WHAT 2 WATCH 4

- North Texas hosts UTSA Sunday in the second meeting of the season between the teams.
- The Mean Green stand alone at the top of the AAC standings with a 9-3 mark, but have four teams within one game of them.
- It's last time out, UNT recorded its 19th win of the season, tying the program's most wins in a regular season. The Mean Green will have a chance to break that record Sunday and continue closing in on the the overall single-season wins mark (21).
- The first meeting between the teams in San Antonio came down to the wire with UNT missing two shots at the end of regulation before UTSA pulled away for a 75-67 OT win.

BURTON'S FAST START TO FIRST YEAR

- **Jason Burton** surpassed UNT Hall of Famer Tina Slinker for most wins by a first-year head coach in UNT's win over UAB on Jan. 28. A look at how Burton's first year compares to the previous UNT head coaches:

A WIN WOULD...

- Improve the Mean Green to 20-5 overall and 10-3 in AAC play
- Mark the most regular season wins by a UNT team in program history
- Extend UNT's lead in the series to 24-13.
- Snap a two-game losing streak to UTSA.
- Improve UNT to 11-0 at home this season.

LAMPKIN IN CONFERENCE PLAY

- **Tommisha Lampkin** has made herself a viable candidate for AAC Player of the Year.
- While being a dominant force in the paint the entire season, Lampkin's play has improved since the start of conference play. Here is how she stacks up individually during American Athletic Conference games:

SERIES HISTORY

- North Texas and UTSA will meet for the 37th time in series history Sunday.
- UNT has won 23 of the 36 matchups all-time.
- UTSA is the fifth-most played opponent in UNT's program history.
- North Texas had won seven in-a-row against the Roadrunners prior to last season's overtime loss on Feb. 20.
- UTSA took the first meeting of the season in overtime, 75-67.

NEVER COUNT OUT THE MEAN GREEN

- North Texas overcame deficits of 15+ points in consecutive home games on Jan. 14 and Jan. 24 during its win streak.
- UNT trailed by 18 against Wichita State before outscoring the Shockers 30-15 in the fourth quarter en route to a 72-68 win. It was the program's largest comeback win since Feb. 22, 2018 when the Mean Green rallied from 18 points down against Old Dominion.
- They followed it up with a 15-point comeback in the second half to down Tulane, 77-70, in overtime.

PLAYER TO WATCH: TOMMISHA LAMPKIN

Lampkin has been dominant since the start of conference play. The senior center has scored 16 or more points in nine conference games, including a career-high 29 points against Tulsa. On top of her scoring output of 17.4 points per game that ranks sixth among individual players in conference play, Lampkin leads the conference and ranks No. 6 nationally in field goal percentage. She also ranks fourth in rebounding and second in double doubles during AAC play.

THE LADY IN THE MIDDLE

- Senior **Tommisha Lampkin** has been a stalwart in the lineup for the Mean Green throughout her career with 100 career games played with 44 starts, including in 26 consecutive games.
- Out of Mansfield, Texas, Lampkin comes into her senior year after averaging 9.7 points per game a season ago and also leading the Mean Green in rebounding at 6.7 boards per game.
- One of the best in program history at finishing around the rim, Lampkin's single-season FG percentage of 60.7 last season was good for the third-best percentage in program history.
- This season, her field goal percentage sits at 64.5, which has raised her career mark to 59.6. If that stands, it would overtake Freda Deckard's mark of 58.3 set from 1994-98 for the best mark in program history.
- On the defensive end, Lampkin has been a valuable rim protector totaling 90 blocks in her career. She is currently in sixth place on the all-time blocked shots list at UNT.

UTSA AT A GLANCE

- Former UNT and Texas head coach Karen Aston is in her third season leading the Roadrunners
- Aston spent the 2011-12 season in Denton and went 15-16.
- UTSA is 12-11 on the season with a 6-6 mark in AAC play. It comes into Sunday's game following a 74-70 loss to Tulsa Wednesday..
- The Roadrunners are one of the top rebounding teams in the entire country, ranked No. 6 with 45.9 rebounds per game. They also lead the AAC in blocks per game (4.7) and field goal percentage defense (36.8).



RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN

- **Jason Burton's** first season at UNT has already seen multiple program records fall.
- The Mean Green set a program record for points in a game in a 117-42 victory over UNT Dallas in the season opener.
- Burton posted the best start for a first-year head coach in program history after passing Tina Slinker's 5-1 start in 1989-90. He also became the winningest first-year head coach in program history with 17 wins so far.
- At 9-1, UNT got off to its best start through 10 games in program history.
- North Texas has also matched the longest overall win streak in program history at eight games and the longest conference win streak at seven games.

KERNAL IS COOKING

- **DesiRay Kernal** wasted no time showcasing her talent to the American Athletic Conference in her first season at North Texas.
- The former Division II All-American leads UNT in scoring (15.6) and is second in rebounding (7.6), while posting six double doubles on the year.
- Kernal ranks in the top-10 in seven categories among individual players in the AAC, including scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage, which she ranks fourth in and is No. 68 nationally.
- She has been a consistent producer for the Mean Green throughout the season collecting six total AAC weekly honors, including two AAC Player of the Week awards that is tied for the most in the conference.

1,500 AND COUNTING

- **DesiRay Kernal** and **Dyani Robinson** both reached 1,500 career points Jan. 2 in UNT's win over Temple.
- Best friends off the court, the duo transferred to North Texas from Texas A&M-Commerce with Jason Burton.
- UNT is one of 15 teams in the country with multiple 1,500-point scorers. Others include LSU, Iowa, Indiana, Kansas State, Mississippi State and more.

CAUSE YOU'RE LOOKING AT A WINNER

- Both **Dyani Robinson** and **DesiRay Kernal** are two of the winningest players in the country regardless of the division.
- Kernal has won 101 games she has appeared in over her five seasons of college basketball. In total, she has played in 137 of 138 career games, making her career winning percentage 73.7%.
- Robinson is not far behind her teammate with 93 career wins. Of note, Robinson missed the final 16 games of the 2022-23 season with a torn ACL.

LINE LEADERS

- As of Feb. 16, North Texas ranks No. 8 in the country in free throw attempts per game (23.54) and No. 11 in free throws made per game (16.00).
- UNT's free throws made and free throws attempted in both of its first two games this season are among the top-10 highest single game totals for a team in makes and attempts.
- **DesiRay Kernal** has made it a habit of getting to the free throw line as she ranks among the top individual players in free throw attempts and in free throws made (112-143).
- Kernal has made 13 free throws twice this season, including a perfect 13-of-13 mark against SFA.

THE DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

- North Texas has had one of the largest turn-arounds in winning percentage from last year to this year.
- The Mean Green (19-5) boast a .792 winning percentage in the 2023-24 campaign after a .354 percentage last season. The .438 difference in percentage ranks fourth among all DI teams, and first among teams who have a first-year head coach.

FRESHMEN FINDING THEIR ROLES

- Two of the three freshmen on the UNT roster have found their roles contributing heavily on the defensive side of the ball.
- Redshirt freshman **Desiree Wooten** has been a statsheet stuffer averaging 2.8 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 0.3 blocks in addition to the 5.0 points and 2.0 assists she provides on offense.
- Coming off of the bench, Wooten is often tasked with guarding one of the opposing team's best guards.
- The lone true freshman on the squad, **Shadasia Brackens** has seen her minutes increase since the start of conference play. Against Florida Atlantic on Jan. 7, she played a season-high 16 minutes and contributed eight points and seven rebounds.

THE MAGIC NUMBER IS 70

- With the UNT offense averaging 75.0 points per game, getting to 70 has proven to be an indicator of success for the Mean Green.
- North Texas is 17-1 this season when scoring 70 or more points.
- The lone loss came on Feb. 4 when North Texas fell to Tulsa 79-74.

DYNAMIC DYANI

- Dyani Robinson has been a different player since the calendar year turned to 2024. Around a year removed from an ACL injury that ended her 2023 season, she looks to be back to full speed once again.
- Through 11 games in 2024, Robinson is averaging 15.6 points per game compared to the 7.0 she was averaging in the first 13 games of the season.
- In the last six games, Robinson has led the Mean Green in scoring twice and surpassed 15 points in five of the games.
- She was named to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll on Feb. 12 following a 22-point outing against SMU.

DII ALL-AMERICANS

- Both **Dyani Robinson** and **DesiRay Kernal** join the Mean Green with strong resumes as they were both named WBCA All-Americans at some point in their careers.
- Robinson, a Cypress, Texas, native was selected as a First Team WBCA All-American in 2021-22 and was tabbed as the TABC Small College Player of the Year with the Lions.
- Last season, Robinson was averaging 18.4 points per contest, including a 23 point performance on the road against Texas, through 17 games before missing the rest of the season due to injury.
- Kernal, meanwhile, started 30 games at Commerce last season and picked up the slack when Robinson went down, averaging 21.3 points per game in the Southland Conference tournament en route to earning a spot on the SLC All-Tournament Team.

MILESTONE MOMENT

- Senior **Jaucklyn Moore** surpassed the 1,000-point mark for her career in UNT's game against Grambling State earlier this season.
- Coming into the year, Moore has scored 960 career points with 280 coming at UNT and 680 coming in her two seasons at Incarnate Word.
- Moore is the third UNT player to reach 1,000 points in her career (Kernal and Robinson), which is tied with Memphis for the most in the conference.

SUPER PIT 50

- This season, North Texas is celebrating 50 seasons of basketball played inside the Super Pit.
- In 1973-74, the UNT men's basketball team moved from Ken Bahnsen Gym (known at the "Snake Pit") into the UNT Coliseum that was dubbed as a "The Super Pit" for basketball games.
- The women's basketball team would go on to play in the Super Pit for the first time in its inaguarl 1976-77 season.
- North Texas is the lone AAC school yet to lose on it's home court this season. The Mean Green are 10-0 at The Super Pit this season, which is tied for the second-best start to a season at home in program history.

PROTECTING THE PERIMETER

- North Texas has excelled at guarding the 3-point line this season. The Mean Green rank No. 17 nationally in 3-Point Percentage defense holding opponents to 26.3%.
- In addition, UNT holds opposing teams to 37.2% overall, which is third in the AAC and No. 40 nationally.

PLAYING FOR EVAN

- The UNT women's basketball program suffered a tragic loss when practice player Evan Moore passed away in an automobile accident on December 26.
- A freshman at North Texas, Moore was a Kinesiology major and and minored in Psychology.
- Players can be seen honoring Moore on their wrist tape with "LLE" standing for "Long Live Evan" written in sharpie. UNT is 9-3 since Moore's passing.

PREPARE TO PINK OUT

- North Texas will host Charlotte on Feb. 21 in its "Play4Kay Plnk Game". Fans are encouraged to wear pink for the game in support of the Kay Yow Cancer Fund.

FREE THROWS FOR A CAUSE

- Jason Burton has pledged to donate one dollar for every free throw made at home games in the month of February to the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Recreation Center in Denton.
- This stems from the UNT staff's support of the center when they donated \$3 for every made free throw during its game against Wichita State on Jan. 14

Head Coach

First season at North Texas • 19-5
10th season overall • 190-95



Jason Burton is the ninth head women's basketball coach in UNT history as he embarks on his first year with the Mean Green. Burton comes to North Texas following nine seasons as the head women's basketball coach at Texas A&M-Commerce.

The all-time winningest coach in TAMUC program history, Burton's Commerce teams produced five All-Americans, three Lone Star Conference player of the year honorees, one South Central Region Player of the Year along with three all-region players and 25 all-conference picks and five all-defensive selections.

Burton guided the Lions through its first season of NCAA Division I competition in 2022-23 with the program reaching the semifinals of the Southland Conference tournament following a 10-8 record in the Southland Conference regular season.

The Plano, Texas native has won 66 percent of his games as a head coach and holds a 171-90 record overall in nine seasons including wins in nearly 70 percent of his league games for a 110-49 record.

In Commerce's last three seasons in Division II, the Lions were 69-12 (.852) with two NCAA Regional Semifinals appearances.

Burton guided the Lions to a program-best ranking of No. 2 in the WBCA poll and No. 1 in the D2SIDA rankings during the 2021-22 season. The Lions advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the fourth straight season and played in the LSC Championship game for the third year in a row. A&M-Commerce downed the Colorado School of Mines in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the South Central Regional Semifinal. A&M-Commerce finished the season leading the country in free throws made and third in rebounding.

The Lions won 27 games that season, the second most in program history.

During the COVID-impacted 2020-21 season, the Lions posted a 14-4 record and were ranked in the Top 25 all season while winning the LSC North Division crown and earning the program's first NCAA tournament win since 2008. Dyani Robinson and DesiRay Kernal were named honorable mention All-Americans by the WBCA, the program's fourth and fifth All-Americans under Burton's leadership.

Burton led the Lions to their most successful season under his tenure in 2019-20, earning LSC Coach of the Year honors for the first time in his career. The team went 28-3, tying the program's record for most wins in a single season. The team qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the second year in a row, the first time in program history the team had made back-to-back appearances before the tournament was canceled due to the pandemic.

The team set records for wins in a season (28), wins in a regular season (26), conference wins (20), most consecutive victories (25), best scoring margin (+18.4), lowest scoring defense (56.8) and the then highest national ranking (3rd). The team won its first 25 games of the year and finished the season as the No. 1 seed in the LSC with a 20-2 record in conference games. The Lions earned a No. 2 seed in the NCAA tournament before the event was canceled due to the pandemic.

During the 2018-19 season, Burton led the Lions to their first berth in the NCAA Regional Tournament since the 2006-07 season, and just the program's second-ever appearance. The team won 20 games for the second time in three seasons, and for only the third time in program history.

In his first four seasons as head coach from 2014-18, TAMUC showed steady improvement posting win totals of 14, 16, 20 and 18. The 20 victories during the 2016-17 season marked only the second 20-win campaign in Commerce history.

Burton returned to TAMUC in 2014 following a three-year stint away that included two years as a men's basketball assistant coach at Texas State and one year as head boys coach at McKinney Boyd High School.

He previously served as an assistant men's coach and later associate head coach for the Lions men's program from 2007 through 2011. He helped the program compile a 68-43 record during that time while recruiting a trio of All-Americans.

Burton earned a BA in Business Administration and Management from Austin College in 2007 and an MBA from A&M-Commerce in 2009. He is married to the former Alexydra Guiton. The couple has two children, Braylon and Jalen.

BRITNEY BROWN
ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH • 1ST SEASON

Britney Brown is in her first season as the Associate Head Coach of the UNT women's basketball program. She comes to UNT with a wealth of experience, with 12 seasons of experience coaching in Division I women's basketball, serving as an assistant coach at TCU, Nebraska and Tulsa.

Brown comes to UNT after seven seasons with the TCU women's basketball program, helping lead the Horned Frogs to three 20+ win seasons and a pair of appearances in the WNIT Semifinal. The former Oklahoma Sooners product named associate coach prior to the 2019-20 campaign while also holding the role of Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator during her time in Fort Worth.

In seven seasons at TCU, Brown helped the Horned Frogs win a total of 105 games, including a three-season stretch from 2017-18 to 2019-20 where they won 22+ games in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. That stretch also included notching a 24-11 mark in 2018-19 - just one win shy of the school's record 25 victories (2000-01, 2003-04).

In addition, TCU also set program records with 17 home victories in 2018-19 and 13 Big 12 Conference wins in 2019-20. The Horned Frogs also managed to register its most road wins since 2003-04, notching nine victories on the road in 2019-20.

TCU collected its first national ranking in 10 years during the 2017-18 campaign, as well, coming in as high as No. 22. The Frogs then made its way back into the WBCA Top-25 rankings during the 2019-20 season, coming in at No. 25, the week of Feb. 25.

Working primarily with TCU's guards, Brown was instrumental in the growth in a number of All-Big 12 caliber guards. Most recently, Brown helped Lauren Heard become a two-time First Team All-Big 12 selection in 2019-20 and 2020-21. Heard was the first TCU player to accomplish the feat since 2015-16.

Brown was also key in the growth of Kianna Ray who was named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention as a sophomore in 2017-18 after leading the Frogs in assists and steals, while ranking second in blocks. Following the 2018-19 season, both Ray and Heard finished among the top-15 of all Big 12 players in assists, assist/turnover ratio and steals. Heard (first team) and Ray (second team), would go onto earn All-Big 12 honors following the 2019-20 season while Ray also landed on the All-Defensive team.

Brown arrived at TCU after serving one season as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Nebraska, helping lead the Cornhuskers to the WNIT.

Prior to arriving at Nebraska, Brown spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Tulsa. In her first season at Tulsa in 2011-12, Brown helped the Hurricane to an eight-game improvement in the win column and their best Conference USA finish since 2005-06. A year later, Brown played a key role in helping the Hurricane capture the 2013 Conference USA Tournament title and advance to the NCAA Tournament. Tulsa finished with 17 wins, a four-game improvement over the previous year. The Hurricane returned to the postseason in 2013-14 with an 18-14 record.

Brown's spent two seasons as the video coordinator at Oklahoma, while working to complete her master's degree. In her second season on the Oklahoma staff, the Sooners advanced to the 2009 NCAA Women's Final Four and finished with a 32-5 overall record. OU went 22-9 and advanced to the second round of the 2008 NCAA Tournament in Brown's first season on staff.

Brown's coaching career began after a successful playing career in which she

played in 129 games and totaled 59 starts over a four-year span for Oklahoma from 2003-07. Brown was a player on OU teams that won a total of 100 games and captured five Big 12 Conference regular season or tournament championships. Eight of her Oklahoma teammates were either drafted or signed WNBA contracts.

As a starter her junior season, Brown earned All-Big 12 honorable mention accolades as the Sooners went 31-5 and advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16. She averaged 7.0 points and 4.3 assists while starting 33 games to help the Sooners to a 16-0 Big 12 mark and three more wins in the Big 12 Tournament.

As a senior in 2006-07, Brown helped the Sooners return to the NCAA Sweet 16. Oklahoma finished with a 28-5 overall record that included a 13-3 Big 12 mark. The Sooners finished 17-13 in Brown's sophomore season (2004-05), after going 24-9 during her freshman campaign (2003-04), when she appeared in 32 games with one start.

A native of Okmulgee, Okla., Brown starred at Norman North High School, where she finished her career as the school's all-time scoring and assists leader.



DR. LEAH FOSTER
DIR OF PLAYER ENGAGEMENT & ASST TO THE HC
1ST SEASON • ST. EDWARD'S, 2006

Dr. Leah Foster is in her first season as the Director of Player Engagement and Assistant to the Head Coach at UNT, joining the Mean Green after spending five seasons as the Player Development Coordinator at TCU.

In her five years with the Horned Frogs, Foster helped the Horned Frogs post a pair of 20+ win seasons as well as an appearance in the WNIT Semifinal in 2018-19.

Before working at TCU, Foster spent three years as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Tulsa. The Hurricane advanced to the Quarterfinal of the American Athletic Conference Tournament in all three years with Foster on staff.

Prior to her stint with the Hurricane, Foster served in the same role at Loyola during the 2014-15 campaign and was an assistant coach at Houston for three seasons (2011-14), where she recruited the 22nd-best class in 2012 according to Dan Olson's Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the 39th-best class by ESPN HoopGurlz.

Foster also spent three seasons (2008-11) as an assistant coach at Dartmouth College where she helped the Big Green capture the 2009 Ivy League Championship, while posting an 18-11 record and earning a bid to the NCAA Tournament.

She began her coaching career as a graduate assistant with the Texas State women's basketball program for two years (2006-08).

A four-year letterwinner at St. Edward's University (Austin, Texas), an NCAA Division II program, Foster led the Hilltoppers to the 2006 Heartland Conference Championship and was tabbed to the all-conference second team in 2005.

Foster earned her bachelor's degree in English literature from St. Edward's University in 2006 and her master's degree in physical education-sports management from Texas State in 2008. She also earned her Doctorate (Eh.D.) in higher educational leadership from TCU in 2023.

Durmon Jennings is in his fourth season with the Mean Green, being retained on staff for the 2023-24 season by head coach Jason Burton.

Jennings works with posts and scout team on a regular basis. He assisted with one of the best seasons in North Texas history, with back-to-back 10+ conference wins in consecutive seasons. It is only the second time that has happened in program history. The Mean Green also received a double-bye in the C-USA Tournament and a WNIT berth in 2021-22.

Jennings came to Denton following two seasons as the women's basketball associate head coach at Eastern New Mexico. Spearheaded by his player development and recruiting, Jennings helped guide the Greyhounds to the second most wins in program history with an overall record of 22-9. ENMU advanced to the NCAA Division II South Central Region Championship Tournament for the third time ever and also posted a victory over No. 1 ranked and defending national champions Lubbock Christian during the regular season.

The Hounds compiled a 19-11 record during the 2018-19 season to secure a spot in the South Central Regional. ENMU went 14-6 in Lone Star Conference play to finish tied for third in the league while also setting the best home record in program history with a 12-1 mark inside Greyhound Arena.

Jennings joined ENMU's women's basketball program prior to the start of the 2017-18 campaign as the team compiled a record of 16-12 and a 12-8 mark in the LSC to finish in a tie for fourth in conference play.

Jennings previously served as the graduate assistant coach of the ENMU men's basketball program during the 2015-16 season and the fall semester of the 2016-17 season before becoming the volunteer assistant coach in January 2017.

Before coming to Eastern, Jennings served as a boys varsity and junior varsity coach at Durango High School in Las Vegas, Nevada, for two seasons. Jennings also served as a 17U coach for the Elite Youth Basketball League in the summer of 2015 and as a 15U coach for the Under Armour Association during the summer of 2014.

In 2013, Jennings served as an intern for the NBA Summer League as well as served as an intern for the Athletic Administration at the University of Nevada at Las Vegas (UNLV) for one year. Before moving to Las Vegas, the Indianapolis native coached back home as a high school girls basketball and track and field coach at Warren Central High School from 2011 to 2013. Jennings got his start in coaching at Manual High School in Indianapolis where he coached the varsity girls' basketball team during the 2010-11 season.

Jennings earned his bachelor's degree in Sports Management at the University of Indianapolis in 2013 after he transferred from Geneva College where he played on the men's basketball team during the 2007-08 season. Jennings earned his master's degree in Sports Administration from Eastern New Mexico University in 2016.



PRINCESS DAVIS
ASSISTANT COACH, RECRUITING COORDINATOR
1ST SEASON • TEXAS A&M-COMMERCE, 2018

Princess Davis, a former Texas A&M-Commerce standout player and coach, is in her first season as an Assistant Coach and Recruiting Coordinator for UNT.

Davis came to UNT after spending the 2022-23 season as an assistant coach on Burton's staff at Commerce. She helped lead the Lions in their transition to Division I and was crucial piece in helping them advance to the semifinal of the Southland Conference Tournament.

In her role for the Lions, she was responsible for coordinating junior college recruiting, working with guards, assisting in scouting opponents, serving as an academic mentor, and had a role in the social media outreach efforts.

Prior to her one season at TAMUC, Davis served as an assistant coach at Trinity Valley Community College in Athens, Texas for two seasons.

In her time with the Lady Cardinals, Davis was on the staff for a pair of NJCAA Tournament runs, including 2020-21 when TVCC finished as the national runner up in the NJCAA Women's Basketball Championship.

In just two seasons, Davis mentored five NJCAA all-region academic players, seven all-conference honorees, eight all-region players, a NJCAA Region XIV Freshman of the Year, and a pair NJCAA All-Americans.

Davis was also a standout on the court TAMUC, playing with the Lions from 2014-19.

No A&M-Commerce women's basketball player has played, started, or won more games than Davis, who was one of Burton's first recruits in Commerce.

The Shreveport, Louisiana, native ended her Lion career second in assists, third in points, and first in minutes played. She averaged 11.3 points and 3.6 assists per game and was named an all-conference player three times as well as the Lone Star Conference Freshman of the Year in 2014-15. She was also honored as an All-American in 2017-18.

Additionally, Davis was part of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want to Be a Coach" training program in 2019, before playing professionally in Europe for ZKK Plamen Pozega in Pozega, Croatia.

After graduating with a degree in Kinesiology & Sport Studies from A&M-Commerce in 2018, Davis also received her master's degree in counseling at A&M-Commerce in 2020.

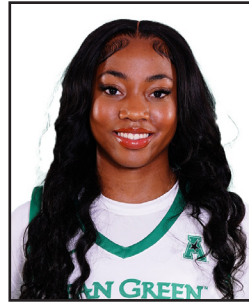
