## « OPENING DRIVE »

- UTSA will kick off its 14th season of play and fifth under head coach Jeff Traylor on Saturday afternoon against Kennesaw State at the Alamodome.
- The Roadrunners are on track to surpass the two-million mark for all-time home attendance at Saturday's game, as the number stands at 1,988,431 through 79 home games.
- This will mark the first meeting on the gridiron between UTSA and Kennesaw State, a first-year member of Conference USA.
- The Roadrunners are 9-4 all-time in season openers.
- UTSA is 8-5 in home openers, including 3-1 with Jeff Traylor at the helm.
- The Roadrunners are 23-3 (.885) at the Alamodome in the Jeff Traylor era, the third-most victories and seventh-best winning percentage among FBS teams for home games since 2020.
- Jeff Traylor is entering his fifth season at UTSA and boasts a 39-14 overall record, the most wins and best winning percentage (.736) in program history, a mark that currently ranks ninth among active FBS coaches.
- The Roadrunners registered their first bowl win in school history with a 35-17 victory over Marshall in the 2023 Scooter's Coffee Frisco Bowl to cap a 9-4 ledger that included a 7-1 mark in their American Athletic Conference debut campaign.
- UTSA has won nine or more games in each of the past three seasons.
- This season, UTSA will face all four FBS teams that use Owls as their nickname: Kennesaw State, Rice, Florida Atlantic and Temple.
- UTSA is receiving six votes in the AP Top 25 and three votes in the AFCA Coaches Poll.

**SETTING THE SCENE**

UTSA will kick off its 14th season of play and fifth under head coach Jeff Traylor on Saturday, Aug. 31, against Kennesaw State. Kickoff is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. at the Alamodome and the game will air live on ESPN+ and Sports Radio AM 760 The Ticket. This will mark the first meeting on the gridiron between the Roadrunners and the Owls, who are one of four opponents with that nickname on UTSA's schedule this season. UTSA welcomes back 49 lettermen — including 16 starters — from last year's 9-4 team that registered the first bowl win in school history with the 35-17 victory over Marshall in the 2023 Frisco Bowl. Much like UTSA, Kennesaw State started its football program from scratch in 2015 as an FCS program. The Owls are in their first season as an FBS member of Conference USA.

**TUNING IN**

Saturday's season opener is set for an ESPN+ broadcast and it also will be available via the ESPN mobile app. Jack Benjamin (play-by-play) and LaDarrin McLane (analyst) will call the action. UTSA Sports Media Network will air the game live in the San Antonio area on Sports Radio AM 760 The Ticket, online at ticket760.iheart.com and via the free iHeartRadio app. Andy Everett (play-by-play), Jay Riley (analyst) and Ed Suarez (reporter) have the call. There will be a two-hour pregame and 45-minute postgame show.

**UTSA SET FOR SECOND SEASON IN THE AMERICAN**

UTSA will enter its second season as a member of the American Athletic Conference in 2024. Under the direction of fifth-year head coach Jeff Traylor, the Roadrunners welcome back 49 lettermen — including 16 starters — for what will be the 14th season in program history. UTSA finished with a 9-4 record last year, including a 7-1 league mark in its debut campaign in The American. The Roadrunners capped the season with a 35-17 victory over Marshall in the Scooter's Coffee Frisco Bowl for the school's first bowl win.

**BREAKING DOWN THE SCHEDULE**

UTSA's 12-game regular season schedule in 2024 features four non-conference contests to kick off the campaign. The Roadrunners will host Kennesaw State on Saturday in the opener before they play back-to-back road tilts at Texas State (Sept. 7) and Texas (Sept. 14). UTSA will close out the non-league slate at home against Houston Christian on Sept. 21. American Athletic Conference play will get underway for UTSA on Sept. 28 with a road date with East Carolina. Following the first of two idle weeks, the Roadrunners will make the short drive over to Houston to race Rice on Oct. 12 and then host Florida Atlantic on Oct. 19. UTSA will wrap up the month of October at Tulsa on the following Saturday before opening up a three-game home stand on Nov. 2 against Memphis. After a second off week, the Roadrunners will welcome North Texas (Nov. 15) and Temple (Nov. 22) to the Alamodome for back-to-back Friday night matchups. The regular season finale is scheduled for Nov. 30 at Army in West Point, New York.

**FIRST-TIME FOES**

UTSA will face a pair of first-time opponents in 2024. Saturday's season opener against Kennesaw State, which is entering its first season as a member of Conference USA, will mark the first time the Roadrunners and Owls have met on the gridiron. UTSA also will face Houston Christian, a member of the Southland Conference, for the first time on Sept. 21 at the Alamodome. UTSA was a previous member institution of both leagues, the Southland Conference from 1991 through 2012 and Conference USA from 2013 through 2023. The Roadrunners captured back-to-back Conference USA Football Championships in 2021 and 2022 but never actually competed in the Southland in football, as their inaugural season in 2011 was as an FCS Independent before they joined the Western Athletic Conference for the 2012 campaign.

**IT'S A HOOT**

The Roadrunners will face all four FBS teams that use the nickname Owls during the 2024 season. UTSA will open the campaign this Saturday at the Alamodome

against the Kennesaw State Owls, who are making their debut in Conference USA this year. The Roadrunners also will meet three American Athletic Conference teams who are the Owls: Rice (Oct. 12), Florida Atlantic (Oct. 19) and Temple (Nov. 22).

**ROADRUNNERS ARE HOT IN AUGUST**

UTSA is set to play a game in the month of August for just the fourth time and the first since 2019 when the Roadrunners beat UIW, 35-7, on Aug. 31 at the Alamodome. Undefeated in the month of August, the Roadrunners also defeated New Mexico, 21-13, on Aug. 31, 2013, in Albuquerque and they scored a 27-7 road triumph over Houston on Aug. 29, 2014, in what still stands as the earliest date that UTSA has played a game. Additionally, the Roadrunners were schedule to play the 2012 season opener at South Alabama on Aug. 29, but that game was moved to Sept. 1 due to Hurricane Isaac’s impacts on the Mobile area.

**SEASON-OPENING SUCCESS**

UTSA is 9-4 all-time in season openers and 3-1 in season openers that have occurred at the Alamodome. Saturday’s lid-lifter against Kennesaw State will mark just the second time in the last five years and fifth time overall that the Roadrunners have opened a season at home.

record 10-game win streak at home that started with a 27-26 victory over Louisiana Tech on Oct. 24, 2020, and ran through the 49-41 win against WKU in the 2021 Conference USA Championship Game before it was snapped in triple overtime against No. 24 Houston in the 2022 season opener. The Roadrunners have won 11 of the last 12 at home and are 49-30 (.620) all-time in the Alamodome.

**PACKING THE DOME**

UTSA fans have packed the Alamodome over the past three seasons, as five of the program's nine-largest home crowds have been recorded during that span. Two of the most recent home games now rank second and fourth on the all-time chart, as 49,342 fans watched UTSA beat Texas State in the 2023 home opener to mark the second-largest crowd in program history. In 2022's final home contest, the Roadrunners raced past North Texas, 48-27, to capture their second straight Conference USA Championship in front of 41,412 fans, which now ranks fourth on the list of largest home crowds. That figure edged the 41,148 fans who watched UTSA outlast WKU, 49-41, in the 2021 C-USA Championship Game, now the fifth-largest home attendance. The 2022 season opener against 24th-ranked Houston drew 37,526 fans, which ranks eighth all-time, just ahead of the thrilling triumph over UAB in front 35,147 fans in 2021. UTSA led C-USA in average home attendance in back-to-back seasons, averaging 28,917 per game in 2022 and 26,643 the previous year. A total of 562,178 fans have filed into the Alamodome to watch the Roadrunners since the return from COVID-19 protocols for the 2021 season. In fact, UTSA is on track to surpass the two-million mark all-time, sitting at 1,988,431 fans entering Saturday's opener against Kennesaw State. UTSA set NCAA modern startup program records in its first season by drawing 56,743 fans to the inaugural game against Northeastern State on Sept. 3, 2011, and by averaging 35,521 fans for six home contests.

The Owls are entering their 10th season of football and first as an FBS member, as they joined Conference USA this year. Kennesaw State returns 12 starters from last year's 3-6 squad that won two of its last three contests. The Owls have been one of the most successful startup programs in recent history under the direction of head coach Brian Bohannon, as they boast a 71-30 all-time record four FCS playoff appearances and three conference championships.

## SERIES HISTORY

Saturday will mark the first meeting on the gridiron between UTSA and Kennesaw State, which is entering its first season as a member of Conference USA.

## SIMILAR STARTUPS

UTSA and Kennesaw State are both modern startup programs. The Roadrunners played their first game in 2011 and are entering their 14th season, while the Owls competed for the first time in 2015 and are entering year 10.

## WHO'S COUNTING?

Entering their 14th season of play, the Roadrunners will play the 160th game in program history on Saturday when they face Kennesaw State at the Alamodome. UTSA is 84-75 all-time and 49-30 at home, including a 23-3 mark under fifth-year head coach Jeff Traylor.

## HISTORY MADE IN FRISCO

The Roadrunners made history on Dec. 19, 2023, registering the school's first bowl win with a 35-17 victory over Marshall in the Scooter's Coffee Frisco Bowl. UTSA trailed 14-0 early in the contest but outscored the Thundering Herd, 35-3, the rest of the way to improve to 1-4 all-time in bowl games. The Roadrunners have made four consecutive bowl games and five appearances overall dating back to the 2016 New Mexico Bowl.

## TRAYLOR TABBED TOP AAC COACH BY ATHLON SPORTS

Athlon Sports picked UTSA's Jeff Traylor as its top head coach in the American Athletic Conference for the 2024 season. Traylor tops the list of the league's 14 head coaches as selected by senior college football writer and editor Steve Lassan. A two-time conference coach of the year, the Gilmer, Texas, native has led the Roadrunners to a 39-14 record in his first four seasons at the helm, the most wins and best winning percentage (.736) by a coach in program history. UTSA has captured a pair of conference championships, earned four straight bowl berths and made a combined 23 appearances in the three major national polls under his leadership. Under Traylor's guidance, UTSA student-athletes have collected awards and honors at a record-breaking pace. During his time in San Antonio, he has coached seven All-Americans, three national award finalists, 83 all-conference selections and a pair of NFL Draft picks. That success is not limited to just the gridiron. The Roadrunners also have received numerous honors for their work in the classroom during the Traylor tenure, including three College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-Americans, 12 CSC Academic All-District Selections and four conference all-academic team selections. Additionally, UTSA was one only 13 FBS programs to receive the 2023 AFCA Academic Achievement Award for graduation success.

## BURKE CHOSEN FOR 40 UNDER 40 LIST

UTSA offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach Justin Burke was chosen for the Dave Campbell's Texas Football 40 Under 40, as the publication recognized 40 of the rising stars in the coaching ranks in the state of Texas. This marks the fourth consecutive year a UTSA coach has been honored, as Burke joins running backs coach/NFL liaison Julian Griffin (2021), associate head coach/pass game coordinator/wide receivers coach Joe Price (2023) and former co-offensive coordinator Will Stein (2022). A veteran of the UTSA staff since 2020, Burke is in his second season as the Roadrunners' offensive coordinator and his first coaching the quarterbacks. He served as associate head coach, special teams coordinator and tight ends coach during the 2022 regular season before being promoted to co-offensive coordinator for the Cure Bowl.

## TRAYLOR TAKING ROADRUNNERS TO NEW HEIGHTS

Head coach Jeff Traylor has guided UTSA to new heights since taking over the program prior to the 2020 campaign. The Gilmer, Texas, native has turned around the program by instilling his 210 Triangle of Toughness culture, producing results on and off the field. Taking over a team that won a combined seven games in the two seasons prior to his arrival, he has led the Roadrunners to a 39-14 record through 53 games, the most wins all-time and best winning percentage (.736) by a UTSA head football coach. In fact, his winning percentage places him ninth among active FBS coaches entering the 2024 season. In the Jeff Traylor era, the Roadrunners are 23-3 (.885) at home, and they own a 27-4 (.871) record in regular season conference games and are 29-4 (.879) against league competition when including the 2021 and 2022 Conference USA Championship Games. Under Traylor's direction, UTSA has won back-to-back conference championships, has been

nationally ranked in all three major polls in 2021 and 2022 and has played in a bowl game in each of his four seasons, including defeating Marshall, 35-17, in the 2023 Frisco Bowl for the program's first bowl win. The two-time conference coach of the year has coached eight All-Americans, three national award finalists, 13 national award semifinalists, seven conference superlative award recipients, 83 all-conference selections, two academic All-Americans and a pair of NFL Draft picks during his UTSA tenure. He was the 2021 AFCA Region 4 Coach of the Year and he has been a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year twice in addition to being a finalist for the 2022 Paul "Bear" Bryant Awards Coach of the Year, 2021 AFCA National Coach of the Year and the 2021 George Munger College Coach of the Year.

## SEASON 14

One of the newest FBS programs and now in its second year as a member of the American Athletic Conference, UTSA will kick off its 14th season of football against Kennesaw State on Saturday at the Alamodome. The Roadrunners started their program from scratch and, following a practice year in 2010, played their first season as an FCS Independent in 2011 before joining the Western Athletic Conference for the 2012 campaign. UTSA moved into Conference USA in 2013 and became a full-fledged FBS member starting with the 2014 season. The Roadrunners set NCAA modern startup program records in 2011 by drawing 56,743 fans to their inaugural game against Northeastern State and by averaging 35,521 fans for their six home contests that season. UTSA made its first postseason appearance at the 2016 New Mexico Bowl in its sixth season of play and registered its first win against a team from the Big 12 Conference the following season with a 17-10 victory over Baylor. The Roadrunners made history in 2021, opening the fall with a road win against Illinois of the Big Ten Conference, capturing their first conference championship with a 49-42 decision against WKU and capping a 12-2 ledger with their third bowl game. They repeated as league champions with a 48-27 win over North Texas in 2022 and made their third straight and fourth overall bowl appearance, ending the year with an 11-3 mark. Last fall, the Roadrunners notched their first bowl victory with a 35-17 decision over Marshall in the Frisco Bowl to cap a 9-4 ledger that include a 7-1 mark in their debut in The American. UTSA now has posted at least six wins in eight of the 13 seasons in program history and it has reached the seven-win plateau six times, including in each of the first four years of the Jeff Traylor era.

## DOWN TO THE WIRE

UTSA is no stranger to close contests in the Jeff Traylor era, as 30 of the 53 have been one-score ballgames in the fourth quarter. The Roadrunners own a 21-9 record in those games. Dating back to the 2021 campaign, UTSA has seen 17 of the last 31 contests decided in the fourth quarter or later. Additionally, the Roadrunners are 13-4 (.765) in games decided by eight points or less since 2021, the most wins and top winning percentage among FBS teams who have played 15 or more one-score games during that stretch.

## HIGH-SCORING ROADRUNNERS

UTSA has emerged as one of the top scoring offenses in the FBS under head coach Jeff Traylor. In his second season at the helm in 2021, the Roadrunners set school records for scoring, tallying 516 total points in 14 contests for a program-record 36.9 points per game to rank 11th nationally. The following year, the Roadrunners came up just shy of the school record with 515 points in 14 games for an average of 36.8 per game, good for 14th in the FBS. UTSA scored 30-plus points in 12 of the 14 contests, and they topped the 40-point barrier seven times and the 50-point plateau twice. The Roadrunners scored 415 points in 13 games in 2023, good for an average of 31.9 per contest. In fact, those three seasons rank as the top three scoring totals and averages in program history. UTSA has scored 20-plus points in 41 of the last 45 games dating back to the 2020 campaign. The Roadrunners have tallied 1,785 points in 53 games under head coach Jeff Traylor, good for an average of 33.7 points per game.

## EXPERIENCE UP FRONT

UTSA once again will boast one of the most experienced offensive lines in the FBS this fall. The Roadrunners own a combined 238 career games played and 116 career starts up front, figures that rank seventh and 13th, respectively, among all FBS teams. Redshirt junior Walker Baty has played in a team-high 37 games with 11 starts, while senior transfer CJ James Jr., who appears on the Rimington Trophy Watch List, paces the unit with 32 starts during his previous stops at New Mexico and Abilene Christian. Senior Makai Hart is close behind with 24 career starts in 25 games, Venly Tatafu will tote 25 appearances and 20 starts into his final campaign and junior Luke Lapeze has 27 games and 11 starts under his belt. Transfers Kamar Missouri and Jaylen Garth have played in 19 and nine games, respectively, while sixth-year senior Demetris Allen owns four starts in 20 career games as a Roadrunner. Honorable mention all-conference performer Cory Godinet made 10 starts in 13 appearances last fall, Buffalo Kruiuze saw action in a dozen contests, Deandre Marshall has 16 games on his resumé and Ben Rios has played in three.

## CARDENAS IS CLUTCH

Senior tight end Oscar Cardenas has developed a reputation for making clutch catches during his career. The San Antonio Brandeis High School product played a role in one of the iconic moments in program history, hauling in the game-winning TD reception after a tipped pass with three seconds left in the 34-31 home victory over UAB in 2021. He also had a 28-yard catch on that game-winning drive versus the Blazers to help the Roadrunners clinch the Conference USA West Division title. In 2022, Cardenas caught two balls in the opener against No. 24 Houston, including a key 25-yard reception that set up the game-tying field goal as time expired. He also made a one-handed grab and then hurdled a defender for a 35-yard play on the final drive of the 31-27 victory over North Texas to set up the game-winning touchdown pass on the following play. Last season, the John Mackey Award Watch List member caught 32 passes for 280 yards and a pair of touchdowns en route to third-team All-American Athletic Conference accolades. A sixth-year senior, Cardenas has 82 receptions for 997 yards and six touchdowns in 57 career games as a Roadrunner.

## THREE-HEADED MONSTER

The Roadrunners featured a three-headed monster in the backfield last season and that is expected to be the same in 2024. Running backs Kevorian Barnes, Rocko Griffin and Robert Henry combined to rush for 1,786 yards and 23 touchdowns on 365 attempts. Barnes, a native of San Augustine, Texas, who earned a spot on this year's Doak Walker Award candidate list, paced the unit with 715 yards on 147 carries to go with six TDs, while Henry, who hails from Mississippi, tallied 588 yards and a team-best 11 TDs on 127

totes. Griffin, a Georgia native, rushed 91 times for 483 yards and six scores and averaged a team-best 5.3 yards per carry. The trio was responsible for 80% of the Roadrunners' rushing yards and 85% of their rushing TDs last fall.

### MCCUIN EMERGES AS RECEIVING THREAT

UTSA wide receiver Devin McCuin emerged as one of the team's top receiving threats as a true freshman last year. The Jacksonville, Texas, native nearly broke a freshman record that has stood since UTSA's inaugural season in 2011, as he piled up 546 receiving yards and three touchdowns on 42 catches to come up only 32 yards shy of Kam Jones' freshman standard of 578. He had a 72-yard TD reception against Army that now ranks as the eighth-longest pass play in program history and he nearly notched his first career 100-yard game with 94 in the 49-34 win at Temple and again with 91 in the 49-21 home triumph over South Florida.

### SACK ATTACK

UTSA enjoyed a record-setting season in 2023 for tackles for loss and sacks. The Roadrunners registered 99 tackles behind the line of scrimmage to eclipse the previous standard of 96 set in 2019. UTSA shattered the program mark for sacks with 46, 13 more than the previous record established in 2021 with the benefit of one more game. The Roadrunners led the American Athletic Conference in both categories and they ranked second in the FBS in sacks per game (3.54) and fifth in tackles for loss per contest (7.6). Individually, Jimmori Robinson returns after recording 11 TFLs, 4.5 sacks and a program-record 10 quarterback hurries.

### TURNING THE TIDE FOR TAKEAWAYS

After going through the first three games of the 2023 season without a takeaway, the Roadrunners finished with 17 turnovers over the last 10 contests. UTSA tallied 10 interceptions, led by two apiece from Elliott Davison, Nicktroy Fortune and Kam Alexander, while the Roadrunners recovered seven fumbles, paced by two from Ronald Triplette.

### D-LINE DEPTH KEEPS ROADRUNNERS FRESH

UTSA has taken advantage of a deep defensive line room with a rotation aimed to keep players fresh throughout the game. The Roadrunners played at least nine d-linemen and as many as a dozen in three different games in 2023. UTSA welcomes back eight players at the position who saw action last fall, led by veterans Brandon Brown, a member of the Outland Trophy Watch List, and Joe Evans, who has earned a spot on watch lists for the Bronko Nagurski Trophy, Shrine Bowl 1000, Reese's Senior Bowl. Brown logged 4.5 tackles for loss, two quarterback hurries and a sack en route to third-team all-conference honors in 2023. Evans posted 2.5 TFLs, a pair of sacks and a safety last season while also collecting third-team all-league accolades.

### LINEBACKER LEADER

Jamal Ligon has been a starter at inside linebacker since he stepped foot on campus in 2020 and he has developed into one of the team leaders. The fifth-year senior from Tyler, Texas, who landed on this year's Shrine Bowl 1000 already owns the UTSA career mark for assisted tackles with 148 and is on pace to become the Roadrunners' all-time leader in total tackles, as he boasts 285 entering the 2024 season, 30 short of Rashad Wisdom's school record. The three-time all-conference selection also is on track to become the program's record holder in starts, as he has 46 entering his final campaign, only 10 shy of the mark held by Joshua Cephus and Wisdom. Additionally, he set the school standard — as a true freshman — for total tackles in a game with 19 in a win over Middle Tennessee in 2020. Last season, Ligon posted 62 total tackles, 35 unassisted stops, seven tackles for loss, five quarterback hurries, one sack, one forced fumble and a pass breakup while earning honorable mention All-American Athletic Conference honors.

### OURS (TAYLOR'S VERSION)

UTSA senior Donyai Taylor is following in the footsteps of former teammate and older brother, Dadrian, who started his career in 2018 and donned the number *seven* jersey for the 2020 through 2022 seasons as a standout at the Roadrunners' money backer position. Donyai, who has played the same spot as his sibling since his true freshman campaign in 2020, earned the coveted single-digit jersey in a vote by his teammates last season, choosing the same number *seven* that Dadrian wore. The younger brother and Shiner High School product, who will keep that number in 2024, started all 12 games last fall and registered 46 total tackles, *seven* tackles for loss, two sacks, six quarterback hurries, two pass breakups, a 78-yard interception return and a 19-yard fumble return en route to second-team All-American Athletic Conference honors.

### STEADY SAFETIES

UTSA's secondary will be led in part by the steady senior safety duo of Elliott Davison and Ken Robinson. Despite playing in only 12 of the 13 games, Robinson, a South Grand Prairie High School product, led the Roadrunners in total tackles with 66 to go along with four pass breakups and a quarterback hurry. Davison, a native of Tyler, registered 40 stops and a pair of interceptions, including one that was returned 76 yards, in his first season at UTSA after transferring from UIW.

### ALLEN'S AIM IS ACCURATE

Last fall, Chase Allen developed into a reliable place-kicker in his debut campaign with the Roadrunners that saw him ear second-team All-American Athletic Conference accolades. The transfer from Alabama made 13 of 15 field goals and all 49 extra-point attempts in 2023, as he led the league and ranked 14th in the FBS in field-goal percentage (.867). After not kicking in the opener versus Houston, he drilled 46- and 43-yard field goals in

the 20-13 victory over Texas State, earning AAC Special Teams Player of the Week honors. The Colleyville Heritage High School graduate tied the school record with a 53-yard make in the 41-20 triumph over UAB on Oct. 14. Currently riding a streak of six consecutive makes, his 13 made field goals put him sixth on UTSA's single-season list, while his 49 PATs rank third in program history. In fact, Allen has continued the Roadrunners' stretch of consecutive extra points made, which is now sitting at 194 dating back to a win over Louisiana Tech on Oct. 24, 2020.

### CARPENTER MAKES HISTORY

UTSA junior Chris Carpenter has stamped his name in the school record book as one of the top returners in program history. In 2022, he brought back a kickoff 97 yards for a score against Texas Southern, the first kickoff return touchdown in program history. Last season, the Jacksonville, Texas, native returned a punt 50 yards for a touchdown in the third quarter of the 34-14 home triumph over Rice to become the first Roadrunner to record a punt and kickoff return for a TD. The punt return TD versus the Owls was the third in school annals, as he joined Kenny Harrison (79-yard TD vs. Texas State, 2012) and Sheldon Jones (76-yard return vs. Lamar in 2021). Carpenter finished 2023 ranked sixth in the league and 34th nationally in punt return average (6.8).

### TV BIRDS

Saturday's game will air on ESPN+, marking 138 straight televised/streamed appearances for the Roadrunners. The last UTSA game that was not broadcast was the 2012 season finale against Texas State.

### A FOCUS ON RECRUITING TEXAS

UTSA's 117-man roster features 92 players — 79% — who hail from the state of Texas. Georgia and Mississippi stand second with four players apiece, while there are two each from Alabama, Florida and Louisiana. Arizona, Arkansas, Hawai'i, Iowa, Maryland, Massachusetts, Oregon, Tennessee and Virginia each have produced one current Roadrunner. Caile Hogan is the lone UTSA player from Australia and Cory Godinet is the first Roadrunner from American Samoa.

### « KEEPING THEM HOME »

UTSA head coach Jeff Traylor and his staff have placed an emphasis on recruiting the city of San Antonio and surrounding area. This year's roster includes 16 players from the San Antonio area.

### BROTHERLY DUOS

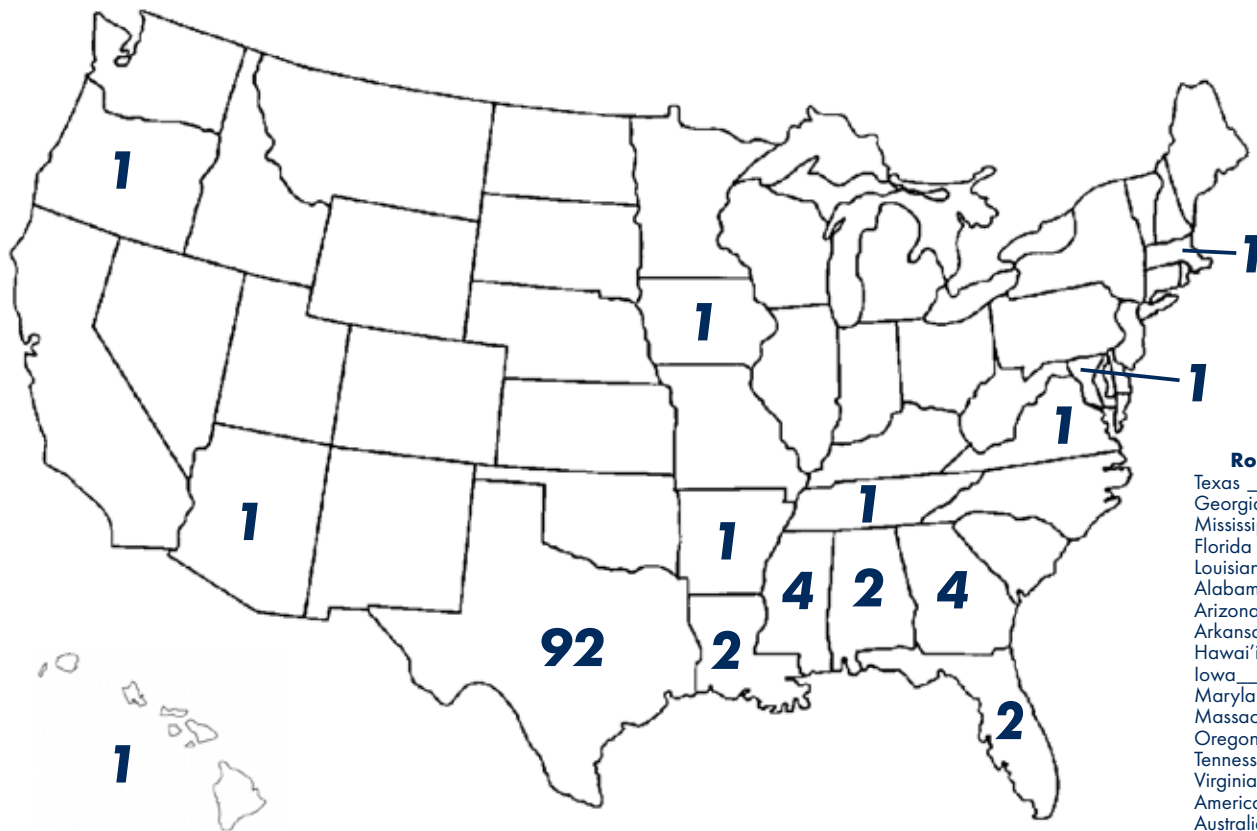
