## « OPENING DRIVE »

• UTSA and East Carolina will meet for the second time on Saturday.

• The Roadrunners registered a 41-27 home triumph over the Pirates in the first meeting on Oct. 28, 2023.

• UTSA is 8-4 all-time and a perfect 4-0 under head coach Jeff Traylor in conference openers.

• The Roadrunners will open league play on the road for the third consecutive season and ninth time overall.

• UTSA is 27-4 (.871) in regular season conference games in the Jeff Traylor era and 29-4 (.879) when including the 2021 and 2022 Conference USA Championship Games.

• The Roadrunners have been victorious in 15 of their last 16 regular season league contests.

• UTSA logged a 7-1 conference record in 2023 in its American Athletic Conference debut season.

• Jeff Traylor boasts a 41-16 overall record at UTSA, the most wins and best winning percentage (.719) in program history.

• Traylor will match Larry Coker for most games coached at UTSA with his 58th against East Carolina this Saturday.

• UTSA has won 10 of its last 13 games dating back to last October.

• The Roadrunners are riding a streak of 14 consecutive games with a takeaway and a sack.

## SETTING THE SCENE

Fresh off a 45-7 victory over Houston Christian to close out the non-conference slate, UTSA will open American Athletic Conference play against East Carolina on Saturday, Sept. 28. Kickoff is set for 3 p.m. Central time at Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium in Greenville, North Carolina, and the game will air on ESPN+ and Sports Radio AM 760 The Ticket. The Roadrunners and Pirates will carry identical 2-2 records in the league lid-lifter, in what will be the second meeting between the two teams. UTSA scored a 41-27 home triumph over ECU on Oct. 28, 2023, at the Alamodome.

### **TUNING IN**

Saturday's game will air on ESPN+ and via the ESPN mobile app. Richard Cross (play-by-play) and Reginald Walker Jr. (analyst) will call the action. UTSA Sports Media Network will air the game live in the San Antonio area on Sports Radio AM 760 The Ticket, online at ticket760.com and via the free iHeartRadio app. Andy Everett (play-by-play), Jay Riley (analyst) and Ed Suarez (reporter) have the call. There will be a two-hour pregame show hosted by Pat Evans and a 45-minute postgame show.

### LAST TIME OUT

UTSA piled up a season-high 536 yards of offense and a school-record 34 first downs and held Houston Christian to just 177 yards in a 45-7 victory last Saturday at the Alamodome. Bryson Donnell and Brandon High Jr. each rushed for a gamehigh 74 yards, while Kevorian Barnes added 64 yards to lead the ground game. Owen McCown completed 18 of 25 passes for 226 yards and three touchdowns. Devin McCuin had a team-best five receptions for 43 yards and a TD, and Willie McCoy racked up 85 yards and a score on two catches. Defensively, Jimmori Robinson had seven tackles, two tackles for loss, one sack, one forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a blocked field goal to help the Roadrunners limit the Huskies to seven points and 50 rushing yards, the fewest allowed since Rice ran for 47 on Nov. 11, 2023. UTSA totaled seven TFLs, including four sacks, as Joe Evans, Owen Pewee and Ronald Triplette joined Robinson in the sack column. The Roadrunners also kept their turnover streak alive on Robinson's forced fumble and recovery in the first quarter, extending the stretch of consecutive games with a takeaway to 14.

## **UTSA IN CONFERENCE OPENERS**

UTSA is 8-4 all-time in conference openers, including a perfect 4-0 under head coach Jeff Traylor. The Roadrunners beat Middle Tennessee in three straight Conference USA lid-lifters before scoring a 49-34 road triumph over Temple last year in their American Athletic Conference debut. This will mark the third straight and ninth time overall that the Roadrunners have opened the league slate on the road.

## **SCOUTING EAST CAROLINA**

The Pirates fell to 2-2 on the season with a 35-24 road setback to Liberty on Saturday night. East Carolina opened the campaign with back-to-win wins over Norfolk State (42-3) and Old Dominion (20-14) before dropping the last two to Appalachian State (21-19) and Liberty. The Pirates are averaging 26.3 points and 406.8 yards per game while allowing 18.3 points and 330.0 yards per contest. Zakye Baker paces the defense with 38 total tackles, including a team-high six for loss. Gavin Gibson and Shavon Revel Jr. share the team lead with two interceptions apiece. Offensively, Jake Garcia has completed 86 of 138 passes for 1,021 yards and five

touchdowns, but he has thrown nine interceptions this year. Winston Wright Jr. is the top pass-catcher with 18 receptions for 207 yards and a TD. Rahjai Harris leads the ground game with 289 rushing yards and three scores on 63 carries. Head coach Mike Houston is 26-36 in his sixth season at the helm.

### SERIES HISTORY

This will mark the second meeting between UTSA and East Carolina. The Roadrunners registered a 41-27 victory over the Pirates in the first matchup on Oct. 28, 2023, at the Alamodome.

### LAST MEETING

Frank Harris threw for 395 yards and four touchdowns and Trey Moore had three sacks to break the program's single-season record and help UTSA to a 41-27 victory over East Carolina in American Athletic Conference action on Oct. 28, 2023, at the Alamodome. Harris completed 20 of 32 passes to rack up a season high in passing yards while notching his 12th career 300-yard game. The senior found eight different receivers, including Joshua Cephus, who piled up a career-high 183 yards - the third-most in program history - and a touchdown on only four catches. In fact, his TD went for 84 yards, the longest pass play in school annals. UTSA tallied a season-high 516 yards of offense, as Tykee Ogle-Kellogg hauled in five passes for 85 yards and a pair of scores while Rocko Griffin rushed for 80 yards on only five attempts. Meanwhile, Moore eclipsed Clarence Hicks's school standard for sacks in a season of 10.5 from the 2021 campaign. The defense also came up with a takeaway for the fifth game in a row, as Elliott Davison picked off a pass in the end zone. Jamal Ligon and Ken Robinson matched Moore with seven stops, while Brandon Matterson and Owen Pewee each registered a sack to give the Roadrunners five for the game.

## **ON EASTERN TIME**

The Roadrunners will play the first of two regular season games in the Eastern time zone this season. UTSA is 7-8 all-time in games played in the Eastern time zone with road wins against Georgia State in 2012, Charlotte in 2015, Old Dominion in 2019, Army West Point and FIU in 2022 and Temple and Florida Atlantic last fall.

Now in their 14th season of play, the Roadrunners will play the 164th game in program history on Saturday when they face East Carolina. UTSA is 86-77 (.528) all-time and 34-44 (.436) in road games. East Carolina has been playing football since 1932 and owns an all-time record of 466-456-11.

### IT'S A HOOT

The Roadrunners will face all four FBS teams that use the nickname Owls during the 2024 season. UTSA opened the campaign on Aug. 31 against the Kennesaw State Owls, who are making their debut in Conference USA this year. The Roadrunners also will meet three American Athletic Conference teams who are the Owls: Rice (Oct. 12), Florida Atlantic (Oct. 19) and Temple (Nov. 22).

## TRAYLOR TABBED TOP AAC COACH BY ATHLON SPORTS

Athlon Sports picked UTSA's Jeff Traylor as its top head coach in the American Athletic Conference for the 2024 season. Traylor tops the list of the league's 14 head coaches as selected by senior college football writer and editor Steve Lassan. A two-time conference coach of the year, the Gilmer, Texas, native has led the Roadrunners to the most wins and best winning percentage (.719) by any coach in program history. UTSA has captured a pair of conference championships, earned four straight bowl berths and made a combined 23 appearances in the three major national polls under his leadership. Under Traylor's guidance, UTSA student-athletes have collected awards and honors at a recordbreaking pace. During his time in San Antonio, he has coached seven All-Americans, three national award finalists, 83 all-conference selections and a pair of NFL Draft picks. That success is not limited to just the gridiron. The Roadrunners also have received numerous honors for their work in the classroom during the Traylor tenure, including three College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-Americans, 12 CSC Academic All-District Selections and four conference all-academic team selections. Additionally, UTSA was one only 13 FBS programs to receive the 2023 AFCA Academic Achievement Award for graduation success.

## **BURKE CHOSEN FOR 40 UNDER 40 LIST**

UTSA offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach Justin Burke was chosen for the Dave Campbell's Texas Football 40 Under 40, as the publication recognized 40 of the rising stars in the coaching ranks in the state of Texas. This marks the fourth consecutive year a UTSA coach has been honored, as Burke joins running backs coach/NFL liaison Julian Griffin (2021), associate head coach/pass game coordinator/wide receivers coach Joe Price (2023) and former co-offensive coordinator Will Stein (2022). A veteran of the UTSA staff since 2020, Burke is in his second season as the Roadrunners' offensive coordinator and his first coaching the quarterbacks. He served as associate head coach, special teams coordinator and tight ends coach during the 2022 regular season before being promoted to co-offensive coordinator for the Cure Bowl.

### TRAYLOR TAKING ROADRUNNERS TO NEW HEIGHTS

Head coach Jeff Traylor has guided UTSA to new heights since taking over the program prior to the 2020 campaign. The Gilmer, Texas, native has turned around the program by instilling his 210 Triangle of Toughness culture, producing results on and off the field. Taking over a team that won a combined seven games in the two seasons prior to his arrival, he has led the Roadrunners to a 41-16 record through 57 games, the most wins all-time and best winning percentage (.719) by a UTSA head football coach. In fact, he will match Larry Coker's program standard for most games coached of 58 set from 2011-15 with the East Carolina game this weekend. In the Jeff Traylor era, the Roadrunners are 25-3 (.93) at home. They own a 27-4 (.871) record in regular season conference games and are 29-4 (.879) against league competition when including the 2021 and 2022 Conference USA Championship Games. Under Traylor's direction, UTSA has won back-to-back conference championships, has been nationally ranked in all three major polls in 2021 and 2022 and has played in a bowl game in each of his four seasons, including defeating Marshall, 35-17, in the 2023 Frisco Bowl for the program's first bowl win. The two-time conference coach of the year has coached eight All-Americans, three national award finalists, 13 national award semifinalists, seven conference superlative award recipients, 83 all-conference selections, two academic All-Americans and a pair of NFL Draft picks during his UTSA tenure. He was the 2021 AFCA Region 4 Coach of the Year and he has been a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year twice in addition to being a finalist for the 2022 Paul "Bear" Bryant Awards Coach of the Year, 2021 AFCA National Coach of the Year and the 2021 George Munger College Coach of the Year.

### **HISTORY MADE IN FRISCO**

The Roadrunners made history on Dec. 19, 2023, registering the school's first bowl win with a 35-17 victory over Marshall in the Scooter's Coffee Frisco Bowl. UTSA trailed 14-0 early in the contest but outscored the Thundering Herd, 35-3, the rest of the way to improve to 1-4 all-time in bowl games. The Roadrunners have made four consecutive bowl games and five appearances overall dating back to the 2016 New Mexico Bowl.

### **SEASON 14**

One of the newest FBS programs and now in its second year as a member of the American Athletic Conference, UTSA is in its 14th season of football in 2024. The Roadrunners started their program from scratch and, following a practice year in 2010, played their first season as an FCS Independent in 2011 before joining the Western Athletic Conference for the 2012 campaign. UTSA moved into Conference USA in 2013 and became a full-fledged FBS member starting with the 2014 season. The Roadrunners set NCAA modern startup program records in 2011 by drawing 56,743 fans to their inaugural game against Northeastern State and by averaging 35,521 fans for their six home contests that season. UTSA made its first postseason appearance at the 2016 New Mexico Bowl in its sixth season of play and registered its first win against a team from the Big 12 Conference the following season with a 17-10 victory over Baylor. The Roadrunners made history in 2021, opening the fall with a road win against Illinois of the Big Ten Conference, capturing their first conference championship with a 49-42 decision against WKU and capping a 12-2 ledger with their third bowl game. They repeated as league champions with a 48-27 win over North Texas in 2022 and made their third straight and fourth overall bowl appearance, ending the year with an 11-3 mark. Last fall, the Roadrunners notched their first bowl victory with a 35-17 decision over Marshall in the Frisco Bowl to cap a 9-4 ledger that include a 7-1 mark in their debut in The American. UTSA now has posted at least six wins in eight of the 13 full seasons in program history and it has reached the seven-win plateau six times, including in each of the first four years of the Jeff Traylor era.

# **DOWN TO THE WIRE**

UTSA is no stranger to close contests in the Jeff Traylor era, as 31 of the 57 have been one-score ballgames in the fourth quarter. The Roadrunners own a 22-9 record in those games. Dating back to the 2021 campaign, UTSA has seen 18 of the last 35 contests decided in the fourth quarter or later. Additionally, the Roadrunners are 13-4 (.765) in games decided by eight points or less since 2021.

### **HIGH-SCORING ROADRUNNERS**

UTSA has emerged as one of the top scoring offenses in the FBS under head coach Jeff Traylor. In his second season at the helm in 2021, the Roadrunners set school records for scoring, tallying 516 total points in 14 contests for a program-record 36.9 points per game to rank 11th nationally. The following year, the Roadrunners came up just shy of the school record with 515 points in 14 games for an average of 36.8 per game, good for 14th in the FBS. UTSA scored 30-plus points in 12 of the 14 contests, and they topped the 40-point barrier seven times and the 50-point plateau twice. The Roadrunners scored 415 points in 13 games in 2023, good for an average of 31.9 per

In fact, those three seasons rank as the top three scoring totals and averages in program history. UTSA has scored 20-plus points in 43 of the last 49 games dating back to the 2020 campaign. The Roadrunners have tallied 1,875 points in 57 games under head coach Jeff Traylor, good for an average of 32.9 points per game.

## **OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION**

UTSA had an offensive explosion in the home victory over Houston Christian last Saturday. The Roadrunners racked up season highs of 45 points, 536 total yards, 269 rushing yards and a school-record 34 first downs against the Huskies. UTSA's offensive output added up to the most yards since a school-record 643 against South Florida on Nov. 17, 2023, and featured the most rushing yards since going for 287 versus North Texas on Nov. 4, 2023. The 34 first downs eclipsed the previous UTSA standard of 32 done five times, most recently in the win against South Florida last fall. In fact, the 34 first downs are tied for the fourth-most in a game this season among all FBS teams.

### **EXPERIENCE UP FRONT**

UTSA once again boasts one of the most experienced offensive lines in the FBS this fall. Entering the season, the Roadrunners owned a combined 238 career games played and 116 career starts up front, figures that ranked seventh and 13th, respectively, among all FBS teams. Through the first four contests this season, those numbers have increased to 275 games and 136 starts. Redshirt junior Walker Baty has played in a team-high 41 games with 13 starts, while senior transfer CJ James Jr., who appears on the Rimington Trophy Watch List, paces the unit in starts with 36, 34 coming during his previous stops at New Mexico and Abilene Christian. Makai Hart has 26 career starts in 28 games, Venly Tatafu totes 26 appearances and 22 starts, and junior Luke Lapeze has 27 games and 11 starts under his belt. Honorable mention all-conference performer Cory Godinet made 10 starts in 13 appearances last fall and earned the start at right guard in each of the first four games this year. Transfers Kamar Missouri and Jaylen Garth have started at both tackle spots and now have played in 23 and 13 games, respectively. Sixth-year senior Demetris Allen owns four starts in 23 career games as a Roadrunner, while Deandre Marshall has 19 games on his resumé, Buffalo Kruize has seen action in 16 contests and Ben Rios has played in seven.

### **CARDENAS IS CLUTCH**

Senior tight end Oscar Cardenas has developed a reputation for making clutch catches during his career. The San Antonio Brandeis High School product played a role in one of the iconic moments in program history, hauling in the game-winning TD reception after a tipped pass with three seconds left in the 34-31 home victory over UAB in 2021. He also had a 28-yard catch on that game-winning drive versus the Blazers to help the Roadrunners clinch the Conference USA West Division title. In 2022, Cardenas caught two balls in the opener against No. 24 Houston, including a key 25-yard reception that set up the game-tying field goal as time expired. He also made a one-handed grab and then hurdled a defender for a 35-yard play on the final drive of the 31-27 victory over North Texas to set up the game-winning touchdown pass on the following play. Last season, the John Mackey Award Watch List member caught 32 passes for 280 yards and a pair of touchdowns en route to third-team All-American Athletic Conference accolades. A sixth-year senior, Cardenas became the ninth Roadrunner and just the second tight end to surpass 1,000 career receiving yards after catching two passes for 38 yards and a touchdown in the 28-16 season-opening win over Kennesaw State. After posting three catches for 21 yards against Houston Christian, he now has 89 receptions for 1,070 yards and seven touchdowns in 61 career games as a Roadrunner.

### **GROUND GAME GETS GOING**

After a slow start to the season, the Roadrunners rushing attack exploded for 269 yards in the 45-7 home triumph over Houston Christian. UTSA had tallied 269 yards on the ground through the first three games and then doubled the season output in the victory against the Huskies. Bryson Donnell and Brandon High Jr. each rushed for a game-high 74 yards with High also reaching the end zone for the first time in his young career, while Kevorian Barnes added 64 yards and a touchdown to spearhead the ground game. Barnes, who is UTSA's active career leader with 1,687 yards and 13 touchdowns in 31 games, and High each have tallied 111 rushing yards this year, while Robert Henry Jr. leads all rushers with 157 and a TD.

### McATTACK

UTSA's offense features a trio of weapons whose last names all start with Mc in senior wide receiver Willie McCoy, redshirt sophomore quarterback Owen McCown and sophomore wide receiver Devin McCuin. McCoy and McCuin have combined for 38 receptions, 393 yards and five touchdowns to lead a receiving corps that rotates as many as seven players. McCoy, a senior from Houston, has a team-high 215 yards and two TDs on 11 catches, while McCuin owns a team-best 27 receptions for 178 yards and three scores. In his first year as the starting QB, McCown has directed the "McAttack" by throwing for 803 yards and six TDs on 77-of-115 passing, good for a 67-percent completion rate and 142.8 pass efficiency rating.

### **MCCUIN EMERGES AS RECEIVING THREAT**

UTSA wide receiver Devin McCuin emerged as one of the team's top receiving threats as a true freshman last year and he has started off his sophomore season on the right foot. In 2023, the Jacksonville, Texas, native nearly broke a freshman record that has stood since UTSA's inaugural season in 2011, as he piled up 546 receiving yards and three touchdowns on 42 catches to come up only 32 yards shy of Kam Jones' freshman standard of 578. He had a 72-yard TD reception against Army that now ranks as the eighth-longest pass play in program history and he nearly notched his first career 100-yard game with 94 in the 49-34 win at Temple and again with 91 in the 49-21 home triumph over South Florida. McCuin opened the 2024 campaign with a career night, catching 11 passes — one shy of the school record and tied for the seventh-best total in the FBS this fall - for 79 yards and two touchdowns in the 28-16 win over Kennesaw State. He followed that with a team-high six receptions versus Texas State five catches at No. 2 Texas and five grabs for 43 yards in the win over Houston Christian. He currently paces the American Athletic Conference and ranks 13th nationally with 6.8 receptions per game, and he stands third in the league and 30th in the FBS with three receiving TDs.

## **BORN TO PLAY QB**

UTSA redshirt sophomore Owen McCown was born to play quarterback. The lefthander is the son of Josh McCown, who was a third-round draft pick in 2002 and played 18 seasons in the NFL after a collegiate career at SMU and Sam Houston. Two of his uncles also played the position. Luke McCown starred at Louisiana Tech before he was selected in the fourth round of the 2004 NFL Draft and enjoyed a 12-year NFL career. Randy McCown played quarterback at Texas A&M from 1996-99, helping the Aggies to the 1998 Big 12 Conference Championship. Those three McCown brothers all played for UTSA head coach Jeff Traylor when he was an assistant coach at Jacksonville High School in the 1990s. Owen won the starting quarterback job coming out of training camp this season and he made the best of his second start as a Roadrunner. He completed 28 of 38 passes for 340 yards and three touchdowns and also ran for another score to help lead UTSA to a 28-16 victory over Kennesaw State, earning Manning Award QB of the Week and American Athletic Conference Honorable Mention Player of the Week accolades for his performance. In his last outing, McCown completed 18 of 25 passes for 226 yards and three TDs in the 45-7 win over Houston Christian. In his first start at UTSA last December, the transfer from Colorado threw for 251 yards and two TDs on 22-of-31 passing to help guide the Roadrunners to a 35-17 triumph over Marshall in the 2023 Frisco Bowl for the program's first-ever bowl win. He made a splash in his UTSA debut last September by breaking the school's single-game completion percentage record against No. 20 Tennessee, connecting on 18 of 20 passes (90%) for 170 yards and a pair of TDs. Through four games this season, McCown has

thrown for 803 yards and six TDs on 77-of-115 passing (67.0%) with zero interceptions.

## TAKEAWAY STREAK

UTSA will enter the American Athletic Conference opener with a streak of 14 consecutive games with a takeaway, a stretch that started on Sept. 23, 2023 at No. 20 Tennessee. After going through the first three games of the 2023 season without a takeaway, the Roadrunners finished with 17 over the last 10 contests. UTSA tallied 10 interceptions, led by two apiece from Elliott Davison, Nicktroy Fortune and Kam Alexander, and recovered seven fumbles, paced by two from Ronald Triplette last year. The Roadrunners have opened 2024 with at least one takeaway in each of the first four contests. Jimmy Wyrick forced a key fumble that was recovered by Syrus Dumas in the fourth quarter of the 28-16 win over Kennesaw State. On the opening possession against Texas State, Zach Morris registered the Roadrunners' first interception of the campaign. Owen Pewee had a first-quarter interception and Brevin Randle recovered a fumble in the second half versus No. 2 Texas, while Jimmori Robinson forced a recovered a fumble in the 45-7 victory against Houston Christian to push the season takeaway total to five and the streak to 14 games.

### SACK ATTACK

UTSA enjoyed a record-setting season in 2023 for tackles for loss and sacks, and the defense has started the 2024 season with similar numbers. Last fall, the Roadrunners registered 99 tackles behind the line of scrimmage to eclipse the previous standard of 96 set in 2019. UTSA also shattered the program mark for sacks with 46, 13 more than the previous record established in 2021 with the benefit of one more game. The Roadrunners led the American Athletic Conference in both categories and they ranked second in the FBS in sacks per game (3.54) and fifth in tackles for loss per contest (7.6). UTSA has tallied 28 tackles for loss and nine sacks through four games in 2024, logging at least five TFLs and a sack in each game this fall. In the seasonopening win over Kennesaw State, the Roadrunners racked up 10 tackles behind the line, including a trio of sacks. That marked the fifth time UTSA has tallied double-digit TFLs in a game over the past two seasons. In the 45-7 home triumph over Houston Christian, the Roadrunners recorded seven TFLs and four sacks, now the 10th time to register three-plus sacks during the past two seasons. They currently rank sixth in The American and 28th in the FBS in tackles for loss per game (7.0) and fourth in the conference and 46th nationally in sacks per game (2.25). UTSA enters Saturday's game riding a stretch of 14 consecutive contests with a sack.

## **D-LINE DEPTH KEEPS ROADRUNNERS FRESH**

UTSA has taken advantage of a deep defensive line room with a rotation aimed to keep players fresh throughout the game. The Roadrunners played at least nine d-linemen and as many as a dozen in three different games in 2023. UTSA rotated nine players up front in the 28-16 season-opening victory over Kennesaw State, as Brandon Brown, Jameian Buxton, Christian Clayton, Joe Evans, Tai Leonard, Chidera Otutu, Asyrus Simon, Ronald Triplette and Daemian Wimberly all saw action. Those nine plus Jon Jones played in each of the next two games, and the Roadrunners went back to a nine-man rotation in the 45-7 win against Houston Christian. UTSA welcomed back eight players at the position who saw action last fall, led by veterans Brown, a member of the Outland Trophy Watch List, and Evans, who has earned a spot on watch lists for the Bronko Nagurski Trophy, Shrine Bowl 1000, Reese's Senior Bowl. Brown logged 4.5 tackles for loss, two guarterback hurries and a sack en route to third-team all-conference honors in 2023. Evans posted 2.5 TFLs, a pair of sacks and a safety last season while also collecting third-team all-league accolades. This season, Brown paces the group in tackles behind the line with two, while five other d-linemen have at least one TFL.

### LINEBACKER LEADER

A starter at inside linebacker since he stepped foot on campus in 2020, Jamal Ligon has developed into one of the team leaders. The fifth-year senior from Tyler, Texas, who landed on this year's Shrine Bowl 1000 already owns the UTSA career mark for assisted tackles with 155, which ranks eighth among active FBS players. He is on pace to become the Roadrunners' alltime leader in total tackles, as he boasts 296 after logging 11 through the first four contests this season, putting him 10th among active FBS players in total tackles. Ligon recently moved past Triston Wade (293) into second place on UTSA's career chart, only 19 stops shy of Rashad Wisdom's school record of 315. The three-time all-conference selection also is on track to become the program's record holder in starts, as he now has 50, only six short of the mark held by Joshua Cephus and Wisdom. As a true freshman, he set the school standard for total tackles in a game with 19 in a win over Middle Tennessee in 2020. Last season, Ligon posted 62 total tackles, 35 unassisted stops, seven tackles for loss, five quarterback hurries, one sack, one forced fumble and a pass breakup while earning honorable mention All-American Athletic Conference honors.

### **EDGE THREAT**

UTSA senior outside linebacker Jimmori Robinson has emerged as a threat on the edge for the defense. A native of Virginia, he has registered 15 total tackles, including team highs of 4.5 tackles for loss and three sacks through the first four games this season. Voted into one of the coveted single-digit jersey numbers (No. 8) during training camp, Robinson opened his final campaign with eight tackles and 2.5 tackles for loss, including sacks in each of the first two contests. He then broke out for seven stops, two TFLs, a sack, one forced fumble and recovery and a blocked field goal in the 45-7 victory against Houston Christian, earning a nod for American Athletic Conference Honorable Mention Defensive Player of the Week. Last fall, Robinson broke Marcus Davenport's school record with 10 quarterback hurries to go along with 40 tackles, 11 tackles for loss, 4.5 sacks, two PBUs and a forced fumble.

### MONEY BACKERS LIVING UP TO THEIR NAME

UTSA's nickel position underwent a name change in the offseason to money backer, and the group is living up to their name so far in 2024. Led by fifth-year senior Donyai Taylor and redshirt sophomore Owen Pewee, five money backers have combined to post 30 tackles, 6.5 tackles for loss, two sacks, three quarterback hurries, one interception, three pass breakups and a forced fumble. Coming off a 2023 campaign that saw him earn secondteam All-American Athletic Conference accolades, Taylor — despite missing the first two games — has registered four tackles, 1.5 TFLs, one PBU and a sack of Texas quarterback Arch Manning that resulted in a 10-yard loss. Pewee paces the unit with 13 stops, 2.5 tackles for loss, one sack, two PBUs, a forced fumble and an 11-yard interception return against No. 2 Texas.

## **STEADY SAFETIES**

UTSA's secondary is led in part by the steady senior safety duo of Elliott Davison and Ken Robinson. Despite playing in only 12 of the 13 games last fall, Robinson, a South Grand Prairie High School product, led the Roadrunners in total tackles with 66 to go along with four pass breakups and a quarterback hurry. Davison, a native of Tyler, registered 40 stops and a pair of interceptions — including one that was returned 76 yards — in his first season at UTSA after transferring from UIW. Robinson paced the Roadrunners with seven stops in each of the first two games this season before missing the past two contests. He now has 188 career stops, including 112 solo and eight for loss. Davison paces the Roadrunners with 20 total tackles and a pair of pass breakups in 2024, and he has upped his career tallies to 195 tackles and 19 PBUs.

### **CARPENTER MAKES HISTORY**

UTSA junior Chris Carpenter has stamped his name in the school record book as one of the top returners in program history. In 2022, he brought back a kickoff 97 yards for a score against Texas Southern, the first kickoff return touchdown in program history. Last season, the Jacksonville, Texas, native returned a punt 50 yards for a touchdown in the third quarter of the 34-14 home triumph over Rice to become the first Roadrunner to record a punt and kickoff return for a TD. The punt return TD versus the Owls was the third in school annals, as he joined Kenny Harrison (79-yard TD vs. Texas State, 2012) and Sheldon Jones (76-yard return vs. Lamar in 2021). Carpenter finished 2023 ranked sixth in the league and 34th nationally in punt return average (6.8). This season, he has seven punt returns with a long of nine yards.

### PAT STREAK SECOND IN FBS

The Roadrunners boast the second-longest streak of consecutive extra points made after starting the 2024 season a perfect 12 for 12 behind the legs of Chase Allen and Tate Sandell. The stretch of consecutive PATs now stands at 208 dating back to the win over Louisiana Tech on Oct. 24, 2020. NC State has the longest active streak at 262.

### **ROADRUNNERS AMONG ACTIVE LEADERS IN GAMES PLAYED**

Several UTSA players are among active FBS leaders in career games played entering this weekend's game. Oscar Cardenas has 61 games under his belt, which stands second in the FBS behind Iowa's Nick Jackson (64) and tied for sixth on the program's all-time list led by Kelechi Nwachuku's school-record 67 games played. Christian Clayton is tied for fourth among active FBS players with 58 games played, while Jamal Ligon, Ken Robinson and Donyai Taylor are part of a tie for 37th (54).

### **TV BIRDS**

Saturday's game will air on ESPN+, marking 142 straight televised/ streamed appearances for the Roadrunners. The last UTSA game that was not broadcast was the 2012 season finale against Texas State.

### **BROTHERLY DUOS**

UTSA is one of 30 FBS teams that have at least two sets of brothers. The Roadrunners list junior wide receiver Elliott Brow and junior cornerback Errionn Brow along with senior inside linebacker Fred Lewis and junior safety Jermarius Lewis. Colorado leads the way with six sets of brothers.

## A FOCUS ON RECRUITING TEXAS

UTSA's 118-man roster features 93 players – 79% – who hail from the state of Texas. Georgia and Mississippi stand second with four players apiece, while there are two each from Alabama, Florida and Louisiana. Arizona, Arkansas, Hawaii, Iowa, Maryland, Massachusetts, Oregon, Tennessee and Virginia each have produced one current Roadrunner. Caile Hogan is the lone UTSA player from Australia and Cory Godinet is the first Roadrunner from American Samoa.

### **UTSA's 210 TRIANGLE OF TOUGHNESS**

Since his arrival in December 2019 head coach Jeff Traylor has instilled into the program his 210 Triangle Of Toughness — run the football, be physical on defense and be sound on special teams — and its Culture Pillars: Integrity, Passion, Mental & Physical Toughness, Selfless and Perfect Effort. As part of that culture, the players voted during fall camp on who would earn single-digit jersey numbers, a reward for representing mental and physical toughness on and off the field. ### **PRO 'RUNNERS**

UTSA currently has three players on NFL active rosters and five on practice squads or the injured list. Marcus Davenport became the first Roadrunner to be selected in the first round of the NFL Draft when the Saints picked him 14th overall in 2018. The defensive end is in his first season with the Lions after spending 2023 on the Vikings roster. Tariq Woolen was selected by the Seahawks in the fifth round of the 2022 NFL Draft. Now in his third season, the cornerback led the league with six interceptions and was a Pro Bowl selection as a rookie and has twice been voted by his peers to the NFL's Top 100 list. Spencer Burford was a fourth-round pick by the 49ers in 2022 and is in his third year as an offensive guard in San Francisco. Additionally, Joshua Cephus (Jaguars), Sincere McCormick (Raiders), Leroy Watson (Titans) and Rashad Wisdom (Buccaneers) are on practice squads, while Eric Banks is on the Buccaneers injured list.



## **UTSA 26, KENNESAW STATE 16** Saturday, Aug. 31 San Antonio, Texas (Alamodome)

SAN ANTONIO — Owen McCown passed for 340 yards and three touchdowns and the UTSA defense held Kennesaw State to 253 total yards in a 28-16 win in the season opener on Saturday in front of 25,911 fans at the Alamodome.

With the win, the Roadrunners notched their 50th all-time home victory and improved to 24-3 in San Antonio under fifth-year head coach Jeff Traylor, who ran his overall record to 40-14.

Making his second start as a Roadrunner, McCown directed three first-half scoring drives that helped UTSA build a 21-3 lead work the Ovis in the first meeting between the two teams. The redshirt sphomore connected with 10 different pass-catchers, led by Devin McCuin, who caught a career-high 11 balls for 79 yards and two TDs. Willie McCoy caught four passes for 59 yards with a long of 45, Patrick Overmyer and Houston Thomas had three receptions apiece for 31 and 28 yards, respectively nd Oscar Cardenas surpassed 1,000 career receiving yards with a pair of grabs for 38 yards.

Meanwhile, the defense was near-dominant at times, holding the Owls' dangerous ground game to only 51 rushing yards And a 1.3-yards-per-carry average. The Roadrunners racked up 10 tackles for loss, including three sacks with one apiece Jimmori Robinson, Martavius French and James Walley Jr. Ken Robinson led UTSA with seven tackles and a TFL, while Ov Pewee and Elliott Davison made six and five stops, respectively.

UTSA marched 53 yards on the game's opening possession to put points on the board first. McCown completed passes for 16 yards to McCuin and 18 yards to Thomas on back-to-back plays to help set up a 2-yard TD pass to McCuin. Chase Allen's extra point made it 7-0.

The Owls answered with a 44-yard field goal by Austin Welch to cap a 44-yard drive that chewed 5:48 off the clock

The Roadrunners tacked on a second touchdown in the opening frame as McCown found paydirt on a 5-yard run to put an exclamation point on an 11-play, 75-yard march and gave the home side a 14-3 advantage. That drive was highlighted by a 29-yard reception from DJ Allen.

McCown connected with McCuin again for a score early in the second stanza, this time on a 4-yard pass over the middle that extended the lead to 21-3. Robert Henry Jr.'s 61-yard reception down to the 6-yard line keyed the drive.

Welch drilled a 34-yard field in the final minute of the opening half to provide the 21-6 halftime margin

Welch hit his third field goal of the day with a 31-yarder at the 2:06 mark of a low-scoring third quarter that pulled the visitors within 21-9

Kennesaw State made things interesting in the fourth quarter when Carson Kent hauled in a 25-yard touchdown pass over the middle. Welch's PAT pulled the Owls within five points with 9:23 remaining.

UTSA put the game away when McCown found Cardenas wide open in the end zone on a 3-yard pass with 3:52 left to play

Davis Bryson completed 14 of 28 passes for 202 yards and a touchdown for the Owls, while Baron Hopson recorded a game-best 13 tackles

The Roadrunners will hit the road to face Texas State next Saturday, Sept. 7, in San Marcos. Kickoff is set for 3 p.m. and the game will be televised nationally on ESPNU.

SAN MARCOS - UTSA dropped a 49-10 decision to Texas State in the I-35 Showdown on Saturday afternoon at UFCU

Roadrunners fell to 1-1 on the season with their first setback in the six-game series with the Bobcats, who improved to 2-0 with the win.

UTSA saw two different quarterbacks combine to pass for 252 yards, as Owen McCown completed 10 passes for 105 in the first half and Eddie Lee Marburger piled up 147 yards and a touchdown on 14 completions, all after halftime. Marburger also had a career-high 23 rushing yards on five attempts.

Marburger connected with Willie McCoy on a 2-yard TD pass in the third quarter, and McCoy also had a 40-yard reception in the fourth, as the senior receiver racked up a team-high 59 receiving yards on three catches.

Devin McCuin led all Roadrunners with six grabs for 29 yards, Patrick Overmyer had three receptions for 31 yards and Chris Carpenter hauled in two passes for 43 yards.

Defensively, Ken Robinson paced UTSA with seven tackles including one for a loss. Martavius French and Jimmori Robinson nade five stops with one TFL apiece, while Jermarius Lewis, Owen P wee and Brevin Randle also recorded five tackles ec

Texas State used a balanced offense in the win, posting 504 total yards, 309 passing and 195 rushing. Jordan McCloud completed 18 of 27 passes for 309 yards and two touchdowns, while Chris Dawn Jr. had 150 yards and both TDs on only five receptions. Lincoln Pare rushed for a game-high 109 yards and a pair of scores.

UTSA came up with the first big play of the day, as cornerback Zach Morris picked off a pass at the Texas State's 33-yard line on the game's opening possession. However, UTSA could not capitalize on the field position, turning the ball back o to the Bobcats on downs.

Texas State got on the board first when McCloud scrambled for a 17-yard touchdown run at the 6:19 mark of the opening

UTSA responded with a 13-play, 66-yard drive that was highlighted by a Houston Thomas 44-yard reception and capped with a 26-yard field goal from Chase Allen.

The Bobcats then reeled off 28 unanswered points over the rest of the first half to take a 35-3 lead into the locker room. # «2024 UTSA GAME CAPSULES»

## TEXAS 56, UTSA 7 Saturday, Sept. 14 Austin, Texas (DKR-Texas Memorial Stadium)

AUSTIN, Texas — Robert Henry Jr. rushed for 65 yards and a touchdown and Martavius French had a team-high seven tackles, but it was not enough in a 56-7 selback to No. 2 Texas on Saturday night in front of 101,892 at Darrell K Rayal-Texas Memorial Stadium.

Henry led the Roadrunners' ground game and scored the lone TD of the day on a 53-yard dash in the second quarter, as UTSA (1-2) rushed for 128 on the day.

French paced a defense that came up with two takeaways — an interception by Owen Pewee and a fumble recovery by Brevin Randle — extending the streak of consecutive games with a takeaway to 13 dating back to last September. Jamal Ligon, Brevin Randle, Elliot Davison and Jimmy Wyrick registered five tackles apiece.

Arch Manning came off the bench to throw for 223 yards and four touchdowns, rushing for another to help the Longhorns (3-0) post 614 total yards, including 427 passing. Ryan Wingo had a game-high 127 receiving yards and Isaiah Bond added 103.

The Longhorns drove 84 yards in eight plays, the last a 7-yard touchdown pass from Quinn Ewers to Bond that put the home team on the board first.

Later in the opening quarter, Pewee came up with his second career interception and returned it 11 yards to the Texas 31-yard line. However, UTSA could not take advantage of field position, turning the ball back over on downs.

Texas pushed its lead to 21-0 after 19-yard TD receptions by Johntay Cook II and DeAndrere Moore Jr., but the Roadrunners got on the board when Henry broke loose for his 53-yard sprint to paydirt. Chase Allen's extra point made it 21-7 with 11:39 left in the second quarter.

The Longhorns answered, as Manning, who came on in relief for an injured Ewers, got loose for a 67-yard TD run to extend the lead back to 21.

Texas quickly upped its lead early in the third quarter with a pair of touchdown passes by Manning, one for 51 yards to Bond and a second for 75 yards to Wingo.

# UTSA 45, HCU 7 Saturday, Sept. 21

## SAN ANTONIO (ALAMODOME)

SAN ANTONIO — UTSA piled up a season-high 536 yards of offense and a school-record 35 first downs and held Houston Christian to just 177 yards in a 45-7 victory on Saturday afternoon at the Alamodome.

With their 13th win in the last 14 home games, the Roadrunners evened their record at 2-2 on the season in their first meeting with the Huskies [1-3]. UTSA also improved to 25-3 (. 893) at the Alamodome and 16-6 versus teams from the state of Texas under fifth-year head coach Jelf Traylor.

UTSA's offensive output added up to the most yards since a school-record 643 against South Florida on Nov. 17, 2023, and featured a balanced attack with 269 rushing yards – the most since 287 versus North Texas on Nov. 4, 2023 – and 267 passing yards. The 35 first downs eclipsed the previous UTSA standard done five times before, most recently in the win against South Florida last fall.

Bryson Donnell and Brandon High Jr. each rushed for a game-high 74 yards, while Kevorian Barnes added 64 yards to lead the ground game, and Owen McCown completed 18 of 25 passes for 226 yards and three touchdowns. Devin McCuin had a team-best five receptions for 43 yards and a TD, and Willie McCoy racked up 85 yards and a score on two catches.

Defensively, Jimmori Robinson had seven tackles, two tackles for loss, one sack, one forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a blocked field goal to help the Roadrunners limit the Huskies to seven points and 50 rushing yards, the fewest allowed since Rice ran for 47 on Nov. 11, 2023.

UTSA totaled seven TFLs, including four sacks, as Joe Evans, Owen Pewee and Ronald Triplette joined Robinson in the sack column. The Roadnuners also kept their turnover streak alive on Robinson's forced fumble and recovery in the first quarter, extending the stretch of consecutive games with a takeavay to 14.

The Roadrunners struck first, marching 61 yards in eight plays for a 26-yard field goal by Chase Allen. They pushed their lead to 10-0 after a 5-yard touchdown pass from McCown to McCuin late in the opening period.

HCU appeared to get on the board initially in the second quarter, but a holding penalty negated a field goal. On the ensuing try, Robinson blocked the kick and Denver Harris recovered it at midfield. That marked the first blocked field goal for the Roadrunners since Tariq Woolen against Marshall on Nov. 17, 2018.

UTSA took advantage of the block, as High ripped off a 28-yard rush to help set up his 9-yard TD run up the middle on third down. Allen's PAT made it 17-0 with 6:14 left to play until halftime.

The Huskies officially broke through for points later in the second stanza, as Jesse Valenzuela got loose around the left side for a 20-yard touchdown scamper.

The Roadrunners responded with back-to-back touchdown drives to close the half.

Willie McCay got free down the right sideline for a 59-yard TD reception from McCawn with just over two minutes remaining in the second quarter. Robert Henry then capped a five-play, 55-yard march with a 17-yard catch and run up the middle to paydirt. Tate Sandell's extra point provided the 31-7 halfilme margin.

The Roadrunners picked up where they left off to start the second half, as Kevorian Barnes' 8-yard touchdown rush put an exclamation point on a nine-play, 68-yard drive.

Jamel Hardy made a one-handed grab on the sideline in the end zone on a 5-yard pass from Eddie Lee Marburger to help push the advantage to 45-7 early in the final frame.

HCU's Eli Brickholder passed for 83 yards and AJ Wilson led the Huskies with four catches for 71 yards.
