

PREGAME REPORT

SAN ANTONIO, Texas — Following two-straight home games, the HCU football team hits the road to take on FBS-member UTSA this Saturday at the Alamodome. Saturday's game will be shown on ESPN+ with Ted Emrich providing play-by-play and Charlie Strong serving as analyst while Garrett Jones provides the radio play-by-play call on Patriot Talk 920 AM.

The Huskies (1-2) head into the matchup with the American Athletic Conference squad coming off a 70-7 win over Louisiana Christian this past Saturday, Sept. 14. HCU finished that game

with 496 yards of total offense with four touchdowns through the air, four on the ground, one from the defense and one on special teams.



At quarterback, Eli Brickhandler and Cutter Stewart each threw for 126 yards and two touchdowns. Stewart currently ranks 11th in the FCS with 14.39 yards per completion.

The Huskies' defense is tied for third in the FCS with five interceptions already, including two from safety Xavier Toliver. Toliver now has five career picks, tied for the most in program history. Toliver's fellow defensive back, Semaj Brown, accounted for two HCU touchdowns against LCU. Brown opened the game with an 83-yard kickoff return touchdown and in the third quarter took a pick-six 65 yards for score number two.

The Roadrunners (1-2) opened the season with a 28-16 home win over Kennesaw State before dropping a pair of road matchups at Texas State and at No. 2 Texas. Sophomore wide receiver Devin McCuin has already totaled 22 receptions with his 7.3 receptions per game ranking 13th in the FBS. Senior Robert Henry Jr. has been UTSA's top running back, averaging 5.8 yards per carry with 121 yards on 21 carries. Owen McCown, son of longtime NFL quarterback Josh McCown, has thrown for 575 yards and three touchdowns without an interception through the first three games.

Defensively, senior linebacker Jimmori Robinson leads the way with two sacks while a pair of safeties, Ken Robinson and Elliott Davison, and a linebacker, Brevin Randle, are tied for the team-lead with 14 tackles. As a unit, the Roadrunners' defense is holding opponents to just a 33.3 percent success rate on third downs.

STORYLINES

BALL HAWK TOLIVER

Redshirt junior safety has recorded an interception in each of the last 2 games, giving him 5 for his career and tying him for the most career interceptions by a Husky in program history. He had one during his freshman season in 2021 before adding 2 in 2022.

Toliver and the HCU defense are currently tied for 3rd in the FCS with 5 interceptions through the first 3 games of the year.

MAKING THE MOST OF THEIR OPPORTUNITIES

The HCU offense ranks 5th in the FCS with 15.49 yards per completion with redshirt freshman quarterback Cutter Stewart checking in at 11th nationally in passing yards per completion (14.39). AJ Wilson, a redshirt sophomore, leads the team and is 34th in the FCS with 18.29 yards per reception while junior Deuce McMillan ranks 79th at 15.17 yards per catch.

NEW LINEBACKER CORPS STEPPING UP

The HCU linebacker group features a number of new faces this season-with the departures of the all-American duo of Rodney Dansby and Jalyx Hunt. Junior Taylor Behl, a transfer from Campbell, has racked up 22 tackles in the last 2 games while senior Tarleton State transfer D.J. Harris is 2nd on the team with 19 tackles. Junior Braden Hay missed last game but totaled 14 tackles in the first two and senior Ruperake Fuavai has 17 through three.

CHANDLEY, WITH A BOOT...

HCU true freshman punter Reed Chandley currently ranks 9th in the FCS with an average of 46 yards per punt. He showed off an impressive leg in his collegiate debut at SMU (8/31), averaging 48.75 yards per punt and has 6 punts of 50+ yards with 4 inside the opponents' 20-yard line.

VALENZUELA AN ALL-PURPOSE THREAT

Senior running back Jesse Valenzuela leads the Huskies with 63.3 all-purpose yards per game, thanks in part to his kick/punt return efforts. Valenzuela is 13th in the FCS and leads the Southland Conference with 12.6 yards per punt return with 5 returns for 63 yards.

BACHTEL TAKES THE REINS AS 3RD HEAD COACH IN HCU HISTORY

HCU announced Jason Bachtel as the third head coach in program history on Jan. 4, 2024. Bachtel spent the 2023 season as the Huskies' offensive coordinator, helping guide HCU to a 6-5 record and the Southland Conference's top rushing offense. After taking over the head job, Bachtel and his staff secured the top high school recruiting class in the FCS. Bachtel has two previous years of collegiate head coaching experience, leading Division III Howard Payne in Brownsville, TX to back-to-back 7-3 records in 2021 and 2022 for a 14-6 overall head coaching record.

PRESEASON SLC ACCOLADES

Three Huskies, senior kicker Dillon Fedor, senior offensive lineman Dion Daniels and junior defensive tackle Zae Smith, were all named preseason all-Southland Conference. Fedor, a 1st team preseason all-SLC selection, was the league's first team all-conference kicker last season after connecting on 10-of-13 field goal attempts and going a perfect 31-of-31 on extra points. Daniels and Smith were each second team preseason picks with Daniels starting every game on the HCU o-line in 2023 with 25 career games and 16 career starts under his belt. Smith, meanwhile, finished his sophomore year with 3.5 sacks, 24 tackles, two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery in 8 games.

HUSKIES BOAST A STABLE OF RUNNING BACKS

The HCU rushing attack ranked first in the Southland Conference last season with 158.4 yards per game on the ground with three players sharing primary duties over the course of the season. In the team's 10 games last

year, Jesse Valenzuela, Darryle Evans and Champ Dozier (all returners in 2024) combined to carry the ball 253 times for 1,272 yards to average better than five yards per carry. They also combined for 10 rushing touchdowns. Dozier, as a true freshman, opened the year as the team's starter for the first four games before injury ended his campaign and earned a spot as one of 22 players nationally named to the Jerry Rice Award (FCS Top Freshman) Watch List. Dozier finished with four touchdowns and 294 yards on 57 carries.

Valenzuela finished the year averaging 5.4 yards per carry with five touchdowns. He gained 542 yards on 101 carries while Evans rushed 95 times for 436 yards and had consecutive games with 132 and 173 yards rushing, respectively. On top of that trio, HCU added senior transfer running back Calvin Hill who appeared in 43 games for Texas State and has 1,701 yards on 352 carries with 10 rushing TDs in his career. Hill also has 60 career receptions for 394 yards. Additionally, true freshman Xai'Shaun Edwards signed with the Huskies from nearby Clear Springs High School as a three-star recruit with offers from Oregon, Missouri, Houston, Texas State, Texas Tech, UTSA, Tulsa and UIW.

PROFESSIONAL HUSKIES

Linebacker/EDGE Jalyx Hunt became the first player drafted from HCU when he was selected by the Philadlphia Eagles in the third round with the 94th pick of the 2024 NFL Draft. He joins Bailey Zappe, who was a four-year starter for the Huskies before getting drafted in the fourth round of the 2022 NFL draft out of Western Kentucky as Huskies selected in the NFL draft. Jacksonville Jaguars linebacker Caleb Johnson is in his fourth season in the NFL and his third with the Jaguars after signing with the Chicago Bears as an undrafted free agent in 2021. Safety Tra Fluellen, who spent two seasons with the Huskies and was a freshman all-American in 2019, was selected by the UFL Houston Roughnecks with their second pick in the 2024 UFL College Draft.

LINEBACKER U

An HCU linebacker led the Southland Conference and ranked among the top five in the FCS from 2016 through 2022. Last season, LB/EDGE Jalyx Hunt wreaked havoc on the SLC and earned Defensive Player of the Year honors. Linebacker Rodney Dansby led the league and ranked second nationally with 11.5 tackles per game in 2022 and 11.3 tackles per game in 2021. Caleb Johnson led the league and ranked fourth nationally with 12.2 tackles per game in 2020. Brennan Young led the league and ranked fifth in the FCS with 11.3 tackles per game in 2019. In 2018, Langston Tunson led the conference and ranked fourth in the nation and in both 2016 and 2017, Garrett Dolan led the conference and ranked second in the nation to earn back-to-back All-America honors.

Young became the second HCU player to top 400 career tackles for his career, joining the late Garrett Dolan, who ranks 12th in FCS history with 467.

BUILDING MOMENTUM AS A PROGRAM

Still a relatively young program (HCU's first official season was 2014), the 2023 Huskies finished the season 6-5 overall and 4-3 in Southland Conference play, the first winning season in program history and the most conference wins in a season under first-year head coach Braxton Harris.

New HCU head coach Jason Bachtel is no stranger to building a winning program following Harris as the head of a program, having done it previously at Howard Payne. Harris spent three seasons as head coach at HPU, improving from 1-9 his first year to 5-5 in his third, and final, season (2019). Following a disrupted and shortened 2020-21 campaign, Bachtel led HPU to a 7-3 record in both 2021 and 2022, giving the program its first winning season since 2005.

GAME 1

SMU 59, HCU 7 + Aug. 31 + Dallas, Texas

DALLAS, Texas – HCU football dropped its season-opening game on Saturday night at Gerald J. Ford Stadium, falling to ACC newcomer SMU by a 59-7 final.

HCU (0-1) opened the game on defense, forcing the Mustangs (2-0) into a quick three-and-out and forcing a punt. The Huskies picked up a pair of quick first downs before the drive stalled out at the HCU 45 leading to a Reed Chandley punt. SMU then scored on four consecutive drives and added another score on a fumble recovery to build a 35-0 lead.

Following that fifth SMU touchdown, the Huskies started the ensuing drive at the 50 after a penalty against the hosts was enforced on the kickoff and the kick went out of bounds. On third and seven, Cutter Stewart connected with Ismael Fuller down the right side for a 37-yard completion to the SMU 10. On the next play, Stewart stepped up under pressure and found Deuce McMillan at the back of the end zone for a 10-yard touchdown pass and the PAT made it a 35-7 ballgame with 12:19 remaining in the first half.

Braden Hay, a junior linebacker, led the Huskies with eight tackles, including one for a loss, and had a fumble recovery. Sophomore Andrew Huff added seven tackles while Caleb King and Ashton Williams had six apiece. The HCU defense finished the night with five tackles for loss.

Offensively, redshirt freshman Champ Dozier led HCU with 94 all-purpose yards. He finished with 48 kickoff return yards along with 22 yards on seven carries and three receptions for 24 yards. Redshirt freshman quarterback Cutter Stewart ended the night completing 10-of-25 through the air for 118 yards, a touchdown and a pair of interceptions.

GAME 2

#20 Tarleton State 35, HCU 18 • Sept. 7 • Husky Stadium

HOUSTON – The HCU football team fell short in its 2024 home opener on Saturday evening at Husky Stadium, dropping a 35-18 decision to 20th-ranked Tarleton State in the program's first-ever non-conference home matchup with a ranked opponent.

The Huskies (0-2) started the game with the ball, moving 47 yards on eight plays with a pair of quick completions to Calvin Stewart and a 20-yard scamper by Champ Dozier but the drive stalled out at the Tarleton State (2-1) 29 when a fourth-and-10 attempt failed in the face of strong winds. The Texans then took over and moved the ball 30 yards on eight plays before ultimately failing to convert on fourth down themselves, giving HCU the ball at the HCU 42.

The game remained scoreless through the first quarter with the visitors in the midst of a drive that became an 11-play, 84-yard touchdown drive early in the second quarter. The Huskies began their next possession at their own 23-yard line but a Cutter Stewart pass on second-and-10 was picked off by Donta Stuart, setting up Tarleton State with a short field. Two plays later, Daniel Greek found Cody Jackson in the end zone for another score and a 14-0 advantage.

HCU answered on their next drive, however, with Deuce McMillan totaling 30 yards on a pair of receptions and Calvin Hill rushing for consecutive 13-yard gains to put the Huskies at the visitors' six-yard line. Dozier then rushed twice and scored on a three-yard gain to cut the HCU deficit in half with 9:49 left in the half.

The Texans tacked on another score with just 2:21 remaining thanks to a 13-play, 75-yard drive that chewed up 7:22 off the clock and sent the teams into the locker rooms at the half with Tarleton State leading, 21-7.

On the opening drive of the second half, safety Xavier Toliver intercepted a pass at the HCU 44 and returned it 41 yards down the Texans' 15 to give HCU a short field and a chance to get back within seven. The Huskies moved up to the six-yard line on an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty but couldn't punch it in to the end zone and settled for a 23-yard Dillon Fedor field goal.

Tarleton State put together another long touchdown drive in response, again taking it 75 yards on 15 plays and taking more than seven minutes off the clock, extending its lead to 28-10. The Huskies went three-and-out on their next drive and the Texans took advantage, pushing their lead to 25 on a nine-yard touchdown pass from Greek to Darius Cooper with 13:57 on the clock.

The Huskies moved the ball on the ensuing possession, taking it 53 yards on nine plays in just over two minutes before coming up just short on a four-yard completion from Stewart to Jesse Valenzuela on fourth-and-five at the Tarleton 22. The Texans missed a 40-yard field goal attempt on the next drive, leaving HCU with the ball at its own 23. Stewart then went 6-of-10 on the next HCU possession, marching 77 yards downfield and connecting with AJ Wilson for a 19-yard touchdown. Stewart then found Wilson in the endzone for a successful two-point conversion to pull HCU back to the final of 35-18.

HCU 70, Louisiana Christian 7 + Sept. 14 + Husky Stadium

HOUSTON – HCU head football coach Jason Bachtel's first victory as the leader of the Huskies' program was a memorable one as the Huskies set a new single-game scoring record, defeating visiting Louisiana Christian 70-7 on Saturday night at Husky Stadium.

HCU's point total surpasses the previous high of 68 that was set during the 2019 season in a 68-31 win over Texas Southern.

The game started with fireworks as Semaj Brown returned the opening kickoff 83 yards for his first collegiate touchdown on his first-ever kick return to stake the Huskies (1-2) to a quick 7-0 lead. On the first possession by the Wildcats (0-2), HCU forced a turnover on downs but then turned the ball right back over on the first play of the next drive on a Deuce McMillan fumble at the visitors' 26.

Evans racked up the third 100-yard rushing performance of his career, finishing the night with 122 yards on just 12 carries with a pair of touchdowns. Brickhandler and Stewart each threw for 126 yards and two touchdowns while nine different receivers registered receptions. Wilson led the way with three catches for 77 yards and a score.

Defensively, Ruperake Fuavai and Taylor Behl led the team with nine tackles with Jayhvion Gipson and Isaiah Johnson each finishing with eight. Johnson and Rufus Toe each had 2.5 tackles for loss.
