UTSA Postgame Notes

TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- UTSA fell to 3-5 on the season and 1-3 in the American Athletic Conference. Tulsa improved to 3-5 overall, 1-3 in league play.
- This marked the second meeting between UTSA and Tulsa.
 - The teams are tied 1-1 in the all-time series
- In the Jeff Traylor era, UTSA is now:
 - 42-19 (.688) overall.
 - 28-7 (.800) in regular-season conference games.
 - 30-7 (.810) versus conference competition when including the 2021 and 2022 Conference USA Championship Games.

TEAM NOTES

- The Roadrunners recorded 443 passing yards, a figure that serves as the new program record.
 - The previous benchmark of 441 came against Texas Southern on Sept. 24, 2022.
- UTSA's 546 yards of total offense represent a new season-high, surpassing the previous total of 536 against Houston Christian (9/21/24).
- Chris Carpenter (115) and Houston Thomas (132) both topped 100 yards receiving to mark the first time UTSA has had two 100-yard receivers in a game since Tykee Ogle-Kellogg (142) and Zakhari Franklin (126) against UTEP (11/26/22).
 - The pair logged the first 100-yard receiving game since Joshua Cephus had 102 in the 35-17 victory over Marshall in the Frisco Bowl (12/19/23)
- Today marked back-to-back games with a touchdown catch by multiple tight ends as Oscar Cardenas and Dan Dishman each found the end zone against Tulsa.
- UTSA extended its streak of consecutive games with a takeaway to 18.
- UTSA posted 15 tackles for loss, breaking the school record which had occurred four times before.
 - It marks the second straight and fourth overall game with 10-or-more TFLs
- The Roadrunners registered a school record-tying seven sacks for the second straight game and now have recorded one in 18 straight games.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Redshirt sophomore QB Owen McCown set a new school record with 434 passing yards, going 30-for-50 with four touchdowns.
 - The previous record was held by Frank Harris, who charted 414 yards against Middle Tennessee
 - McCown's four passing touchdowns also represent the most in his career and tie multiple Harris performances for the second-most by a Roadrunner in a game.
- Senior WR Chris Carpenter hauled in seven passes for a career-high 115 yards and a score.
 - His 69-yard touchdown reception was UTSA's longest play of the season.
- Redshirt sophomore TE Houston Thomas caught six passes for a career-best 132 yards.
- Senior WR Willie McCoy recorded four receptions for 76 yards including a 49-yard catch.
- Senior RB Robert Henry Jr. posted 67 yards and a touchdown on 20 carries.
- Senior TE Oscar Cardenas caught a 9-yard touchdown pass in the first quarter.
 - Cardenas now has the most career touchdown receptions (9) by a UTSA tight end in addition to the most catches (95) and receiving yards (1,138) at the position in program history.
- Redshirt junior TE Dan Dishman caught a 23-yard pass for a touchdown in the second quarter.
- Senior ILB Martavius French posted a team-high eight tackles including 1.5 for loss.
- Senior DL Asyrus Simon registered six tackles, a team-high three TFLs and a sack.
- Senior LB Jamal Ligon had five tackles, a sack, a pass breakup, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.
- Redshirt junior DL Ronald Triplette logged four tackles with two sacks and a forced fumble.
- Redshirt senior OLB Jimmori Robinson tallied 1.5 sacks and a forced fumble.
- Redshirt sophomore LB Camron Cooper recorded his first career sack.
- Redshirt freshman DL Daemian Wimberly had one tackle and a 28-yard fumble return in the second quarter.
 - That marked UTSA's first fumble return for a touchdown since Lorenzo Dantzler's 3-yard return versus Middle Tennessee (9/18/21).
- Freshman P Caille Hogan recorded a career-long 63-yard punt in the fourth quarter, the first UTSA punt to go 60-plus yards since Lucas Dean booted one 67 yards against Troy in the Cure Bowl on Dec. 16, 2022.
