FROG HOPS

- With four regular season crowns and four tournament trophies, TCU's eight Big 12 championships are the most of any program in the league since TCU joined in 2013.
- The eight total championships are the second most in league history.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ TCU was ranked in the preseason for the 16th straight season.
- Bill Mosiello returns to TCU after spending two seasons at Ohio State as the head coach where he put together a 60-51 record.
- From 2014-22, Saarloos and Mosiello guided TCU to a 355-165 (.683) record, four regular season titles, three Big 12 tournament titles, seven postseason appearances and four CWS appearances (2014-17).
- D1Baseball ranked the incoming freshman class No. 8. The group features 14 members.
- TCU has a pair of juniors that hail from the same high school in California. Karson Bowen and Louis Rodriguez both played at Orange Lutheran.
- $\bullet~$ TCU has two sets of brothers on the squad Anthony and Jacob Silva along with Jax and Nolan Traeger.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT

En route to its 21 wins, the Horned Frogs have utilized the comeback method to record 13 of the wins. In nine of those 13 comeback victories, TCU has rallied from a multi-run deficit.

TCU has been slow-starting on the offensive side this season, hitting just .257 (85-for-331) with 61 runs through the first three innings. The Frogs pick up steam in the middle innings, hitting. 295 with 80 runs scored.

TCU has been outscored 62-61 in the first three innings, but is outscoring its opponents 157-86 over the final six innings.

EN FUEGO

Sawyer Strosnider had a rough start to his collegiate career, hitting .167 (6-for-36) with 17 strikeouts. The past 17 games have seen Strosnider explode offensively. He raised his average 212 points to .379 after hitting .493 (33-for-67) in the last 17 games. He has tallied multiple hits in 11 of the 17 games. Additionally, the RBIs have piled up as he tallied 27 in the 17 games, bringing his season total to 32.

MASTER RELIEVER

Braeden Sloan has found his home in the bullpen. His final six appearances of the 2024 campaign came out of the bullpen. He allowed just one earned run over nine innings with 17 strikeouts. This season, he's surrendered just four runs over 27 1/3 innings.

Sloan's last 14 appearances, all of the relief variety, he boasts a 1.24 ERA having surrendered four runs over 36 1/3 innings while piling up 55 strikeouts.

FRESH FACES

TCU has debuted 11 true freshmen this seasons.

At the plate, four freshmen are hitting .325 (90-for-277) with 20 doubles, six triples, 13 home runs and 60 RBIs.

On the mound, nine arms have debuted. Collectively, they have started 45% of the team's games and accounted 41% of the total innings pitched. They have racked up 113 strikeouts in $106\ 2/3$ innings of work.

IMPACT TRANSFERS

Ten transfers have made their TCU debut between the field and the mound. Collectively, the six hitters have 82 hits, including 12 doubles, four triples, nine home runs and 55 RBIs. Jack Bell and Isaac Cadena rank fourth on the team with three home runs, while Cadena ranks fifth on the squad with 19 RBIs.

On the mound, Trey Newmann, Tommy LaPour, Blake Rogers and Gianluca Shinn debuted. They have contributed 48.2 innings of work on the mound and tallied 40 strikeouts.

WELCOME HOME

Coach Mosiello is highly regarded as one of the top offensive minds in baseball. In his previous stint with TCU, the Frogs had three All-Americans, three Big 12 Freshmen of the Year, two Big 12 Players of the Year and five freshmen All-Americans. Additionally, TCU produced 45 all-conference selections and 17 draft picks.

Under his tutelage, TCU twice led the league in batting average. Four times the Frogs surpassed the 100-stolen base mark. They ranked in the top 50 nationally in runs per game in six of nine campaigns.

In nine seasons under the direction of Coach Mosiello, the Horned Frogs hit .276 and averaged 6.48 runs per game. Six times the squad ranked in the top 23 nationally in stolen bases.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation. The Frogs have stolen 100 or more bases in three of the last four seasons. Since 2015, TCU has ranked in the top 10 nationally in stolen bases four times.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced at a high success rate, converting on 80% of their attempts over the last eight years (1117-of-1401). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 12 seasons, TCU is 200-of-243 (82%) in stealing third.

This season, TCU is 45-for-59 in stolen bases, including 38-of-60 when stealing second and 6-of-8 when stealing third. Eleven Frogs have tallied at least one stolen base.

NATIONWIDE

The United States is well-represented on the Horned Frogs rosters. The 40 athletes hail from 12 states spanning the continental USA.

There are 16 players from the state of Texas. California is represented by 13 athletes. Missouri is the only other state with multiple representatives with two.

Nine other states have one representative in Arizona, Florida, Iowa, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Oregon and Washington.

STINGY STAFF

The Frogs' 3.67 ERA since 2013 is fourth nationally. TCU led the nation with a 2.22 ERA in 2014 and ranked second in 2015 with a 2.45 ERA. The TCU pitching staff has produced four of the top 10 lowest ERAs in program history. Additionally, the TCU pitching staff has the eighth-most shutouts [65] nationally over the last 13 years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 266 times in the 727 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 288 times in those contests.

K-ZONE

Over the last 13 seasons, TCU pitchers have struck out batters at a high rate. In 727 games, they have tallied double-digit strikeouts 309 times. TCU set a school record with 36 double-digit strikeout games in 2024.

Already this season, the TCU pitching staff has produced 11 double-digit strikeout contests.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 46 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 28-18 mark in those games. TCU is 9-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU has played in two extra inning games this season and is 2-0 in those contests. The Horned Frogs have won six straight extra inning games dating back to 2023

The Frogs' longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
