UTSA Postgame Notes

TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- UTSA fell to 6-6 overall and 4-4 in the American Athletic Conference, while Army improved to at 10-1 and 8-0 in the league.
- This marked the fifth meeting between UTSA and Army.
 - Army now leads the series, 4-1.
- In the Jeff Traylor era, UTSA is now:
 - 45-20 (.692) overall.
 - Traylor's 45 wins represent the most of any active FBS head coach hired in 2020.
 - 31-8 (.794) in regular-season conference games.
 - 33-8 (.804) versus conference competition when including the 2021 and 2022 Conference USA Championship Games.
 - 16-3 (.842) in the month of November.

TEAM NOTES

- UTSA extended its streak of consecutive games with a takeaway to 22.
 - The Roadrunners now have 21 takeaways this season, 11 fumble recoveries and 10 interceptions.
- The Roadrunners recorded a total of seven tackles for loss, bringing their season total to 104 and breaking the single-season program record of 99 set last year.
- The Roadrunners recorded two sacks on the day.
 - UTSA now has registered a sack in 22 straight games.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior CB Syrus Dumas posted a career-high-tying 12 tackles, including three for loss.
 - He bettered his previous career high of 10 posted against FIU in 2022 when he was at New Mexico State.
- Senior OLB Jimmori Robinson registered three tackles, two of which were solo, and one sack.
 - Robinson pushed his season sacks total to a league-high 10.5, good for a tie for second place on the program's single-season chart.
- Senior ILB Martavius French turned in nine tackles, a half-TFL and one quarterback hurry.
- Senior \$B Donyai Taylor logged his second sack of the season in the first half. He totaled four stops on the day.
- Senior DL Christian Clayton had four tackles, tying his career high, and a fumble recovery.
- Sophomore QB Owen McCown completed 17 passes for 207 yards and one touchdown.
- Sophomore WR David Amador II caught seven passes for 75 yards with a long of 26.
- Sophomore WR Devin McCuin had three receptions for a team-leading 82 yards and one touchdown in his first game back since Oct. 12 against Rice.
 - His 55-yard catch in the fourth quarter is a season-long.
- Redshirt freshman RB Brandon High Jr. rushed for 61 yards on a career-high 16 attempts with a career-best two touchdowns.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- UTSA's captains today were senior DL Brandon Brown, senior ILB Martavius French, and senior ILB Jamal Ligon.
- Temperature at kickoff was 36, making this the coldest game UTSA has played in during its 14-year history. The previous low temperature was 39 degrees against North Texas on Nov. 23, 2013, in Denton.
