OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Byrum Brown • Sr. • QB • South Florida

Brown finished with 329 yards of total offense – the most of any player in the American in Week 2 – to lead South Florida to an 18-16 win at No. 13 Florida. He completed 23 of 36 passes for 263 yards and a touchdown and rushed for 66 yards on 17 carries.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Collin Matteson • Sr. • S • Army

Matteson finished with five tackles and came away with three pass breakups and the decisive interception on Kansas State's final drive to clinch a 24-21 road win.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Nico Gramatica • So. • K • South Florida

Gramatica scored 10 points on three field goals and a PAT, including the walk-off field goal as time expired, in South Florida's 18-16 win at No. 13 Florida.

HONORABLE MENTION

Cale Hellums • Jr. • QB • Army

Rushed for 124 yards and two touchdowns on 41 carries and completed 7 of 11 passes for 43 yards and a TD in a 24-21 win at Kansas State in his first career start.

Blake Horvath • Sr. • QB • Navy

Rushed for 72 yards and two touchdowns on 18 carries and completed 6 of 9 passes for 168 yards and a TD in a 38-24 win against UAB.

Makenzie McGill II • So. • RB • North Texas

Rushed for 102 yards on 16 carries, including the game-winning touchdown in overtime, in a 33-30 win at Western Michigan

Mac Harris • Gr. • LB • South Florida

Registered 10 tackles with a sack in an 18-16 win at No. 13 Florida, leading a defense that limited the Gators to one touchdown.

Robert Henry • Sr. • RB • UTSA

Rushed for 159 yards on 17 carries and two touchdowns and added a receiving TD in a 43-36 loss to Texas State, turning in his fourth consecutive 100-yard game.

AMERICAN NOTEBOOK

Perfect Six

Six teams from the American sit at 2-0 through two weeks of the season. The only other conferences with at least six 2-0 teams are the ACC (eight), the Big 12 (seven), the Big Ten (14) and the SEC (12). No other conferences have more than two 2-0 teams.

Matching Up

Teams from the American are a combined 2-2 against the Big Ten and SEC. Those conferences are a combined 55-5 against all other opponents.

The American ranks fifth among NCAA FBS conferences in nonconference winning percentage through two weeks of the season.

Deja Vu?

South Florida is ranked No. 18 in this week's Associated Press poll and faces No. 5 Miami (Fla.) Saturday. The last time a No. 18 South Florida squad faced the No. 5-ranked team was Sept. 28, 2007, when the Bulls knocked off West Virginia 21-13.

Streaking

Memphis enters Week 3 with a six-game winning streak, which is tied with Ohio State and Illinois for the nation's longest active streak. Navy has won five straight, which ties Missouri, TCU, LSU, Louisville and Air Force for fourth.

Gauntlet

South Florida is the only team in college football to open the 2025 season with three consecutive games against top-25 teams. The Bulls defeated No. 25 Boise State in Week 1, No. 13 Florida in Week 2 and face No. 5 Miami Saturday.

Sunshine State Success

South Florida is the first program to have won at least one game on the home field of each of the other six FBS programs in the state of Florida (Florida Atlantic, Florida, Florida State, Miami, UCF, FIU).

Caretaker

South Florida QB Byrum Brown has thrown a school-record 240 consecutive passes without an interception.

Hardware

The American Conference won the 2024 Bowl Challenge Cup as the FBS conference with the best winning percentage in Bowl Season. American teams were a combined 6-2 in bowl games in 2024, including wins against teams from the SEC, Big 12, ACC, Mountain West, Sun Belt and Conference USA.

Road, Sweet Road

Army, which won at Kansas State last Saturday, has won its last five road games – the fourth-longest active streak nationally (Oregon - 7, Penn State and Louisiana - 6).

Possessive

Army had possession for 40 minutes and 44 seconds in its win against Kansas State last Saturday.

Sunset Cruise

Memphis, which visits Troy Saturday, has won its last 12 games against opponents from the Sun Belt Conference.

Keys To Victory

Tulane head coach Jon Sumrall is 27-0 in his career when his team outrushes its opponent.

First Time For Everything

North Texas' 33-30 overtime win at Western Michigan was the Mean Green's first win in program history in which it did not hold a lead in regulation.

Back-To-Back

North Texas has registered a 2-0 start in back-to-back years for the first time since the 1989 and 1990 seasons.

Twenty And Counting

Memphis has scored at least 20 points in 42 consecutive games, marking the longest active streak among FBS teams

Conversion Rates

Army was 6-for-7 on fourth down conversions against Kansas State, including 5-for-5 in the second half.

Workhorse

Army QB Cale Hellums, who was making his first career start, had 41 rushing attempts in the win at Kansas State, the most by a quarterback in American Conference history and the second-most among all players (46, D'Angelo Brewer of Tulsa at Fresno State, 9/24/16).

Going National

The American has had the FWAA National Defensive Player of the Week in each of the first two weeks of the season. South Florida LB Jhalyn Shuler was the Week 1 winner, while Army S Collin Matteson won in Week 2.

80-Yard Field

Navy has scored on 27 consecutive red zone possessions at home (24 touchdowns, three field goals), dating to the start of last season

Oh Henry

UTSA RB Robert Henry has registered four consecutive 100-yard games.

We're Available

The American will issue player availability reports in advance of all conference games in the 2025 season. Reports will be published to the American website and on social media two hours prior to kickoff.

People Watching

More than 52 million viewers watched American Conference football on television in 2024. The American had 17 games that drew at least one million viewers.

National Brand

In the first year with both Army and Navy in the American, the annual Army-Navy game on CBS drew 9.4 million viewers, the largest television audience for the game since at least 1990 and a 31% increase over the 2023 game.

Must See TV

The 2024 American Championship Game between Army and Tulane drew more than 2 million viewers on ABC, marking the eighth time in 10 years that the game surpassed 2 million viewers.

The Sooners started with a 35-3 win against Illinois State and followed with a 24-13 victory against No. 15 Michigan last Saturday ... COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The Bracket

The format of the College Football Playoff is built on a 12-team bracket. The five highest-ranked conference champions will earn a place in the Playoff, but will no longer include a bye for the four highest-ranked champions.

The 12-team bracket will now be seeded directly based on the final ranking of the CFP Selection Committee, with the four highest-ranked teams receiving a first-round bye. If one or more of the five highest-ranked conference champions are ranked outside the top 12, that team or teams would move up to the 12th seed, 11th seed, etc., based on the number of conference champions outside the top 12.

- The 12 participating teams will be the five conference champions ranked highest by the CFP selection committee, plus the next seven highest-ranked teams.
- The ranking of the teams will continue to be done by a selection committee.
- The eight teams seeded No. 5-12 will play in a first round with the higher seeds hosting the lower seeds either on campus or at other sites designated by the higher-seeded institution (No. 12 at No. 5, No. 11 at No. 6, No. 10 at No. 7 and No. 9 at No. 8).
- The four highest-ranked teams will be assigned to Playoff Quarterfinals bowls on Selection Day in ranking order and in consideration of current contract bowl relationships (for example: if the highest-ranked team is from the Big Ten, that team would be assigned to the Rose Bowl Game).
- The highest seed will receive preferential placement for the Playoff Semifinal bowl assignment.
- All 11 games will be under the CFP umbrella with the administrative policies determined by the CFP.

American Conference teams are guaranteed at least eight bowl appearances in 2025 as part of the conference's postseason lineup, which began in the 2020 season.

The American champion would play in the College Football Playoff if it is ranked among the five highest-ranked conference champions by the CFP selection committee.

As part of the current bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Go Bowling Military Bowl in Annapolis, Maryland, and the Wasabi Fenway Bowl in Boston, facing opponents from the Atlantic Coast Conference in those matchups. In 2025, The American will send a team to the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the Sheraton Hawai'i Bowl.

In the 2025 season, The American will additionally fill four spots from a group of eight bowls: the Birmingham Bowl, the StaffDNA Cure Bowl, the Union Home Mortgage Gasparilla Bowl, the Boca Raton Bowl, the Scooter's Coffee Frisco Bowl, the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl, the Isleta New Mexico Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.
