'RUNNERS IN THE RANKINGS

• As of 12/27, UTSA enters league play at 52nd in the most recent NET, and a plus-12.2 rebound margin is 11th in the NCAA.

 They top the AAC and are 32nd nationally with a 55.2 scoring defense and a plus-13.5 scoring margin also paces the conference.

• Individually, graduate student Nina De Leon Negron averages 5.4 assists per game, a figure that is the 30th-most across the country.

• She, along with Love, sits inside the top five on The American's assist/ turnover ratio leader board, with De Leon Negron second at 2.16 and Love fourth at 1.79.

 Redshirt senior Jordyn Jenkins leads the league in points (209), points per game (19.0), and free throws (50).

A HOT START

• After compiling a 7-1 record to begin the season, the Roadrunners have the second-hottest start in program history.

 UTSA's 1985-86 campaign serves as the best, with the 'Runners posting an 11-1 mark before wrapping up the season 18-9.

 The Roadrunners have also secured their first seven-game winning streak since 2013-14.

 After falling to Texas A&M 55-51 on the road in the season opener, UTSA rattled off seven in a row with victories over UTRGV (74-69), New Mexico State (75-61), UTEP (78-73), and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (62-43), UNC Greensboro (62-53), Towson (71-40) and Sam Houston (79-36).

ANOTHER ONE

 For the second time this season, redshirt senior Jordyn Jenkins was named the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week, as announced by the league on 12/2.

 Jenkins had another stellar week, first recording 14 points with nine rebounds in a win over UNC Greensboro, ahead of an 18-point performance against Towson. In total, she averaged 16.0 PPG at a 52.2% clip with three blocks, three steals and 11 boards at the Puerto Rico Clasico.

• She has now earned eight Player of the Week awards (4x CUSA, 1x Pac-12, 3x AAC) across her collegiate tenure, last receiving recognition on Nov. 18, when she was also chosen as a USBWA National Player of the Week, and to the NCAA Starting Five.

<u>VIVA SAN</u> JUAN

• UTSA went 2-0 at the Puerto Rico Clasico, a Feast Week tournament in San Juan, Puerto Rico

 The Roadrunners took down UNC Greensboro, 52-53, on Thanksgiving Day, before besting Towson 71-40 on Black Friday.

 The 'Runners first bested the Spartans with a trio recording double-digit scoring figures.

• Redshirt senior Jordyn Jenkins posted 14 points and was one rebound shy of a double-double, while sophomore Idara Udo was not far behind, charting 10 points and seven boards.

 Junior Maya Linton scored 11, with classmate Cheyenne Rowe tallying eight points and five rebounds.

Sidney Love scored seven points, with five assists and four rebounds.

• UTSA dominated in the paint, with 26 points to UNCG's 16, and also logged 19 more rebounds and 12 more second-chance points than their opponents.

The 'Runners then led wire-to-wire across a 71-40 victory over Towson.

 The win was the largest margin of victory since a 72-40 routing of Lamar on Nov. 23, 2014

• Jenkins worked 18 points, while Puerto Rico native Nina De Leon Negron posted 14 with eight assists and five rebounds and junior Cheyenne Rowe scored 10.

 After dominant performances on the road against New Mexico State and UTEP, redshirt senior Jordyn Jenkins received a wealth of accolades.

• Jenkins posted double-doubles in a pair of victories over previously undefeated teams, with 28.5 PPG at a 70.4% clip and 11.5 RPG.

 She first went 9-for-14 from the field and 8-for-8 from the charity stripe for 27 points in a 75-61 win over New Mexico State, ahead of a 30-point, 10-for-13 day across a 78-73 victory against UTEP that featured a 10-for-12 mark from the free-throw line and 12 rebounds in just 25 minutes.

• The last Roadrunner to crack the NCAA Starting Five was current Director of Operations Elyssa Coleman who was picked on Feb. 10, 2024 after averaging 21.5 PPG and 11.5 RPG with three steals and four blocks.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

• Both redshirt senior Jordyn Jenkins and junior Sidney Love posted double-doubles across the opening week of competition.

• Jenkins charted 18 points and 11 rebounds on 11/7 against Texas A&M in the season opener, before Love logged 21 points and 11 assists against UTRGV on 11/9

• Their performances represented the 17th double-double of Jenkins collegiate tenure and the second of Love's career

DIME DROPPER

• Junior Sidney Love was phenomenal against UTRGV on 11/9 recording a career-high 11 assists to go with 21 points, five rebounds, and five steals

• Love became the first squad member to tally 20-plus points and 10-plus rebounds in a single game since UTSA Athletics Hall of Farmer Monica Gibbs charted 20 points and 10 assists against Lamar on Feb. 28, 2009.

• No 'Runner has recorded double-digit assist figures since Karrington Donald on Jan. 2, 2021, against Rice.

LAST SEASONS SUCCESS

• The Roadrunners ended 2023-24 ranked at or near the top in several statistical categories at both the national and conference level recording: 44.5 Rebounds per game (6th in NCAA, 1st in AAC), 15.8 Offensive Rebounds Per Game (10th in NCAA, 3rd in AAC), +8.2 Rebound Margin (13th in NCAA, 1st in AAC), 36.3% Field Goal Defense (19th in NCAA, 1st in AAC), 28.6 Defensive Rebounds per game (27th in NCAA, 2nd in AAC), 4.6 Blocks Per Game (32nd in NCAA, 3rd in AAC).

FOR THE FIRST TIME

• UTSA is coming off a season that saw them pick up the programs first postseason victory on March 21, 2024 as they took down Northern Colorado, 80-62, in the First Round of the 2024 Postseason WNIT.

•The Roadrunners fell in the Second Round to Wyoming, 80-64 in Laramie, and are now 1-3 all-time in national postseason play.

It was UTSA's third national postseason selection, following first-round exits in the 2007-08 and 2008-09 NCAA Tournaments, both coming as a result of winning the Southland Conference Tournament Championship.
In their last NCAA postseason bout, UTSA hung tough, taking No. 2 seed Baylor to overtime in Lubbock in the

opening round of the NCAA Tournament before falling 87-82 on March 22, 2009.

• In UTSA's first NCAA Tournament contest, they suffered a 92-51 defeat at the hands of No. 2 seed Texas A&M in Baton Rouge, Louisiana on 3/21/08.

YEAR TWO IN THE AMERICAN

• The Roadrunners embarked on their first season as a member of the American Athletic Conference last year, going 10-8 in conference play before edging past South Florida in the quarterfinal of the 2023-24 American Championships, and falling to East Carolina in the semifinals.

• The step up in competition didn't faze the Roadrunners, as a 10-8 mark represented the first time since the 2016-17 season that UTSA posted a winning conference record, while the 'Runners 18-15 overall mark was the first overall winning record since managing a 16-15 record across 2014-15.

• This marked back-to-back seasons in which UTSA reached the semifinals of its conference tournament, and the 11th semifinal appearance in the program's history.

• UTSA joined the league from Conference USA were they went 44-107, and last claimed a league championship as a member of the Southland Conference

• The 'Runners were the 2002-03 SLC Regular Season Champs, and won the league again in 2008-09.

• The program has won two SLC Tournaments, punching its ticket to the NCAA Tournament in 2008 and 2009.

GUESS WHO'S BACK?

• The 2022-23 CUSA Player and Newcomer of the Year, Jordyn Jenkins will be back in action for UTSA after she was sidelined for the majority of the 2023-24 campaign.

• Jenkins became the third player in CUSA history to win all three awards and the first in 10 years, was the first Roadrunner to earn CUSA Player of the Year, and was the first UTSA student-athlete to win four CUSA POW honors in a single season.

• She was awarded All-Texas First-Team by Dave Campbell's Texas Basketball, after leading the league with 659 points, averaging 20.6 PPG at a 49.3% clip 659 points scored serves as the UTSA school record.

• Jenkins maintained a 79.0% free throw percentage and recorded 7.5 RPG and 1.3 SPG.

• She appeared in the final 12 games of the 2023-24 season, averaged 17.1 PPG and 6.8 RPG with 15 steals and

13 blocks despite a minutes restriction

• Jenkins quickly made an impact upon her return, earning AAC Player of the Week honors.

• She won the award on Feb. 19 after battling two of The American's top teams in Tulsa and UNT, first scored 11 points and snagging seven boards against the Golden Hurricane before exploding for 29 points and four rebounds in just 24 minutes against the Mean Green.

• She's primed for another sensational season, with the goal of becoming the first player in the history of the program to make a WNBA roster.

BACK IN ACTION

• In addition to Jordyn Jenkins, UTSA returns a trio of top performers, including junior Sidney Love, and sophomores Idara Udo and Aysia Proctor.

• Love started all but one contest for the 'Runners, finishing second on the team with 106 assists and a team-high 43 steals with 9.6 PPG.

 Udo received an AAC Freshman of the Week honor, and figures to play a major role defensively in 2024-25 after hauling in 195 rebounds with 25 blocks and 15 steals.

• Proctor, meanwhile, was a three-time conference Freshman of the Week, becoming the first to win three since Mikayla Woods did so in Conference USA across the 2019-20 campaign.

• She averaged 9.7 PPG at a 44.8% clip, and knocked down the second-most triples on the team nailing 40 at a 38.5% rate.

NOTABLE NEWCOMERS

• UTSA added five to the squad, including transfer pieces in Nina De Leon Negron (UIW) and Nyayongah Gony (Mississippi State).

• De Leon Negron has been one of the Southland's top point guards, winning SLC Newcomer of the Year in 2022-23, along with an all-defensive team pick, ahead of a first-team selection in 2023-24.

• Including her time at Austin Peay before UIW she averages 8.19 PPG and 4.4 RPG while dishing out 352 assists. • Gony saw action in 49 games between stints at Mississippi State and Miami, and previously was as the top re-

cruit in the state of Nebraska, receiving a four-star rating from both espnW HoopGurlz and ProspectsNation.com.

• True freshman Damara Allen, Mia Hammonds, Taylor Ross, and Emilia Dannebauer.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

• The Roadrunners will have to replace critical members of the squad, as Kyra White signed a professional contract after graduating, and Elyssa Coleman transitions to a role as Director of Basketball Operations.

• White signed a one-year professional contract with Fr. Mathews Basketball Club out of Ireland, where she'll compete on the organization's Women's Super League team (WSL).

• She wrapped up 2023-24 with 4.8 assists per game, a figure that slotted her second in the AAC, and she also posted a 1.65 assists/turnover ratio that ranked third.

• White played 34.7 minutes per game for the third most in the league and 1.0 blocks per game were 10th.

• In addition to her stellar assist number she charted 9.9 points per game, 5.0 rebounds per game, and was second on the team swiping 34 steals.

• Coleman, meanwhile initially planned to return for the 2024-25 season, before an offseason injury pushed her towards a medical retirement.

 After redshirting at Texas, Coleman transferred to UTSA and had an immediate impact on the squad, eventually becoming the program's all-time blocking leader swatting 140 shots and joining the 500-rebound club with 588 boards representing the ninth-most in program history.

• Across 94 games for the Roadrunners she started 78, averaging 9.3 PPG and 7.2 RPG.

• She was named to the 2022-23 Conference-USA All-Defensive Team as a redshirt sophomore, and for her work in the classroom was featured on the 2021-22 C-USA Commissioners Honor Roll and the 2023-24 American Athletic Conference All-Academic Team.

ALL ABOARD THE ASTON EXPRESS

• The UTSA rebuild is ahead of schedule, as head coach Karen Aston inherited a 2-18 squad in 2021 and never looked back.

 Aston who holds a career record of 322-203, has gone 38-57 at UTSA across three season improving from a 7-23 mark in 2021-22, to 13-19 in 2022-23 and 18-15 in 2023-24.

• Under her tutelage, the Roadrunners achieved their first ever postseason victory on March 21, 2024 as they took down Northern Colorado, 80-62, in the First Round of the 2024 Postseason WNIT, and also recorded the most wins in a single season since 2008-09, the first national postseason selection since 2008-09.

• The 'Runners finished fourth in the conference for the highest since the 2014-15 CUSA campaign and went 8-7 for the first winning nonconference record since 2013-14.

• UTSA's NET ranking of 136 in 2023-24 was the program's highest ranking to conclude a season since NET rankings began, and an average opponent NET of 97 was also the highest.

Head Coach Karen Aston Fourth Season 332-205 (47-59 UTSA)

Aston was named the 10th head coach in program history on March 29, 2021.

Throughout her first three seasons at UTSA, Aston has compiled a 38-57 record, making history along the way.

The 2023-24 season featured a wealth of firsts. including achieving UTSA's first ever postseason victory on March 21, 2024 with an 80-62 win over Northern Colorado in the First Round of the 2024 Postseason WNIT. UTSA went 18-15 (10-8 The American) for the most wins in a single season since 2008-09, and the WNIT selection was the first national postseason pick since 2008-09. The 'Runners finished fourth in the conference for the highest since the 2014-15 CUSA campaign and went 8-7 for the first winning nonconference record since 2013-14. UTSA's NET ranking of 136 in 2023-24 was the program's highest ranking to conclude a season since NET rankings began, and an average opponent NET of 97 was also the highest.

The Roadrunners ended the season ranked at or near the top in several statistical categories at both the national and conference level recording: 44.5 Rebounds per game (6th in NCAA, 1st in AAC), 15.8 Offensive Rebounds Per Game (10th in NCAA, 3rd in AAC), +8.2 Rebound Margin (13th in NCAA, 1st in AAC), 36.3% Field Goal Defense (19th in NCAA, 1st in AAC), 28.6 Defensive Rebounds per game (27th

in NCAA, 2nd in AAC), 4.6 Blocks Per Game (32nd in NCAA, 3rd in AAC).

UTSA posted a a 13-19 (9-1, C-USA) record in the 2022-23 season, opening up the C-USA tournament with a thrilling 69-68 win over No. 11 seed Florida Atlantic, before besting No. 3 seed Rice 62-54 to advance to the leagues semifinals were they fell to No. 2 seed Western Kentucky.

Jordyn Jenkins had a fantastic season under Aston's tutelage, taking home 2022-23 C-USA Player of the Year, Newcomer of the Year, and First-Team All-C-USA. Additionally, Jenkins became the third person in league history to win all three awards, and the first in 10 years.

The 'Runners went 7-23 (3-14, C-USA) in her inaugural year before collecting a 58-57 overtime win over UTEP at the league's postseason tournament.

Aston has been consistently recognized as one of the top coaches in the nation. She was one of four finalists for the Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year award in 2017 and was one of 10 semifinalists for the honor in 2018. Aston also earned Big 12 Coach of the Year accolades in 2017.

Aston has a career record of 305-188 [.618] which includes head coaching positions at Charlotte, North Texas and Texas. In her 13 seasons as a head coach, Aston's teams have averaged 22 wins per year and have made a combined 10 postseason appearances.

At the University of Texas, Aston led the Longhorns to a 184-83 [.689] record in eight seasons. In her final seven seasons combined at Texas, Aston's teams averaged 24.6 wins per year, making six NCAA Tournament appearances. From 2015-18, her squads made four consecutive NCAA Sweet 16 showings, marking the first time that had been accomplished at Texas since 1990. Aston also directed the 2015-16 Longhorns to the program's first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 2003.

Aston, who also spent eight years as an assistant and associate head coach at Texas for Naismith Hall of Fame head coach Jody Conradt as Texas' second-winningest coach all-time behind Conradt's 783 victories.

Three of Aston's Texas players [Nneka Enemkpali, Imani McGee-Stafford and Ariel Atkins] were drafted by WNBA teams with McGee-Stafford [10th] and Atkins [7th] being selected as first-round picks. As a starter, Atkins helped lead the Washington Mystics to the 2019 WNBA Championship and has earned WNBA All-Defensive Team honors in each

post a 108-32 [.771] overall record, four NCAA Tournament appearances, four NCAA Sweet 16 appearances, one NCAA Elite Eight appearance and three Big 12 Conference second-place finishes. Aston was a semifinalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year award.

Aston was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in 2016-17, as the Longhorns swept the league's annual honors. McCarty was named the Big 12 Player of the Year, Brianna Taylor was selected as the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year and Holmes earned Big 12 Freshman of the Year accolades. Aston was one of four finalists nationally for the Naismith Coach of the Year honor.

The Longhorns recorded a 25-9 overall record during the 2016-17 campaign. Texas strung together a 19-game winning streak during the course of the season, which ranks tied for the 10th-longest spree in program history. With a rigorous slate that featured 14 top-25 opponents, the Longhorns recorded seven victories against

ranked foes. Texas won 14 consecutive games to start Big 12 Conference play, which marked the

best start to the Big 12 schedule in school history. The Longhorns charted a 15-3 record in Big 12 play to finish second in the conference for the second consecutive year.

In 2015-16, Aston led Texas to an historic season. The Longhorns posted a 31-5 overall record, which marked the school's most victories since the 1987-88 season, and tied the school record for most Big 12 Conference wins [15] in a single season. Texas hosted the NCAA First and Second Rounds for the first time since 2010 and advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight for the first time since 2003. The Longhorns opened the year with a 16-0 record, marking the third-best start in program history.

McGee-Stafford, a senior center, was named an honorable mention All-America selection from both the Associated Press and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association in 2015-16, and became the first player in program history to reach the combined milestone of 1,000 career points, 1,000 career rebounds and 200 career blocks. McGee-Stafford was the fourth player in school history to be drafted in the first round of the WNBA Draft, going to the Chicago Sky with the 10th overall pick.

The 2014-15 Longhorns began the season on a 13-game winning streak and capped the year with a run to the NCAA Sweet 16. Texas finished with a 24-11 overall record and advanced to the championship game of the Big 12 Tournament for the first time since 2004. The Longhorns won nine of their last 12 games and posted what were then their most wins in more than a decade. Enemkpali was selected by the Seattle Storm in the third round of the 2015 WNBA Draft.

In 2013-14, Texas began a steady incline that included five wins against ranked opponents, a thirdplace finish in the Big 12 standings, a 10-win improvement from the previous season, and winning a game in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2008. UT's tie for third place in the Big 12 was its highest league finish since 2005.

Aston returned to the Forty Acres in 2012 after five years of experience reviving the women's basketball programs at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte and the University of North Texas.

Aston tripled the Mean Green's victory total in one season, as UNT went 15-16 during the 2011-12 season under her direction after winning just five games the previous year. At Charlotte, Aston led the program to record-breaking heights, with 86 victories in four seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 2010-11.

Aston led the 49ers to four consecutive postseason appearances and the 2009 Atlantic 10 Tournament Championship en route to the school's second ever NCAA Tournament appearance. In her final season at Charlotte, Aston's squad advanced to the WNIT Final Four.

While on Conrad's Texas staff from 1998-2006, Aston helped the Longhorns post a 173-83 [.676] record during that span, with seven NCAA Tournament appearances, two trips to the Sweet 16 and a march to the 2003 Final Four. The Longhorns also captured the 2003 Big 12 regular-season and tournament titles, and UT shared the 2004 Big 12 regular-season title. Aston was promoted from assistant coach to associate head coach in July of 2000 after serving as an assistant coach for two seasons.

During her time as an assistant on the Forty Acres, Aston spearheaded the signing of 25 nationallyrecognized recruits, including seven McDonald's High School All-Americans and seven WBCA/Nike All-Americans. Two of those high school All-Americans - Tiffany Jackson and Erika Arriaran - were named National High School Players of the Year. All eight of the recruiting classes Aston attracted were nationally ranked, including the No. 1 class in the nation in 2005-06.

Aston first came to Austin in 1998 from the University of North Texas, where she served as an assistant coach for two seasons [1996-98]. Prior to joining the North Texas staff, Aston was an assistant coach at Baylor for two seasons [1994-96].

Following Aston's initial stint on the Forty Acreshe was named associate head coach at Baylor during the 2006-07 season. With Aston on board, the Lady Bears won 26 games and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Before entering the collegiate coaching ranks, Aston was recognized as one of the top high school coaches in the nation. She coached five years at Vilonia High School [1988-93] in Vilonia, Ark., and one year at Fort Smith Northside [1993-94] in Fort Smith, Ark. She guided Fort Smith Northside to a 24-10 record and a fifth-place finish in Class 4A. For her effortshe was named the Arkansas Northwest Region Coach of the Year.

While at Vilonia, Aston was not only the head basketball coach but also the head cross country and track coach. In 1992-93he was named the Arkansas Basketball Coach of the Year after leading Vilonia to a 36-1 record and a Class 2A State Championship. Aston's cross country teams also claimed back-to-back state titles in 1991 and 1992.

A native of Benton, Ark., Aston was a two-time first-team all-state selection at Bryant High School. She capped her high school career by leading Bryant to the 1982 Arkansas Class 4A State Championship. Aston earned a bachelor of arts degree in physical education from Little Rock in 1987. She played two seasons of basketball at UALR after transferring from Ouachita Baptist. In 2019, Aston was inducted into the Trojan Athletics Hall of Fame at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock and the Bryant [Ark.] High School Athletic Hall of Honor.





NINA DE LEON NEGRON FUELING UTSA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL'S HISTORIC START

Relentless.

To capture the essence of Nina De Leon Negron, one need only reference the single, meaningful word tattooed in script on her right arm. She added the ink this past May after committing to the UTSA women's basketball program as a graduate transfer.

"It's to remind me that you can do anything you set your mind to," she said. "It's motivation."

De Leon Negron, a graduate transfer from UIW and the first Puerto Rican-born UTSA women's basketball player, is now the engine that's driving the Roadrunners' historic 7-1 start to the 2024-25 season, the second-best record over the first eight games in program annals. The 5-foot-6 point guard ranks in the top-25 nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (+2.92) and is providing significant leadership to one of the most talented teams in UTSA history.

"She has some really cool qualities about herself that you don't hardly even see anymore," UTSA's fourth-year head coach Karen Aston said. "She was a wonderful gift – for our program, but also for our players. They understood that we really needed someone like her. They get to be around someone who has super confidence in herself and great leadership skills."

Teammate Jordyn Jenkins, a preseason favorite for the American Athletic Conference Player of the Year honor, believes that De Leon Negron brings the basketball and leadership traits that the team needs to reach its collective goals.

"She's brought a seriousness that we wish we would have had earlier," Jenkins said. "She works really hard and is always in the gym. She is the point guard who is going to assist and facilitate, but she's also going to shoot the three, so she gives opposing defenses a really good challenge."

De Leon Negron grew up in San Juan, the daughter of Angel and Denise, both of whom played collegiate volleyball in Puerto Rico. She was so drawn to basketball at an early age that Angel entered her into a basketball club called Las Vaqueras de Bayamon.

"I kind of got into it because every time I would see a ball, I would try to bounce it and dribble it," De Leon Negron said. "My dad said 'We should take her to a club."

De Leon Negron always knew she would play collegiate sports, like her parents, but never envisioned she would have the opportunity to compete at the Division I level in the United States. Added exposure from playing for the Puerto Rican National Team at the Centrobasket U17 Women's Championship – De Leon Negron averaged 15.0 points per game and 5.0 assists per game during that event – ended up changing the course of her athletic career.

She came on the radar of Laura Harper, the coach of Monteverde Academy, a college preparatory school in the greater Orlando area that is well known for its basketball prowess. De Leon Negron was offered an opportunity to attend and compete for the school in her senior year of high school.

"Once I got the call to move to Orlando, I thought, 'If I have the opportunity, why not do it?" she said. "I have so many Puerto Rican friends that would love to have the opportunity and, since I had it, I thought, why not? At first it was hard and I felt homesick. I just kept saying that I wanted to make my family proud. The sacrifice has been worth it."

It was during the experience at Monteverde that De Leon Negron began considering the possibility of playing high-level basketball in the United States.

"It had never been a dream because I didn't think I could do it," she said. "I was just thinking that I was going to go to a college in Puerto Rico. But once I moved to the United States my senior year, I was like, I think I can achieve that."

De Leon Negron played her first two collegiate seasons at Austin Peay in Clarksville, Tenn. As a sophomore, she led her squad and ranked fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference with 111 assists on the year. De Leon Negron ranked among the top-60 players nationally with a +1.95 assist-to-turnover ratio, and helped lead the Governors to a postseason appearance in the Women's Basketball Invitational.

She arrived in San Antonio in the fall of 2022 as a transfer to the University of the Incarnate Word. In two years there, she totaled 201 assists and charted six 20-plus-point performances. She was the Southland Conference Newcomer of the Year as a junior in 2022-23 and was a First-Team All-Southland Conference selection as a senior last season.

In her first season with the Cardinals, De Leon Negron turned in one of her best collegiate performances against UTSA, scoring 25 points. She made an immediate impression on Aston, who would later recruit her as a graduate transfer.

"She came on our radar because she kicked our tail two years ago," Aston said. "We played against them and she just wore us out. You could really tell how competitive she was. We didn't really have a grasp on her other qualities, but we knew her competitive spirit and we knew that she could contribute in that manner. We also knew she could shoot the 3 and thought it would help us to have another perimeter player that could stretch the floor."

De Leon Negron didn't enter the graduate transfer process with any preconceptions about where she might play next. She knew countryman Jhivvan Jackson, UTSA men's basketball's all-time scoring leader, and he had told De Leon Negron about the school.

She thought her history of success against UTSA might be a barrier to her moving across town to play for the Roadrunners. What she found was quite the opposite; the candor of the UTSA coaching staff was a difference-maker in De Leon Negron's decision-making process.

"I loved the coaches," she said. "Once I got here and saw what the coaches were telling me, it felt like family, it didn't really feel like business. The coaches told me the truth and I knew that they were telling me the truth. I knew that Coach Aston's intentions were real and that's kind of hard to find."

Leadership is perhaps the trait that De Leon Negron has been most counted upon to bring to her new team. Joining a team as a fifth-year player and immediately taking the lead can be a challenge for even the most confident players, but De Leon Negron has handled it with grace.

"It's probably what indicates who she is best of all," Aston said. "That she was able to walk in here and blend so quickly with the group. I think it has just been a tribute to her personality and her skillset as a human being. She understands relationships. She literally came in here with the understanding and the concept of getting to know everybody and who they are, and she didn't force herself or her personality on anybody. She has been accepted by the whole group."

De Leon Negron admits that the situation was somewhat intimidating to enter, but the support of her coaches and, particularly, her teammates has made her transition nearly seamless.

"The first month was a struggle," De Leon Negron said. "I had to prove myself. But I feel like it would have been like that at every single school that I could have gone to. The coaches just gave me that freedom since the moment that I walked in here. Coach would kind of say, 'We brought Nina here because we needed a leader.' The girls allowed me to do that. They started listening and there was never a problem with it."

She perfectly navigated what could have been a challenging relationship with junior Sidney Love, a hometown favorite from nearby Cibolo who was one of Aston's first recruits. Love's commitment to UTSA early in her head coach's tenure provided an early indicator to other top area players that the Roadrunners were taking big strides to become an elite program. Many of the talented student-athletes on UTSA's current roster soon followed with their commitments to the program.

The Roadrunners have relied on Love, who came to the program as a point guard, to start since her freshman season of 2022-23. She had to quickly learn how to be an NCAA Division I floor general from the very beginning of her collegiate career. Love has moved to the shooting guard position with De Leon Negron earning the starting nod at point guard. What could have been an awkward situation has turned into a strong relationship.

"Sidney really had to learn her own way of doing things without having a role model," Aston said. "I had some anxiety about bringing someone else in here with a now-three-year starter, but it has been really fun to see her relationship with Sidney and how they've meshed together. I think that Sid really looks up to her and has shown her a different way to be. And that's super cool."

The bond between De Leon Negron and Love has given the Roadrunners a dynamic backcourt that has been central to their success. Both players rank among the top-60 nationally in assists per game and are both equally threatening to opponents as scorers.

"We go into the film room with coach every single week and we watch point guard film," De Leon Negron said. "Sidney has been starting since she was a freshman so she had to be a leader because she had no other choice. When you're a freshman, that's hard."

From the outside, it also might seem unexpected that De Leon Negron has built a strong relationship with Jenkins, the 2022-23 Conference USA Player of the Year, whose name is synonymous with the program and brings definite star power to the roster after transferring from USC in 2022. It is a tribute to the humility and dedication of both players, as well as their shared goals for the program.

"Nina and I have really good chemistry," Jenkins said. "I feel like a lot of people wouldn't have expected it because she's new. Her love and care for the game allows us to have that chemistry because we're on the same page."

De Leon Negron credits the closeness of her team for helping make her transition that much smoother.

"We hang out a lot outside of basketball," she said. "We're in each other's apartments and we're always talking. Nine times out of 10, we're talking about basketball and the team."

For the first time in her collegiate career, she had the opportunity to play at home in front of her family when the Roadrunners traveled to San Juan to play in the Puerto Rico Clasico over Thanksgiving.

"Who would have thought?" De Leon Negron wondered aloud. "I don't think I've ever felt a better feeling than what I felt at that first game when I saw my family there. It was amazing; I hadn't felt that in years."

In a pair of wins during her homecoming, De Leon Negron averaged 9.5 points per game, 6.0 assists per game and 5.5 rebounds per game. Her coach was equally delighted for her player to get to experience the moment with family.

"That was one of the coolest experiences I've had as a coach," Aston said. "Mainly because of the fact that it wasn't pre-planned. For that to play out the way that it did, for her to decide to come here and to be able to see her show everybody in our program her surroundings was really cool. You could tell that she was proud to be able to see her family and she got to spend Thanksgiving with them, which she probably hasn't done since she first left home."

Over the years, De Leon Negron has modeled her game after two prominent Puerto Rican basketball players who have played at the highest level – former Dallas Mavericks player and Puerto Rican national team member J.J. Barea and former Atlanta Dream and University of Texas player Carla Cortijo. Cortijo was recruited and mentored by Aston, who was an assistant with the Longhorns at the time.

De Leon Negron's passion for the game of basketball is palpable and she hopes to continue playing professionally once her time at UTSA has concluded.

"If I keep playing how I've been playing, I think that I would really like to [play professionally]," she said. "I know for sure that I would like to play in Puerto Rico but, if I ever get the opportunity to go overseas, I might just go ahead and take it."

De Leon Negron earned her bachelor's degree at UIW, where she was a member of the Dean's List, and is currently pursuing a graduate certificate in health from UTSA's College for Health, Community and Policy.

Regardless of when the ball stops bouncing for De Leon Negron, she never plans to be far from the game. She looks to pursue a career in coaching, a desire that has only been increased since she began playing for Aston.

De Leon Negron has built a strong bond with Associate Head Coach Jamie Carey, who was an All-Big 12 Conference point guard at Texas, where she was recently inducted into the Athletics Hall of Fame, and led the Longhorns to the 2003 NCAA Final Four. Aston, who was an assistant at Texas during Carey's playing days, sees many of Carey's best attributes in De Leon Negron.

"Nina puts everybody before herself and Jamie has that type of personality too," Aston said. "Jamie's a little more serious and Nina can be super bubbly at times. She has really helped our team change its personality because she balances out the seriousness of Jamie and I. I think she's a real benefit in that manner. Her desire to study the game, to pick the brains of the people that she's playing for, and then to get to know her teammates and what they need from her is very similar to Jamie. Those are all the point guard qualities that you're looking for."

Carey has become a pivotal mentor for De Leon Negron, guiding her to pursue her passion as both a point guard and, in the future, as a coach.

"Coach Jamie and I have had so many conversations about basketball and, every time, she's like, 'You need to be a coach." De Leon Negron said. "She helps me a lot. I feel like we see the game the same way."

For now, De Leon Negron is focused on helping the Roadrunners be the best team they can be on a daily basis. She won't allow herself to get caught up in the statistics or the accolades or the wins. She embraces the process of being great.

"We've been working so hard and Coach keeps talking about stacking wins," De Leon Negron said. "Even when we win, we don't see it as we've won so many in a row, we just see it as another game. It's just another step to reaching the goal. We can't get too high or too low, we need to keep it neutral. That's how I see it. That's what championship teams do."

And while she's careful not to look too far ahead, De Leon Negron believes that this UTSA team has the potential to be one of the best in program history.

"We have a really talented team," she said. "Everyone is talented in their own way. I say we can get to wherever we set our mind to. I really believe it."
