Please refrain from using UT-San Antonio, Texas-San Antonio, UT-SA, Lady Roadrunners or any other variation.

MEDIA COVERAGE

The UTSA Athletics Communications Office assists members of the media with their coverage of all Roadrunners sports by providing player and coach interviews, feature ideas and updated statistics. In addition to the 2023 media guide, media members may check UTSA's official athletics website – **goUTSA.com** – for the latest information on all the department's 17 sports.

INTERVIEWS

All interviews with coaches and student-athletes must be arranged at least 24 hours in advance through soccer contact **Michael Stambaugh**. Telephone interviews are available to the media on a "call-back" basis at a time that is convenient for the coach or student-athlete. Post-game interviews with coaches and student-athletes will be conducted on the field following a 10-minute "cooling off" period.

MEDIA SERVICES

Media members are encouraged to contact the UTSA Athletics Communications Office with credential requests at least 24 hours before a home game. Credentials can be picked up with proper photo identification at the Park West press box. Complimentary wireless Internet access for radio, SIDs and members of the print media are available along press row.

PRACTICES

UTSA welcomes all media to attend soccer practices during the season with 24 hours notice to the athletics communications office. In most cases, coaches and student-athletes are available after practice. Pre-game practices are closed to the media.

BROADCASTS

All of UTSA's regular-season home games are slated to stream live (subscription required) on ESPN+ this season, while any games selected for linear television will be announced in a timely fashion on both **goUTSA.com** and via press release.
