Head Coach Larry Coker Opening statement ...

"Offensively, we have really improved over the course of the spring. Today, we ran the ball well and the receivers had opportunities to make plays. Defensively, I thought during the second half, we played much better and created some turnovers. I think we got some things accomplished this spring. I'm very pleased. We did not have a lot of injuries. We had some guys leave, but it's not very serious."

On what he can take out of spring practice and today's game ...

"Offensively, we are much more physical across the offensive line. We did not have many negative plays. Everybody played some. We got a chance to take a look at everybody. All the quarterbacks played and they have really improved. (Eric) Soza threw the ball well, (Ryan) Polite has come a long way and so has Tucker (Carter). We have to work on the kicking game. Obviously, it was limited in some phases, but overall we got to see guite a bit today.

"As a head coach, you want the final score in this type of game to be balanced. In the first half, the offense dominated and the defense did not play well, but in the second half, the defense got into it and made some plays."

On the defense closing the gap in the second half ...

"Yeah, they're pretty good. As far as the defense, I'm glad they're on our team. They fought and they didn't quit. I like that in our defense."

On some of the good things he saw in the first half ...

"We were able to move the ball. We moved the ball well in the first half, but in the second half we stalled a couple times. The team in itself was able to move the ball well and get everybody in the game."
