## UTSA adds DJ Allen to early signing class on Thursday

**SAN ANTONIO** — UTSA head football coach Jeff Traylor on Thursday announced that the program has added DJ Allen to the early signing class, which now numbers 15 signees.

The signees include DJ Allen (Gladewater, Texas/Gladewater HS/TCU), Mekhi Anderson (Tampa, Fla./Armwood HS), Briley Brown (Helotes, Texas/O'Connor HS), Caile Hogan (Eltham North, Australia/Marcellin College), Davion Hurth (Mesquite, Texas/Horn HS), CJ James (Springfield, Mass./Central HS/New Mexico), Kenyan Kelly (Denison, Texas/Denison HS), Nate Markiewicz (McKinney, Texas/North HS), Jonah Miller (Tucson, Ariz./ Salpointe Catholic HS/Santa Rosa [Calif.] JC), Elijah Newell (Maumelle, Ark./Maumelle HS), Chidera Otutu (Pflugerville, Texas/Weiss HS), Zechariah Robinson (Brookshire, Texas/Royal HS), JJ Sparkman (Longview, Texas/Pine Tree HS/Texas Tech), Joseph Ugwu Jr. (Katy, Texas/Paetow HS) and Daemian Wimberly (Austin, Texas/Vandegrift HS/SMU).

The group features 10 players from the state of Texas, one apiece from Arizona, Arkansas, Florida and Massachusetts, as well as one from Australia. Of the players from the Lone Star State, three each hail from the Greater Houston Area and Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex/North Texas, two are from Central Texas and one apiece from San Antonio and East Texas.

Nine of the players are slated to play on the offensive side of the ball, five are pegged for the defense and one is a specialist.

Ten of the players are joining the Roadrunners from the high school ranks, while the other five are transfers who were part of FBS programs.

Transfer wide receiver from TCU ... appeared in three games in 2023 after redshirting the previous season ... had a pair of receptions for 10 yards ... two-way star for head coach Jonny Louvier at Gladewater High School in East Texas ... District 6-3A Division I MVP as a junior and senior ... totaled 71 receptions, 1,604 receiving yards and 18 receiving touchdowns and added 1,133 rushing yards and 10 TDs on the ground during his prep career ... passed for 741 yards and three touchdowns and rushed for 1,008 yards and 10 TDs as a senior ... also caught 12 passes for 288 yards and a score ... recorded 24 tackles, a sack, eight pass breakups, a forced fumble and fumble recovery in 2021 ... a first-team all-district selection at wide receiver as a sophomore ... helped lead the Bears to a 10-4 record and a 3A Division I state quarterfinal appearance that season ... four-star recruit who was ranked by 247Sports as the No. 28 wide receiver in the nation as a senior ... rated the No. 27 player in Texas and No. 161 nationally ... also lettered in basketball, baseball and track & field ... placed fourth as a junior at the 2021 Texas 3A state meet in the 100 meters (10.92) and eighth in the long jump (20-9) ... set personal records of 10.82 in the 100m and 22-8.25 in the long jump at regionals that year.

Speedy offensive weapon for head coach Evan Davis at Armwood High School in Tampa, Florida ... piled up more than 1,200 all-purpose yards over his final two prep seasons ... caught 33 passes for 668 yards and 10 touchdowns and averaged 20.2 yards per reception as a senior ... also rushed for 103 yards and a TD on 15 attempts and had a kickoff return for a touchdown to help lead the Hawks to a district championship and playoffs ... had 21 catches for 381 yards and three scores his junior year ... also a state qualifier in the 100 meters, 200m and 4x100m relay ... has clocked personal bests of 10.70 in the 100m and 21.35 in the 200m.

Three-year starter in the offensive line for head coach David Malesky at San Antonio O'Connor High School ... two-time first-team all-district performer ... selected to play in the San Antonio All-Star Game ... rated as a three-star prospect by 247Sports and Dave Campbell's Texas Football, which ranks him as the No. 6 center in the state ... also competes for the track & field team ... won the district title in the shot put and advanced to the area meet, where he finished second, and the regional meet, placing in the top 10 as a junior ... owns a personal-best mark of 50-5 in the shot put ... member of the National Honor Society ... two-time first-team academic all-district in track & field and three-time second-team academic all-district in football ... brother, Brady, played offensive line for UTSA in 2011 ... brother, Baylen, played football for Texas Tech in 2013-16 ... brother, Brannon, played football for TCU in 2019-22 ... grandfather, Bobby Maples, played football at Baylor and in the NFL for 14 seasons with the Oilers (1965-70), Steelers (1971) and Broncos (1972-78).

No. 1 offensive guard in the state by 247Sports and the 247 composite, and the second-ranked tackle in Arizona by ESPN and Rivals ... played freshman through junior seasons at Salpointe Catholic High School before opting out of his senior year during the COVID-19 pandemic ... selected to All Sports Tucson's All-Decade team at the end of 2019 ... first-team 4A all-state selection as a junior ... earned first-team All-Kino League honors ... also competed for the track & field team.
