Quick NOTES...

• UTSA's 22-11 start to the season is tied for the second best start in program history through 33 games. The 1994 team started 24-9 and advanced to UTSA's first-ever NCAA Regional (Austin, Texas) while the 2008 team also started the year 22-11. Both teams share the program record for total wins in a season at 39.

• Senior 1B Mike Warren extended his career-high consecutive reached base streak to 27 games. He has reached base in all but one game (Feb. 22 vs. BYU) this season.

UTSA returns home Friday to face Marshall in three-game series

UTSA BRIEF: The Roadrunners will look to break free of a four-way tie for second place in Conference USA with the weekend three-game set against Marshall. UTSA has won three of its past four following Tuesday's, 10-2, triumph over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and a 2-1 series victory over Tulane a weekend ago. Against Tulane, Brock Hartson and Justin Anderson book-ended the weekend with complete game victories on the hill. Combined, the two hurlers tossed 18 innings without allowing an earned run, striking out 17 and issuing just two walks.

SERIES HISTORY: UTSA will be meeting the Thundering Herd for the first-time ever. It will also be the Roadrunners first meeting with a team from the state of West Virginia. The two campuses are separated by 1,278 miles, equivalent to a 18 hour, 36 minute drive, according to *Google Maps*. A road trip from the Alamo City to Huntington would take you through Texas, Arkansas, Tennessee, Kentucky and finally West Virginia.

SCOUTING MARSHALL

Marshall comes into the weekend having won seven of its past nine including Conference USA series' victories over Tulane and Florida Atlantic.

Junior TJ Diffenderfer carries a hot bat into the series, going .353 in his last five games with two doubles, a triple, and a home run.

Sophomore Aaron Bossi provided a presence in the batter's box last weekend, going 5-for-8 with three runs. Redshirt sophomore Robert Fajardo also helped lift the Herd, going 5-for-10 with two doubles and four RBI.

Bossi and Fajardo scored three times apiece in the FAU series.

As a team the Herd ranks towards the bottom of C-USA in most offensive categories including batting average (.227, 12th), extra-base hits (41, t12th), walks (85, 11th) and strikeouts (234, 11th).

On the hill, Marshall has a 3.91 ERA which ranks 10th in C-USA. The Thundering Herd have allowed opposing hitters to hit just .256, but have allowed a league-high 144 free passes.

HOME COOKING

The Roadrunners have played 21 of their 33 games at home this season and have only left the state of Texas for a pair of three-game series at Southern Miss and Tulane. UTSA has a 15-6 record at Roadrunner Field following a three-game sweep of Louisiana Tech.

SQUAD BREAKDOWN

Among the 31 players on the Roadrunners' roster, 28 hail from Texas. Only Tony Ramirez (Ferndale, Mich.), Andre Vieyra (Valley Center, Kan.), and Jeremy Filipek (Langley, B.C.) come from outside the Lone Star State. There are (8) seniors, (12) juniors, (4) sophomores, and (7) freshmen.

NCAA TOP-50 RANKS

As a team the Roadrunners hold Top-50 rankings in double plays (40th), doubles (25th), doubles per game (35th), ERA (19th), fielding percentage (48th), hits (42nd), runs (43rd), shutouts (26th), strikeout-to-walk ratio (41st), strikeouts per nine innings (36th), and winning percentage (41st).

Individually, Brock Hartson and Nolan Trabanino both rank 28th in games started while Wesley Cox ranks 14th nationally with six victories. John Welborn ranks 26th in runs scored and 34th in runs scored per game. Mike Warren ranks 29th in RBIs and 49th in RBIs per game. RJ Perucki ranks 49th in sacrifice flies.

MULTIPLE HITS

UTSA catcher John Bormann has recorded two hits in each of the Roadrunners past five games. During that stretch, the Seguin native has raised his season average from .209 to .267.

BASES CHUCKED

UTSA has been outstanding this season with the bases loaded going 25-for-56 (.446). Mike Warren has done the most damaged in the situation with six hits in 11 opportunities (.545).

#15 JOHN BORMANN, Jr. C: 2013 and 2014 Johnny Bench Award nominee ... leads C-USA with seven pickoffs this season and is second in *caught stealing by* having thrown out 11 attempted base stealers ... has picked off 21 baserunners dating back to the beginning of the 2013 season ... had first career multi-home run game in 9-2 win over then-No. 18 Sam Houston State (Mar. 11) ... finished the game 2-for-4 with a walk and a career-high 5 RBIs ...

#8 HORACIO CORREA III, Jr. SS: Started all 33 games at shortstop ... tied 8th in C-USA with Perucki 44 hits ... team-high 16 multi-hit games ... switch hitter had a hit from both sides of the plate in each of the Roadrunners last two games against Louisiana Tech... ranks seventh in C-USA with 23 fielding double plays.

#23 GRANT GIBBS, Jr. C/IF: Started nine games (all at DH) ... season-high two hits twice (Feb. 15 vs. St. Peter's (NJ), and March 14 vs. Columbia)...scored career-high three times in Feb. 15 win over St. Peter's (NJ).

#6 MATT HILSTON, Jr. OF: Junior college transfer from McLennan JC has not played this season.

#1 LOGAN KINDER, Fr. OF: Broke out with a 3-for-4 performance (3/29) in 10-1 win over Louisiana Tech picking up first career RBI ... first runner off the bench has appeared in six games as a pinch runner ... batting .303 in 33 at-bats.

#9 MITCHELL MATULIA, Fr. C/IF: Had five multi-hit games in first 10 career games ... has 18 starts ... debuted with a 2-for-4 game against St. Peter's (NJ) that included two runs scored, three RBIs, a double, walk and stolen base ... walked 11 times in 89 career plate appearances.

#13 RJ PERUCKI, Sr. 3B: Started all 33 games at third base ... UTSA's lone representative on the preseason All-C-USA team ... hitting a team-best .391 in C-USA play ... conferece ranks of fifth in walks (20), 8th in hits (44), fifth in batting average (.344) and third in on-base percentage (.425) ... hit a game-tying grand slam with two outs in the bottom of the ninth against South Dakota St. (Mar 1).

#27 C.J. PICKERING, Fr. 2B: Started all but one contest at second base ... four multi-hit games ... has made only one error in 162 chances at second ... tied for fifth on team with three multi-RBI games.

After serving as an assistant and associate head coach at UTSA for 12 years, Jason Marshall just completed his first season as the head coach of the Roadrunners baseball program. Marshall was named the fourth skipper in UTSA baseball history on June 18, 2012.

In his first year at the helm, Marshall guided the Birds to a 35-25 overall record and their third appearance in an NCAA Regional after the club captured the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Tournament Championship. UTSA, which posted a perfect 4-0 record en route to the league title, was sent to the Corvallis (Ore.) Regional and took No. 3 national seed Oregon State to its last at-bat before the Beavers rallied for a 5-4 victory. The Roadrunners wrapped up their first postseason run in eight years the following day with a 6-1 loss to Texas A&M.

Three UTSA players — Daniel Rockett (ninth round/Kansas City Royals), Riley Good (14th round/Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim) and Clint Sharp (38th round/Angels) — were drafted after the campaign concluded, while right-handed pitcher Brock Hartson was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball. Third baseman RJ Perucki earned first-team all-league honors, while Good, Hartson and Rockett garnered second-team accolades.

In their first and only season in the WAC, the Roadrunners led the circuit with a .299 batting average and 629 hits. Perucki (.350/fifth) and Good (.335/ninth) both ranked among the top 10 batting averages in the league and the duo tied for second in the WAC with 84 hits apiece. Perucki also finished second in the circuit with 132 total bases and third with 12 home runs, while Rockett's .562 slugging percentage was good for third.

Marshall spent 12 years on the Roadrunners' coaching staff before being promoted to head coach, including nine as the associate head coach from 2004-12.

The Abilene native was hired at UTSA prior to the 2001 season and spent three campaigns as an assistant before being promoted to associate head coach. He served as both the infielders coach and recruiting coordinator while running the Roadrunners' summer camps.

A standout performer at Texas A&M from 1989-92, he was named the Aggies' Most Valuable Player after leading the team in games played (61), hits (66), runs scored (35) and RBIs (40) as a senior.

Following his collegiate career, he was drafted by the Royals in the 13th round of the 1992 MLB Draft. Marshall went on to play four seasons in the Royals organization before finishing his professional career in 1995.

Marshall earned a bachelor of science degree in kinesiology from Texas A&M in 1996. His wife, Ashleigh, have two sons, Cooper and Jackson, and a daughter, Kate.
