> This is the AAC Conference opener for both teams,

- as well as UTSA's first-ever American Athletic Conference game.
- > Temple is 8-2 all-time in AAC openers. The Owls
- have won their last five opening matchups.
- > This will be the 40th matchup the Owls have had
- against schools from the state of Texas. UTSA is the

seventh Texas school Temple has faced, the Owls

are 21-18 in those games.

HEADLINES

THE OWLS

- > Temple has dominated the offensive glass, currently ranking 4th in the nation in rebounding on that end of the court (17.9 orpg). The Owls have also controlled possession, clocking in at 13th in the land in turnover margin (+7.75). The team leads in the American in turnovers per game (13.2) and assist to turnover ratio (+1.19).
- > Aleah Nelson ranks second in the AAC in assists per game (5.0). She is scoring 11.2 points per contest, good for second on the team. The point guard has now passed for at least five assists in seven straight games. Nelson ranks 11th in Division I among active players in assists with 515, eight behind George Amoore of Virginia Tech. She is one of only six players in Division I with at least 500 assists and 1400 points.
- > East paces Temple in scoring with 12.0 ppg. The wing has now scored in double figures in each of the last six games. She is one of only 12 players in the American who has had multiple 20-point performances.
- > Tucker has recorded a double-double in two of the last three games. Her 7.2 rebounds per game check in at 9th in the American. The forward is third on the team in scoring.

- > Delaware State: 2nd most points in program history, largest margin of victory in program history, & more (see page 4 opening with a bang)
- > Bucknell & SJU: 48 rebounds, most since 2-18-2016

LAST TIME OUT

> Temple fell for the first time since the beginning of the month to Big Ten opponent Northwestern before the break.

> The Owls led 30-26 at halftime before Northwestern took the lead in the third quarter. Temple made several comeback attempts, including cutting the lead to as little as two points in the fourth quarter, but the Wildcats held on to snap Temple's three-game winning streak.

> Rayne Tucker had her best game of the season, setting new season highs in points (19), rebounds (13), and assists (5). Her five assists are also a new career high. Tiarra East led the team in scoring with 20 and set a season-high in rebounds (7).

> Temple grabbed 27 offensive rebounds, its most in a game since 2014.

SCOUTING UTSA

- > UTSA spent last season in Conference USA where the team earned a 13-19 overall, and 9-11 in conference record.
- > The Roadrunners concluded non-conference play with a 6-5 record. Of their five losses, four came against high-profile opponents, including Arizona State, Texas Tech, Houston, and Oregon.
- > A trio of Roadrunners are averaging double-figures in Sidney Love (12.2 ppg), Kyra White (10.6 ppg), and Elyssa Coleman (10.3 ppg). Coleman also leads the team in rebounds with 7.4 per contest. Love, Aysia Proctor, and White have been recognized on the AAC Honor Roll this season. Idara Udo was named AAC Rookie of the Week on Tuesday following a 15 point, nine-rebound performance.
- > Karen Aston is in her 16th season as a Division I women's basketball coach and her 3rd at UTSA. She has made stops at current AAC rivals Charlotte and North Texas before landing at Texas, where she coached for eight years. She is 311-193 in her career and 26-47 at UTSA.

OWLS FROM DEEEEP

- > Temple had a tremedous day from beyond the arc against Delaware on December 14.
- > Temple shot 8-14 from deep (.571), it's best three point shooting day since Bucknell last season. Aleah Nelson went 5-6 from deep, the best single game three point shooting performance since Kristen McCarthy went 5-5 vs Richmond on 1/29/2011.

A BIG TIME CLASS IN '24

- > Coach Rich and Temple added three signees to the class of 2024 on National Signing Day this week. Kelain Cedano, Savvanah Curry, and Adena Webster.
- > Massachutes native Cedano played at a nationally ranked high school and held offers from several ACC and BIG EAST programs alongside AAC Champion ECU.
- > Curry is a Pennsylvania high school star and state champion. She was ranked No. 37 nationally by Blue Star Basketball.
- > Adena Webster hails from the Bahamas, and ranked second in scoring among juniors last season (34.5 ppg).

SOMETHING IN THE WATER

> The DMV (DC, Maryland, Virginia) is well known for having some of the best high school basketball in the nation, with Maryland having the highest percentage of D1 basketball players in the nation (5% of high school seniors in 2017).

> Temple has deep Maryland roots, with four players hailing from the state (Nelson, Tucker, Waleed, and Williams). Additionally, Coach Rich herself is a Maryland native, with all three assistants and several members of the support staff also having ties to the region.

> Despite originating in North Carolina, both Drew Alexander and Demi Washington attended high school in Maryland.

NEWS AND NOTES

OPENING WITH A (HISTORIC) BANG

- > The Owls throttled Delaware State by a margin of 66 points, the largest margin of victory in program history.
- > Temple absolutely dominated the first quarter, jumping out to a 30-6 lead. The 26-point first quarter margin is the most of a Temple team since NCAA women's basketball began using quarters in the 2015-16 season. This was the first time Temple has scored 30 points in the first quarter of a game since 11/5/17 against the University of Charleston.
- > 109 points is the second most points scored in program history, while 43 field goals are the second most fields goal made in program history. Both second only to 1/17/83 against La Salle.
- > Eight Owls (Jaleesa Molina, Ines Piper, Tiarra East, Tarriyonna Gary, Aleah Nelson, Rayne Tucker, Demi Washington, and Kendall Currence) scored in double-figures setting a new program best.
- > This was the first time Temple has scored 100 points in a game since 2015, also against Delaware State.

> Temple's +24 rebound margin is the best since the Owls faced off against Sacred Heart on 12/9/15 (+26). 12 three pointers are also the most Temple has hit since the Owls knocked down 12 from downtown in the same game.

THE G8 EIGHT

- > Jaleesa Molina is believed to be the first number 8 in Temple women's basketball history.
- > The NCAA changed the rules in the offseason to allow basketball players to wear numbers higher than 5.

YEAR TWO OF COACH RICH

> This season will be the second of the Diane Richardson era on North Broad.
> In her second season at Towson, Coach Rich took a monumental leap recording only the second 20 win season in Tigers program history at the time and qualifying for the only NCAA Tournament in the history of Towson women's basketball/

ALEAH NELSON RUNS IN BACK

> Star point guard Aleah Nelson is returning to Temple for a 5th season after a stellar senior campaign. The Baltimore native was named First-Team All Big 5 and Second-Team All-AAC.

> Last season, Nelson scored her 1000th point against Duquesne in December. She scored 33 points in that game, tied for the 15th most in a single-game in Temple history.

TECHICALLY DEBUTING

> Possibly the two "newcomers" that will make the greatest impact on the Cherry & White this season are players that were already on the roster last season in guard Kendall Currence and center/forward Rayne Tucker.

> Currence was a 1000 point scorer at Northeastern where she faced off against Coach Rich, Nelson, and company as a conference foe. Currence was voted 2022 All-CAA after averaging a team-high 15.9 points. She sat out all of last season after tearing her ACL in preseason.

> Tucker played for Richardson at Towson where she started 18 games and averaged 5.4 rebounds per contest. She was named 3rd team All-CAA in 2021 at James Madison.

NEWS AND NOTES

WISE OWLS

> Temple has seven players listed as a senior/5th/grad student, including five in their final season of eligibility (Currence, Nelson, Solis, Tucker, and Washington).

> Of the five players in their final campaign, only two (Nelson and Solis) saw action for the Cherry & White.

REFRESHING TO HAVE FRESHMEN

- > This season, Temple has five freshmen, tied with Memphis for the most in the conference. This means the Temple has both one of the oldest, and youngest rosters in the American this season.
- > Last season, Temple housed just one freshman on the roster (Kourtney Wilson). Wilson left the team on her own terms in January after playing only four games.

WNBA CONNECTIONS

> The Owls' program is briming with WNBA connections at every level.

> Alumnus Shey Peddy has spent the last four seasons with the Phoenix Mercury, including playing a key role in the 2021 WNBA Finals run.

 > Former MVP and WNBA superstar Jonquel Jones of the New York Liberty is the daughter of Coach Richardson. Jones and the Liberty faced the Las Vegas Aces in the WNBA finals, Coach Richardson attended several games including the WNBA Finals.
 > 2021 WNBA Finals MVP Kahleah Copper is a friend of the program. Despite not attending the school, Copper grew up a Temple fan in North Philadelphia and has attended several Temple events in the last 18 months.

CROSSING THE POND

- > Temple has two European imports on the roster in forwards Jaleesa Molina and Ines Piper.
- > Piper had a solid first season for the Owls in 2022-23. Molina arrives to Temple after playing several high level seasons in her native Netherlands. She represented the Orange Lions on the international stage at the FIBA U-20 championships where she helped the squad win bronze.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY OFFENSE

> The hallmark of a Coach Rich led team is her "equal opportunity offense."

> We have already seen a marked difference between this season and last in terms of scoring distribution. Last season, the vast majority of Temple's scoring production came from three players, East, Gary, and Nelson. This season, eight players have hit double figures already.

> In the equal opportunity offense, everybody gets and touch and everyone shoots. Richardson's teams have regularly scored in the high 70s and low 80s during her time at Towson.

THE CAPTAINS

> Tiarra East, Aleah Nelson, and Demi Washington were named team captains on the first day of practice. All three come different backgrounds in terms of their path to Temple and Coach Rich.

> East is the only career Temple player of the three. She arrived to North Broad in 2021-22 under Coach Tonya Cardoza.

> This will be the fourth season Nelson has spent under Richardson and her second as a captain. She followed Richardson to Temple from Towson last season.

> Washington arrived this summer at The Nest after spending four seasons at

Vanderbilt. She is one two first year captains under Coach Richardson, with the other being Nelson.

TEMPLE TIGERS

> In addition to Richardson, the Owls have several connections to Towson throughout the program.

> Two of the three assistants on the Temple staff coached under Richardson in the Baltimore area. Cheyenne Curley was on the Towson staff for five years as Director of Basketball Operations before being elevated to an assistant in 2019. Myles Jackson took the same route, starting as Assistant Director of Operations before becoming an assistant in 2021-22.

> On the support staff side, Director of Basketball Operations Jasmine Allen comes to Temple after filling the same role at Towson. Assistant Director of Basketball Ops Shelby Bailey-Smiley was a student manager at Towson last season while Video Coordinator Aaron Thomas previously held the role at Towson.

> On the court, Aleah Nelson, Rayne Tucker, and Tarriyonna Gary all played at Temple last season under Richardson.

The Temple women's basketball team has 11 active players in professional basketball leagues around the world and one alumnae who is coaching in the largest basketball league in the world, the NBA. While Shey "Playoff P" Peddy is the only player currently in the WNBA, several players are among the best in their respective leagues, including 2023 Mexican League champion Tanaya Atkinson.

One of the most interesting stories among Temple's professional alumnae is Candice Dupree, one of only six active women on NBA staffs. Dupree was hired as a player development coach in 2022 following a stellar playing career. After being sixth overall in the 2006 WNBA draft, Dupree was a 7-time WNBA All-Star and 2014 WNBA Champion with the Pheonix Mercury. The 2016 Temple Hall of Fame inductee is a two time FIBA World Cup Champion.

DIANE RICHARDSON

Diane Richardson was named the 21st head women's basketball coach of Temple University on April 5, 2022.

Richardson, who led Towson to more postseason appearances (2) in her five years at the helm than in the program's previous 49 seasons of existence (1), owns an 80-66 overall head coaching record at Towson. In 2021-22, she led Towson to a school record 24 wins and only its second berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT).

In 2018-19, her second season as Towson's head coach, Richardson led the Tigers to the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament Championship and the program's first NCAA Tournament berth in program history. Towson finished that season with a 20-13 overall record, marking just the second 20win season in program history.

Under Richardson, Towson's Kionna Jeter became the first player in program history to be selected in the WNBA Draft when she was drafted in the third round of the 2021 draft. Jeter enjoyed sustained success under Richardson's guidance as she was also the first player in program history to earn three consecutive All-CAA first team selections.

Before Towson, Richardson worked as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at West Virginia University (2016-17) following coaching stints at George Washington University (2012-16), the University of Maryland (2007-08), and American University (2006-07). As the recruiting coordinator at West Virginia, Richardson led the efforts which helped the Mountaineers' 2017 recruiting class being ranked No. 17 by ESPNW.

At Maryland, she helped lead the Terrapins to a 33-4 record and a number one seed in the NCAA Tournament. In eight years of head coaching experience at the high school level, Richardson led Riverdale Baptist High School in Upper Marlboro, Md. to five National Championships and was ranked in USA Today's Top 10 in five of her eight years. Richardson was named the National High School Coach of the Year in 2005 and coached a host of talented players including Temple alum Tyonna Williams, a 1,000-point career scorer.

From 2009-2016, Richardson coached WNBA All-Star Jonquel Jones at Riverdale Baptist (2009-12) and again at George Washington (2012-16). Jones was selected sixth overall in the 2016 WNBA Draft after being one of the most decorated players in George Washington's history.

Richardson's path to coaching was a unique one. A highly successful businesswoman who was named one of the top female executives in the country in 1995, Richardson, who at the time was the Founder and COO of American Security Corporation, decided to walk away from corporate America to pursue her passion for mentoring young women through coaching basketball.

Richardson earned her master's degree in management from Central Michigan in 1984 and holds a bachelor's degree in psychology and sociology from Frostburg State. As the 1979 NCAA Regional Champion in the 200and 400-meter races, she earned a spot on the 1980 U.S. Olympic team.

Richardson and her husband, Larry, have four children – Dana, Larry "Donnie" II, Jonquel and Michael.
