UTSA Postgame Notes

TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- Texas improved to 3-0 with the win, while UTSA fell to 1-2 on the season.
- Today's game marked the second meeting between UTSA and Texas.
- The Longhorns now own a 2-0 advantage in the series.
- Ranked No. 2 in the AP Top 25 and No. 3 in the AFCA Coaches Poll, Texas is the highest-ranked team UTSA has played in its 14-year history.
- UTSA is now 40-16 (.714) under fifth-year head coach Jeff Traylor.
- UTSA is now 35-22 all-time — 15-6 under Traylor — against teams from the state of Texas.
- The Roadrunners are now 9-3 over their last 12 games.

TEAM NOTES

- The Roadrunners forced two turnovers, an interception by Owen Pewee and a fumble recovery by Tyan Milton.
 - UTSA has four total takeaways this season, two fumble recoveries and a pair of interceptions.
 - UTSA now has come up with a takeaway in 13 consecutive games dating back to last September.
- UTSA rushed for a season-high 128 yards.
- The Roadrunners won the possession battle, holding the football for 31:01 minutes to the Longhorns' 28:59.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior ILB Martavius French logged seven tackles to lead UTSA.
 - He now has 13 stops on the season, slotting him just behind Ken Robinson (14), Brevin Randle (14) and Elliot Davison (14) for the team lead.
- Senior ILB Jamal Ligon, senior ILB Brevin Randle, senior S Elliott Davison and sophomore S Jimmy Wyrick registered five tackles apiece.
- Senior \$B Donyai Taylor recorded three tackles and a sack for a 10-yard loss in his first appearance of the season.
- Sophomore \$B Owen Pewee had an interception return of 11 yards in the first quarter, the second INT of his career.
- Senior RB Robert Henry Jr. rushed for 65 yards on six attempts.
 - His 53-yard TD run in the second quarter is the longest rush of his career.
 - He now has rushed for a team-high 121 yards this season.
 - He now has 12 career rushing TDs, tied for ninth in school history.
- Sophomore QB Owen McCown completed 21-of-29 passes for 132 yards.
 - McCown completed passes to 12 different receivers.
- Sophomore WR Devin McCuin led the receiving corps, hauling in five passes on five targets for 27 yards.
 - McCuin leads UTSA with 22 receptions and 135 yards this season.
- Sophomore WR Jace Wilson had a career-high two receptions for 14 yards.
- Freshman RB Brandon High Jr. rushed for 27 yards on seven carries, both career highs.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- UTSA's captains were junior CB Zah Frazier, senior ILB Martavius French and senior S Elliott Davison.
- Tonight's attendance was 101,892, marking the fourth-largest crowd to see a UTSA game.
