- The Roadrunners (12-10, 6-5 The American) are fresh off a 76-58 victory over a first-place UAB squad.
- · Newcomer Aysia Proctor's 14-point, seven-rebound performance earned her the AAC Freshman of the Week accolade for the second time this season.
- The Golden Hurricane (17-7, 7-4 The American) are tied for fourth in the tightly contested AAC standings, and UTSA is a game behind in
- · Tulsa fell victim to a potent Rice squad last time out, suffering a 78-66 defeat at the Tudor Fieldhouse in Houston.
- · Nobody in The American takes more shots from beyond the arc than the Golden Hurricane, as 25.7 attempts sit 18th nationally. 8.2 makes per game is second in the league.
- · Tulsa also ranks just behind UTSA in defensive rebounds per game with 29.2 and field goal defense, as opponents only hit 36.9% of their
- · The squad boasts two of the conference's best in Temira Poindexter and Delanie Crawford. Poindexter leads the AAC in shots made, sinking 177 on the season for the 22nd-most in the NCAA, and her 428 attempts are the ninth-greatest in the country.
- · She averages 20.4 ppg, which ranks 16th nationally, and Crawford is not far behind scoring 18.7 ppg.
- · Crawford represents The American's thirdmost efficient three-point shooter, making 40.4% of her shots from beyond the arc and 2.71 triples a game sit second.
- She also paces the Golden Hurricane with 64 assists and 28 steals tie Mady Cartwright for the most on the squad.
- · Defensively, Poindexter logs 32 blocks and Hadley Periman 31, while Periman snags 6.9

ROADRUNNER NOTES AND NEWS

LAST TIME OUT

- The Roadrunners (12-10, 6-5 The American) are fresh off a 76-58 victory over a first-place UAB squad.
- Newcomer Aysia Proctor's 14-point, seven-rebound performance earned her the AAC Freshman of the Week accolade for the second time this season.
- She led the contest in scoring, going 6-for-9 from the field, including 2-for-4 from beyond the arc, and tied fellow freshman Idara Udo with a team-high seven rebounds.
- Senior Kyra White, sophomore Sidney Love, and senior Jordyn Jenkins joined Proctor in the double-digit scoring club, as White charted 12 while Love and Jenkins each logged 11.

'RUNNERS IN THE RANKINGS

- As of 2/11 UTSA is leading The American and ranking inside the top 25 nationally in five different statistics, including a 46.3 rebounds per game figure that's sixth in the NCAA.
- 16.5 offensive boards per game sit eighth, and 29.7 defensive are 14th, while a plus-11.1 rebounds margin ranks eighth as well.
- Defensively, the Runners keep their opponents to a 36.3% shooting clip, the 20th-best in the country, and 4.9 blocks per game sit 22nd.
- Redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman has played a significant role in the Roadrunner's success, logging 1.62 bpg for the second-most in the AAC.

Senior Kyra White, meanwhile, logs 5.0 apg, the second-highest total in the league, and her 1.54 assists/turnover ratio is fifth.

• Additionally, she plays 34.8 minutes, a figure that ranks second, and freshman Idara Udo's 3.7 offensive rebounds per game are fourth.

- On 2/12 the American Athletic Conference announced its weekly awards, selecting Aysia Proctor as the league's Freshman of the Week for the second time this season.
- Proctor was issued the accolade after propelling the Roadrunners to a 76-58 victory over a first-place UAB squad on Sunday.
- She led the contest with 14 points, going 6-for-9 from the field, including 2-for-4 from beyond the arc, while collecting seven rebounds and two assists.
- She last was awarded on Jan. 22, following a week that saw her work 14.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg, two blocks, and an assist across contests with South Florida and UAB.
- This marks the first occasion since the 2019-20 campaign in which a UTSA student-athlete claimed multiple iterations of the award, as Mikayla Woods did so three times in Conference-USA.

THE UNDERDOGS

- On 2/11 The UTSA women's basketball team took down the American Athletic Conference's leader on Sunday, as they bested UAB, 76-58, inside the Convocation Center.
- The win represented the third occasion of the 2023-24 season in which the 'Runners dethroned the league's top team, this time doing it behind a quartet of double-digit scorers.
- The 'Runners bested the Blazers after sinking 32 shots at a 45% clip.
 UTSA also pulled down 13 more rebounds than their opponent, scored 22 more points in the paint, and recorded twice as many assists.
- Freshman Aysia Proctor led the contest in scoring, dropping 14, while senior Kyra White logged 12 points.
- Sophomore Sidney Love put up 11, and senior Jordyn Jenkins matched her total and collected six rebounds in her season debut.
- Additionally, Proctor tied freshman Idara Udo with a team-leading seven rebounds, and Love topped the contest with six assists.

ON THE DOUBLE

- Sophomore Maya Linton recorded UTSA's first double-double of the season on Nov. 18, 2023 against UTA, and freshman Aysia Proctor the second on Dec. 17
- •Redshirt junior Elyssa Colman accomplished the feat on Jan. 6 against Wichita State, before doing it again on Jan. 10 against FAU and on Feb. 4 against Tulane
- Proctor secured her second double-double of the campaign on Jan.
- 14 in a matchup with Charlotte
- •Senior Kyra White logged her first double-double of the season on Jan. 21 in a contest against UAB
- Freshman Idara Udo launched the first double-double of her collegiate career on 1/31 in an overtime win over North Texas
- Linton scored a career-high 15 points to go along with 10 rebounds in a 70-66 victory over the Lady Mavs
- Proctor charted a career-best 20 points to go with 11 rebounds in a 61-48 loss to Oregon in Eugene
- Coleman was incredible against the Shockers, logging a career-high 32 points and a whopping 19 rebounds

- •She then accomplished the feat in her second consecutive contest, scoring 16 point with 10 rebounds against FAU
- Proctor recorded her second double-double of the campaign as she scored 17 points to go with 13 rebounds in a double-overtime win against the 49ers.
- White scored 11 points to go with 10 rebounds in a tough 54-53 loss at the hands of the Blazers
- Udo issued 14 points and 12 rebounds across a 75-67, overtime victory over the Mean Green
- Coleman recorded her third double-double of the season against the Green Wave, scoring 21 points to go with 12 rebounds

ON THE GLASS

- Entering the month of February, the Roadrunners ranked third across the NCAA with 46.7 rebounds per game
- The Roadrunners have led the AAC in boards since opening the 2024 season
- Redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman leads the team with 7.8 rpg, while freshman Idara Udo collects 6.4 rpg and senior Kyra White 5.9.

A GRAND OLE TIME

- On 1/31, graduate student Hailey Atwood scored five points in a 75-67 win over North Texas, allowing her to surpass the 1,000 point threshold
- She scored 309 points as a freshman at Blinn College and 444 as a sophomore
- •Entering UTSA as a junior, she had recorded 753 points and has since logged 250, for 1,003 across her collegiate career

TO BE THE BEST YOU HAVE TO BEAT THE BEST

- On 1/31, UTSA took down a first-place North Texas squad, 75-67 in an overtime thriller
- •The win marked the second occasion of the year in which UTSA bested the team atop The American, after the Roadrunners downed Charlotte, 81-80, with a game-winning putback by freshman Idara Udo in double-overtime
- Defensively, UTSA was stellar against the Mean Green, holding the nation's 15th-most efficient shooting team to a 29% clip, 18% under their 47.6% average. The Roadrunners collected 11 more rebounds than the opposition and performed better at the charity stripe, sinking 79% of their freebies to UNT's 68%.
- The UTSA forwards were phenomenal across the contest, with Udo scoring 14 points and logging 12 rebounds, while redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman scored nine points with nine boards and four blocks.
- Sophomore Sidney Love and freshman Aysia Proctor joined Udo in the double-digit scoring club, as Love charted 13 and Proctor 11.
- Senior Kyra White was also solid, scoring seven points to go with six assists and four rebounds.

JOINING THE CLUB

- Following a six rebound performance against SMU, redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman has joined UTSA's 500-rebound club
- Coleman becomes the 16th Roadrunner to ever accomplish the feat, and the first since Marie Benson did so in the 2019 season
- It took her 81 games to join the club, as she logged 146 rebounds as a freshman, 212 as a sophomore, and through 18 games, 142 across her junior year

NEWCOMERS? NO PROBLEM.

- Newcomer Aysia Proctor became the second Roadrunner to win AAC Freshman of the Week in the 2024 season on Jan. 22
- Proctor shot the basketball extremely well across the week.
- She scored 19 points with eight rebounds in a 65-42 victory over defending champions South Florida before dropping nine and eight rebounds against UAB. She went 10-for-24 from the field, including 5-for-10 from beyond the arc, working 14.0 ppg and 8.0 rpg to go along with two blocks and an assist.
- Idara Udo claimed the accolade earlier in the year, doing so on Dec. 3
- •This marks the first occasion in which multiple UTSA freshmen have been honored by a league office since the 2019-20 campaign as Mikayla Woods and Adryana Quezada both accomplished the feat in Conference-USA.

GOING STREAKING

- After falling to Temple and East Carolina, UTSA sparked a four-game winning streak, taking down some of The American's top teams
- UTSA first bested Wichita State, 74-60 for their inaugural AAC victory, with redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman dominating to the tune of 32 points and 19 rebounds.
- They then visited Boca Raton and bested FAU, 73-60, before topping a Charlotte team that sat atop the league standings 81-80 in a double-overtime showdown at the Convo.
- Two days later, UTSA was back in action, hosting the AAC's 2023 Regular Season Champions in South Florida with Senior Kyra White's career-high 23 points leading to a 65-42 win

SHE'S ON A ROLL

- Senior Kyra White, sophomore Sidney Love, freshman Aysia Proctor, redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman and freshman Idara Udo have now each been selected for The American's Weekly Honor Roll
- White was recognized on 11/20 after delivering a pair of solid performances in road victories against TAMUCC and UT Arlington.
- First, White dropped 18 points to go with six rebounds and five assists while propelling the squad to a 15-point come-from-behind victory over the Islanders.
- Later in the week, she added five more points to her total, hauling in six boards and dishing off six assists in a 70-66 win against UTA
- On the week, she swatted a shot and swiped a steal, all while averaging the most assists per game in the league at 5.50.
- Love was chosen on 11/27 after leading the Roadrunners in scoring on the week, first dropping 18 points at a .500 clip against Texas Tech.
- She then scored 12 more in a victory over Sam Houston, allowing her to average 15.0 ppg, to go along with 10 rebounds, and two assists.
- Love shot an efficient 47.6% and went 8-for-9 from the charity stripe.
- Defensively, she boasted a block and swiped five steals.
- •Proctor was selected on 12/18 after averaging 19.5 ppg to go with 8.0 rpg after coming off the bench against Houston and Oregon .
- •She first went 9-for-11 from the field for 19 points and five rebounds against the Cougars before logging a career-high 20 points and 11 rebounds against the Ducks on the road.
- Her double-double in the matchup with Oregon represented the first of her collegiate career.
- •Coleman was awarded on 12/26 after posting 18 points and nine rebounds in a 75-64 victory over Seattle U and against on 1/6 after averaging 21.5 ppg and 11.5 rpg across contests against ECU and WSU
- Udo was selected on Jan. 15 after collecting seven rebounds with four assists and four points against Florida Atlantic, and recording a double-overtime game-winner against Charlotte.
- Following a 49er three-pointer with 13 seconds on the clock, Udo hauled in an offensive rebound and got a second-chance layup to fall, handing UTSA the lead with 1.8 seconds remaining in the period.
- She scored a career-high 26 points in the win, with nine rebounds, three blocks and a steal.
- On the week, Udo averaged 15 ppg at a 55% clip, with eight rpg, five blocks, a steal, and four assists.

DOWN GOES CHARLOTTE

- On Jan. 14, UTSA secured their third straight victory, with a freshman Idara Udo putback with 1.8 seconds remaining in double-overtime allowing UTSA to top Charlotte, 81-80.
- UTSA dealt Charlotte their first AAC loss of the season, knocking the 49ers off the top of the standings with the victory
- Udo dropped a career-high 26 points in the effort, shooting 69% from the field and collecting nine rebounds with three blocks to work her way onto the AAC Weekly Honor Roll.
- Newcomer Aysia Proctor was also excellent, logging a game-high 13 rebounds to go with 17 points, while senior Kyra White finished just shy of a triple-double.
- White scored nine points, hauled in 10 boards, and dished out nine assists in 44 minutes of action.

CROWN HER

- Redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman was phenomenal against Wichita State on Jan. 6, logging a career-high double-double and earning her a spot on the NCAA Starting Five for the week
- She scored 32 points at a 70% clip while hauling in 19 rebounds
- Coleman became the first member of the squad to record at least 19 rebounds since 2016, tying her for the fifth-best single-game performance in school history.
- Her 32 points are also tied for the 10th-best single-game performance in the program's history.
- As of 1/6, she's been the AAC's leader in blocks with 25, helping UTSA to the 22nd highest blocks per game total in the NCAA (5.1 bpg), and is the Roadrunner's top rebounder, with 7.9 rpg, propelling UTSA to the 11th-best rebounds per game average in the NCAA (46.0 rpg).
- Coleman also serves as UTSA's all-time blocking leader, swatting 120 shots across her career.

FIRST OF MANY

- On Jan. 6, 2024, UTSA won it's first ever American Athletic Conference contest, routing Wichita State 74-60 inside of the Convocation Center
- •Redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman propelled the squad to victory with 32 points and 19 rebounds, while sophomore Sidney Love scored 16 and senior Kyra White 12
- •As a team, UTSA recorded 12 more rebounds than the opposition, helping achieve 24 second-chance points and 36 points in the paint.

FRESHMAN PHENOM

- The American recognized Idara Udo on 12/26/23, selecting the Plano, Texas native as their Freshman of the Week after she delivered a solid shift off the bench in a 75-64 victory over Seattle U.
- Udo helped UTSA best the Redhawks to the tune of 15 points, nine rebounds, and two assists while going an incredibly efficient 62.5% from the field.
- The Roadrunners last boasted a Freshman of the Week on Nov. 22, 2021, after Elyssa Coleman claimed the C-USA accolade, dropping 14 points and 12 rebounds across a 66-60 win over UIW.
- Udo's accomplishment marks the first occasion in which a UTSA squad member was honored since joining the AAC.

ENTERING LEAGUE PLAY

- The Roadrunners enter their inaugural American Athletic Conference slate after going 6-5 across the teleconference slate
- UTSA will enter league play with a postie record for the first time since the 2013-14 campaign, when the team went 10-5 before kick-starting the C-USA slate
- The 'Runners bested New Mexico State, Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, UT Arlington, Sam Houston State, UTEP, and Seattle U, while falling to Arizona State, Texas Tech, Texas State, Houston and Oregon
- UTSA went 2-2 inside the Convocation Center, and 4-3 on the road

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR

- The Roadrunners came close to making history on Dec. 14th as they fell to Houston, 66-64
- After trailing by as much as 22 points late in the second quarter a Sidney Love three-pointer put UTSA down two with 12 seconds remaining in the contest
- Houston, however, prevailed and the comeback fell short in what would have represented the largest deficit overcome in school history
- A 22 point comeback would also have tied UTSA for the 13th largest deficit overcome in the history of NCAA Division I Women's Hoops

90'S KIDS

- The Roadrunners scored 90 points on Dec. 3, 2023 in a victory over UTEP, marking the first time a UTSA squad has reached the benchmark since accomplishing the feat since a 97-47 win against Sul Ross State on Nov. 10, 2017
- The 24-point win represents the largest margin of victory in the Karen Aston era at UTSA.
- Redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman was an incredibly efficient 11-for-13, scoring a career-high 23 points and helping the team shoot 58% from the field.
- The squad also sunk eight three-pointers for their highest total of the season.
- •Along with Coleman, sophomore Sidney Love posted 16 points, marking her sixth straight game achieving the feat, while classmate Siena Guttadauro and senior Kyra White each charted 12.

THE QUEEN OF THE COURT

- Redshirt junior Elyssa Coleman became the Roadrunners all-time blocking leader on 11/25/23 after she swatted three shots against Sam Houston
- On that day, she recorded her 106th block wearing a UTSA uniform, allowing her to surpass the previous record of 105 that was held by Whitney Wright who played for the Roadrunners from 2009-2013
- •Coleman's 57 blocks across the 2022-23 campaign helped propel her towards this award and is currently tied with Kim Duncan for the second-best single season mark

WELCOME TO THE BLOCK PARTY

- The Roadrunners recorded the sixth-most blocks per game in the NCAA through the first month of the season, swatting 6.9 shots each time out
- Senior Elyssa Coleman heavily aided that figure, with 16 swats leading the American Athletic Conference and ranking 21st across the NCAA
- Not far behind, freshman Idara Udo ranked third in the American with 12 blocks and senior Kyra White sixth, logging 10.

IT'S A LOVE STORY

- Sidney Love had recorded double-digit scoring performances in seven consecutive contests dating from 11/15/23-12/14/23
- She first scored 10 points in a matchup with Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, before working a career-high 26 points against UT Arlington, dropping 18 on Texas Tech and 12 on Sam Houston
- Love then added 11 against Texas State and 16 against UTEP increasing her streak to six
- The streak concluded with a 13 point performance against Houston on Dec. 14

OFF TO A HOT START

- UTSA opened the season going 3-1 and using wins over New Mexico State, Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, and UT Arlington to capture a three-game winning streak
- The last time the Roadrunners started the season 3-1 against NCAA Division I opponents was the 2012-13 campaign
- That squad earned wins over UTRGV, Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and Austin Peay, while falling to Wichita State en route to a 16-14 overall record with a 10-8 mark in conference play

FABULOUS FRESHMEN

- In their first week of collegiate competition, freshmen Idara Udo and Aysia Proctor delivered stellar performances
- Udo lead the AAC in rebounds per game on the first week of competition after averaging 10 rpg despite coming off the bench.
- She first scored 10 points and hauled nine boards in against Arizona State before snagging 11 rebounds in a win against New Mexico State.
- Additionally, she swiped two steals and swatter four shots, including a last-second block to secure a 58-55 victory over the Aggies.
- Proctor shot 75% from the field, scoring 21 points across the games against Arizona State and New Mexico State. In addition to her offensive success, she swiped a steal and hauled in 12 rebounds off the bench.

RUN IT BACK

- 11 Roadrunners are back in Navy and Orange, as the team graduated Queen Ulabo, Kennedy Harrell, and Deborah Nwakamma
- A star-studded cast returns with Jordyn Jenkins, Hailey Atwood, Kyra White, Sidney Love and Elyssa Coleman all slated to be back in action
- Jenkins represents the reigning C-USA Player and Newcomer of the Year, while Love was an All-Freshman team selection and Coleman an All-Defensive pick
- Rounding out the group, Atwood was crowned the C-USA Scholar Athlete of the Year and White an All-Texas Honorable Mention by Dave Campbell Texas Basketball
- •Other returnees include sophomores Alexis Parker, Siena Guttadauro, Madison Cockrell, and Maya Linton, along with seniors Kyleigh McGuire and Nissa Sam-Grant

ALL ABOARD THE ASTON EXPRESS

- Five newcomers inked with UTSA ahead of the 2023-24 season; two entering the Alamo City via the portal and three true freshmen
- Notably, sophomore Cheyenne Rowe transfered in from James Madison where she was crowned Sun Belt Champion after appearing in 16 games for the Dukes.
- Also transferring into UTSA, junior Sarai Estupiñan has spent time with both St. Mary's (TX) and Tallahassee CC
- Guards Emma Lucio and Aysia Proctor joins as well, along with forward Idara Udo

INTO THE AMERICAN

- The Roadrunners are set to embark on their first season as a member of the American Athletic Conference
- UTSA went 44-107 in the C-USA era, and last won a championship as a member of the Southland
- The 'Runners were the 2002-03 SLC Regular Season Champs, and won the league again in 2008-09
- The program has won two SLC Tournaments in its history, punching its ticket to the NCAA Tournament in 2008 and 2009

Karen Aston, former head coach at Texas, North Texas and Charlotte, was named the 10th head coach in program history on March 29, 2021.

Throughout her first two seasons at UTSA, Aston has compiled a 20-42 record, going 7-23 (3-14, C-USA) in her inaugural year before collecting a 58-57 overtime win over UTEP at the league's postseason tournament.

She then lead the 'Runners to a 13-19 (9-1, C-USA) campaign in the 2022-23. Her squad opened up the C-USA tournament with a thrilling 69-68 win over No. 11 seed Florida Atlantic, before besting No. 3 seed Rice 62-54 to advance to the leagues semifinals were they fell to No. 2 seed Western Kentucky.

Jordyn Jenkins had a fantastic season under Aston's tutelage, taking home 2022-23 C-USA Player of the Year, Newcomer of the Year, and First-Team All-C-USA.

Aston has been consistently recognized as one of the top coaches in the nation. She was one of four finalists for the Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year award in 2017 and was one of 10 semifinalists for the honor in 2018. Aston also earned Big 12 Coach of the Year accolades in 2017.

Aston has a career record of 305-188 [.618] which includes head coaching positions at Charlotte, North Texas and Texas. In her 13 seasons as a head coach, Aston's teams have averaged 22 wins per year and have made a combined 10 postseason appearances.

At the University of Texas, Aston led the Longhorns to a 184-83 [.689] record in eight seasons. In her final seven seasons combined at Texas, Aston's teams averaged 24.6 wins per year, making six NCAA Tournament appearances. From 2015-18, her squads made four consecutive NCAA Sweet 16 showings, marking the first time that had been accomplished at Texas since 1990. Aston also directed the 2015-16 Longhorns to the program's first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 2003.

Aston, who also spent eight years as an assistant and associate head coach at Texas for Naismith Hall of Fame head coach Jody Conradt, stands as Texas' second-winningest coach all-time behind Conradt's 783 victories.

Three of Aston's Texas players [Nneka Enemkpali, Imani McGee-Stafford and Ariel Atkins] were drafted by WNBA teams with McGee-Stafford [10th] and Atkins [7th] being selected as first-round picks. As a starter, Atkins helped lead the Washington Mystics to the 2019 WNBA Championship and has earned WNBA All-Defensive Team honors in each of her two seasons.

Defense has been a staple of Aston's teams her entire coaching career. Each of her eight teams at Texas ranked in the top-25 nationally in rebounding margin, including three years in the top-five. Her 2017-18 and 2018-19 teams ranked third in the NCAA in rebounding margin. Four of the top-eight single-season team rebounding averages in Texas history came during Aston's tenure, as did five of the top-nine best seasons in field-goal percentage defense.

Aston's prowess as one of the nation's best recruiters is also well known. Five of the classes she recruited to Texas were ranked among the top-11 in the nation according to ESPN. com, including three top-five classes. Recruits Charli Collier and Joyner Holmes were both No. 2 prospects according to ESPN and were listed as the nation's top recruits by some services. Aston brought 14 McDonalds All-Americans to Texas during her eight seasons.

In a season shortened due to COVID-19, the 2019-20 Longhorns posted a 19-11 overall record and finished third in the Big 12 Conference. A season that began with off-season injuries to a number of key contributors featured some impressive accomplishments. Texas defeated three Associated Press Top-25 teams, including knocking off No. 1 Stanford, which marked the program's first win against an AP No. 1 squad since 2004. The Longhorns also won at No. 17 and previously undefeated Tennessee, and earned a road victory against No. 25 TCU. Texas led the nation in double-doubles during the 2019-20 campaign with 31.

Aston mentored Collier, a sophomore center, to First-Team All-Big 12 Conference honors, as she was one of only six players in the league to average a double-double. Collier became the first player in program history to average more than seven defensive rebounds per game in a single season. Freshman guard Celeste Taylor was a Big 12 All-Freshman Team selection and earned three Big 12 Freshman of the Week accolades.

In 2018-19, Aston led Texas to a 23-10 overall record and a third-place showing in the Big 12 Conference with a 12-6 overall mark. The Longhorns advanced to the semifinals of the Big 12 Conference Tournament for the sixth consecutive year. It marked the sixth year in a row that the Longhorns had won 20 or more games.

Under Aston's tutelage, junior point guard Sug Sutton earned First-Team All-Big 12 Conference honors in 2018-19 and was named to the Big 12 All-Tournament Team. She led the Longhorns in scoring [12.7 points per game], assists per game [5.4] and steals per game [1.3]. Sutton scored in double figures 23 times, including four 20-point performances, and her 178 assists on the year marked the seventh-most in a single-season in school history. She was the conference's best all-around point guard as a junior.

In 2017-18, Aston led the Longhorns to a 28-7 overall record and a second-place finish in the Big 12 Conference with a 15-3 overall mark. Texas advanced to the championship game of the Big 12 Conference Tournament for the third time in four years. It marked the fourth year in a row that the Longhorns had won 24 or more games.

For the third time in four seasons, Aston had one of her players selected in the WNBA Draft in 2018. Atkins was chosen with the No. 7 pick by the Washington Mystics, making her the third-highest draft pick in Texas history.

INTRODUCING HEAD COACH KAREN ASTON

Before entering the collegiate coaching ranks, Aston was recognized as one of the top high school coaches in the nation. She coached five years at Vilonia High School [1988-93] in Vilonia, Ark., and one year at Fort Smith Northside [1993-94] in Fort Smith, Ark. She guided Fort Smith Northside to a 24-10 record and a fifth-place finish in Class 4A. For her efforts, she was named the Arkansas Northwest Region Coach of the Year.

While at Vilonia, Aston was not only the head basketball coach but also the head cross country and track coach. In 1992-93, she was named the Arkansas Basketball Coach of the Year after leading Vilonia to a 36-1 record and a Class 2A State Championship. Aston's cross country teams also claimed back-to-back state titles in 1991 and 1992.

A native of Benton, Ark., Aston was a two-time first-team allstate selection at Bryant High School. She capped her high school career by leading Bryant to the 1982 Arkansas Class 4A State Championship. Aston earned a bachelor of arts degree in physical education from Little Rock in 1987. She played two seasons of basketball at UALR after transferring from Ouachita Baptist.

In 2019, Aston was inducted into the Trojan Athletics Hall of Fame at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock and the Bryant [Ark.] High School Athletic Hall of Honor.


