UTSA Postgame Notes

TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- UTSA improved to 3-4 on the season, including 1-2 in American Athletic Conference play, while Florida Atlantic fell to 2-5, with an 0-3 mark in league action.
- This marked the fifth meeting between UTSA and Florida Atlantic.
 - The Owls lead the all-time series, 3-2.
- UTSA is now 2-1 against opponents with "Owls" nicknames in 2024.
- The Roadrunners have won 14 of their last 15 home games, including wins in the last seven consecutive games.
- UTSA is 52-30 all-time at the Alamodome.
- UTSA has won 16 of its past 19 conference contests.
- In the Jeff Traylor era, UTSA is now:
 - 42-18 (.700) overall.
 - 26-3 (.896) at home.
 - 28-6 (.834) in regular-season conference games.
 - 30-6 (.833) versus conference competition when including the 2021 and 2022 Conference USA Championship Games.

TEAM NOTES

- UTSA logged 485 yards of total offense, 340 in the air and 145 on the ground.
 - The 'Runners converted on third down 12 times, two shy of a school record 14 which occurred on Nov. 23, 2013, at North Texas.
 - UTSA last had 12 successful conversions on Sept. 9, 2023, against Texas State.
- The Owls were held to 203 yards, and amassed just 29 yards in the second half.
 - Over the last two meetings with Florida Atlantic, UTSA has held the Owls to 365 total yards (182.5 ypg).
- UTSA held the opposition to 4-14 on third-down conversions, representing a 22% conversion rate
 - UTSA entered the contest ranked 23rd nationally with opponents converting just 31.3% of their third down attempts.
- The Roadrunners recorded seven sacks for a loss of 59 yards, tying the single-game record which was set on Sept. 9, 2023 against Texas State and went for a loss of 41 yards
 - UTSA now has recorded a sack in 17 straight contests.
- UTSA registered 13 tackles for loss, one shy of tying the school record of 14, last recorded for the fourth time vs. Troy on Dec. 16, 2022.
- The Roadrunners had a fumble recovery in the second quarter and an interception in the fourth, bringing UTSA's takeaway streak to 17 consecutive games.
- 21 of the last 38 UTSA contests have been decided in the fourth quarter or later.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior DL Brandon Brown registered four tackles, tying his career high.
 - Brown charted 2.5 tackles for loss and a sack.
 - He now has 16 tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks during his career.
- Senior S Ken Robinson charted four tackles and a pass breakup.
- Redshirt So. \$B Owen Pewee had four tackles, 1.0 sacks, 2.0 TFL and an interception in the fourth quarter to end FAU's final possession.
- Senior ILB Martavius French recorded four tackles, including 1.5 for loss.
- Redshirt senior OLB Jimmori Robinson managed four tackles and two quarterback hurries.
- Senior DL Asyrus Simon had a tackle for loss and a sack.
 - His strip-sack in the second quarter extended UTSA's takeaway streak to 17 games.
- Redshirt sophomore QB Owen McCown went 26-45 with two touchdown passes and tied his career-high with 340 passing yards.
 - McCown previously managed 340 passing yards in the season opener against Kennesaw State.
- Senior WR Chris Carpenter hauled in a team-high six receptions for 58 yards.
- Redshirt sophomore TE Houston Thomas racked up 63 yards on three receptions to pace UTSA on receiving yards.
- Redshirt freshman TE Patrick Overmyer recorded his first career touchdown reception on a 42-yard catch in the second quarter.
 - He caught three total passes for 47 yards.
- Redshirt freshman WR Jamel Hardy caught three passes for 47 yards and a touchdown.
- Redshirt freshman RB Brandon High Jr. led the way on the ground, picking up 65 yards on nine attempts and a touchdown with 2:25 remaining in the fourth quarter that sealed the game with a two-possession UTSA lead.
- Senior RB Robert Henry Jr. tallied 49 yards and a touchdown on 16 carries.
- Redshirt senior TE Oscar Cardenas hauled in a 30-yard pass in the first quarter, moving him into sixth on the school's all-time reception leader board with 94
- Redshirt sophomore K Tate Sandell sunk three field goals and three PAT's marking the first time since Nov. 4, 2023 against North Texas that a Roadrunner has booted three field goals.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- UTSA's captains today were senior RB Robert Henry, senior C CJ James and junior QB Eddie Lee Marburger.
- Today's attendance was 20,802.
 - UTSA has an all-time attendance total of 2,056,117 in 82 home games (25,075 avg).
