

2023 UTSA Roadrunners Football Army 37, UTSA 29 Friday, Sept. 15 Alamodome · San Antonio Postgame Notes · Attendance: 27,138

TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- UTSA fell to 1-2 on the season. Army improved to 2-1.
- Army now leads the series 3-1 and has won all three meetings at the Alamodome.
- UTSA is 31-12 (.721) under Jeff Traylor, the best record and winning percentage for a UTSA head coach through 42 games in program history.
- The Roadrunners fell to 45-30 all-time at the Alamodome.
- UTSA is now 6-3 in games played on a Friday.
 - The Roadrunners are now 7-6 in non-Saturday games.

TEAM NOTES

- UTSA recorded 360 total yards; 239 in the air and 121 on the ground
- The Roadrunners averaged 5.5 yards-per-carry on 22 attempts
- The UTSA defense recorded 92 tackles and three for a loss
- The Roadrunners spent 15:35 with possession of the football to Army's 44:25
- Army recorded 65 rushes, the most by an opponent in program history.
 - The previous high was 60 by Army in 2020 and North Texas in 2021.
- Army went 6 for 6 when going for it on fourth down to set a new opponent record, surpassing Charlotte, which went 4 of 5 in 2015.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Making his first career start, sophomore QB Eddie Lee Marburger completed 17 out of 25 passes for 239 yards and three touchdowns
 - Marburger's three TDs are the most by a Roadrunner quarterback since Frank Harris tossed four in the 2022 C-USA Championship game against North Texas on 12/2/2022
 - His three touchdown passes also are the most by a UTSA quarterback in his first start since Harris had three versus UIW in the 2019 season opener.
- Senior WR Joshua Cephus caught eight passes for 84 yards and a touchdown
 - Freshman WR Devin McCuin had his first career TD reception on a 72-yard strike from Marburger over the middle in the fourth quarter
 - The 72-yard reception represents UTSA's longest play of the season and the first passing touchdown over 70 yards since Frank Harris hit Tykee Ogle-Kellogg for 70 on 11/26/22 at UTEP
 - Junior LB Martavius French registered a career-high 10 tackles.
- · Senior S Rashad Wisdom posted seven tackles including five solo stops.
 - Wisdom now has 269 tackles to rank second in program history and he pushed his school-record tally for unassisted tackles to 190.
 - Senior S Ken Robinson recorded seven tackles with three unassisted.
- Senior P Lucas Dean recorded a season-long 59-yard punt, his longest since booting a 67-yarder on 12/16/22 against Troy in the Cure Bowl
- Offensive linemen Cory Godinet and Luke Lapeze, along with tight end Houston Thomas joined Marburger in making their first career starts.

- Today's attendance was 27,138.
- UTSA's captains were Kevorian Barnes, Oscar Cardenas and Lucas Dean.
- UTSA senior QB Frank Harris missed his first start since the home game against Army on Oct. 17, 2020, snapping a streak of 36 consecutive starts. It was his first missed game since Oct. 3, 2020, at UAB.
