UTSA Postgame Notes

TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- UTSA falls to 2-3, 0-1, while Temple improves to 3-2, 1-0
 - The Roadrunners lead the series, 2-1.
- UTSA is 8-6 in conference openers.
 - This marked the fourth straight and 10th time overall that UTSA has opened conference play on the road.
- The Roadrunners are 8-11 in games played in the Eastern time zone.
- The Roadrunners are now 36-50 (.419) in road games.
- Head coach Jeff Traylor is 48-23 (.676) overall.
 - Traylor is 4-2 in conference openers.
 - He is 5-6 in games played in the Eastern time zone.

TEAM NOTES

- UTSA posted 304 yards of offense, 234 through the air and 70 on the ground.
- The Roadrunners received the game's opening kickoff for the first time this season.
- UTSA scored on its first possession for the second time this year with a 1-yard TD rush by Patrick Overmyer.
 - The Roadrunners are 1-1 this season when scoring on their first possession.
- UTSA held Temple to 309 yards of offense, 181 passing and 128 rushing.
- UTSA now has registered a sack in 27 of the past 28 games.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Junior QB Owen McCown passed for two touchdowns and 234 yards, completing a total of 25 passes on 37 attempts.
- Junior WR Devin McCuin pulled in six receptions for a total of 60 yards and one touchdown.
- Junior WR AJ Wilson led the team in receiving yards with 67 on three catches, including a long of 36 yards.
- Sophomore TE Patrick Overmyer caught one pass for seven yards and a touchdown and also had a one-yard rushing TD.
 - It marked the second game in a row where a Roadrunner had both a rushing and receiving touchdown.
- Senior ILB Kendrick Blackshire notched a career high 10 tackles, six of which were solo.
- Redshirt senior ILB Shad Banks Jr. registered six tackles and a forced fumble.
- Redshirt sophomore DL Daemian Wimberly recorded 1.5 TFLs, which ties his career high with one sack, which is a career high.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- UTSA's captains today were senior ILB Shad Banks Jr., junior DL Tai Leonard and junior QB Owen Pewee.
- The Roadrunners wore white helmets, white jerseys and orange pants, and the record now stands at 2-7 in that uniform combination.
- This is the 15th season of UTSA Football. The Roadrunners' all-time record now sits at 93-84 (.525).
