#### **Embracing Growth: UTSA Football's Kendrick Blackshire**

Kendrick Blackshire marvels at how much he's grown over the course of his collegiate football journey.

The senior linebacker from the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex was a consensus four-star prospect coming out of high school and was considered to be one of the top-10 players in the nation at his position. He signed with Alabama, playing his first three seasons there, and spent the spring of 2024 at Texas before finding a home at UTSA.

Blackshire, 6-foot-1, 230 pounds, recalls always being one of the biggest kids and says his origins with football date back to kindergarten.



"They had me tackling," Blackshire said with a laugh. "I wasn't supposed to be tackling, but I was tackling. It was fun. Ever since then, I just fell in love with football."

At the prep level, he played three seasons at Mesquite Horn High School before competing for storied Duncanville High School as a senior. At Duncanville, Blackshire was a first-team MaxPreps All-American in 2020, helping his team to a 10-2 record and a Class 6A state semifinal appearance.

"Duncanville is a special place to play," he said. "It was like a college in a high school. It's amazing, just the legacy that they have there and all the talented players that they've had. It was a blessing to be able to play that level of high-quality football."

Blackshire took the field in 24 games at inside linebacker for the Crimson Tide and was a member of two Southeastern Conference Championship teams. Playing for Nick Saban at Alabama, Blackshire lived "The Process," the legendary head coach's discipline-based philosophy focused on the day-to-day approach to details.

"I never really understood it until now, but it's about the details," Blackshire said. "With Coach Saban, it was very disciplined. You do it so much, it becomes a routine. It's not about the big things, it's not about the game, it's about what you do to prepare yourself to get there. It's the preparation and details of your work and I never really understood it until now, but it helps me a lot."

Blackshire struggled with Achilles tendinosis, a condition where the Achilles tendon breaks down over time due to constant use. He transferred to Texas following the 2023 season but was unable to get healthy. After becoming a Roadrunner last fall, he played in the first three games but suffered a season-ending injury. He credits UTSA's coaching staff for placing an emphasis on his recovery.

"I knew that I was going to be given a chance to really recover and take care of the injuries I'd had in the past," Blackshire said. "I wasn't able to perform or do anything. I needed to take time to recover and get my body healthy. At UTSA, Coach [Jeff] Traylor and Coach [Jess] Loepp really took the time to be patient with me and let me get myself healthy."

The time away from the field not only helped Blackshire heal physically, but it also strengthened his love for the game and increased his awareness of all the various aspects that go into staying healthy.

"It definitely made me realize how much I love football," he said. "Being humbled and realizing that this can be taken away from me has just opened my eyes to not taking anything for granted. I really just work hard and focus on what I can do better and getting my body healthy."

The opportunity for self-reflection allowed Blackshire to identify areas in which he could improve and mature as a football player.

"I feel like I was holding myself back in a lot of ways," Blackshire said. "I was not eating the right things. I was not communicating whenever I felt my body was exhausted. They have really just been very patient with me on communicating and teaching me how to communicate. With the family vibe around here, it makes you open up and feel comfortable."

Blackshire focused heavily on nutrition, working with UTSA Athletics' Director of Sports Nutrition Paul Eom, RD, who joined the Roadrunners at the beginning of 2025, and his staff to understand how to properly fuel himself to optimize his performance and health.

"They are very detailed, and they don't leave any stone unturned when it comes to research," Blackshire said. "If I need to get my specific body fat percentage or if I need to research on what nutrients I need in my body, they're going to take the time to do it. They actually give you feedback and put things in front of you, so you do consume the proper things. It becomes repetition over time."

His hard work paid off. Despite having only played in three games at UTSA entering this season, Blackshire's teammates voted him into one of the program's coveted single-digit numbers. It was affirmation that he was making positive progress, not just as a football player but as a person.

"It meant the world to me and I wasn't expecting it," Blackshire said. "I knew I had a good spring and a good offseason. Whenever I found out, I called my mom and I was crying. It's an accomplishment, just knowing I'm headed in the right direction, because I've been through a lot. I'm thankful and extremely grateful. I just want to be a good representation of the UTSA Football program."

Blackshire has been a leader on the UTSA defense this season, registering 42 total tackles, one sack and one interception. While he is proud of how far he's come, he's most excited about continuing to progress in the future.

"I'm not even done yet; I'm still developing as we speak," Blackshire said.
"I'm thankful for Coach Traylor and the staff for bringing back the joy in playing the game I love. I hope the fans see a young man who is putting it all on the line and that they see the passion that's coming through me. I'm giving it my all and just playing for my teammates and my family. I'm striving for greatness each and every day."



#### **GAME CENTER**

#### OPENING DRIVE

- UTSA and East Carolina will meet for the third time on Saturday.
- The series is tied at 1-1 with each team winning at home over the past two seasons.
- Under the direction of sixth-year head coach Jeff Traylor, the Roadrunners are 24-0 against conference opponents at the Alamodome — including 22-0 in regular season league games — since 2020. UTSA is the only FBS team with an undefeated record in regular season conference home games during that span.
- The Roadrunners are 17-4 (.801) in the month of November in the Jeff Traylor era.
- UTSA is 51-25 (.671) under head coach Jeff Traylor, the most wins among current American Conference teams since 2020.
- The Roadrunners are 32-4 (.889) in home games with Jeff Traylor at the helm, tied for the eighth-most home victories in the FBS since 2020 and deadlocked with Memphis for the most among current American Conference members over that stretch.
- In the Jeff Traylor era, the Roadrunners are 34-11 (.756) in conference games, including 14-8 (.636) in the American.
- The Roadrunners have registered a sack in 32 of their last 33 games and a takeaway in 29 of their last 33 contests.
- UTSA boasts a 100-yard rusher in seven of the 10 games this season.

#### **SETTING THE SCENE**

UTSA will return to the friendly confines of the Alamodome to host East Carolina on Saturday, Nov. 22, in the first of two straight home games to wrap up the regular season slate. Kickoff is set for 2:30 p.m. and the game will air on ESPN+ and Sports Radio AM 760 The Ticket. The Roadrunners are coming off a 28-7 road triumph over Charlotte that evened their overall record to 5-5 and conference mark to 3-3. The Pirates used a late touchdown to slip past Memphis at home last Saturday night, improving to 7-3 and 5-1. This will mark the third meeting between the two programs in a series that has seen the home team come out on top in each of the past two seasons.

#### **TUNING IN**

Saturday's game will air on ESPN+ and via the ESPN app. Ted Emrich (play-by-play), Taylor McHargue (analyst) and Smacker Miles (reporter) will call the action. UTSA Sports Media Network will air the game live in the San Antonio area on Sports Radio AM 760 The Ticket, online at ticket760.com and via the free iHeartRadio app. Andy Everett (play-by-play), Jay Riley (analyst) and Ed Suarez (reporter) have the call. There will be a two-hour pregame show hosted by Pat Evans and a 45-minute postgame show.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

UTSA held Charlotte without an offensive touchdown and to fewer than 200 yards, while the Roadrunners piled up 521 yards in a 28-7 victory over the 49ers in American Conference action on Saturday at Jerry Richardson Stadium. UTSA limited Charlotte to 197 yards, including only 51 rushing, and surrendered just a kickoff return for a touchdown in winning a conference road game for the first time in two years. Shad Banks Jr. paced the defense with eight tackles, while Tyan Milton made six stops and picked off a pass late in the game to keep the Charlotte offense out of the end zone. Offensively, Owen McCown completed 24 of 37 passes for 306 yards and two touchdowns, also rushing for one score. Will Henderson III piled up a career-high 185 yards and a TD on 19 rushes, while Devin McCuin registered his first career 100-yard receiving game with 100 yards and a touchdown on seven catches. AJ Wilson added 87 yards on five receptions, as UTSA logged its second 500-yard offensive output of the year.

#### **HOME SWEET DOME**

UTSA has been tough to beat at the Alamodome during the Jeff Traylor era, boasting a 32-4 (.889) record at the facility dating back to the 2020 season. The 32 wins are tied with Memphis for the most among current American Conference members and tied with the Tigers and Notre Dame for the eighth most in the FBS during that span. Additionally, UTSA is a perfect 22-0 in regular season conference home games and 24-0 against league foes when including the 2021 and 2022 Conference USA Championship Games

under Traylor. The Roadrunners are the only FBS team with an undefeated record in conference home games since 2020 (Notre Dame, an Independent, was 5-0 in home ACC games in the adjusted COVID season in 2020) and the 22 wins in those contests place UTSA in a tie with Ohio State and Oregon for the secondmost in the FBS behind Alabama (24). The Roadrunners entered 2025 with a school record-tying 10-game home winning streak, but that was snapped in a heartbreaking loss to Texas State in the home opener on Sept. 6. UTSA has won in convincing fashion against UIW, Rice and Tulane in their last three Alamodome appearances, giving them 20 wins over the last 22 home contests.

UTSA also reeled off a 10-game home win streak that started with a 27-26 victory over Louisiana Tech on Oct. 24, 2020, and ran through the 49-41 win against WKU in the 2021 Conference USA Championship Game before it was snapped in triple overtime against No. 24 Houston in the 2022 season opener. The Roadrunners have been victorious in 30 of their last 33 home contests and are 58-31 (.652) all-time in the Alamodome.

#### **REMEMBER NOVEMBER**

The Roadrunners have experienced much success in the 11th month of the calendar year under head coach Jeff Traylor era. Since he took over the program prior to the 2020 season, UTSA boasts a 17-4 (.801) record in November, including a 7-3 (.700) mark in American Conference games.

#### TRAYLOR TAKING ROADRUNNERS TO NEW HEIGHTS

Sixth-year head coach Jeff Traylor has taken UTSA to new heights during his time in San Antonio. The Roadrunners are 51-25 (.671) under his direction, the most wins among current American Conference teams since 2020, tied for the 11th-most in the FBS and knotted with SMU for the second-most among teams from the state of Texas during that span. UTSA boasts a 32-4 (.889) home record in the Traylor era, tied for the eighthmost home victories in the FBS since 2020 and deadlocked with Memphis for the most among current American Conference members during that stretch. Additionally, with the 48-26 victory over Tulane on Oct. 30, the Roadrunners ran their record under Traylor to a perfect 22-0 in regular season conference home games and 24-0 against league foes when including the 2021 and 2022 Conference USA Championship Games at the Alamodome. Since Traylor — the winningest coach in program history — arrived in San Antonio, UTSA has captured a pair of conference championships, earned five straight bowl berths with back-to-back bowl wins and made a combined 23 appearances in the three major national polls. He has coached nine All-Americans, three national award finalists, 91 all-conference selections and a trio of NFL Draft picks at UTSA.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

This will mark the third meeting on the gridiron between UTSA and East Carolina with each team winning on its home turf over the past two seasons. The Roadrunners registered a 41-27 victory on Oct. 28, 2023, at the Alamodome while the Pirates pulled out a 30-20 decision on Sept. 28, 2024, in Greenville, North Carolina.

#### **SCOUTING EAST CAROLINA**

The Pirates used a late touchdown pass to upend Memphis, 31-27, at home on Saturday night, running their record to 7-3 overall and 5-1 in the American Conference. East Carolina is averaging 466.3 yards and 33.6 points per game while allowing 339.1 yards and 18.3 points per contest. Katin Houser has completed 231 of 347 passes for 2,801 yards and 15 touchdowns. His top target is Anthony Smith, who has 51 receptions for 745 yards and four TDs. London Montgomery paces the ground game with 637 yards and seven scores on 128 attempts. Defensively, Ja'Marley Riddle leads the way with 58 tackles, five pass breakups and a pair of interceptions, while Zion Wilson has team highs of eight tackles for loss and five sacks. Head coach Blake Harrell is 12-4 in his second season at the helm. ECU offensive line coach Matt Mattox was a former assistant coach at UTSA from 2020 to 2022.
