Series History: UTSA leads the all-time series by an 18-16 count. UTSA has won the last seven meetings, two in overtime. Last season the Roadrunners prevailed 83-79 in overtime at Nicholls State and 83-67 at home.

LAST GAME:

Northwestern State went to the free throw line 22 times in the second half, connecting on 19 in fueling a 71-66 come-from-behind win for the Demons. Rapheal Posey led UTSA with 14

points. The Demons, which outscored UTSA 43-31 in the second half, had 22 offensive rebounds and out-rebounded UTSA, 40-38.

RADIO:

All UTSA games this season can be heard live in San Antonio and South Texas on the Roadrunner Radio Network (KKYX Radio 680 AM and www.goUTSA.com) beginning 15 minutes prior to tipoff.

The Coach:

Tim Carter is in his 10th season at UTSA and has a career record of 140-128 (.523) with the Roadrunners and 151-144 (.512) overall . . . He is the winningest men's basketball coach in UTSA history and has the longest tenure . . . He scored his 100th career win on Dec. 1, 2001 over Illinois State and his 100th win at UTSA on Feb. 4, 2002 at Texas-Arlington . . . Carter was named the 1999 SLC "Coach of the Year" . . . He came to UTSA after one season at Nebraska-Omaha. He has served as an assistant coach at Oklahoma (1984), Midwestern State (1984-86), Houston (1986-87), Oklahoma State (1987-90) and Northwestern (1990-94) . . . He has led UTSA to the NCAA Tournament in 1999 and 2004.

The Matchup:

This will be the 35th all-time matchup between the two schools with UTSA holding an 18-16 lead in the all-time series. UTSA won 83-79 in overtime in Thibodaux, La., and 83-67 in San Antonio. Justin Harbert averaged 15.5 points in the two games against the Colonels.

Carter Versus Piper:

Tim Carter has an all-time record of 0-0 in games played against coach J.P. Piper and the Colonels.

Home Sweet Home:

Tough to beat in the UTSA Convocation Center, the Roadrunners have an all-time home record of 214-86 (.717) in the Convo. UTSA is 1-1 all-time in the Alamodome.

Working Overtime:

UTSA enters to 2004-05 season with a reputation as team that is tough in overtime. The Roadrunners are now 13-7 all-time in extra session games under coach Tim Carter, and have won 10 of the past 11.

358 and Counting:

UTSA men's basketball has 358 wins as a program. UTSA has averaged 15.3 wins a season as a program over the first 23 years, and is the winningest program in the SLC over the past nine years.

Banging The Boards:

UTSA has been a beast on the boards through 11 games this season, and have been out-rebounded by only two opponents -- Texas on Dec. 29 and Northwestern State on Jan. 6. The Roadrunners average 43.5 rebounds per game to only 36.7 for their opponents. UTSA's 39-32 advantage at Wichita State was the first game this season that the Shockers had been out-rebounded.

Second Half Scoring Outbursts:

UTSA has enjoyed second halves this season in terms of scoring points. The Roadrunners average 37.6 points per game in the final 20 minutes of each game. Unfortunately for UTSA, opponents are averaging 39.8 per game in the second half.

According to the Sagarin College Basketball Rankings, UTSA has played the 36th toughest schedule of all NCAA Division I schools after the game with Northwestern State. UTSA is currently ranked No. 155 overall.

Injury Report:

Point guard **Kurt Attaway** is sidelined with an injured right thumb (torn ligament suffered on Dec. 12) and will be sidelined for up to six weeks.

Diaper Dandies:

UTSA freshmen **Abe Donlon** (2.8 ppg/2.8 rpg), **Adam McCoy** (4.8 ppg/0.6 rpg) and **Roderick Rodgers** (3.0 ppg/2.9 rpg) have all played important roles for the Roadrunners during the first 10 games. They have combined to average 10.6 points and 6.3 rebounds per a game.

Harbert Returns With A Bang:

Senior **Justin Harbert**, who was academically ineligible for the first six games, has returned to the lineup with a bang, averaging 14.7 points and 4.3 rebounds in the last four games. With 16 3-point field goals in those games he already ranks second on the team in that category. He had a career-high 25 points at Texas, including 21 in the first half. Harbert, a 6-1 guard, appeared in all 33 games last season, averaging 10.5 points per game and he led the Roadrunners with 63 3-point field goals.

Sign 'Em Up:

Recently UTSA announced that four players had signed national letters of intent to play for the Roadrunners next season. The signees include three incoming freshmen and a junior college transfer. Signing with UTSA are 6-6 forward Kyle Byrd from Lon Morris (Texas) Junior College; 6-1 guard Tim Maiden and 6-9 center Nkem Ojougboh from Scottsdale (Ariz.) Christian Academy; and 6-4 guard Eric Young from Eisenhower High School in Houston, Texas.
