TEAM RECORDS AND SERIES NOTES

- UTSA improved to 5-5 overall and 3-3 in American Conference play. Charlotte fell to 1-9 and 0-7.
 - o This marked the third meeting and UTSA now leads the series, 3-0.
- The Roadrunners are 37-52 (.416) in road games.
- UTSA is now 62-45 (.579) in conference games.
 - The Roadrunners are 14-8 (.636) in American Conference games.
- The win was UTSA's first conference road victory since a 37-29 decision at North Texas on Nov. 4, 2023,
- The Roadrunners are 9-12 (.429) in games played in the Eastern time zone.
- Head coach Jeff Traylor is 51-25 (.671) overall (since 2020).
 - He is 34-11 (.756) in conference games including 14-8 (.636) in the American Conference.
 - O He is 17-4 (.801) in the month of November.

TEAM NOTES

- The Roadrunners held Charlotte to 197 yards of offense, a season low for an opponent.
- UTSA did not surrender an offensive touchdown for the first time since Oct. 21, 2023, against Florida Atlantic.
- UTSA did not allow Charlotte to cross midfield until midway through the third quarter, and the 49ers did not reach the red zone until the fourth.
- UTSA posted three sacks and now has a sack in 32 of the last 33 games.
 - The Roadrunners have logged multiple sacks for the fifth time this season and have registered three or more for the third time.
- UTSA now has a takeaway in 29 of the last 33 games after an interception in the fourth guarter.
- The Roadrunners registered 521 yards of total offense, 306 through the air and 215 on the ground.
 - UTSA has surpassed 500 yards of total offense twice this season after charting 523 against Tulane on Oct. 30, 2025.
- UTSA scored on its first offensive possession for the fifth time in the last six games.
- The Roadrunners had a 300-yard passer, 100-yard rusher and a 100-yard receiver in the same game for the first time since Nov. 15, 2024, vs. North Texas.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Junior QB Owen McCown completed 24-of-37 passes for 306 yards, logging two passing touchdowns and one on the ground.
 - o It marked his second 300-yard game of the season and sixth of his career.
- Junior WR Devin McCuin piled up a career-high 100 receiving yards and a touchdown on seven catches.
 - o It marked his first career 100-yard receiving game and the third by a Roadrunner this season.
- · Redshirt freshman RB Will Henderson III rushed for a career-high 185 yards
 - o It marked his second 100-yard rushing game of the season and UTSA's seventh.
 - His total is the most rushing yards by a Roadrunner this season and the sixth-most in program history.
 - He became the first Roadrunner to reach 185 rushing yards since Sincere McCormick scampered for 204 against Western Kentucky on Dec. 3, 2021.
 - His 59-yard TD rush in the third quarter is a career long, eclipsing a 57-yard run in the win over Rice on Oct. 11.
- Junior WR AJ Wilson hauled in five passes for 87 yards, including 70 yards after the catch.
- Sophomore WR David Amador II caught four passes for 31 yards and a score.
- Redshirt junior TE Houston Thomas caught four passes for 54 yards.
- Senior ILB Shad Banks Jr. posted a team-high eight tackles.
- Senior S Tvan Milton recorded six tackles, including one for loss, and an interception.
 - Milton's pick was his second of the season.
- Redshirt freshman DL Kenny Ozowalu recorded two tackles and a sack.
- Senior DL Jon Jones posted two tackles and a sack.
- Redshirt freshman ILB James Walley Jr. logged his first sack of the season.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- UTSA's captains today were senior ILB Shad Banks Jr., junior DL Tai Leonard, junior \$B Owen Pewee and senior OL Trevor Timmons.
- The Roadrunners wore blue helmets, white jerseys and white pants, and the record now stands at 9-13 in that uniform combination.
- This is the 15th season of UTSA Football. The Roadrunners' all-time record now sits at 96-86 (.528).
