QUICK HITTERS

- Tulsa Golden Hurricane women's basketball is in its 40th season in 2024-25.
- Tulsa's entering its 11th season as members of the American Athletic Conference.
- TU is 70-100 in the AAC and 3-3 in 2024-25.
- This season's roster features six returners and nine newcomers, including five transfers and four true freshmen.
- All six returners, who bring back 46% of last year's scoring, have seen valuable playing time this season, with four of them (Mady Cartwright, Delanie Crawford, Elise Hill and Hadley Periman) earning starts and averaging over 20 minutes per game.
- Head Coach Angie Nelp is in her fourth year of leading the Hurricane with a 68-43 record.
- Delanie Crawford, a senior from Piedmont, Okla., is coming off a tremendous All-American (WBCA Honorable Mention) junior season where she averaged 19.0 points (665), 5.7 rebounds (201), 2.7 assists (95) and 1.1 steals (39) per game ... she was named the AAC's Most Improved Player of the Year and Second Team All-Conference.
- TU was picked to finish 4th in the AAC this season, tying the program's highest selection in the preseason poll with the 2022-23 season.
- #LoveTrustWork** is the culture upon which Angie Nelp and her coaching staff instill in the team. "We love, we trust, we work!"

A Hurricane in Tulsa?

In 2022, Tulsa celebrated the 100th anniversary of adopting the school's nickname of Golden Hurricane.

In 1922, first-year football coach Howard Acher saw great potential in his team and wanted to publicize it by creating a new identity with a new nickname. Sports writers and others had called the school by any number of names from the Presbyterians to the Orange and Black, to the Kendallites.

After an opening day win against a strong TCU team in 1922, Acher put his mind to work. The press had claimed that the Tulsa football team blew through its opponents like a tornado. So, it figured that Tornadoes would be the nickname with "golden" added to identify the color of the uniforms. However, it was later found that Georgia Tech had claimed that name, so from tornado it was evolved meteorologically to a hurricane. Thus the squad voted, and the name "Golden Hurricane" became the new school moniker with the gold added because of the jersey color.

Facing the Undefeated Roadrunners

- UTSA remains undefeated in conference play with a 7-0 record.
- The Roadrunners are 16-2 overall with wins in their last nine games.
- UTSA was voted to finish fifth this season in the AAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- Three players average double-digit scoring with redshirt senior Jordyn Jenkins leading the AAC with 19.6 points per contest. She's the only player in the league scoring more than Delanie Crawford (17.7 ppg).
- UTSA leads the American in rebounding margin (10.8), scoring defense (55.9 ppg), scoring margin (12.2) and winning percentage (.889). Their rebounding margin is ninth in the nation.

Crawford Set to Break TU Career 3-Point Record

- Senior guard Delanie Crawford enters Wednesday's game against the UTSA Roadrunners with 232 career triples across four seasons at TU.
- The current record is held by Kelsee Grovey, who had 233 treys in 123 games in four seasons with the Hurricane.
- Crawford needs just two to surpass the record. Wednesday is her 111th game.

Dynamic Crawford Can Do It All

- It should come to no surprise that returning All-American Delanie Crawford continues to be a scoring leader in the AAC with her 17.7 points-per-game mark, the second-best effort in the league.
- The multi-level scorer has earned double-digit points in all but two games, peaking with 36 against East Carolina (12/29) in the conference opener.
- She enjoyed her 22nd career 20+ scoring game with 21 points at Temple (1/11)
- This season, Crawford is averaging 6.4 FG, 2.7 3PT and 2.3 FT per game.
- She's shooting .399 from the field (115-288), .324 in threes (48-148) and .911 at the charity stripe (41-45).
- Crawford is also first in the AAC for field goal attempts (288) and 3-point attempts (148), second for field goals made (115), total points (319) and points per game (17.7) and third for 3-pointers per game (2.67) and total threes (48).
- Her 148 3-point attempts are the seventh-most in Division I.
- She has also been one of Tulsa's most prominent rebounders and assisters. Crawford is second on the team with 104 total rebounds, ranking only behind teammate Hadley Periman (8.3 rpg) with a 5.6 average per game.
- Crawford also has the third-most assists on the team with 40 (2.2 apg).
- She earned her first AAC Weekly Honorable Mention nod this season after earning a double-double with 25 points and 13 rebounds vs Chicago State. She picked up her second one after averaging 21.5 points across the two West Palm Beach Classic games (Montana and Tennessee), including tying her then-season-high of 26 points in the win over Montana (12/20).
- Crawford dropped 36 points on East Carolina (12/29) on a 14-20 clip from the field, 3-7 from three and 5-5 at the line, earning her second career AAC Player of the Week award and first of the season.
- Crawford's led Tulsa in scoring 12 times this season and paced the Hurricane in rebounds and steals five times and assists four times.
- Finally, she is the longest active tenured AAC player in the league with 3,314 minutes played in 110 games. The next closest is UAB's Maddie Walsh (1,701 minutes, 51 games)

Tidbits on the TCU Transfer Paige Bradley

- Redshirt junior Paige Bradley, an offseason transfer from TCU, has made an immediate impact for the Hurricane with 17 starts in 18 games played.
- She came to Tulsa with only three double-digit scoring games in her career. She has six this season.
- Bradley is fourth on TU for rebounds (81) and boards per contest (4.5).
- Bradley averages 7.9 points, the Hurricane's fourth-best mark.
- Bradley had her first double-figure scoring game for Tulsa against Marshall (11/23) in the WBCA Showcase. She also brought down a career-high 10 rebounds, helping her achieve her first double-double.
- The Hurricane is 7-3 when Bradley records three or more field goals.
- Bradley took home her first career AAC Weekly Honorable Mention after averaging 16.0 points and 8.0 boards in wins over San Jose State (12/10) and Kansas City (12/15).

Periman Scores, Boards and Blocks

- After missing the first two games of the season and the Chicago State game (11/27) with injury, junior guard/forward Hadley Periman is still the Hurricane's top rebounder with 125 boards at a 8.3 rate per game.
- She has 512 career rebounds with a career rate of 6.40 per game, marking the seventh-best average among all active players in the AAC.
- Only two players in the league - ECU's Amiya Joyner (761) and South Florida's Carla Brito (563) have more career boards than Periman.
- Periman also blocks the ball better than most in the conference this season with a 23 rejections at 1.64 per contest, the second-best marks in the league.
- Her 17 rebounds against FAU (1/15) is tied for the second-most in a game by an AAC player so far this season.
- She ranks seventh in TU history with 107 career rejections.
- Periman has led TU in rebounding eight times, all in the last 11 games. She's also led the Hurricane in blocking in 12 games.
- She has four double-doubles this season with three of them occurring in the last five games. Tulsa is 3-1 when Periman records a double-double.
- Four double-doubles is the fourth-most among all AAC players.
- Periman came within two assists shy of a triple-double against Charlotte (1/8), finishing with 16 points, 15 boards, eight assists, three assists and two blocks, leading TU in the latter four categories.

Rolling Hill Continues to Succeed on the Floor

- Sophomore guard Elise Hill has scored in double-figures in 11 of 18 games this season and in 13 of her last 21 games for the Hurricane dating back to the end of her freshman season last year.
- She has scored 10 points once this year, 12 points on four occasions, 13 points against Marshall (11/23), 15 points against the league's toughest defense in UTSA (1/4), 16 points against FAU (1/15), 18 points against Grambling (12/5) and a career-best 22 points at North Texas (1/1).
- Hill called her own number in the waning seconds of the season-opener against UAPB, sinking the game-winning three-pointer with less than a second to go to seal the 63-60 win.
- She went 8-14 with six treys for 22 points vs. UNT. It was the seventh-most threes in a game by a TU player.
- She has also recorded 5+ assists four times this season and has 43 assists (2.4 apg) so far, tying with teammate Kristol Ayson.
- Hill also thrives on defense, using her quickness and speed to steal the ball 25 times this season.
- Hill stole the ball from ECU (12/29) eight times for Tulsa's second-highest effort in history, spanning both nonconference and conference play.
- She grabbed her first career AAC Weekly Honorable Mention award after she scored a team-leading 18 points with five assists and six rebounds in the win over Grambling (12/5).
- Hill has led Tulsa in scoring five times and assists four times this year.

Cartwright the Swiss Army Knife

- Mady Cartwright, a sophomore guard, shines on both offense and defense for the Hurricane.
- She is one of three players to start every game this season, along with Delanie Crawford and Elise Hill.
- Cartwright is sixth in the American Athletic Conference with a .718 free throw percentage (51-71).
- Cartwright shot a perfect 8-8 game at the line against Marshall (11/23) for TU's 14th all-time perfect free throw game of over eight attempts.
- She has reached double-digit scoring in eight games this season.
- On offense, Cartwright leads the team for free throws (51) and free throw attempts (71) and ranks third for points (175) and scoring average (9.7).
- On the defensive end, Cartwright is third on the team for total boards (82) and rebounds per game (4.6) and is fourth for steals (21).
- Cartwright had her first career double-double against San Jose State (12/10) with 12 points and 10 rebounds against the Spartans.
- She had her first 20+ point game against Charlotte (1/8) with 21 points.
- Tulsa is 4-2 this season when Cartwright steals the ball two or more times in a game and 5-3 when assisting on three or more field goals.

Ayson Adds Speed and Versatility

- Kristol Ayson, a senior transfer from Jacksonville State and Arizona Western, has played in all 18 games, averaging 20.9 minutes per game off the bench.
- She's second on TU with 26 steals at 1.44 per contest.
- She also leads the Hurricane in assists with 43 total for 2.4 per game.
- Ayson has hit three or more assists in 10 games, with a season-best of five assists against San Jose State (12/10).
- Tulsa is 6-4 when she records three or more assists in a game.
- She had a 13-point game against Oral Roberts for her first and only double-figure scoring game with the Hurricane.
- Ayson has led TU in steals five times and assists four times this year.
- She came to Tulsa after leading Jax State with 8.1 points, 1.7 assists and 1.1 steals per game while securing 3.7 rebounds in 26.1 minutes per contest.
- At Arizona Western, a junior college, Ayson recorded three double-doubles and 34 double-digits scoring games across two seasons. She was an NJCAA All-American Honorable Mention as a sophomore.

- Tulsa's Angie Nelp won her 60th career game in her four seasons with a 63-60 win against Arkansas-Pine Bluff in the 2024-25 season opener on Nov. 6.
- She is currently 68-43 18 games into her fourth season.
- No previous Tulsa coach had reached 50 wins in their first three seasons ... only three other Tulsa head coaches won more than 60 games in their careers.
- Nelp needs five wins to pass Charlene Thomas-Swinson's (2005-11) 72 wins for third on the all-time TU coach wins list.

Home Court Advantage

- The Hurricane has been deadly in the Donald W. Reynolds Center under fourth-year head coach Angie Nelp.
- TU is 22-5 at home since the start of last season, 33-9 since 2022-23 and 41-14 since Nelp joined the program.
- 2024-25: TU is 7-3 at home so far this season.
- 2023-24: The Hurricane enjoyed their winningest home record in program history, going 15-2 under the lights of the Reynolds Center, including 2-1 in postseason play in the WBIT.
- 2022-23: Tulsa went 11-4 and started the home slate 9-0.
- 2021-22: The Hurricane enjoyed its first winning home record in three years at 8-5 under Nelp in her first season.

Fun Facts About Player Names

- Tulsa is one of two teams in the country (Sacramento State) to have four players with a last name that starts with the letter "A": Tobi Ademuwagun, Brooklyn Alexander, Kennedy Alexander and Kristol Ayson.
- TU is also the only team in the country with over half the roster having last names starting in the A-C letter range. This list includes Tobi Ademuwagun, Brooklyn Alexander, Kennedy Alexander, Kristol Ayson, Paige Bradley, Mady Cartwright, Jade Clack and Delanie Crawford.

Crawford and Periman Climbing the Career Charts

- Delanie Crawford through 110 career games in four seasons with the Hurricane stars in multiple top 10 career charts in program history.
- She ranks second in three-pointers made with 232 ... she has a chance to set the TU record next game as she is just one treys behind Kelsee Grovey's (2012-16) 233 made threes.
- Crawford is sixth for career points (1,514) and field goals made (521).
- Crawford is also ninth in free throw percentage (.816) and 10th in free throws made (240).
- Finally, Crawford is 10th all-time in assists with 280. She needs five more to pass Grovey's 284 assists for ninth.
- Junior Hadley Periman has played 80 games for Tulsa. She ranks seventh in TU history with 107 blocks, needing 14 more to pass Megan Moody's (2002-06) 120 rejections for sixth.

Going for 20

- Tulsa players have combined for nine 20+ point scoring efforts this year.
- Delanie Crawford currently has six under her belt with Mady Cartwright, Elise Hill, Hadley Periman each having one.
- Tulsa is 5-3 when a player scores over 20 points.
- There's been one game where two players scored over 20 in the same game: North Texas (1/1) with Delanie Crawford and Elise Hill each scoring 22.
- Crawford has recorded 22 20+ scoring games while Cartwright, Hill and Periman each have one so far in their careers, all in this season.

- Tulsa has had a 30+ scorer once this season.
- Delanie Crawford collected a career-high 36 points against ECU (12/29) off 14-20 FG, 3-7 3PT and 5-5 FT. It was her fourth career 30+ scoring game and first of this season.

Tulsa in Conference Action

- Despite sitting at a 3-3 AAC record, Tulsa players are enjoying strong statistical showings through the first six games.
- Four Hurricane average double-digits points, including Delanie Crawford (18.5), Elise Hill (13.0), Mady Cartwright (10.7) and Hadley Periman (10.3).
- Crawford is also second in steals (2.22), third for threes (2.67), seventh for 3-point shooting (.364) and eighth in field goal shooting (.433) per game.
- Hadley Periman is second for rebounding (9.67) and minutes (35.55), third for blocks (1.67) and assist/turnover ratio (2.00) and 13th for assists (3.33).
- Hill currently ranks sixth for 3-point percentage (.395) and made threes (2.50) and 14th for steals (1.50) per conference game.

Deadly Free Throw Shooters

- Mady Cartwright stands as the sixth-best free throw shooter in the conference at .718 (51-71).
- Before the Temple game (1/11), Delanie Crawford was leading the league in free throw percentage. She is currently at .911 after shooting 41-45 (2.4 FT/G), now outside the threshold of 2.5 FT per game needed to be ranked in the AAC.
- Cartwright has made her way to the line the most out of all TU players as she has gotten stronger at drawing fouls.
- Cartwright has had eight perfect games from the stripe, including a 4-4 mark in the season-opener against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (11/6), a 2-2 clip vs. Oral Roberts (11/17), an impressive 8-8 tally against Marshall (11/23) for Tulsa's 14th-ever perfect free throw game when making over eight free throws, 4-4 contests against Chicago State (11/27) and UTSA (1/4) and a 2-2 showing against Temple (1/11).
- She also had a 6-10 contest against #18/16 Tennessee (12/21) and a 6-8 effort against Charlotte (1/8).
- Crawford had an 8-9 free throw game against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (11/6) and 5-5 contests against Georgia (11/21) and East Carolina (12/29).
- Crawford has made 22 free throws in a row, dating back to her final two of the Marshall game (11/23).
- Paige Bradley is 18-23 (.783) in free throws at 1.1 per contest ... she is also outside the threshold of 2.5 FT per game required to be ranked in the AAC.
- TU shot its 19th perfect free throw game in program history against Chicago State (11/27), going 10-10 from the line ... it's TU's third time ever having a perfect free throw game with over 10 attempts (10-10 vs. Hawaii (2-27-03); 12-12 vs. Nevada (3-8-03)).
- The Hurricane went 10-14 in free throws in the fourth quarter to outscore Arkansas-Pine Bluff (11/6) 15-5 in the final period to complete a 17-point comeback victory, the largest in school history. TU finished 19-28 at the line in the win.

All-Time Great Performances in Conference Opener

- Big games by senior Delanie Crawford and sophomore Elise Hill pushed the Golden Hurricane to a record-setting victory in the AAC opener against ECU.
- Crawford finished with 36 points on 14-20 shooting, the third-highest individual scoring game in program history and the second-most scored in a conference game. Hill picked up eight steals, the second-most ever by a Tulsa player.
- 35 team field goals by the Hurricane tied the record for the most field goals made against a conference team.
- A .565 shooting percentage is the second-best mark against a conference foe.
- 21 team steals now stands as the second-highest tally against a conference program.
- The two teams combined for 67 made field goals (Tulsa (35), ECU (32)) for a Reynolds Center record.

The Hurricane Style of Play

- Tulsa plays a brand of positionless basketball.
- Although players on the roster have designated positions, TU hoopers are forced to be versatile and adapt to different roles, rather than being restricted to traditional positions.
- In a positionless scheme, players can score at all levels of the court, making schemes difficult to read for opposing defenses.

Angie Nelp

Colorado State, 2002 • Fourth Year • 68-43

Angie Nelp is in her fourth season as the head basketball coach at The University of Tulsa. She became the school’s 11th head coach in women’s basketball history when appointed to the position on April 12, 2021.

In three seasons, Nelp has compiled a 59-34 record for a .634 winning percentage. She has won the most games of any Tulsa coach in their first three seasons and is the first coach in program history to post winning records in her first three seasons, registering 17 wins in her first and second years and 25 wins in her third.

While at TU, Nelp’s players have earned two WBCA All-America honors, two WBCA Region Finalists, one American Athletic Conference Player of the Year, one AAC Most Improved Player of the Year, one AAC Freshman of the Year, four All-Conference awards and three All-Freshman hoopers.

In her 16-year Division I coaching career, Nelp has helped lead teams to postseason competition 10 times. She has coached 37 all-conference players, nine conference players of the year, four conference freshman of the year honorees, 50 academic all-conference selections and has had 19 players play professionally.

Nelp came to Tulsa following four seasons (2017-21) on the coaching staff at Arizona State. She spent her first three years as an assistant coach and was promoted to associate head coach in April 2020. During her tenure, the Sun Devils posted a .617 winning percentage with an overall 76-47 record and advanced to the postseason three times. ASU played in the NCAA Tournament twice, moving to the “Sweet Sixteen” in the 2018-19 campaign, and competed in the WNIT during the 2020-21 campaign.

Nelp also had stints at Rice (2015-17) and Mercer (2011-15) as an assistant coach, Marquette (2008-10) as an assistant director of operations and at Arkansas (2007-08) as a graduate assistant.

Nelp played collegiately at Colorado State (1998-02), accumulating 1,397 points, 629 rebounds, 356 assists and 261 steals in four seasons, and leading the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances. She earned Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year honors, was a first-team All-MWC selection, a Kodak All-America Honorable Mention honoree and was named an academic all-conference performer all four seasons. Nelp was inducted into the Colorado State Athletics Hall of Fame in 2019.

A native of Eufaula, Okla., Nelp, formerly Angie Gorton, starred at Canadian High School in Oklahoma, and led her team to the 1998 Oklahoma State Championship while earning state tournament MVP honors and was tabbed as the 1998 Oklahoma Gatorade Player of the Year.

After graduating from Colorado State in 2002 with a bachelor’s degree in health and exercise science, she went on to spend two seasons with the NWBL Colorado Chill and one season with 08 Stockholm in Sweden. As a professional, she helped lead the Chill to the 2005 NWBL title and 08 Stockholm to the 2003 Swedish national crown.

Following her professional career, Nelp returned to the United States to serve as the head girls’ basketball coach at Yorktown High in Yorktown, Ind.

Nelp and her husband Jake have four children: JJ, Louis, Ellie Kaye and Harrison.
