STARTING FIVE

1 OPENING TIP: Wichita State continues its Texas road trip in San Antonio, taking on UTSA on Jan. 6 at 2 p.m. in the Convocation Center. The Shockers seek their first road win of the season as they are currently 0-4 in true road games. The teams meet for the 7th time and first since 2012 with Wichita State leading 5-1. The Shockers have won the last three straight against the Roadrunners, most recently claiming a 50-36 win on Nov. 18, 2012 in Charles Koch Arena.

2 LAST TIME OUT: Turnovers troubled Wichita State as the Shockers fell 76-64 to Rice Wednesday evening in the Fertitta Center. The Shockers committed 24 turnovers in their first American Athletic Conference loss of the season, while Rice opened their conference slate with a win. Tre'Zure Jobe recorded her first career double-double, finishing with 13 points and 10 rebounds, while Salese Blow led the Shockers in scoring, tying for a game-high 16 points in her third career start. Daniela Abies also finished in double figures for the ninth time this year, tallying 14 points and nine rebounds. Five Owls finished in double figures, led by Dominique Ennis with a game-high 17 points. The Shockers were only down three at halftime after going on a 10-2 run to close the gap on an 11-point deficit to finish the second quarter. Wichita State came out swinging in the second half, scoring the first five points to take a two-point lead, but its third quarter woes returned as the Owls scored 12 points off eight turnovers, outscoring the Shockers 20-13 to go into the fourth quarter with a 10-point lead. Turnovers continued to plague the Shockers in the fourth quarter as Rice's lead didn't drop below nine despite an eight-point effort by Blow in the final period.

3 STATISTICALLY SPEAKING: Wichita State ranks in the top 100 nationally in the following categories: No. 33 in three-point percentage defense (25.9), No. 37 in free throw attempts per game (20.9), and No. 95 in free throws made per game (13.2).

The Shockers are ranked second in the American Athletic Conference in free throw attempts per game and fourth in three-point percentage defense.

4 SCOUTING THE ROADRUNNERS: Led by 16th-year head coach Karen Aston (third at UTSA), UTSA (6-7, 0-2 AAC) is coming off two AAC road losses to Temple, 58-71, and East Carolina, 54-82). Terry Nooner coached under Aston at Texas during the 2019-20 season. The Longhorns were 19-11 before the season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Roadrunners are 2-2 at home with their wins coming against New Mexico State and UTEP. Two Roadrunners are averaging double-digit scoring with Sidney Love leading the team with 10.9 points per game and Elyssa Coleman averaging 10.4. Idaro Udo was named AAC Freshman of the Week on Dec. 26 following her 15 points and nine rebounds off the bench in UTSA's win over Seattle U. Sydney Love, Aysia Proctor and Kyra White have also landed on the AAC Honor Roll this season. Elyssa Coleman leads the conference and ranks 55th in the nation in blocks per game with 1.7. Kyra White ranks in the top 100 in the nation in assists and assists per game. UTSA was picked eighth of 14 teams in the American Athletic Conference preseason poll and currently sits in 13th at 4-9 (0-2 AAC).

5 LEADING LADIES: Four Shockers are averaging double-digit scoring with Jobe leading the team with 12.6 points per game and Morrow averaging 12.2, Daniela Abies averaging 12.0 and Salese Blow averaging 10.4. Abies is the team's leading rebounder, averaging 7.1 rebounds per game with one double-double (18 pts, 11 reb) against Akron. Morrow is also recording 4.8 rebounds per game. Abies has finished in double figures in nine of 14 games with three 18-point games and a career-high 19 against Oral Roberts.

NATIONAL TRE'ZURE

Jobe has started all 125 games of her collegiate career, including her five years at Emporia State.

Tre'Zure Jobe had her best game of the season in the conference opener against Tulane, recording 21 points, 8 assists and 2 steals and being named American Athletic Conference Player of the Week. She recorded her first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

Jobe is ranked 120th in the nation, fourth in the conference in steals with 26 and 137th in the nation, fourth in the conference in steals per game with 2.0.

SIERRA SNIPER

Sierra Morrow became the first Shocker since 2004 to shoot 100% from three with a minimum of four attempts, shooting 5-for-5 in her career game against Oral Roberts

LONG-AWAITED DEBUT

Senior transfer from Miami (OH), Sierra Morrow, made her long-awaited Shocker debut against Kansas after her NCAA transfer waiver was finally approved. She tied for a team-high 12 points and grabbed a team-high six rebounds off the bench. In her third game of the season, Morrow scored a career-high 29 points against Oral Roberts to land herself on the AAC Weekly Honor Roll.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Wichita State faced three first-time foes in the non-conference docket, Presbyterian, Belmont and Dayton. The Shockers opened their season against No. 23 Oklahoma. Belmont (MVC) and Southeastern Louisiana (Southland) were picked to win their respective leagues. The Shockers' play two games against teams that finished inside the Top 50 of last year's NCAA NET Rankings (Kansas - 30 and Oklahoma - 38).

#MOREBOBO

Freshman Salese Blow (@BoboDaShow) claimed the American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Week award on Nov. 27 following her 19 points in the win over Omaha and career-high 20 points against Dayton, leading the team in scoring in both contests. She went on to tie for a team-high 18 points against Missouri State. Blow has scored in double figures four times with a career-high 20 points against Dayton and got her first collegiate start at Belmont. She has led the team in scoring in four games, most recently scoring 16 points at Rice.

RUNS IN THE FAMILY

Salese Blow's mom, Stacie (formerly Tave) played at Arizona in 1993 and 94, leading the team in field goals made in 1994 with 27 and free throws made both years with 25 and 27. She is tied for the Wildcats' single-game steals record with 9. Salese currently ties for the Shocker lead in free throws made with 36.

QUEEN OF THE COURT

After each win, one Shocker is crowned player of the game in the locker room. Ornella Niankan, Daniela Abies and Tre'Zure Jobe have all been crowned this season.

SHOCKERS SIGN THREE GUARDS

Nooner announced the signing of guards, Princess Anderson, Kyleigh Ortiz and Kileyah Parr to National Letters of Intent on Nov. 8. Anderson and Ortiz will be junior college transfers, and Parr is the lone high school signee, Nooner's first high school commit as a head coach.

HOMETOWN HEROES

Wichita native, **Tre'Zure Jobe**, a two-time NCAA Division II All-American who scored over 2,000 points in her career at Emporia State, joins the Shockers for her final year of eligibility, and **Ella Anciaux** returns for her junior season after a summer of much improvement and development.

ROSTER RETENTION

First-year head coach Terry Nooner retained nine of 13 potential returners from 2022-23, including the lone returning starter, **DJ McCarty**, the Shockers' assists and steals leader from 2022-23. He also maintained the commitment of Salese Blow, who signed with the Shockers prior to Nooner's appointment.

Wichita State returns just 34.7 percent of its scoring from a season ago, having lost its top two leading scorers and three other triple-digit point scorers. Trajata Colbert and Curtessia Dean exhausted their eligibility, and three of the top six scorers departed through the transfer portal.

AROUND THE WORLD

► The Shockers' roster features international athletes from four different countries, including Canada (Ornella Niankan and Raissa Nsabua), Mozambique (Carla Budane), Australia (Ambah Kowcun) and Spain (Daniela Abies).

Wichita State also represents seven U.S. states with two Wichita natives, Ella Anciaux and Tre'Zure Jobe.

JUCO PRODUCTS

Redshirt-sophomore forward **Jayla Murray** joins **Ambah Kowcun**, **Ornella Niankan**, **Raissa Nsabua** and **Jeniah Thompson** to make five junior college transfers on the Shockers' roster. Murray brings a season and a half of experience from Florida SouthWestern State, where she was the 2022 Southern Conference Player of the Year and earned third team NJCAA All-America recognition.

HALL OF FAMER

► Shocker legend, Alex Harden, has officially been selected as a member of the 2024 Class of the Wichita State Pizza Hut Shocker Sports Hall of Fame. Harden is Wichita State's all-time leading scorer with 1,708 points, an honorable mention All-American and the 2015 MVC Player of the Year. She will be inducted on Jan. 27.

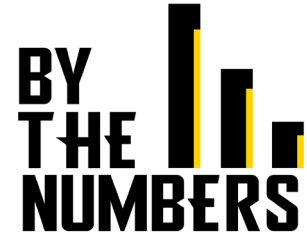

Terry Nooner was named the 10th head women's basketball coach on April 17, 2023.

"To say this is a dream come true is an understatement," Nooner said. "As someone who played in Kansas, met my wife here and have raised my children here, I couldn't be happier to land my first head coaching position in the state I love so much. My family and I are incredibly excited to join Shocker Nation and make Wichita our home for years to come. I can't thank Kevin Saal and Dr. Muma enough for their belief and support, and I'm ready to build something special with our women's basketball program."

Nooner has a decade's worth of coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently as an associate head coach at the University of Kansas. Nooner was an integral part of Kansas' recent run to the 2023 WNIT title.

It's no coincidence that the last two NCAA Tournament appearances for Kansas have come with Nooner on staff.

In addition to his time at Kansas, he has coached at Texas, Maryland, Alabama and Southern Illinois along with one season as a player development coach with the Cleveland Cavaliers.

His third season at Kansas marked his second stint as an assistant at Kansas after spending the 2012-13 campaign with the Jayhawks. In his return to Kansas, Nooner assisted head coach Brandon Schneider – the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year – during the Jayhawks breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. The Jayhawks finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2010-11, and the Jayhawks had 20 wins during the regular season

for the first time since 1999-2000. Kansas capped off the season with a berth in the 2022 NCAA Tournament, where KU earned the No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional.

"Terry Nooner is a highly respected leader with a proven track record of success," Saal said. "As a result of his impressive journey, Terry is incredibly well-connected within our region and nationally. We are excited to welcome Terry, his wife Tracy and the Nooner family into the Shocker family."

Nooner was a big reason for the emergence of Kansas post player Taiyanna Jackson over the past two seasons. Jackson burst onto the scene as a junior college transfer, leading the Big 12 and ranking fourth in the Big 12 with a single-season school record 95 blocked shots. For her efforts, Jackson became the first Jayhawk in program history to be selected to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team.

Before returning to Lawrence, Nooner spent the 2019-20 season as an assistant coach at Texas, working heavily with players at the post position. He coached a pair of All-Big 12 selections and one WNBA draft pick while on the Forty Acres and UT earned three wins against Top 25 opponents that season.

Nooner joined the Longhorns from the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers, where he spent the 2018-19 season as Player Development Coach.

Prior to his time with the Cavaliers, Nooner served three seasons as an assistant coach for the University of Maryland women's basketball team. He helped the Terrapins to a record of 89-14 [.864], including a 43-7 [.860] mark in Big Ten Conference play. During his stint in College Park, Maryland won back-to-back Big Ten regular season and tournament titles and earned three NCAA Tournament berths. While at Maryland, Nooner helped recruit the nation's No. 1 class in 2016 and the fourth-ranked class in 2018.

Nooner was an assistant coach at the University of Alabama for two seasons from 2013-15. In his first season in Tuscaloosa, the Crimson Tide won 14 games, playing one of the most difficult schedules in the nation. Seven of those victories came in Southeastern Conference play, which were the most league wins for the Tide in more than 12 years.

Nooner spent one season at his alma mater, the University of Kansas, as an assistant coach with the women's basketball team. He helped the Jayhawks to one of their most successful seasons, as Kansas finished with 20 wins in 2012-13. Kansas advanced to the fourth NCAA Sweet 16 in program history.

Nooner began his collegiate coaching career as an

assistant coach at Southern Illinois in 2011-12. During that season, he worked with Cartaesha Macklin, who was named Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Year.

Nooner, a Raytown, Mo., native, was a former guard and team captain for the University of Kansas from 1997-2000. He helped the Jayhawks to a Sweet Sixteen, four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Big 12 Championships.

He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in African-American Studies from the University of Kansas in 2000. In 2002, he earned his Master's degree in Sport Administration from Kansas.

Nooner and his wife Tracy have three children.
