

2023 UTSA Roadrunners Football #20 Tennessee 45, UTSA 14 Saturday, Sept. 23 Neyland Stadium · Knoxville, Tenn. Postgame Notes · Attendance: 101,915

TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- UTSA fell to 1-3 on the season. Tennessee improved to 3-1.
- This was the first meeting between the Roadrunners and the Volunteers and the second SEC team UTSA has faced (Texas A&M; 2016, '19).
- The Roadrunners are 0-2 on the road this season and 44-31 all-time.
- UTSA is now 3-1 in games played in the state of Tennessee.
- The Roadrunners dropped to 0-13 all-time versus ranked teams.
- UTSA is 31-13 (.705) under Jeff Traylor, the best record and winning percentage for a UTSA head coach through 42 games in program history.

TEAM NOTES

- UTSA recorded 319 yards of offense, 231 through the air and 88 on the ground.
- The Roadrunners registered a 37:12-22:48 edge in time of possession.
- UTSA converted 8 of 19 third-down attempts.
- The Roadrunners posted five tackles for loss including two sacks.
- UTSA came up with its first takeaway of the season when Kelechi Nwachuku recovered a fumble on a punt return at the 8:41 mark of the first quarter.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Redshirt freshman QB Owen McCown completed his first 10 pass attempts and finished 18 of 20 for 170 yards and two touchdowns, all in the second half in his first action as a Roadrunner.
 - McCown set the school record for completion percentage in a game, as his .900 mark eclipsed Frank Harris' .866 (13-15) against Lamar in 2021.
 - McCown tossed TD passes of 3 yards to Joshua Cephus and 43 yards to Tykee Ogle-Kellogg.
- Senior WR Joshua Cephus had seven receptions for 58 yards and a touchdown.
 - Cephus now has caught a pass in 43 straight games, the third-longest streak in the FBS.
 - Cephus now has 31 catches for 305 yards and three TDs this season.
 - o Cephus upped his career totals to 255 receptions, 2,793 yards and 21 TDs, marks that rank second in school history.
- Senior WR **Tykee Ogle Kellogg** had two receptions for 46 yards including a 43-yard touchdown catch in the third quarter.
 - Ogle-Kellogg is from nearby Alcoa, Tennessee, 15 miles from Neyland Stadium.
 - Ogle-Kellogg has caught 12 passes for 186 yards and a pair of TDs in 2023.
 - Ogle-Kellogg now owns 68 receptions, 969 yards and 10 touchdowns as a Roadrunner.
- Senior TE Oscar Cardenas caught four balls for 31 yards.
 - Cardenas now has eight receptions for 65 yards this season.
 - Cardenas owns 58 catches, 782 yards and four TDs during his career.
- Senior S **Elliott Davison** posted six tackles with one for a loss.
- Senior S Kelechi Nwachuku recorded six tackles and a fumble recovery for UTSA's first takeaway of the season.
- Senior DL Brandon Matterson tallied four tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss, one sack, a forced fumble and a quarterback hurry.
- Senior LB Jamal Ligon made five tackles.
 - Ligon now has 238 career tackles, good for sixth on UTSA's all-time list.
- S Elliott Davison and WR Willie McCoy made their first career starts.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Today's attendance was 101,915 to mark the third-largest crowd to watch a UTSA game.
- UTSA's captains were Joe Evans, Nicktroy Fortune and Brandon Matterson.
