Green Wave In National Rankings

The program is now No. 24 in the first College Football Playoff ranking and No. 18 in both the Associated Press (AP) Poll and USA Today Coaches Polls.

22-3

The win over Florida Atlantic made Tulane 22-3 in its last 25 games over the last two seasons. No Tulane team has ever won 20 or more games over a two-year period of time. The 22 victories since the start of the 2022 season ranks third nationally behind Georgia (26) and Michigan (24).

Road Warriors

Tulane has won a school-record 10 consecutive road games and currently has the third-longest road winning streak nationally, trailing only Georgia (14) and Michigan (11).

Individually, quarterback Michael Pratt is ninth in pass efficiency (169.5).

Atop the AAC

As a team, Tulane paces the American Athletic Conference in rushing defense (77.7), pass efficiency (158.81), net punting (40.81), fewest punts (31), field goals made (16), defensive interceptions (12) and time of possession (32:31).

The Green Wave's Makhii Hughes is the league's leader in rushing yards (1,080) and rushing yards per game (98.18). Michael Pratt (169.47) is atop the conference in pass efficiency (176.0) and Shedro Louis leads in kick return average (31.54).

On the defensive side, Lance Robinson is tied for the league lead with four interceptions.

Air Attack/Pratt

Michael Pratt has thrown at least one touchdown pass in 43 of his 44 career games, including 25 in a row, and has 30 career multiple TD pass games. The only contest when he didn't find the end zone was November 6, 2021 at UCF.

Pratt tossed three touchdowns against Florida Atlantic to give him 87 for his career, moving him 15 clear of Patrick Ramsey for the all-time school record.

Pratt also currently holds the program's all-time mark for passing yardage (9,239), completion percentage (61.0, 699-1145), just ahead of Ryan Griffin (.599, 836-1396 from 2009-12) and Mike McKay (.599, 230-384 from 1981-82).

In home games, Pratt is 375-for-586 with 49 TD passes, 10 interceptions and has thrown for 5,010 yards. He has four 300-yard passing games, 12 200+ yard passing games and 17 multi-TD passing games.

Heroics from Hughes

Makhi Hughes surpassed the 1,000-yard mark on the season with his 131 yards against Tulsa. It is the 10th time a Tulane player has reached the 1,000 yard mark on the ground and he is just the eighth different player to get there in a single season. It was the sixth-straight game that Hughes has topped 100 yards rushing. He is the first freshman in the 129 years of Tulane football (In 1897, the school did not field a football team) to rush for 1,000 yards in a season.

The previous Green Wave freshman rushing record was 925 yards by Orleans Darkwa in 2010.

Turnovers!

Tulane, who forced one turnover against Florida Atlantic, has now won 18 of its last 19 games when forcing a turnover.

Glorious Ground Game

Tulane's run defense has a strong recent history of stinginess toward opposing running backs. The program has now gone 32 straight games without allowing a 100-yard individual performance (10/2/21 against ECU's Keaton Mitchell – 222 yards) to a running back.

On the team front, the Green Wave has outrushed the opposition in 19 of its last 23 games (including its current streak of 13 in a row). In such contests, Tulane holds a 17-2 record (losses: 2022 vs. Southern Miss, 2023 vs. Ole Miss).

Perfect for a While

The Green Wave has been successful on 187 consecutive extra-point attempts. The last miss came courtesy of Merek Glover in the 27-24 win over South Alabama in the 2020 season opener. Tulane's current streak is currently the nation's fourth-longest. The top six are as follows:

1. 269, Northern Illinois
2. 244, NC State
3. 190, UTSA
4. 187, Tulane
5. 178, Toledo

Fast Starts Under Fritz

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Tulane is 41-6 (.872) when leading at the half and 43-9 (.827) when leading through three quarters under head coach Willie Fritz. Since the beginning of the 2022 season, the Green Wave is 18-1 (.947) when scoring first.

Fritz Climbs the List

Tulane head coach Willie Fritz collected his 53rd Green Wave victory in the triumph over Florida Atlantic. That total moves him 16 wins dear of Chris Scelfo for second on the school's all-time win list. Clark Shaughnessy (59, 1915-20 and 1922-26) holds the top mark.

Notes at Florida Atlantic

It was the 30th time that he has had multiple passing touchdowns (8x in 2020, 7x in 2021, 9x in 2022 and 6x in 2023) in a game and his 14th time with three or more passing touchdowns in a game in his career (3x in 2020, 4x in 2021, 4x in 2022 and 3x in 2023)

Pratt broke Tulane's career passing yards record with his 37-yard pass to Yulkeith Brown in the fourth quarter. He passed Patrick Ramsey (9,205) for the all-time record and has now thrown for 9,239 yards in his career.

Darius Hodges' 7.5 sacks this season are tied for the 10th-most in Tulane's single-season records, along with Justin Adams (2010). Hodges' 18.5 career sacks has him ranked fifth all-time. His 35 career tackles for loss has him in eighth.

Tulane is 10-1 for the first time under Coach Fritz. This is the first time in school history that Tulane has won 10 or more games in back-to-back years. Overall, the program is 10-1 or better for the fourth time since 1893 (2023- 10-1, 1998 – 11-0, 1934 – 10-1, 1931 – 11-0).

The Green Wave is 7-0 in conference play for the first time under Willie Fritz and it is the second time overall that the program is 7-0 or better in conference games. It was only bettered by the 1934 team going 8-0 when playing in the SEC.

Wide receiver Chris Brazzell II posted career-highs in receptions (seven) and tied a career-high with 103 receiving yards.

Notes vs. Tulsa

Shedro Louis's 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown tied the school record. It was the eighth time that a Tulane player has had 100-yard kick return in school history and the first since 2003 and Fred Smith against TCU (9/1/03). It was only the third 100-yard kick return for Tulane since 1985. The kick return touchdown was the first for Tulane since 2019 against UCF by Stephon Huderson (11/23/19).

Tulane is 9-1 on the season for the first time under Coach Fritz. Overall, the program is 9-1 or better for the sixth time since 1893 (2023- 9-1, 1998 – 10-0, 1948 – 9-1, 1934 – 9-1, 1931 – 10-0, 1925 – 9-0-1). The Green Wave is 6-0 in conference play for the first time under Fritz and the third time overall (2023, 1998, 1934).

The win made Tulane 21-3 in its last 24 games over the last two seasons. No Tulane has ever won 20+ games over a two-year period of time.

The six wins in conference play this season are tied for the third-most in school history behind the eight by the 1934 team (SEC), the seven from the 2022 team (AAC) and the six from the 1998 team (CUSA).

Tulane has run for 100 yards as a team in 95 of the last 99 games.

Safety Bailey Despanie tied a career-high with eight tackles, while wide receiver Bryce Bohanon set career marks with four catches for 57 yards.

Comeback Kids

Tulane's 13-10 win at East Carolina was the program's third victory this season when trailing by 10 or more points.

Tulane is 8-1 on the season for the second straight year under Coach Fritz (2023 and 2022). Overall, the program is 8-1 or better for the 12th time since 1893.

The Green Wave is 5-0 in conference play for the second straight year under Willie Fritz and the sixth time overall (2023, 2022, 1998, 1949, 1939, 1934).

Tulane has run for 100 yards as a team in 95 of the last 99 games.

Makhi Hughes' 105-yard rushing was his fifth-straight game topping 100-yards on the ground.

Notes at Rice

Tulane is 7-1 on the season for the second straight year under Coach Fritz (2023 and 2022).

The Green Wave is 4-0 in conference play for the second straight year under Willie Fritz and the ninth time overall (2023, 2022, 2013, 1998, 1949, 1939, 1934).

Tulane has run for 100 yards as a team in 94 of its last 98 games.

Makhi Hughes' 153-yard rushing was a career high and his fourth straight game topping 100 yards on the ground.

Alex Bauman, Chris Brazzell II and Yulkeith Brown all set career-highs with five receptions.

Notes vs. North Texas

Michael Pratt's rushing touchdown was his 27th career touchdown scored (26 rushing, 1 receiving) and ties him with Jamaican Dartzet for 10th all-time at Tulane in touchdowns scored.

The Green Wave is 3-0 in conference play for the second straight year under Willie Fritz and the ninth time overall (2023, 2022, 2019, 2013, 1998, 1997, 1949, 1939, 1934).

Tulane has run for 100 yards as a team in 93 of the last 97 games.

North Texas' successful on-side kick recovery was the first allowed by the program since giving one up to ECU during the 2020 campaign (11/7/20).

Makhi Hughes' 121-yard rushing performance was his third-straight game topping the century mark on the ground. He joined Spears and Matt Forte as the only Tulane players in the 21st century to run for at least 120 yards and a touchdown in either three consecutive games or three conference games.

The Tulane defense has now gone 28 straight games without allowing 100-yard individual rusher (10/2/21 against ECU's Keaton Mitchell – 222 yards rushing).

The announced attendance of 30,000 was a sellout and ranks as tied for the third-largest in Yulman Stadium history. Four of the program's sellout crowds have come within the last 365 days.

Michael Pratt Named To Five Weekly Award Lists

After his outstanding play in the Homecoming Game victory over North Texas on Saturday, Tulane quarterback Michael Pratt has been selected to five weekly awards this week.

Pratt accounted for 264 yards and four total touchdowns to help keep Tulane atop the American Athletic Conference (AAC) standings in the 35-28 victory over the Mean Green. He completed 15 of 21 passes for 194 yards and three touchdowns, helping Tulane build a 28-7 lead. He added 70 rushing yards, including a 19-yard touchdown run with 2:34 remaining in the game that stood up as the eventual game-winner.

For his efforts he was named the AAC's Offensive Player of the Week, the Davey O'Brien Great Eight, one of the Manning Stars of the Week, East-West Shrine Bowl's "Monday Morning Quarterback" and as the Louisiana Sports Writers Association's (LSWA) Offensive Player of the Week. It was the second time that Pratt has been named the AAC's Offensive Player of the Week (9/4) as one of the Manning Stars of the Week (9/4) and as the LSWA Offensive Player of the Week (9/4).

95 for Fritz Sets School Record

Tulane head coach Willie Fritz coached his 95th Tulane game when the Green Wave defeated the Mean Green on Saturday. That moved him atop the school's all-time list and one clear of Chris Scelfo (94, 1998-2006) and Clark Shaughnessy (1915-20, 1922-26).

Notes at Memphis

The 31-21 win over Memphis in the state of Tennessee was the first for Tulane football since 1998 when the program defeated the Tigers 41-31. This was only the third time that Tulane has won in the city of Memphis since the 1998 season (once in 2023 and twice in 1998 – BYU in the Liberty Bowl – 41-27).

The road win over Memphis was the seventh straight victory away from home for the Green Wave and, for the moment, ties North Carolina for the third-longest active road winning streak in the country.

Tulane has run for 100 yards as a team in 92 of its last 96 games.

The Green Wave is 2-0 in conference play for the second straight year, the second time under Willie Fritz and the 10th time overall.

Makhi Hughes's 130-yard rushing total was a career-high and his second straight 100+ yard rushing performance.

Chris Brazzell II's 103 yards receiving was a career-high and his first 100-yard receiving game. He is the second Tulane receiver to have 100 yards or more receiving yards this season (Jha'Quan Jackson's 106 yards vs. South Alabama). Brazzell's performance was the school's first 100-yard receiving game on the road since Darnell Mooney's October 26, 2019 outing (112) at Navy.

The Tulane defense has gone 27 straight games without allowing 100-yard individual rusher (10/2/21 against ECU's Keaton Mitchell – 222

yards rushing).

Darius Hodges (2.0) became just the fourth Tulane player in the last 10 years to have multiple sacks on the road. The others were Dorian Williams (2.0, 11/5/2022 at Tulsa), Patrick Johnson (3.0, 11/7/2020 at East Carolina and Cam Sample (2.0, 9/12/2020 at South Alabama).

Willie Fritz Named to the Watch List for the Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award

Tulane University head football coach Willie Fritz was named to 2023 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Watch List on Tuesday.

Fritz was a finalist for this award last season after a historic 2022 campaign in which he led Tulane to the American Athletic Conference (AAC) Championship and a victory in the Goodyear Cotton Bowl Classic. He has the Green Wave off to another strong start at 5-1 this season, including a mark of 2-0 in AAC play.

He is one of 26 active football coaches that make up the watch list of the American Heart Association's 2023 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award. The award is given each January to a college football coach for contributions that make the sport better for athletes and fans alike by demonstrating grit, integrity and winning approach to coaching and life – both on and off the field.

Football's Kam Pedescleaux and Will Karoll Named LSWA Players of the Week

The Louisiana Sports Writers Association (LSWA) named Tulane's Kam Pedescleaux and Will Karoll as Players of the Week on Tuesday.

Pedescleaux was named the LSWA Defensive Player of the Week after tallying three tackles, an interception and a pass breakup in the 31-21 victory over Memphis.

Karoll was selected as the LSWA Special Teams Player of the Week after punting five times for 226 yards for an average of 45.2 yards per kick. He had a long of 57 yards plus placed a pair of punts inside the 10.

Pedescleaux and Karoll are the fourth and fifth Tulane players who have been recognized with a weekly award by the LSWA this season. Michael Pratt was named the organization's Offensive Player of the Week following the team's first game against South Alabama. Jesus Machado earned Defensive Player of the Award distinction follow the contest against Nicholls State on Sept. 25 and Devean Deal earned Defensive Player of the Week honors following the game against UAB on Oct. 2.

Football Has A Pair Named to the AAC's Weekly Honor Roll

The American Athletic Conference (AAC) named a pair of Tulane football players to its weekly honor roll following the Green Wave's 35-23 win over UAB.

Makhi Hughes was named to the honor roll after running for a career-high 123 yards on 22 carries and two touchdowns in the victory over UAB.

Devean Deal was an AAC Honor Roll selection after putting up eight tackles, a sack and four tackles for loss against the Blazers. His four tackles for loss are the most for any Tulane defensive player since the 2015 season. He also became the first Green Wave player in the 2000s to post a stat line of at least eight tackles, four tackles for loss and a sack against an FBS opponent.

Deal and Hughes are the second and third Tulane players recognized by the league office this season as Michael Pratt was named the AAC's Offensive Player of the Week following the first week of action on September 5.

Deal was also named the Louisiana Sports Writers Association's Defensive Player of the Week for his efforts.

Notes vs. UAB

Makhi Hughes' 123 yards on the ground was his first career 100-yard rushing performance.

In terms of touchdown responsibility, Michael Pratt's first score was the 100th of his Tulane career (adding to his own school record). Pratt now has 27 multiple touchdown passing performances during his career.

Tulane has run for 100 yards as a team in 91 of the last 95 games.

Tulane is 4-1 on the season for the second straight year and the third time under Willie Fritz (2023, 2022 and 2019). The Green Wave is 1-0 in conference play for the second straight year and fifth time under Willie Fritz.

The win was the 47th victory in the Tulane career of Willie Fritz and put him above .500 (47-46) in his eight years leading the program. Only ten Tulane coaches (who have coached multiple seasons) have ever finished with a record above .500.

Notes vs. Nicholls

Michael Pratt now has 26 multiple touchdown passing performances during his career.

The Green Wave is 19-0 in its last 19 games against Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) opposition dating back to 2000. This was Tulane's first game against an FCS opponent since taking on Alcorn State last season. Tulane is 16-0 all-time against current schools in the Southland Conference with the last meeting coming in 2018 against Nicholls. Tulane has outscored the four opponents it has taken on from the Southland (Nicholls, McNeese State, Northwestern State and Southeastern Louisiana) by a 597-215 margin.

The win was the 200th win in the FBS career of head coach Willie Fritz. Fritz ran his all-time record to 54-8 against FCS opponents. He has played an FCS opponent in each of the last three seasons at Tulane and is 6-0 against FCS opponents while at Tulane. His last loss to an FCS opponent came when his team was also playing FCS football while at Sam Houston State in a 30-29 victory by Southeastern Louisiana during the playoffs.

Tulane has run for 100 yards as a team in 90 of the last 94 games.

Tulane is 3-1 on the season for the second straight year and the fourth time under Willie Fritz (2023, 2022, 2019 and 2016).

Arnold Barnes' 65-yard rush was the longest for Tulane since Tyjae Spears had a 70-yard carry against USC in the Goodyear Cotton Bowl (1/2/23).

Shi'Keem Laister's punt return touchdown in the first quarter was the first for Tulane since Jha'Quan Jackson's 90-yard return for a score against Memphis last season (10/22/22).

Tulane's four interceptions against Nicholls is the first time the program has registered that many in the Willie Fritz era. Its last four-INT game came on November 8, 2014 when the Green Wave bested Houston 31-24 on the road. The team's 102 interception return yards were the most for the team since posting 108 in a 52-9 road win on October 5, 2002. Only Arkansas and Tulane have had a four interception/100 interception return yard game thus far in 2023.

Notes vs. Southern Miss

This was the third career start (Cincinnati in 2020 and Ole Miss in 2023) and 11th career appearance for Kai Horton.

Jha'Quan Jackson (17) moved into a tie for 10th place all-time at Tulane along with Wil Ursin (1990-93) in career touchdown receptions.

Tulane has now run for 100 yards as a team in 89 of its last 93 games.

The two teams have played the "Battle for the Bell" since 1979. Tulane has won three of its last four games of the series against Southern Miss.

Head Coach Willie Fritz ran his all-time record to 19-2 against Sun Belt Conference opponents with his only two losses coming to Southern Miss last year and to Georgia State in 2015 while he was at Georgia Southern.

The last time Tulane had 11 tackles for loss was against UCF in 2021 (11/6). The last time the Green Wave had more was against Southern Miss during the 2020 season (12-9/26).

The last time Tulane held an FBS opponent without a touchdown was against Temple (10/31) during a 38-3 victory in 2020.

Tulane held the Golden Eagles to just 202 total yards, its fewest against an FBS opponent since Wake Forest managed just 175 on September 1, 2016 in head coach Willie Fritz's NOLA debut.

The Green Wave surrendered just 25 yards rushing to Southern Miss. The last time the program yielded fewer was on October 3, 2015 when UCF was held to minus-35 yards in a 45-31 Tulane victory.

Notes vs. Ole Miss

Jha'Quan Jackson now has 55 catches for 792 yards and six touchdowns in home games in his career. His 41-yard touchdown catch in the second quarter moved him into 11th place all-time at Tulane in career touchdown receptions (16).

This was the second start (Cincinnati in 2020) and 10th career appearance for quarterback Kai Horton.

Awards

Quarterback Michael Pratt was named the Offensive Player of the Week by the Senior Bowl and the American Athletic Conference on Monday. The recognition came on the heels of Tulane's 37-17 victory over South Alabama, where he was 14-for-15 passing for 294 yards and four touchdown passes. His fourth touchdown pass tied the Tulane school record for career touchdown throws as he now sits atop the leaderboard along with Patrick Ramsey (1998-01) with 72. Pratt also ran for 39 yards in the game. Pratt now has 25 multiple touchdown passing performances in his career. His four passing touchdowns against the Jaguars matched his career-high set against UCF in the AAC Championship Game on Dec. 3, 2022.

Notes vs. South Alabama

Linebacker Corey Platt, Jr. made 15 tackles (10 solo) in the 37-17 win over South Alabama.

Valentino Ambrosio's three field goals in the win over South Alabama was the first time the Green Wave had three successful field goal attempts since the Armed Forces Bowl win over Southern Miss on January 4, 2020.

The win extended Tulane's winning streak to four games from the end of last season.

Tulane improved to 6-2 all-time in season openers under Willie Fritz.

This game was the second straight year that Tulane has started the season at home. The team started at home for four straight years from 2015-19.

With the win, Tulane improved to 2-1 all-time against South Alabama.

Tulane, which entered the game ranked at No. 24 in the Associated Press Preseason Poll, was ranked for its first game for the first time since being ranked in the Week 1 poll four times from 1936-49.

Jha'Quan Jackson now has 51 catches for 709 yards and five touchdowns in home games.

Tulane football head coach Willie Fritz had a banner seventh year in charge of the program in guiding the Green Wave to a 12-2 mark and a 7-1 record in the conference to earn the 2022 American Athletic Conference regular season title, win the league's championship game against UCF and cap the season with a thrilling 46-45 victory over USC in the Cotton Bowl.

With the victory over the Knights, Fritz helped Tulane earn its first major bowl appearance since the 1939 season. The win over the then No. 10 nationally ranked Trojans at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas marked Tulane's third straight.

For his efforts he was named the AAC Coach of the Year for the first time in his career. Among his numerous accomplishments this year are being only the second coach in school history to win Coach of the Year honors, leading the team to 10 or more wins for only the fourth time in school history and first time since 1998, leading Tulane to its first AP national ranking in 24 years and first ever College Football Playoff ranking, guiding the team to its most conference wins since 1934, earning only the third-ever conference regular season title, ending Cincinnati's 32-game home winning streak, beating a fellow ranked team for the school for the first time since 1956, having a school-record 15 All-AAC performers (Prince Pines – First, Sincere Haynesworth – First, Tyjae Spears – First, Dorian Williams – First, Jarius Monroe – First, Macon Clark – First, Joey Claybrook – Second, Michael Pratt – Second, Darius Hodges – Second, Patrick Jenkins – Second, Nick Anderson – Second, Casey Glover – Second, Jha'Quan Jackson – Second, Larry Brooks – Honorable Mention and Tyrick James – Honorable Mention), coaching the AAC's Offensive Player of the Year (Tyjae Spears) and leading the team to its fourth bowl appearance in the last five years.

Under trying and uncertain conditions in 2021, due to having to evacuate the state of Louisiana because of Hurricane Ida, he guided Tulane to a 2-10 record in his sixth season at the helm of the program. The Green Wave, despite being forced to play its originally scheduled home game against No. 2 Oklahoma in Norman, Oklahoma to start the season, pulled off the near upset on national television game before falling by a 40-35 margin. Overall, five of the team's 10 losses came by one score or less.

Tulane had four players that earned post-season recognition from the American Athletic Conference in Ryan Wright (First), Dorian Williams (Honorable Mention), Sincere Haynesworth (Honorable Mention) and Macon Clark (Honorable Mention). The program also had 12 players that earned selection by Phil Steele Magazine for its All-American Athletic Conference Team.

The Green Wave once again finished the year with a strong running game, as they averaged 164.8 yards per game - a figure that ranked in the top half of the AAC. Defensively, Tulane ranked among the conference's best in putting pressure on the quarterback with an average of 2.83 sacks per game. On special teams, the program led the conference in punting with an average of 43.4 yard per punt plus were one of three team in the league that were perfect on their point after touchdown attempts.

The 2022 season marks Fritz's 30th year as a collegiate head coach and 26th leading a NCAA program at the Division I or Division II level. Under Fritz's watch, the Green Wave have established a renewed sense of enthusiasm and a winning culture for the Green Wave. Tulane also has posted a 5-0 record against teams from the state of Louisiana during his tenure.

Coach Fritz continued his model of success in Uptown in 2020, as he guided the Green Wave to a third straight bowl appearance for the first time in program history.

The Green Wave's appearance in the 2020 Famous Idaho Potato Bowl marked the 14th bowl appearance in the 127-year history of the program. Three of those bowl appearances have occurred under Fritz's watch. Fritz's three bowl appearances are the most by any Tulane football head coach.

Fritz also has helped Tulane re-establish its presence on the professional circuit, as 21 of his former Green Wave players have seen action in the National Football League since he stepped foot on campus in 2016. Eight of his former Tulane pupils have been selected in the NFL Draft through the start of the 2022 campaign.

During the 2020 regular season, Tulane overcame numerous off the field challenges as part of the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite the pandemic, Fritz guided his team into 12 games during the season.

Tulane was one of just 15 teams nationally to play in 12 or more games during the 2020 campaign. In those 12 games, Tulane faced three nationally-ranked teams and in the process, the Green Wave picked up their first win over a Top 25 team in over 30 years, as they defeated 25th-ranked Army at home.

Tulane's victory over Army was one of four wins in its final five games that propelled the Green Wave to their third straight bowl appearance.

The Green Wave once again finished the year with a strong running game, as they averaged 217.1 yards per game - a figure that ranked led in the American Athletic Conference. Defensively, Tulane ranked among the nation's best in putting pressure on the quarterback, averaging 3.17 sacks per game which led the AAC and ranked 13th nationally.

Following the 2020 regular season, Tulane had eight student-athletes recognized by The American - the most since the Green Wave joined the league in 2014. Additionally, the eight all-conference players were the most since the Green Wave put 10 on the All-Conference USA team in 1997.

In April of 2021, Tulane had two players picked in the NFL Draft, as Cameron Sample and Patrick Johnson were selected by the Cincinnati Bengals (fourth round) and the Philadelphia Eagles (seventh round), respectively.

In 2019, Fritz led the Green Wave to the best start to a season in over 20 years and came within one spot of cracking the top 25 in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches Poll for the first time over 20 years. The Green Wave also established a strong home field advantage under Fritz's direction in 2019, as they posted a 5-1 record inside Yulman Stadium. Tulane's 5-1 mark at home was the team's best record at Yulman Stadium since the venue opened in 2014.

Tulane's 2019 unit also featured an impressive rushing attack, which ranked 13th in the country, averaging 249.8 yards per game. The Green Wave rushing attack finished the year with a program-best 3,162 yards. Tulane closed the year with 5,841 yards of total offense, which marked just fourth time in program history the Green Wave surpassed 5,000 yards of offense.

Tulane also finished the 2019 campaign by scoring 430 points for the season, averaging 33.1 points per game.

The Green Wave defensive unit also posted another impressive season, as they held eight of their 13 opponents under their season average in total yards and forced 16 turnovers.

Following the regular season, Tulane had four players receive All-American Athletic Conference honors for the third straight season, as Patrick Johnson, Corey Dublin, P.J. Hall and Thakarius Keyes were all honored by the league office.

Tulane's victory in the 2020 Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl marked first time in program history that the Green Wave had won a bowl game in back-to-back seasons.

In April of 2020, Tulane continued its NFL Draft tradition, as the Green Wave had a pair of players selected for the second time in three years. Wide receiver Darnell Mooney and cornerback Keyes were taken in the fifth (Chicago Bears) and seventh rounds (Kansas City Chiefs), respectively. The selections of Mooney and Keyes on day three of the event marked the fourth consecutive year that a Tulane player was drafted.

Of Fritz's 224 wins, 86 have come on the NCAA Division I level (Football Bowl Subdivision and Football Championship Subdivision), and 164 of his wins have come at NCAA institutions.

In 2018, Fritz guided Tulane to its first bowl trip since 2013, a share of the American Athletic Conference title and just its sixth winning season in the last 37 years, while facing the second toughest schedule among teams from the conference.

Tulane closed the year with wins in five of its last six games to earn a share of the American Athletic Conference West Division crown and a bid to the 2018 AutoNation Cure Bowl where it would post a convincing win over in-state rival Louisiana-Lafayette to claim its fifth bowl victory in program history. Three of the Green Wave's losses in 2018 came by seven points or less.

Following the regular season, four Tulane players earned all-conference honors from The American, while eight players earned all-league recognition from Phil Steele College Football Magazine, including junior long snapper Geron Eatherly, who also earned fourth team all-America from the publication.

Under Fritz's watchful eye in 2018, Tulane's rushing attack was among the nation's best, ranking 23rd in the nation and fifth in The American, averaging 218.2 yards per game. The Green Wave rushing attack also proved to be an explosive unit, as they totaled 18 plays of 30 yards or more.

Tulane's defense also proved to be a force, as it ranked third in The American in total defense, but it was the Green Wave's ability to rush the quarterback that made the unit one of the best in the conference. In 2018, Tulane averaged just over three sacks per game (3.15), which led The American and ranked eighth nationally. Sophomore Patrick Johnson led the way for the Green Wave as he averaged nearly one sack a game (0.81), which ranked 12th in the FBS and second in The American.

The Green Wave continued their success in April of 2019, as cornerback Donnie Lewis Jr., was drafted in the seventh round by the Cleveland Browns.

The 2017 campaign saw Tulane finish the year with its highest win total since 2013 despite facing one of the nation's toughest schedules, as nine of its opponents earned invitations to bowl games. In addition, four of the Green Wave's losses came by six points or fewer.

The Green Wave earned three victories against bowl participants in 2017 while four players earned All-Conference honors. Among the players was former cornerback Parry Nickerson, who was named to the all-conference first team, and earned All-America honors from Sports Illustrated and SB Nation.

Under Fritz's direction, the 2017 squad featured an aggressive ground attack, which averaged 231.5 yards per game – a figure that ranked No. 20 nationally and fourth in The American – and an opportunistic defensive unit that recorded 19 turnovers.

The 2017 season also served as a milestone season for Fritz as he earned his 200th victory as a head coach and in the process became just the fourth active Football Bowl Subdivision head coach with 200 wins.

The program's success continued into April, as Fritz saw two of his players selected in the 2018 NFL Draft. Nickerson and defensive lineman Ade Aruna were both selected in the sixth round by the New York Jets and Minnesota Vikings, respectively.

In his first season in the Crescent City, Fritz guided Tulane to a 4-8 record and earned his first AAC victory in the team's season finale at UConn. The Green Wave posted 30 or more points in five games in 2016, four of which were in wins. Three of the eight losses were by seven points or fewer with Tulane leading in four of those games entering the fourth quarter.

Following the year, linebacker Nico Marley, defensive tackle Tanzel Smart and Nickerson earned All-AAC honors. In the spring of 2017, Smart was selected in the sixth round of the NFL Draft by the Los Angeles Rams.

The Shawnee Mission, Kansas, native was named the Green Wave's 40th head coach by director of athletics Troy Dannen on Dec. 15, 2015. At that time, he brought 33 years of collegiate experience as a football student-athlete or coach to Tulane, having led teams to six combined conference championships (one at every level he had coached) and two bowl appearances. He was twice named the national coach of the year, including the American Football Coaches Association FCS Coach of the Year in 2011 and the Liberty Mutual FCS Coach of the Year in 2012.

Fritz came to New Orleans from Georgia Southern where he spent two seasons and led the Eagles to a combined record of 17-7, a 2014 Sun Belt Conference title and the school's first-ever NCAA postseason bowl game with their berth in the 2015 GoDaddy.com Bowl. Georgia Southern concluded the 2015 regular season with an 8-4 overall record including a mark of 6-2 in conference play.

Fritz led the Eagles to a 9-3 overall record and a perfect mark of 8-0 in conference play during his first season at Georgia Southern in 2014, and was named the Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year. However, the school's waiver claim to allow Georgia Southern to play in a bowl despite being in the second year of the NCAA's transition period was denied. Georgia Southern was the first team in NCAA history to post an undefeated conference season in its first season at the Division I FBS level.

Prior to Georgia Southern, Fritz served as head coach at Sam Houston State from 2010-13 where he led the Bearkats to back-to-back Southland Conference titles, NCAA Division I Championship game appearances in 2011 and 2012 and a third straight NCAA playoff berth in 2013.

Honored as the American Football Coaches Association Regional

Coach of the Year in 2011 and 2012, Fritz was selected by the media and his peers in the Southland Conference as the league's Coach of the Year in 2011 after his team went a perfect 7-0 in conference play.

In 2011 and 2012, Sam Houston State posted the two highest single-season win totals in program history with marks of 14-1 (2011) and 11-4 (2012) and Bearkat players were showered with accolades. More than 50 earned All-Southland Conference honors under Fritz in his last four years, not including additional Player of the Year, Offensive Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year awards. All-America status from national coaching and media outlets were bestowed on 11 Sam Houston State players during his tenure.

Prior to his head coaching tenure at Sam Houston State, Fritz revitalized Central Missouri and guided the Mules to 11 winning seasons in 13 years. The NCAA Division II program's ledger included two 10-win seasons with the 2001 Mule squad earning its first postseason trip in more than 30 years.

In 2002, Central Missouri made its first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II playoffs and was the Mid-America Athletic Association (MIAA) co-champion a year later. A 97-47 mark in 13 seasons ranks Fritz as the winningest coach in the program's history. He was the only coach to ever win seven or more games in eight consecutive seasons, and his victory total ranked him 15th among active Division II coaches at the time. In addition to his impressive 67.4 winning percentage with the Mules, Fritz coached his student-athletes to achieve their potential on the field and in the classroom. More than 150 Mules were recognized with All-MIAA honors with 41 first-team selections and 24 All-Americans.

Under Fritz, Central Missouri recorded a graduation rate of 84 percent with 144 MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll recipients, 14 Academic All-Region and three Academic All-Americans. For all of his accomplishments guiding Central Missouri, Fritz was honored by the school with induction into its Athletics Hall of Fame on Feb. 11, 2017.

Prior to his time at Central Missouri and Sam Houston State as a head coach, Fritz spent two different stints as an assistant coach with the Bearkats. He first served as a graduate assistant during the 1984 and 1985 seasons when he earned a master's degree in kinesiology. During that two-year stretch, Sam Houston State posted a 16-6 record and won the 1985 Gulf Star Conference championship. He returned to Sam Houston State a second time in 1991 after spending four years at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas under legendary coach Dick Foster, earning a promotion to defensive coordinator after one year. He stayed another two years to work for Coach Foster's Skip and the Red Ravens. During the 1990 season, Fritz served as the defensive coordinator where he helped guide the Red Ravens to a national title.

When Fritz was brought back to Sam Houston State in 1991 under Ron Randleman as secondary and special teams coach, he instilled an attitude of excellence on special teams that would last more than a decade. The Bearkats' "block party" racked up 80 blocked punts, field goals and extra points beginning with Fritz in 1991 and lasting through 2004.

In Fritz's first year as a full-time assistant coach at Sam Houston State in 1991, the Bearkats won the Southland Conference. That league title and an eight-win season launched Sam Houston State to the program's second-ever appearance in the NCAA Division I Football Championship.

Fritz departed Huntsville for a second time prior to the 1993 season for an opportunity to be the head coach at Blinn College, where he would turn around a program that had only five wins in its previous three seasons.

From 1993-96, Fritz and the Buccaneers would rack up 39 victories against only five losses with a tie and claim two national junior college championships. He was inducted into the NJCAA Football Hall of Fame for the environment of success he created at Blinn.

One of seven children, Fritz is the son of the late Harry Fritz, who coached the Central Missouri football team in 1952 before continuing his career as the Executive Director at the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) in Kansas City. The elder Fritz also served at several colleges and universities in administration as an athletics director.

Fritz played on two conference title teams and was a four-year starter at defensive back for Randleman at Pittsburg State and remained at his alma mater as a student assistant coach in 1982. Early coaching stops included a year at Shawnee Mission Northwest (Kansas) High School in 1983 and Willis (Texas) High School in 1986, with his return to Sam Houston State for graduate school in between those years.

Fritz and his wife Susan have three children, a son and two daughters. Their son Wesley, who was married in the summer of 2019 to his wife Rebecca, is a member of the Tulane football staff and serves as the Director of Player Personnel. The couple's daughter Lainie is an elementary school teacher and sports broadcaster while their youngest daughter Brooke is a CPA for Deloitte in Houston, Texas.

Fritz is now a grandfather, courtesy of Wesley's newborn son Grant, who arrived in the spring of 2023.
