Redshirt Super Senior (2023)

Started all 13 games on the defensive line ... registered 11 total tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss, two sacks, a pair of quarterback hurries and a fumble recovery ... posted two TFLs including a sack, in the 20-13 home victory over Texas State ... had a solo sack in the 35-17 win over Marshall in the Frisco Bowl ... had a hand in a stop behind the line of scrimmage in the 41-20 triumph over UAB ... registered two tackles in the 49-34 road victory over Temple ... finished his UTSA career ranked fourth on the program's all-time sacks list with 13.5 and seventh with 24 TFLs ... totaled 66 tackles, 33 solo stops, a forced fumble and one fumble recovery as a Roadrunner.

Redshirt Senior (2022)

Played in 13 games and drew three starts on the defensive line ... posted 19 total tackles, six solo stops, 5.5 tackles for loss, two sacks and four quarterback hurries ... logged four tackles including one for a loss in the 41-38 overtime win at Army ... had four stops, one TFL and two QB pressures in the 52-24 victory over Texas Southern ... registered four tackles with one behind the line of scrimmage in the 30-10 win at FIU ... recorded a sack for a 6-yard loss in the 31-27 triumph over North Texas ... also had a sack for a loss of six yards versus No. 23 Troy in the Cure Bowl ... Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll member.

Redshirt Junior (2021)

Appeared in all 14 games ... registered 19 total tackles, 11 solo stops, 7.5 tackles for loss, five sacks, three quarterback hurries and a forced fumble ... piled up 56 yards lost, including 44 on sacks ... named C-USA Defensive Player of the Week after posting four tackles, 2.5 TFL, a pair of sacks, two QB hurries and a forced fumble in the 27-13 victory over Middle Tennessee ... his strip-sack early in the fourth quarter led to a 3-yard fumble return for a touchdown by Lorenzo Dantzler in the win over the Blue Raiders ... had a sack and a pressure in the 24-17 home win over UNLV ... dropped the UTEP quarterback for a 7-yard loss in the 44-23 road triumph over the Miners ... had four stops, including a half-sack, in the 45-16 road victory over Louisiana Tech ... shared a sack in the 52-46 win at Western Kentucky ... Super Senior (2023)

Tabbed first-team All-American Athletic Conference at wide receiver ... named to the Dave Campbell's Texas Football All-Texas College First Team ... piled up a school-record 1,151 receiving yards and 10 touchdowns on 89 receptions while starting all 13 contests ... Frisco Bowl Offensive MVP after catching seven passes for 102 yards, including a 44-yard touchdown to help lead UTSA to its first bowl victory with a 35-17 win over Marshall ... had 183 yards on only four catches, including a school-record 84-yard TD reception in the 41-27 win over East Carolina ... posted 163 yards and a TD on nine receptions in the 49-21 rout of South Florida ... opened his final campaign with 123 yards and a score on nine catches ... made seven grabs for 81 yards and a touchdown in the 49-34 road triumph over Temple ... was on the receiving end of eight passes for 84 yards and a TD versus Army ... had six catches for 83 yards at No. 18 Tulane ... finished his UTSA career as the program's all-time leader in receptions (313), receiving yards (3,639) and starts (56) ... scored 28 touchdowns, logged eight 100-yard receiving games and returned 10 punts for 52 yards as a Roadrunner ... ended his collegiate career with a catch in 52 consecutive contests ... was charged with only nine drops in 433 targets (2.8% drop rate) according to Pro Football Focus ... appeared on preseason watch lists for the Paul Hornung Award, Reese's Senior Bowl and Shrine Bowl 1,000 ... played in the East-West Shrine Bowl in Frisco, Texas, and caught four passes for 46 yards with a long of 18 yards ... also hauled in a two-point conversion pass to help the West to a 26-11 victory ... also played in the Hula Bowl.

First-team all-district wide receiver as a senior for head coach Anthony Williams at Dekaney High School ... caught 19 passes for 358 yards and four touchdowns in 2018 ... also threw for 311 yards and four TDs and rushed for 109 yards and a score in his final season ... as a quarterback his junior year, completed 104-of-201 passes for 1,388 yards and 11 touchdowns and rushed for 242 yards and four TDs ... totaled 2,304 yards and 20 TDs through the air and 425 yards and five scores on the ground for his prep career ... versatile athlete who also excelled for the Wildcats' baseball and track & field teams ... batted .443 with 27 hits, six doubles, one triple, a home run and nine RBIs as a junior ... won the district, area and regional high jump titles as a junior and owns a personal-best jump of 6-10 ... finished third in the high jump at the state meet with a 6-8 clearance.

Redshirt Senior (2023)

Played in seven games and drew a start in the 37-29 road win over North Texas ... helped the offense pile up 5,421 yards of offense (421.6 yards per game), including 3,248 passing and 2,531 rushing ... helped UTSA register 421 yards of offense, including a season-high 287 yards on the ground, in his start versus North Texas ... played 26 snaps in the 49-21 rout of South Florida, helping the Roadrunners record a program-record 643 yards of offense ... only surrendered one sack and did not allow a hit on the quarterback in 64 pass-blocking snaps according to Pro Football Focus ... was not charged with a penalty all season.
