STARTING FIVE

1 OPENING TIP: Wichita State hosts UTSA for its final home game of the season, seeking revenge on the Roadrunners Saturday at 2 p.m. The teams meet for the eighth time in program history with Wichita State leading the series 5-2. The Shockers' six seniors will be honored following the game.

2 LAST TIME OUT: Wichita State dropped an overtime heartbreaker, falling 88-84 to SMU despite a career night from Salese Blow. For the second time this season, Blow, the freshman from Murphy, Texas, hit a buzzer beater to send the game to overtime, banking in a three pointer as time expired. Blow finished with a career-high 24 points, shooting 6-for-18 from the field and going a perfect 9-for-9 from the charity stripe. Daniela Abies recorded her ninth double-double of the year with 17 points and a game-high 13 rebounds. Jayla Murray and Raissa Nsabua also finished in double figures, with Murray putting up 13 and Nsabua scoring a career-high 12. Ella Anciaux collected a career-high 11 boards, playing her most minutes of the season after getting her first career start. The Shockers recorded their best assist to turnover ratio of the season with a season-high 21 assists and 11 turnovers and out-rebounded the Mustangs 48-43. The Shockers held SMU to just 3-for-15 (.200) from behind the arc, but SMU dominated the paint, scoring 56 points inside.

3 STATISTICALLY SPEAKING: Wichita State is now 0-2 in overtime contests after Salese Blow hit buzzer beaters at the end of regulation in both games to send the Shockers to OT at home against UAB and SMU. Wichita State ranks in the top 100 nationally in the following categories: No. 52 in free throw attempts per game (19.4), No. 58 in three-point percentage defense (28.6) and No. 78 in offensive rebounds per game (12.9). The Shockers are ranked third in the American Athletic Conference in three-point percentage defense.

4 SCOUTING THE ROADRUNNERS: Led by third-year head coach Karen Astron (16th overall), the Roadrunners are coming off a 60-53 road loss to Memphis. Five Roadrunners are averaging double figures with AAC Preseason All-Conference Second Team selection Jordyn Jenkins leading the way with 14.2 points per game, having played just the last six games. Elyssa Coleman, Kyra White, Aysia Proctor and Sidney Love are also averaging double figures. Coleman is the team's leading rebounder, averaging 7.8 per game and ranking 10th in the conference in rebounds per game. Coleman also ranks second in the conference in blocks per game with 1.6. Kyra White ranks second in the conference in assists with 4.7 per game. The Roadrunners lead the conference in field goal percentage defense (36.3), rebounds per game (45.5) and rebound margin (10.0) and rank second in the conference in blocks per game (4.7). UTSA was picked eighth in the American Athletic Conference preseason poll and currently sits in 10th.

S LEADING LADIES: Three Shockers are averaging double figures with Daniela Abies leading the team with 12.6 points per game, Salese Blow averaging 11.9 and Tre'Zure Jobe averaging 9.2 rebounds per game with nine double-doubles. Blow has led the team in scoring 11 times and now has four 20-plus point games in the books. DJ McCarty is just 56 points away from 1,000 career points with only two remaining regular-season games before the conference tournament. She scored a career-high 26 points in the win over Tulsa on Feb. 17.

DANI DOMINANCE

Daniela Abies has finished with 10-plus rebounds 12 times and has led the team in rebounding in 21 games this season. She has nine career double-doubles, all this season. She scored a career-high 23 points against UAB and recorded a career-high 16 rebounds against Memphis and has led the team in scoring seven times.

FRESHIE ON FIRE

Salese Blow had finished in double figures in 10-straight games before being held scoreless against Tulsa. She came back to lead the team in scoring at Charlotte with 17 points and score a career-high 24 points at home against SMU. She has now finished in double figures in 17 games. She made her first career start at Belmont in November and then didn't start again until Dec. 30 against Tulane and has started every game since. Blow has led the team in scoring 11 times and now has four 20-plus point games in the books.

MORE McCARTY

Senior DJ McCarty has come alive in the last four games, scoring a career-high 26 points to lead the Shockers to a home win over Tulsa. She re-entered the starting lineup on Feb. 17 and recorded back-to-back career highs in assists with seven at Charlotte and nine against SMU. She is now just 56 points away from 1,000 career points.

NATIONAL TRE'ZURE

Tre'Zure Jobe had her best game of the season in the conference opener against Tulane, recording 21 points, 8 assists and 2 steals and being named American Athletic Conference Player of the Week. She recorded her first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds at Rice and has scored in double figures 14 times this season with two 20-plus point games.

SIERRA SNIPER

Sierra Morrow became the first Shocker since 2004 to shoot 100% from three with a minimum of four attempts, shooting 5-for-5 in her career game against Oral Roberts. She broke the Charles Koch Arena three-point percentage record (min. 5 attempts).

WOE-VERTIME

Wichita State is now 0-2 in overtime contests after Salese Blow hit buzzer beaters at the end of regulation in both games to send the Shockers to OT at home against UAB and SMU.

LONG-AWAITED DEBUT

Senior transfer from Miami (OH), Sierra Morrow, made her long-awaited Shocker debut against Kansas after her NCAA transfer waiver was finally approved. She tied for a team-high 12 points and grabbed a team-high six rebounds off the bench. In her third game of the season, Morrow scored a career-high 29 points against Oral Roberts to land herself on the AAC Weekly Honor Roll.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Wichita State faced three first-time foes in the non-conference docket, Presbyterian, Belmont and Dayton. The Shockers opened their season against No. 23 Oklahoma. Belmont (MVC) and Southeastern Louisiana (Southland) were picked to win their respective leagues. The Shockers' play two games against teams that finished inside the Top 50 of last year's NCAA NET Rankings (Kansas - 30 and Oklahoma - 38).

#MOREBOBO

Freshman Salese Blow (@BoboDaShow) claimed the American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Week award on Nov. 27 following her 19 points in the win over Omaha and career-high 20 points against Dayton, leading the team in scoring in both contests.

RUNS IN THE FAMILY

Salese Blow's mom, Stacie (formerly Tave) played at Arizona in 1993 and 94, leading the team in field goals made in 1994 with 27 and free throws made both years with 25 and 27. She is tied for the Wildcats' single-game steals record with 9.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Daniela Abies and Tre'Zure Jobe have recorded the Shockers' 10 double-doubles of the season with Abies' coming against Akron, UTSA, Memphis, Tulsa, UAB, Temple, Florida Atlantic, Tulsa again and SMU, and Jobe's at Rice. Abies has recorded a double-double in each of the last two games she's played in.

BLOCKS WILL COME OUT TO-MORROW

Sierra Morrow surpassed the 100-block mark against Florida Atlantic, recording a game-high four blocks. She now has 108 career blocks.

BELL'S BIG GAME

Aniya Bell hit three triples, scoring a career-high 16 points off the bench at UTSA, her second game with three three pointers.

Bell has hit two or more three pointers in four games this season.

QUEEN OF THE COURT

After each win, one Shocker is crowned player of the game in the locker room. Ornella Niankan, Daniela Abies, Tre'Zure Jobe and DJ McCarty have all been crowned this season.

SHOCKERS SIGN THREE GUARDS

Nooner announced the signing of guards, Princess Anderson, Kyleigh Ortiz and Kilyeah Parr to National Letters of Intent on Nov. 8. Anderson and Ortiz will be junior college transfers, and Parr is the lone high school signee, Nooner's first high school commit as a head coach.

HOMETOWN HEROES

Wichita native, **Tre'Zure Jobe**, a two-time NCAA Division II All-American who scored over 2,000 points in her career at Emporia State, joins the Shockers for her final year of eligibility, and **Ella Anciaux** returns for her junior season after a summer of much improvement and development.

ROSTER RETENTION

First-year head coach Terry Nooner retained nine of 13 potential returners from 2022-23, including the lone returning starter, **DJ McCarty**, the Shockers' assists and steals leader from 2022-23. He also maintained the commitment of Salese Blow, who signed with the Shockers prior to Nooner's appointment.

Wichita State returns just 34.7 percent of its scoring from a season ago, having lost its top two leading scorers and three other triple-digit point scorers. Trajata Colbert and Curtessia Dean exhausted their eligibility, and three of the top six scorers departed through the transfer portal.

AROUND THE WORLD

► The Shockers' roster features international athletes from four different countries, including Canada (Ornella Niankan and Raissa Nsabua), Mozambique (Carla Budane), Australia (Ambah Kowcun) and Spain (Daniela Abies).

Wichita State also represents seven U.S. states with two Wichita natives, Ella Anciaux and Tre'Zure Jobe.

Redshirt-sophomore forward **Jayla Murray** joins **Ambah Kowcun**, **Ornella Niankan**, **Raissa Nsabua** and **Jeniah Thompson** to make five junior college transfers on the Shockers' roster. Murray brings a season and a half of experience from Florida SouthWestern State, where she was the 2022 Southern Conference Player of the Year and earned third team NJCAA All-America recognition.

HALL OF FAMER

► Shocker legend, Alex Harden, has officially been selected as a member of the 2024 Class of the Wichita State Pizza Hut Shocker Sports Hall of Fame. Harden is Wichita State's all-time leading scorer with 1,708 points, an honorable mention All-American and the 2015 MVC Player of the Year. She will be inducted on Jan. 27.

Terry Nooner was named the 10th head women's basketball coach on April 17, 2023.

"To say this is a dream come true is an understatement," Nooner said. "As someone who played in Kansas, met my wife here and have raised my children here, I couldn't be happier to land my first head coaching position in the state I love so much. My family and I are incredibly excited to join Shocker Nation and make Wichita our home for years to come. I can't thank Kevin Saal and Dr. Muma enough for their belief and support, and I'm ready to build something special with our women's basketball program."

Nooner has a decade's worth of coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently as an associate head coach at the University of Kansas. Nooner was an integral part of Kansas' recent run to the 2023 WNIT title.

It's no coincidence that the last two NCAA Tournament appearances for Kansas have come with Nooner on staff.

In addition to his time at Kansas, he has coached at Texas, Maryland, Alabama and Southern Illinois along with one season as a player development coach with the Cleveland Cavaliers.

His third season at Kansas marked his second stint as an assistant at Kansas after spending the 2012-13 campaign with the Jayhawks. In his return to Kansas, Nooner assisted head coach Brandon Schneider – the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year – during the Jayhawks breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. The Jayhawks finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2010-11, and the Jayhawks had 20 wins during the regular season

for the first time since 1999-2000. Kansas capped off the season with a berth in the 2022 NCAA Tournament, where KU earned the No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional.

"Terry Nooner is a highly respected leader with a proven track record of success," Saal said. "As a result of his impressive journey, Terry is incredibly well-connected within our region and nationally. We are excited to welcome Terry, his wife Tracy and the Nooner family into the Shocker family."

Nooner was a big reason for the emergence of Kansas post player Taiyanna Jackson over the past two seasons. Jackson burst onto the scene as a junior college transfer, leading the Big 12 and ranking fourth in the Big 12 with a single-season school record 95 blocked shots. For her efforts, Jackson became the first Jayhawk in program history to be selected to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team.

Before returning to Lawrence, Nooner spent the 2019-20 season as an assistant coach at Texas, working heavily with players at the post position. He coached a pair of All-Big 12 selections and one WNBA draft pick while on the Forty Acres and UT earned three wins against Top 25 opponents that season.

Nooner joined the Longhorns from the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers, where he spent the 2018-19 season as Player Development Coach.

Prior to his time with the Cavaliers, Nooner served three seasons as an assistant coach for the University of Maryland women's basketball team. He helped the Terrapins to a record of 89-14 [.864], including a 43-7 [.860] mark in Big Ten Conference play. During his stint in College Park, Maryland won back-to-back Big Ten regular season and tournament titles and earned three NCAA Tournament berths. While at Maryland, Nooner helped recruit the nation's No. 1 class in 2016 and the fourth-ranked class in 2018.

Nooner was an assistant coach at the University of Alabama for two seasons from 2013-15. In his first season in Tuscaloosa, the Crimson Tide won 14 games, playing one of the most difficult schedules in the nation. Seven of those victories came in Southeastern Conference play, which were the most league wins for the Tide in more than 12 years.

Nooner spent one season at his alma mater, the University of Kansas, as an assistant coach with the women's basketball team. He helped the Jayhawks to one of their most successful seasons, as Kansas finished with 20 wins in 2012-13. Kansas advanced to the fourth NCAA Sweet 16 in program history.

Nooner began his collegiate coaching career as an

assistant coach at Southern Illinois in 2011-12. During that season, he worked with Cartaesha Macklin, who was named Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Year.

Nooner, a Raytown, Mo., native, was a former guard and team captain for the University of Kansas from 1997-2000. He helped the Jayhawks to a Sweet Sixteen, four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Big 12 Championships.

He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in African-American Studies from the University of Kansas in 2000. In 2002, he earned his Master's degree in Sport Administration from Kansas.

Nooner and his wife Tracy have three children.
