The American Way

The American Athletic Conference plays its second season as a 14-team conference in 2024 and its first under its current membership. The American welcomed Army as a football-playing member as of July 1, 2024.

Auld Lang Syne

The American Athletic Conference has sent its champion to a New Year's Six bowl game in eight of the conference's first 11 seasons.

Top 10

The American Athletic Conference has had a team finish in the top 10 of the national polls six times in the league's first 11 seasons, most recently in 2022, when Tulane finished at No. 9.

Top 11

The American Athletic Conference was one of six FBS conferences that had two 11-win teams last season (Big Ten, MAC, Pac-12, SEC, Sun Belt).

Top 12

The 2024 season will be the first to include a 12-team College Football Playoff. The top five conference champions will be included in the 12-team field, while seven spots will be filled with at-large teams as chosen by the CFP Selection Committee.

Top 25

American Athletic Conference teams play a combined nine nonconference games against teams ranked in this week's 25 polls.

Conference Call

In the College Football Playoff era (since 2014), The American has a combined 102-59 record against non-autonomous FBS conferences (a .634 winning percentage).

Variety Show

Since The American began playing a championship game in the 2015 season, eight different teams have played in the game at least once, six schools have hosted the championship game, and seven schools have won the league title.

The New Guy

The American Athletic Conference has only one coach in his first year at his institution in 2024. Tulane's Jon Sumrall joined by an NCAA FBS team last season. Northwestern improved by seven wins last year.

Reversal Of Fortune

South Florida's six-game improvement from 2022 (when the Bulls went 1-11) to 2023 (7-6) marked the second-best turnaround by an NCAA FBS team last season. Northwestern improved by seven wins last year.

Table-Toppers

Army and Navy, which had never competed in the same conference in football until this season, sit tied atop the American Athletic Conference standings after each team won its respective conference opener last Saturday.

Go Figure

East Carolina has committed 10 turnovers through two games, the most of any team nationally. The Pirates are 2-0 however, and have won their two games by an average of 22.5 points.

Pressure Points

Rice leads the nation with 11 sacks through two games.

Twenty

Memphis has scored at least 20 points in 29 consecutive games, marking the longest active streak among FBS teams

Passing Fancy

North Texas QB Chandler Morris' 737 passing yards in 2024 rank second among FBS players. Only Ole Miss QB Jaxon Dart has passed for more yards (795).

One And Only

Memphis QB Seth Henigan is the only fourth-year player in FBS who is starting at quarterback for the same school in all four years.

Within Reach

Memphis QB Seth Henigan enters Week 3 needing 2,694 yards to tie The American's career passing yards record, set by East Carolina's Holton Ahlers from 2018-22. Henigan has 11,072 career passing yards, good for fourth on The American's career chart.

Good Company

South Florida QB Byron Brown was one of two FBS players to finish with at least 3,000 passing yards and 800 rushing yards in 2023. The other was Heisman Trophy-winner Jayden Daniels of LSU.

Clincher

Navy has won 70 consecutive home games when leading after the third quarter. The Midshipmen's last home loss when leading after 45 minutes was in 1999.

Jersey Swap

Rice QB E.J. Warner is the first player to start at quarterback for two American Athletic Conference schools in a career. Warner was a two-year starter at Temple.

Parliamentary Affairs

UTSA plays four of its 12 regular-season games against teams nicknamed 'Owls' (Florida Atlantic, Rice and Temple from The American and Kennesaw State in nonconference play). Army plays The American's three Owl-monikered teams in succession from Sept. 7 to Sept. 26.

Market Share

Under its reconfigured membership, American Athletic Conference media are located in five of the nation's top 10 Nielsen media markets. The American has a presence in 12 of the top 50 markets, while all 14 football-playing schools are situated among the top 103 markets.

Black Friday

One late-season American Athletic Conference game will move to Friday, Nov. 29, for national television opportunities on either ABC or ESPN. The Black Friday selections will come from UAB-Charlotte, Navy-East Carolina, or South Florida-Rice. The selection will be made by Oct. 7

Championship Week

The 2024 American Athletic Conference Football Championship is scheduled for Friday, Dec. 6, and will be televised in prime time on ABC.

2024 MAJOR RULES CHANGES

Coach-To-Player Communications

Coach to player communications through the helmet is permissive in 2024 for the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) based on the following guidelines:

- Only one player may be on the field per team at a time with radio receiving capability and the player must be identified by an unbranded green dot on the back midline of the helmet.
- Coach-to-player communications will be cut off when the play clock reaches 15 seconds or at the snap, whichever comes first. When the play clock resets to 25/40, the communications will be turned back on.
- If more than one green dot helmet is detected on the field by the game officials, the result is a live ball 5-yard equipment violation penalty, and this penalty initiates a conference review.
- On free kick plays, the coach-to-player communications will not be in effect. There is no limitation to the number of green dot helmets for either team during free kick plays.
- A conference may develop a policy to provide guidance in handling situations dealing with communications failure.
- FCS teams playing an FBS team may utilize coach-to-player communications in that game.

Tablets For In-Game Video

Standard Tablets for in-game video only is permissive in 2024 for all football playing subdivisions and are subject to the following guidelines:

- Tablets shall be restricted to "in-game video" (current game) and may not include analytics, data or data-access capability or any other communications access. No other video is allowed (e.g., scouting video, practice video, etc.).
- Tablets may be used in the coach's box, sideline, and locker room and may not be interconnected to other devices to project larger/additional images.
- Video may include coach's sideline, coach's endzone, and a program feed per play from the current game only and may also display "game circumstances," including down/distance/time/quarter/play-number/score.
- A team may have up to 18 standard tablets active, and all team personnel may view the tablets.
- If any team personnel engages an official with a tablet to show or review video, an automatic Unsportsmanlike Conduct foul will result

Two-Minute Timeout

When the game clock is running and the ball is not live, the Referee shall stop the clock with exactly two minutes remaining in the second and fourth quarters for a Two-Minute Timeout. If the ball is live when the game clock reaches two minutes in the second and fourth quarters, the play will continue, and the Referee shall stop the clock when the ball is subsequently declared dead for a Two Minute Timeout.

The radio / TV broadcast partner will hold back at least one media timeout to coincide with the Two-Minute Timeout. If there is no media timeout partner in the game, the timeout shall be one minute plus the five-second referee notification and the 25-second play clock interval.

The play clock will be set at 25 seconds and the clock will start on the snap.

Florida State, which is coached by former Memphis head coach Mike Norvell, looks to bounce back from a surprising 0-2 start to the season after the Seminoles fell 24-21 to Georgia Tech (in Dublin, Ireland) and 28-13 to Boston College ... The Seminoles had won 19 straight games from 2022-23, but have dropped their last three, including last year's Orange Bowl ... Florida State entered the season ranked No. 10 in the preseason polls, but are unranked entering Week 3 ... Norvell went 38-15 in four years at Memphis ... The 38 wins rank fifth among American Athletic Conference coaches ... QB DJ Uiagalelei has passed for 465 yards and a touchdown ... The Seminoles have been held to 59.5 rushing yards per game ... S Shyheim Brown has a team-high 21 tackles.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The Bracket

The format of the College Football Playoff is built on a 12-team bracket. The 12 participating teams are the five conference champions ranked highest by the CFP selection committee, plus the next seven highest-ranked teams. The four highest-ranked conference champions will be seeded 1-4 and will receive first-round byes. The remaining teams, including the fifth conference champion, will be seeded 5-12 based on their final ranking.

- The 12 participating teams will be the five conference champions ranked highest by the CFP selection committee, plus the next seven highest-ranked teams.
- The ranking of the teams will continue to be done by a selection committee.
- The four highest-ranked conference champions will be seeded one through four and will receive a first-round bye. The fifth conference champion will be seeded where it was ranked or at No. 12 if it is outside the top 12 rankings. Non-conference champions ranked in the top four will be seeded beginning at No. 5. Because of this, the seeding, 1 through 12, could look different than the final rankings.
- The eight teams seeded No. 5-12 will play in a first round with the higher seeds hosting the lower seeds either on campus or at other sites designated by the higher-seeded institution (No. 12 at No. 5, No. 11 at No. 6, No. 10 at No. 7 and No. 9 at No. 8).
- The selection committee will assign the four highest-ranked conference champions to Playoff Quarterfinals hosted by bowls. This will be done in consideration of historic bowl relationships, then in consideration of rankings. For example, if the Sugar Bowl hosts a Playoff Quarterfinal and the SEC champion is ranked No. 1 and the Big 12 champion is ranked No. 3, the SEC champion would be assigned to the Sugar Bowl and the Big 12 champion would be assigned elsewhere.
- With the four highest-ranked conference champions assigned to bowls, their four Playoff Quarterfinal opponents will be dictated by the bracket (i.e., No. 1 vs. No. 8/9 winner, No. 4 vs. No. 5/12 winner, No. 2 vs. 7/10 winner; No. 3 vs. 6/11 winner.).
- The College Football Playoff bracket will follow the selection committee's rankings, with no modifications made to avoid rematches between teams that may have played during the regular season or are from the same conference.
- The bracket will remain in effect throughout the playoff (i.e., no re-seeding).
- The highest seed will receive preferential placement for the Playoff Semifinal bowl assignment.
- All 11 games will be under the CFP umbrella with the administrative policies determined by the CFP.

The American Bowl Lineup

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances in 2024 as part of the conference's postseason lineup, which began in the 2020 season and is in place through 2025.

The American Athletic Conference champion would play in the College Football Playoff if it is ranked among the five highest-ranked conference champions by the CFP selection committee.

As part of the current bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Go Bowling Military Bowl in Annapolis, Maryland, and the Wasabi Fenway Bowl in Boston, facing opponents from the Atlantic Coast Conference in those matchups. In 2024, The American will send a team to the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl.

In the 2024 season, The American will additionally fill four spots from a group of eight bowls: the Birmingham Bowl, the StaffDNA Cure Bowl, the Union Home Mortgage Gasparilla Bowl, the Boca Raton Bowl, the Scooter's Coffee Frisco Bowl, the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl, the Isleta New Mexico Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

Aside from the eight primary bowl affiliations in place for the 2024, The American has secondary agreements with the AutoZone Liberty Bowl and the Quick Lane Bowl.
