Winners of seven of eight, Roadrunners look to remain hot when they travel to Rio Grande Valley to face Broncs on Tuesday night

UTSA HEADS SOUTH FOR MIDWEEK TILT AT UTPA: UTSA — winners of three in a row, seven of its last eight games and nine of 11 — heads to the Rio Grande Valley on Tuesday to square off against Texas-Pan American in Edinburg. It is the Roadrunners' second trip to the Valley this season, as they played in the Al Ogletree Classic from March 2-4. UTSA enters the 5 p.m. non-conference contest with a 13-11 overall record and perfect 6-0 mark in the Southland Conference. The Roadrunners, who scored in double figures just twice in their first 17 games, have done so in the last three contests and in five of their last seven overall.

SCOUTING THE BRONCS: Texas-Pan American, an NCAA Division I independent program, enters Tuesday's contest with an 11-20 mark on the year. The Broncs have lost seven of their last nine games and will be playing for the first time since March 20 (4-1 loss to Texas A&M-Corpus Christi). UTSA leads the all-time series, 42-29, and it has won six of the last eight matchups between the two programs. UTPA collected a 3-2 win earlier this season and its 5-4 victory at home on May 16 a year ago snapped the Roadrunners' six-game winning streak in the series. Head coach Sherman Corbett is 24-7 all-time against the Broncs.

RED HOT OFFENSE: After starting the year slowly, the UTSA offense has exploded the past eight games, seven of which have resulted in victories. The Roadrunners have scored 81 times (10.1 pg) and outscored the opposition by 40 runs during that time. UTSA has posted a .343 batting average on the strength of 104 hits (13.0 pg), slugged an astonishing .660 (200 total bases) and reached base at .402 clip. Half of the offense's 104 hits (52) have gone for extra bases, including 25 doubles, 10 triples and 17 home runs. The Roadrunners also have stolen 11 bases in 13 attempts, which translates to an 84.6 percent success rate.

YOU DROPPED A BOMB ON ME: Seventeen of UTSA's 22 home runs (77.2 pct.) this season have been hit during the past eight contests. Leading the long ball parade is junior Zach Etheredge, who has slugged five in the past seven games. Sophomore James Keithley, junior Trent Lockwood and senior Ryan Saltzgaber each have hit three bombs in the last eight tilts and Lockwood and Saltzgaber have grand slams among their three bombs. Also on the board are redshirt freshman Tim Palincsar, senior Mitch Ponza and sophomore Michael Rockett, all three of whom have left the yard once during the past eight contests.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Three Roadrunners currently are enjoying career-best hitting streaks. Sophomore James Keithley has hit safely in 12 consecutive games dating back to March 4. Keithley is hitting .390 (23-59) with three doubles,

three triples, four home runs (.746 slugging pct.) and nine RBIs. Meanwhile, junior Trent Lockwood and senior Ryan Saltzgaber enter Tuesday's game riding nine-game hitting streaks (both began March 11). Lockwood, who hit safely in his first eight games as a Roadrunner, has a robust .541 batting average (20-37) with six doubles, three homers (.946 slg%) and 15 RBIs. He is the only UTSA player with two streaks of eight games or better this season. Saltzgaber is hitting at a .385 clip (15-39) with two doubles, a pair of triples, three long balls (.769 slg%) and 13 RBIs during his nine-game stretch. Junior Zach Etheredge has hit safely in seven straight games, two short of his career best. He has posted a .452 average (14-31) with three doubles, a triple, five home runs (1.097 slg%) and 16 RBIs during his streak.

CLOSE GAMES: The Roadrunners have shown the knack of playing close games

this season. Sixteen of the club's 24 contests have been decided by three runs or less and it has a 9-7 mark in those games. UTSA has a 4-3 record in one-run tilts,

C • Zach Etheredge, Jr. - Starter in all 24 games ... leads the squad with eight multi-RBI performances, ranks second with five home runs, 24 RBIs and a .589 slugging percentage and third with six doubles, 53 total bases and 11 multi-hit efforts ... also hitting .333 with a triple and a .390 on-base percentage ... has hit safely in the last seven contests, posting a .452 average (14-31) with three doubles, a triple, five home runs (1.097 slg%) and 16 RBIs during the streak ... claimed SLC Hitter of the Week honors on March 26 after he hit .450 (9-20) with three doubles, a triple, three home runs and 11 RBIs ... named to Southwest Diamond Classic All-Tournament Team (4-10, 4 R, 4 RBIs).

1B/DH • Trent Lockwood, Jr. - Has started 23 games, 20 at first base and three at DH ... leads club in batting average (.380), multi-hit games (12), home runs (six), RBIs (27), total bases (60), slugging percentage (.652) and on-base percentage (.442) ... also ranks second in hits (35), doubles (seven) and multi-RBI games (seven), including six-RBI performance on March 17 at McNeese State ... currently on a season-best nine-game hitting streak, the last seven of which have resulted in multi-hit performances ... owns a .541 batting average (20-37) with six doubles, three homers (.946 slg%) and

15 RBIs in during the streak ... hit safely in his first eight games as a Roadrunner (only player with two eight-game streaks this season) ... named to Southwest Diamond Classic All-Tournament Team (5-14, 3 R, 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBIs, SB).

2B/LF • James Keithley, So. - Has started 15 games at second base and nine in left field ... leads team with three triples and five stolen bases, ranks second with 23 runs and 57 total bases and third with 34 hits, four home runs, a .538 slugging percentage and 11 multi-hit games ... also has .321 batting average with five doubles and 15 RBIs ... currently on a career-best 12-game hitting streak in which he is hitting .390 (23-59) with three doubles, three triples, four home runs (.746 slg%) and nine RBIs ... squad is 9-2 since he moved into the leadoff spot on March 9 ... has scored in eight games in a row ... has .392 batting average (31-79) with seven two-hit games, three three-hit performances and a career-best four-hit effort (March 10) in last 17 contests ... hitting .376 (32-85) with five doubles, three triples, four home runs and 15 RBIs since starting the season 2-for-21 (.095) ... went 7-14 (.500) with four runs scored, a triple, his first homer of the year and four RBIs vs. the College of Charleston (March 9-11) ... was 7-for-15 (.467) with eight runs scored, a double,

in team-high 43.2 innings and also has three quality starts ... is 2-1 with 5.77 ERA in seven starts ... tossed a four-hitter for first complete game of year and struck out seven, as UTSA won its SLC opener at McNeese State (March 16) ... allowed just one run on five hits and fanned six in seven innings vs. the College of Charleston (March 9) ... struck out career-high nine and picked up first victory of year vs. Gonzaga (Feb. 23) after allowing just three runs on six hits in eight-plus innings ... 2006 first-team All-SLC pick.

HEAD COACH SHERMAN CORBETT: With more than 20 years of playing and coaching experience, Sherman Corbett is in his seventh season at UTSA. The winningest coach in school history (188 victories), Corbett led the Roadrunners to 37 victories a year ago, the second-most in school history. In his first six seasons, he has coached a pair of 30-win squads and 24 All-SLC players, including seven first-teamers. Corbett also has mentored the 2001 SLC Pitcher of the Year (Jared Howton), 2002 SLC Player and Hitter of the Year (Mark Schramek), 2003 SLC Freshman of the Year (Ryan Crew) and two Freshman All-Americans — Crew (2003) and Michael Rockett (2006). Twelve of his Roadrunners have gone on to professional careers, including eight being selected in the MLB Draft.
