

2024 UTSA Roadrunners Football UTSA vs. East Carolina Saturday, Sept. 28 Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium · Greenville, N.C. UTSA Postgame Notes

TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- UTSA fell to 2-3 overall and 0-1 in the American Athletic Conference. East Carolina improved to 3-2 and 1-0.
- This marked the second meeting between UTSA and East Carolina.
 - The series is now even at 1-1.
- Head coach Jeff Traylor has matched Larry Coker for the most games coached in program history with his 58th today.
- In the Jeff Traylor era, UTSA is now:
 - o 41-17 (.707) overall.
 - o 27-5 (.844) in regular season conference games.
 - 29-5 (.853) versus conference competition when including the 2021 and 2022 Conference USA Championship Games.
 - 4-1 in conference openers.

TEAM NOTES

- UTSA tallied 456 yards of offense and ran 89 plays.
 - The Roadrunners passed for 286 yards and rushed for 170.
- UTSA held East Carolina to 47 rushing yards, a season low for opponents.
 - The Roadrunners have held two straight and three overall opponents to 51 or fewer rushing yards in 2024.
- The Roadrunners recorded two interceptions and now have a takeaway in 15 consecutive games.
- UTSA now has recorded a sack in 15 straight contests after Jamal Ligon and Ronald Triplette each recorded one today.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior ILB Martavius French led UTSA with eight total tackles, including six solo stops and a tackle for loss.
 - o French now has 24 tackles, 4.5 TFLs, two pass breakups, one guarterback hurry and a sack this season.
 - O His 24 stops rank second on the team this year.
- Junior CB Zah Frazier picked off two passes, both in the second half.
 - He is now the fifth Roadrunner and first since Clayton Johnson against Rice in 2017 to have two interceptions in a game.
- Senior ILB Jamal Ligon posted five total tackles, one sack, one forced fumble and a quarterback hurry.
 - Ligon now has 16 total tackles, two TFLs and a sack in 2024.
 - o Ligon became the second Roadrunner to reach 300 career tackles, and he now has 301 in 55 games.
- Sophomore QB Owen McCown completed 24 of 49 passes for 251 yards and a touchdown.
 - McCown now has thrown for 1,054 yards and seven TDs on 101-of-164 passing this season.
- Redshirt freshman RB Brandon High Jr. rushed for 92 yards and a touchdown on only seven attempts.
 - High's 66-yard TD run in the fourth guarter was his second career score and is tied for UTSA's longest play of the season.
- Willie McCoy caught four passes for 91 yards with a long of 66, and he had 53 yards after the catch.
 - McCoy's 66-yard reception is tied for UTSA's longest play of the season.
- Senior TE Oscar Cardenas had two receptions, including a 5-yard TD catch in the first half.
 - o His TD grab was the eighth of his career.
 - Cardenas played in his team-best 62nd game today.
- Junior PK Chase Allen made both field-goal attempts today, as he was good from 23 and 35 yards.
 - Allen now has made his last three field-goal attempts and all 11 extra-point tries this season.
