TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- UTSA improved to 2-3 overall and 1-0 in the American Athletic Conference. Temple dropped to 2-4 and 0-2.
- Today marked the first meeting between the Roadrunners and the Owls.
- UTSA improved to 8-4 all-time in conference openers.
- UTSA is now 3-0 in conference debuts.
- The Roadrunners are 21-3 (.875) in regular season conference games under fourth-year head coach Jeff Traylor.
 - Including the two Conference USA Championship Game victories, UTSA is 23-3 (.885) against league competition under Traylor.
- UTSA is 49-37 (.570) all-time in regular season conference games.
- The Roadrunners are 1-2 on the road this season and 31-42 all-time.
- UTSA is 32-13 (.711) under Jeff Traylor, the best record and winning percentage for a UTSA head coach through 45 games in program history.

TEAM NOTES

- UTSA racked up season highs for points (49), total offense (495) and takeaways (2).
 - The previous season best for points was 29 vs. Army on Sept. 15.
 - The previous season high for total offense was 417 at Houston on Sept. 2.
- The Roadrunners passed for a season-best 338 yards.
- UTSA rushed for 157 yards on 36 attempts.
- The Roadrunners held Temple to 70 rushing yards, the second-fewest yards allowed on the ground this season.
- UTSA recovered a pair of fumbles, also a season high.
- The Roadrunners recorded seven tackles for loss, including one sack.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior QB **Frank Harris** completed 25 of 33 passes for 338 yards and three touchdowns.
 - Today marked Harris' first game action since the 20-13 win over Texas State on Sept. 9.
 - Harris surpassed the 10,000-yard mark for his career as he now has 10,117 passing yards and 79 TDs on 885-of-1,317 passing.
 - He has completed 69 of 106 passes for 761 yards and five TDs this season.
- Senior WR **Joshua Cephus** caught seven passes for 81 yards and a touchdown.
 - Cephus leads UTSA with 38 catches for 386 yards and four TDs this season.
 - He tied the program's career receptions record of 262 held by Zakhari Franklin (2019-22)
 - He now has 2,874 receiving yards and 22 touchdowns for his career.
- Freshman WR **Devin McCuin** caught six passes for 94 yards and a touchdown, all season highs.
 - McCuin made his first career start today.
 - He now has 14 catches for 220 yards and two TDs this season.
- Senior TE **Oscar Cardenas** caught five passes for 51 yards.
 - Cardenas now has 13 receptions for 116 yards this season and 63 catches for 833 yards and four TDs as a Roadrunner.
- Senior WR **Tykee Ogle-Kellogg** piled up 83 yards on three receptions.
 - Ogle-Kellogg caught a 40-yard TD pass, his third of the season.
 - He now has 15 receptions for 269 yards this year and 71 catches for 1,052 yards and 11 TDs for his career.
- Junior RB **Robert Henry** ran for a team-high 78 yards and two touchdowns on 11 carries.
 - Henry now has 207 rushing yards and three TDs on 34 attempts this year.
 - He averaged 7.1 yards per tote today and now is averaging 6.1 yards per carry this year.
- Junior LB **Martavius French** led the team with 10 tackles, including five unassisted, and a pass breakup.
 - French paces UTSA with 29 total tackles this season.
- Senior LB **Avery Morris** posted a career-high nine tackles, including four solos and a half tackle for loss.
 - Morris now has 23 tackles and 1.5 TFLs this season.
- Senior S **Ken Robinson** logged seven tackles, one PBU and a half TFL.
 - Robinson now has 22 tackles and a pair of PBUs this year.
- Junior OLB **Jimmori Robinson** was credited with six stops, including two for a loss and a sack, one forced fumble and a quarterback hurry.
 - Robinson now has 18 tackles, five TFLs and a pair of sacks this year.
- Junior DL **Brandon Brown** and sophomore DL **Ronald Triplette** each recovered a fumble.
- Senior CB **Dywan Griffin** posted five tackles and forced a fumble.
