OPENING TIP

AT A GLANCE

Oregon concludes a four-game homestand on Sunday, as UTSA pays a visit to Matthew Knight Arena for the Ducks' final nonconference home game at 11 a.m. PT.

UO looks to extend its winning streak to a season-long four games after winning three games in four days last weekend at Matthew Knight Arena. Head coach Kelly Graves seeks his 600th Division I win Sunday.

Oregon won the only previous meeting with UTSA, a 77-63 win in Eugene on Nov. 20, 2016.

LAST TIME OUT

Playing its third game in four days, Oregon came away with a 67-37 win over Southern Monday night in the Pac-12/SWAC Legacy Series.

UO's trio of Chance Gray, Phillipina Kyei and Grace VanSlooten each scored in double figures and combined for 46 points. Over the Ducks' three-game winning streak, the three have scored 156 of Oregon's 191 points, including 106 of 124 points in wins over Idaho and Portland State.

Kyei turned in her fourth straight double-double against the Jaguars, scoring 16 points while grabbing a career-high 21 rebounds. She is averaging 16.8 points and 17.0 rebounds over the last four games, with her eight double-doubles tying the national lead.

Gray and VanSlooten each added 15 points in the win over Southern, while Ula Chamberlin scored a season-high seven off the bench.

DID YOU KNOW?



PHILLIPINA KYEI leads the Pac-12 and is tied for the national lead with eight double-doubles, and is averaging 16.7 ppg and 17.0 rpg over her last four contests.

Chance Gray went 8-for-8 from the free throw line over the final 3:22 against Idaho to help seal the victory.

SCOUTING UTSA

UTSA (5-4) makes the trek to Eugene following a three-game homestand in which the Roadrunners went 1-3. UTSA dropped a 66-64 decision to Houston on Thursday after defeating UTEP, 90-66, on Dec. 3. Three of the Roadrunners' four losses have been by eight points or less, and eight of their last nine games have been decided by single digits.

Two players average double-figure points in Sidney Love (13.3) and Kyra White (11.9). Elyssa Coleman averages 9.8 points a game and is also the team's leading rebounder at 6.6 per game, helping the Roadrunners to a conference-leading plus-12.2 rebounding margin. UTSA also leads the American Athletic Conference and ranks seventh nationally with 6.2 blocks per game.

The Roadrunners were picked eighth out of 14 teams in the AAC preseason coaches poll. Jordyn Jenkins, the 2022-23 Conference-USA Player of the Year, was a second-team preseason all-conference pick, but has yet to appear in a game this season for UTSA.

INSIDE THE SERIES

Oregon and UTSA will meet for just the second time Sunday, and first since the Roadrunners visited Matthew Knight Arena on Nov. 20, 106. In the series' first matchup, the Ducks defeated UTSA 77-63. UO is 6-5 all-time against current members of the American Athletic Conference, while head coach Kelly Graves is 2-1 in his tenure at Oregon.

THE DUCKS' NEW BIG THREE

Oregon's top returning trio of **CHANCE GRAY**, **PHILLIPINA KYEI** and **GRACE VANSLOOTEN** helped the Ducks snap a two-game losing skid with three straight home wins over a three-game span last week. Against Idaho on Dec. 8, the three accounted for 53 of UO's 59 points in an eight-point victory. The following afternoon, they again combined for 53 total points in a 65-54 win over Portland State. In that 24-hour span, they have scored 106 of Oregon's 124 total points - or 85.4 percent of the team's total offense. The three were the only Ducks to score in double figures in a 67-37 win over Southern on Monday, combining for 46 points.

- » Over the last three games, Gray, Kyei and VanSlooten have combined to score 152 points (50.7 PPG) of Oregon's 191 total points - or 79.6 percent.
- » Gray finished with a game-high 20 points against Idaho, her second 20-point outing of the season and fourth of her career.
- » Kyei was a force in all three contests, scoring a career-high 20 points against Portland State and hauling in a career-high 21 rebounds against the Jaguars.
- » Kyei extended her streak to four straight double-doubles, a career-long streak, while upping her season total to eight to lead the Pac-12.
- » VanSlooten was consistent across the three wins, scoring at least 15 in all three games with 17 against Idaho, 18 against the Vikings and 15 in just three quarters against Southern.
- » VanSlooten scored 16 of her 18 in the second half against PSU, hitting on 6-of-13 shots from the field.
- » On the season, the three are responsible for 431 of the Ducks' 659 points (65%), or 43.1 points per game.

CLOSING TIME

Oregon has been at its best when it counts this season, averaging 19.0 points per game in the fourth quarter - the most of any quarter on the season. The Ducks have a plus-35 point differential in the fourth quarter, 15 points more than any quarter, and hold a plus-55 scoring margin in the second half compared to an even scoring differential in the first halves of games. As a team, UO has a higher field goal percentage (44.1%), 3-point percentage (33.3%) and free throw percentage (82.3%) in the fourth quarter than overall for the season.

- » Leading by just four headed into the fourth quarter against Idaho on Dec. 8, Chance Gray went a perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line over the game's final 3:22 to help stave off Idaho.
- » Gray knocked down all five of UO's 3-pointers against PSU, including four in the fourth quarter and three coming on consecutive trips down the floor to help seal the victory.
- » In the last five minutes of games, the Ducks shoot 89.2 percent from the free throw line (33-for-37) while Gray is a percent 14-for-14 from the stripe.

NOTES

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMPS

Oregon has been fueled by the Ducks' top two returners in sophomores **CHANCE GRAY** and **GRACE VANSLOOTEN**. The duo has combined to average 30.0 points per game, or about 45.5 percent of the team's total offense. Both Gray and VanSlooten have scored in double figures in nine of the team's 10 games. VanSlooten scored 19 in each of UO's first two games and dropped a season-high 21 at Grand Canyon on Nov. 16, and has scored in double figures in six straight games. VanSlooten also averages 9.0 rebounds in all 10 games this season and averages a league-high 35.6 minutes a night. Gray opened the season with 17 points against Northern Arizona and has logged a season-high 20 points twice: vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Nov. 8) and Idaho (Dec. 8).

- » Gray and VanSlooten account for 46.7 percent of Oregon's field goal attempts (277 of 592).
- » Gray equaled her career high with six 3-pointers against the UAPB, going 5-for-6 in the first half, and made all five of UO's treys against PSU on Saturday. She has made 21 of Oregon's 46 3-pointers on the year.
- » Gray has played at least 30 minutes in all 10 games this season and averages a league-high 35.6 minutes a night.
- » Gray flirted with a triple-double at Nevada on Nov. 21, grabbing a career-high eight rebounds while also tying her career high with seven assists and scoring nine points in a 76-47 win.
- » Gray has tallied multiple assists seven times this season and leads the team at 3.8 per game (ninth in Pac-12).
- » VanSlooten produced her first 20-point outing of the season at Grand Canyon, and the sixth of her career, scoring 21 points on 8-of-16 shooting.
- » VanSlooten hauled in a career-high 16 rebounds in two straight games (at Nevada, at Portland), upping her season double-double total to three and five in her career.
- » The Ducks are 5-1 when VanSlooten scores at least 20 points (1-0 this season) and 3-1 when she finishes with a double-double this season.

PHIED PHILLI

Junior center **PHILLIPINA KYEI**, the tallest player in Oregon history, has turned in a double-double in eight of Oregon's first 10 games this season to lead the Pac-12 and tie for the national lead. Kyei has produced a double-double in four straight games, the longest such streak of her career, after a career-high 21 rebounds to go with 16 points against Southern. She upped her career total to 16 double-doubles, moving her into 14th in program history. She is just the 23rd player in UO history with at least 10 career double-doubles.

- » Kyei leads the Pac-12 and ranks second in the country at 12.6 rebounds per game, while her 8.4 defensive rebounds per game ranks fourth and her 4.2 offensive boards a game is 16th.
- » Kyei has 16 double-doubles in just 72 career games, the fewest number of any Duck with at least 13 double-doubles.
- » Kyei is one of five players in the Pac-12 averaging at least 10 points and 10 rebounds, while her eight double-doubles lead the conference.
- » Oregon is 14-2 when Kyei records a double-double and 16-3 when she scores at least 10 points.
- » 32 career games with 10 or more rebounds, with 27 coming since the start of last season.
- » Scored a career-high 20 points against Portland State, and

C PHILLIPINA KYEI now has 16 career double-doubles after scoring 16 points to go with 21 rebounds vs. Southern, and is now alone in 14th place in program history. She is just the 23rd Duck to record at least 10 career double-doubles.

NOTES

- » six of her seven career games with at least 15 points have come this season.
- » Kyei has led Oregon in scoring four times in her career, with three coming this season (Baylor, Portland State, Southern).
- » Double-digit rebounds in 10 of her last 13 games, dating back to last season.
- » Surpassed the 500-rebound mark at GCU and her 590 career rebounds ranks seventh among active players in the Pac-12.
- » Since the start of last season, Kyei is averaging 11.2 rebounds and 8.4 points per game.

RING THE BELL

Just 10 games into her collegiate career, freshman **SOFIA BELL** has been one of the Ducks' most consistent players this season. Bell has started all 10 games and is the only freshman to crack Oregon's starting five. The Portland product ranks second on UO with 16 made 3-pointers, helping her to 7.6 points per game. Bell is also the team leader with 15 steals and one of three Pac-12 freshman averaging at least 1.5 steals a game.

Bell plays 34.1 minutes a game, the most among conference freshmen, nearly three minutes more per game than the next closest in USC's JuJu Watkins (31.4). Bell's offensive rating of 92.8 (points per 100 individual possessions) is No. 3 among Pac-12 freshman who play at least 25 minutes a game.

- » Bell and sophomore guard Chance Gray are responsible for 37 of the Ducks' 46 made 3-pointers this season (80.4 percent).
- » One of two Pac-12 freshmen averaging at least 7.0 points and 1.5 steals per game while playing at least 30 minutes, and one of just 12 nationally.
- » Bell has played at least 30 minutes in nine of 10 games this season and played all but one minute in back-to-back games (39 at Portland, 40 at Baylor).

CAN'T SPELL DUCKS WITH D

Through 10 games this season, Oregon has made life difficult for its opponents on the offensive end. The Ducks have limited teams to a combined 35.3 percent shooting from the field - and held their opponent below 37.0 percent shooting in each of its seven wins. Additionally, UO opponents have combined to shoot just 29.2 percent from beyond the 3-point line, while the Ducks held teams to just 22.5 percent through the season's first three games.

- » Oregon limited Nevada to a season-low 24.0 field goal percentage, holding the Wolf Pack to 5-for-39 (12.8%) in the second half.
- » In its seven victories, UO has held its opponents to a combined 23.2 percent shooting from the 3-point line.
- » Seventh in the country and third in the Pac-12 with 32.3 defensive rebounds per game.
- » Despite the loss, Oregon held 13th-ranked Baylor to season lows in points (71) and field goal percentage (39.4%) at Ferrell Center on Dec. 3. The Bears entered the contest averaging 92.0 points (sixth in the country) while shooting 50.6 percent from the floor.
- » Opponents are attempting just 8.8 free throws per game, the second fewest nationally. Teams are making just 5.7 free throws a game, also second fewest in the country.

KEYS TO VICTORY

This season, Oregon is 6-0 when scoring over 60 points while going 7-0 when holding opponents to 60 points or fewer. The Ducks are also unbeaten (7-0) when scoring more points in the paint than its opponent while going 0-3 when being outscored. The same can be said for UO recording more rebounds, assists and finishing with a better field goal

percentage than its opponents.

- » In its seven victories, Oregon is averaging 71.1 points a game while shooting 42.6 percent from the floor.
- » Over its three losses, the Ducks score 53.7 points per game at a 36.3 percent clip.

NO PLACE LIKE MKA

Since its opening in 2011, the Ducks have been dominant in defending Matthew Knight Arena, posting an all-time record of 155-61 (.718). UO is 87-14 (.861) over the last seven seasons at Matthew Knight Arena, with a 40-12 conference record, winning by an average of 24.8 points per game during that span.

Under head coach **KELLY GRAVES**, UO's offense is averaging 79.4 points a game at home - the highest number of any Pac-12 team since 2014-15. The Ducks also lead the Pac-12 in attendance over the last five seasons, averaging 7,852 fans in attendance.

The Ducks are 68-4 (.944) at home against non-conference teams under Graves, with two of the four losses coming in his first season (2014-15). Oregon has won 63 of its last 65 home games against nonleague opponents, including a 44-game winning streak from Dec. 29, 2014 to Dec. 1, 2021.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

This year's Oregon team features eight underclassmen (four freshmen, four sophomores) and just five combined juniors and seniors. Underclassmen account for 479 of the Ducks' 659 points on the season, or 72.6 percent, and average 47.9 points for game for the Ducks. The Ducks' top three scorers are freshmen or sophomores, and five of the top six.

RETURN AISLE

Oregon brings back four letterwinners, including three starters, from last year's team in **KENNEDY BASHAM**, **CHANCE GRAY**, **PHILLIPINA KYEI** and **GRACE VANSLOOTEN**. Kyei was the Ducks' leader in both rebounds (376) and blocked shots (53) last season, with her rebound total equaling the third-most ever in a season in UO history. Her 10.7 rebounds per game ranked second in the Pac-12 while her 54.1 field goal percentage ranked fourth.

Gray and VanSlooten each wrote their names in Oregon's freshman record book, as Gray's 56 3-pointers were tied for third-most in a single season in UO freshman history and her 77 assists were good for ninth on that list. VanSlooten finished in the top 10 in Oregon freshman history with 113 made free throws (third), 423 points (fifth), 28 blocks (seventh) and 155 made field goals (tied for seventh).

- » Gray set an Oregon freshman record by going 10-for-10 from the free throw line at California on Jan. 27.
- » VanSlooten was just the third player in Pac-12 history to sweep both freshman- and player-of-the-week awards.
- » VanSlooten ranked second in the Pac-12 in scoring among freshmen at 13.2 points per game (second on team in scoring).
- » Kyei's 376 total rebounds were the most by a Duck since Jillian Alleyne's 455 in 2014-15.
- » Basham, who played in just 16 games last season due to injuries, recorded multiple blocks six times, with a season-high four coming at Washington on Feb. 19 (tied for seventh-most in a single game by a UO freshman).

Kelly Graves enters his 10th season at the helm of the Oregon women's basketball program in 2022-23. He was named the seventh head coach in program history on April 7, 2014. On March 20, 2019, Graves and UO agreed to terms on a contract extension that will keep him in Eugene through the 2025-26 season.

Graves enters 2023-24 with an overall record of 210-90 during his nine seasons with the Ducks, including an impressive 100-60 mark in conference play. Graves led Oregon to three straight Pac-12 regular-season championships from 2018-20, as well as the Pac-12 Tournament title in both 2018 and 2020. The Ducks reached the Elite Eight for the first time in program history in both 2017 and 2018 before reaching Oregon's first-ever Final Four in 2019. Graves had the Ducks at 31-2 overall and in position for the program's first-ever No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2020 before the postseason was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

A two-time winner of the John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year award, Graves owns a 637-272 overall record in 29 seasons as a collegiate head coach and a 592-252 mark in 26 seasons at the Division-I level.

Graves has coached some of the premier players in the history of women's basketball, including Oregon legend Sabrina Ionescu (2016-20). Ionescu is the only player in NCAA history (women and men) to surpass 2,000 career points, 1,000 career rebounds and 1,000 career assists, and she was the unanimous national player of the year as a senior in 2019-20. Courtney Vandersloot - who played under Graves at Gonzaga - is the only other player in history to reach 2,000 points and 1,000 assists.
