, Nov. 10 the signing of 2022 guards Otega Oweh, Benny Schröder and Milos Uzan to National Letters of Intent.

► Oweh and Uzan are both ranked in the ESPN100 and it is the first time since the 2019 signing class that two Sooner signees have been in the ESPN100.

► A 6-6 guard from Somerset, N.J., Oweh is a four-star prospect on ESPN.com, 247Sports and Rivals. Oweh is ranked No. 73 by 247Sports, No. 76 by Rivals and No. 89 by ESPN nationally. Oweh appeared in 56 career games for Blair Academy prior to his senior season. During the 2019-20 campaign for Blair Academy, he averaged 14.9 points, 6.5 rebounds, 2.4 steals and 1.9 assists per game. Oweh led Team Final EYBL (PA) to a 17U Peach Jam title and averaged 14.9 points, 4.9 rebounds, 1.8 steals and 1.3 assists per game. He was named Nike EYBL Peach Jam Breakout Player of the Session.

► Uzan, a 6-4 point guard from Las Vegas, is ranked No. 52 on the ESPN100 and the No. 1 prospect in Nevada. He is a four-star prospect by 247Sports and ESPN and a three star by Rivals. Uzan and Dream City Christian (Ariz.) attended the 2021 Geico Top Flight Invite. Uzan also played for Prolific Prep in the 30-game Grind Session in Arizona and averaged 13 points, 6.0 assists and 5.0 rebounds per game. Prior to his time in Arizona, he led Desert Pines High School to the 2020 Nevada state championship game.

► Schröder, a 6-7 wing from Germany, was labeled the top international prospect by ESPN. He plays for Kickz IBAM (International Basketball Academy Munich) in the U19 NBBL, and averages 29 points, 6.0 boards and 4.0 assists per game. He played for the U18 German National Team that played in the 2021 FIBA U18 European Challengers tournament. He averaged 16.6 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 2.4 assists in 23 minutes per game. In Germany's final game against North Macedonia, he tallied 21 points on 9-for-12 shooting. Prior to his time with IBA, He played the 2020-21 season for TSV Oberhaching and spent time with FC Bayern Munich U16 (2017-19) and U19 (2019-20) teams. In 2019, he was named the JBBL (U19) Top 4 MVP.

JUDE STARKEY JOINS THE SOONERS

► Jude Starkey officially signed with the Sooners Saturday, Nov. 6 as OU's Team Impact teammate. Starkey was diagnosed with leukemia and is in the remission stage of his treatment. He was paired with the Sooners through Team IMPACT - an organization that has matched over 2,200 kids on over 700 college campuses. Two other Team IMPACT teammates are matched with OU teams.



ASSOCIATED PRESS NAMES OKLAHOMA A TOP-20 ALL-TIME BASKETBALL PROGRAM

The Associated Press announced its All-Time Top 100 in 2017, a ranking system to determine the top programs in men's college basketball since the AP poll began in 1949. Oklahoma ranked 20th in the All-Time Top 100 – the second highest of any team in the Big 12.

To determine the all-time Top 100, the AP formula counted poll appearances (one point each) to mark consistency and No. 1 rankings (two points each) to acknowledge elite programs. The AP doesn't release a poll after the NCAA Tournament, so eventual national champions are not factored into these rankings.

Below are numbers breaking down Oklahoma's history in the AP poll and the Sooners' place in the All-time Top 100.

- ▶ Oklahoma ranks second among Big 12 schools in the All-Time Top 100. Kansas (No. 5) is the only school in the conference ahead of the Sooners.
- ▶ Oklahoma's football program ranks second in the AP Football All-Time Top 100. OU is the only Big 12 school to finish in the top 20 of the All-Time Top 100 in both football and men's basketball.
- ▶ Since the mid-80s, the Sooners have appeared in a majority of all AP polls. Oklahoma has been voted a top-25 team in 55 percent of AP polls since the start of the 1984 season.
- ▶ The Sooners have gone nine seasons of being ranked in every AP poll of that season - most recently 2015-16 when Lon Kruger's squad was in the top 10 of every week's poll.
- ▶ Oklahoma has been ranked No. 1 in the country for a total of eight weeks, most recently claiming the top spot for three straight weeks in 2015-16. All eight No. 1 appearances have come since 1988.
- ▶ Oklahoma has reached the Final Four on five occasions - 1939, 1947, 1988, 2002 and 2016.
- ▶ OU has seen two players earn National Player of the Year honors in the past 11 years (the most of any school in that span) - Blake Griffin (2008-09) and Buddy Hield (2015-16).

FROM LAST SEASON

- ▶ Oklahoma was 10-3 at Lloyd Noble Center during the 2020-21 slate.
- ▶ Lon Kruger added 16 victories to his impressive win total last season, giving the former head coach 195 victories with the Crimson and Cream. Kruger finished his 35 year career with 674 victories.
- ▶ OU burst into the AP Top 25 last season after a stretch in late January where the Sooners beat three top-10 teams in eight days. By defeating No. 9 Kansas, No. 5 Texas and No. 9 Alabama, Oklahoma became just the third team in NCAA history to beat top-10 teams in back-to-back games, joining Michigan (2014) and Iowa (1987).
- ▶ In the month of January, Oklahoma became the first college basketball team since 1974 to beat four top-10 teams in one calendar month.
- ▶ Oklahoma committed only 11.0 turnovers per game - the second fewest in the Big 12 and 30th best in Division I.
- ▶ The Sooners led the league in fewest fouls committed per game, fouling an average of 14.7 times - the 22nd-lowest in the country. Oklahoma showed the same discipline in 2019-20, committing only 14.4 personal fouls per game – the third fewest in the country.
- ▶ Oklahoma made seven of the last eight NCAA Tournaments. Oklahoma is one of only three Big 12 schools with at least six NCAA Tournament appearances during that span, joined only by Iowa State and Kansas. Oklahoma was on the verge of another trip to the Big Dance in 2020 before the event was cancelled due to COVID-19.
- ▶ The Sooners made their 33rd NCAA Tournament appearance in 2021, its 28th trip in the past 37 years. The Sooners' 28 NCAA Tournament appearances since 1984 are the ninth most in the nation during that span, behind only Kansas, Duke, North Carolina, Arizona, Connecticut, Kentucky, Michigan State and Syracuse.

One of the most successful coaches of the past half-decade, Porter Moser was named the 15th head coach in University of Oklahoma men's basketball history by Vice President and Director of Athletics Joe Castiglione on April 3, 2021.

Over the previous four seasons at Loyola University Chicago, Moser (pronounced "MO-zer") claimed three regular-season Missouri Valley Conference titles, won six NCAA Tournament games, secured two Sweet 16 berths and reached the 2018 Final Four. During that stretch, Moser totaled a record of 99-36 (.733) – tied for the 10th most wins by a Division I head coach since the start of the 2017-18 season.

Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles in the 2020-21 season. As an eight seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

This past season's Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program record for most wins in conference play.

A 17-year Division I head coach, the 52-year-old Moser is most known for his run to the 2018 Final Four.

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed. The Ramblers' run included wins over Miami, Tennessee, Nevada and Kansas State.

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins since 2018 – tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston are the only teams outside of major conferences to reach two of the last three Sweet 16s.

In his 10 seasons with Loyola, Moser assembled a 188-141 (.571) record and reached the postseason every year since 2017, winning the CBI title in 2017 and qualifying for the NIT in 2019 in addition to the Ramblers' NCAA Tournament runs in 2018 and 2021. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

The 2018 Missouri Valley Coach of the Year, Moser has mentored his student-athletes to multiple league honors over recent seasons.

His roster has boasted three of the last four Missouri Valley Players of the Year and two of the last four MVC Defensive Players of the Year.

Owner of a 293-242 (.548) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season prior to his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later. The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories prior to his tenure, but Moser turned the program around in just one season to finish with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003. After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011.

He then returned to a head coaching role by being named Loyola's head coach prior to the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife, Megan, have four children – Jordan, who is a member of OU's women's basketball team, Jake, who is on the Sooners' men's basketball team, and Max and Ben.
